TIPOFF

• Kansas Women's Basketball returns home to Allen Fieldhouse on Wednesday evening for a non-conference matchup with former Big 12 Conference foe Texas A&M.

• Tipoff is set for 7 p.m. CT and the game will be televised by Big 12 NOW with Josh Klingler and Jill Dorsey-Hall on the call. Jayhawk fans can also listen to the game on the Jayhawk Radio Network from Learfield, with Steven Davis and David Lawrence calling the action.

• The Jayhawks improved to 5-0 on the year with victories over Maine and Saint Mary's last weekend at the Saint Mary's Thanksgiving Classic. With the wins, KU is now 5-0 for the first time since 2018-19 and the fourth time under head coach Brandon Schneider.

• Texas A&M comes to Lawrence with a record of 4-2 following a 66-58 defeat against Rice on Sunday. The Aggies have victories over Texas A&M-Corpus Christi, Army, Texas Southern and Texas State, while its other defeat came at Duke on Nov. 17.

• Wednesday night's matchup will be the first meeting between Kansas and Texas A&M since the Aggies left the Big 12 Conference. KU and A&M were conference foes from 1997-2012, with the Aggies holding a 12-7 advantage in the all-time series.

• Wednesday's game will be Native American Heritage Night at Allen Fieldhouse, featuring special performance and interactions from select Native American groups.

KANSAS NOTES

• Kansas is 5-0 on the year, coming off three-straight victories by 20+ points. The Jayhawks have held the last three opponents to less than 55 points and currently rank second in the Big 12 with a scoring defense of 56.0 points per game.

• Leading the way for Kansas is center Taiyanna Jackson, who has had a superb start to her senior season at KU. Jackson currently leads the Jayhawks in scoring (16.0), rebounding (10.0), blocks (15) and field goal percentage (66.0%), and her three double-doubles is the most of any player in the Big 12 Conference.

• In KU's win at Saint Mary's, Jackson put together perhaps her best performance in a Jayhawk uniform. She recorded her third double-double of the season with a career-high 24 points and 10 rebounds, while adding a season-best five blocked shots and two assists.

• For the year, Jackson leads the Big 12 in rebounds, blocks, field goal percentage and double-doubles, while ranking fifth in scoring.

• KU has four players averaging better double figures in scoring and six players at 9.0 points per game or better. Behind Jackson are Zakiyah Franklin (12.6), Holly Kersgieter (12.4) and Wyvette Mayberry (12.2), with Chandler Prater not far behind at 9.6 points per game.

• With a season-high 21 points against Maine, Franklin became the 31st player in program history to score 1,000 points in a Jayhawk uniform.

ABOUT THE JAYHAWKS

- Among the four starters returning for Kansas are Preseason All-Big 12 selections Holly Kersgieter, Zakiyah Franklin and Taiyanna Jackson.
- Kersgieter earned preseason recognition from the Big 12 for the third-straight season, having previously garnered honorable mention prior to each of the past two seasons. She was named 2022 All-Big 12 First Team as a junior after leading the Jayhawks in scoring at 13.4 points per game. During the 2021-22 season, Kersgieter surpassed the 1,000-point milestone for her career and she entered the year ranked No. 24 on KU's all-time scoring list.
- Franklin earned All-Big 12 Honorable Mention honors last season after averaging 12.0 points per game and she led the Jayhawks with 4.0 assists per game. Franklin entered her senior season ranked 10th on KU's all-time career assists and she was second in the Big 12 in free throw percentage (85.6%) last season.
- Jackson claimed a spot on the All-Big 12 preseason team for the first time following a dominant first season at KU. She became the first-ever Jayhawk selected to the Big 12 All-Defensive Team last season after setting a new single-season school record with 95 blocked shots, which ranked fourth in the nation.
- Kansas also returns junior forward Ioanna Chatzileonti, who was third on the team in scoring (9.9 points per game) and second in rebounding (5.6 per game) last season.
- Junior transfer Wyvette Mayberry projects to have the biggest role of the newcomers after playing the first two seasons of her collegiate career at Tulsa. Mayberry started 44 games over two years at Tulsa and was an All-Conference Second Team selection in 2021-22 after leading TU in scoring at 14.1 points per game.

ABOUT THE OPPONENT

- From College Station, Texas, the Aggies were picked to finish 11th in the SEC Preseason Media Poll after reaching the semifinals of the Southeastern Conference Tournament in 2021.
- Texas A&M returns nine players from last year's team, which finished 14-15 overall and 4-12 in league play. The Aggies are led by freshman forward Janiah Barker, who is averaging a team-high 14.0 points and 7.5 rebounds per game.
- Joni Taylor, the 2021 SEC Coach of the Year at Georgia, is in her first season leading Texas A&M after she joined the Aggies this offseason as the eighth women's basketball head coach in program history.

NATIONAL SIGNING DAY RECAP

- Head Coach Brandon Schneider announced the addition of guards **Laia Conesa** and **S'Mya Nichols** on November 9, the first day of the early signing period.
- Both players will join the Jayhawks as freshmen for the 2023-24 season. Conesa is a 5-10 guard coming to Kansas from Barcelona, Spain, while Nichols is staying close to home and joining the Jayhawks from Overland Park, Kansas.
- Nichols, a five-star prospect and No. 22-ranked prospect in the country by Collegiate Girls Basketball Report, becomes the highest-rated high school prospect signed by Kansas in Schneider's tenure.

- The Jayhawks reached several milestones during the 2021-22 season, which culminated with a 21-10 record and a trip to the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 2013.
- The 21 wins in 2021-22 was an improvement of 14 wins over the previous season, which is the largest win improvement in school history.
- KU notched the 22nd 20-win season in program history and first since 2012-13, while entering the postseason with 20 wins for the first time since the 1999-2000 season.
- Taiyanna Jackson set a new single-season school record with 95 blocked shots, which ranked fourth in the nation. Jackson led the way as Kansas ranked fifth in the country in blocked shots with 177, which is a new single-season school record.
- The Jayhawks set a new single-season school record for free throw percentage, shooting 75.4% from the stripe. Zakiyah Franklin led the way for KU, shooting 85.6% from the line, which ranks as No. 3 at KU for a single-season..
- KU's defense held opponents to 36.6% shooting year ago, a mark that ranks No. 2 in school history.

THE SERIES

- Kansas and Texas A&M have met 19 times all-time in women's basketball, with the Aggies holding a 12-7 record against the Jayhawks.
- The series dates back to a non-conference matchup in 1987, but the other 18 meetings took place between 1997 and 2012, when Texas A&M was a member of the Big 12 Conference.
- Texas A&M has won the last 11 meetings in the series, with the last matchup being a 78-63 victory on March 8, 2012, in the quarterfinals of the Big 12 Tournament.

FIBA U20 EUROPEAN CHAMPIONSHIPS

- Four Jayhawks were selected to compete for their national teams at the FIBA U20 Women's European Championship, held in July 2022.
- The Jayhawks had two players competing in Group A as Zsófia Telegdy (Hungary) and Sanna Strom (Sweden) competed in Sopron, Hungary. Meanwhile, Ioanna Chatzileonti and Danai Papadopoulou represented Greece in Group B in Skopje, North Macedonia.
- Telegdy helped Hungary to a fifth-place finish, averaging 2.9 points and 3.9 rebounds per game.
- Strom started six games for Sweden and averaged 7.2 points, 4.8 rebounds and 2.5 assists per game.
- Chatzileonti was the third-leading scorer in Group B and nearly averaged a double-double with 18.3 points and 9.9 rebounds per game.
- Papadopoulou averaged 6.6 points and 3.7 rebounds per game while shooting 67.7%.

Brandon Schneider is in his eighth season at the helm of the Kansas Women's Basketball program. He was named the sixth head coach to lead the Jayhawks on April 20, 2015, and he signed a new four-year contract on March 9, 2022, that will keep him in Lawrence through the 2025-26 season.

Schneider guided the Jayhawks to a breakthrough campaign in 2021-22. Kansas finished the season with a record of 21-10, marking the program's first 20-win season since 2012-13, and the Jayhawks had 20 wins during the regular season for the first time since 1999-2000. Schneider was named the 2022 Big 12 Coach of the Year after guiding the Jayhawks to a fifth-place finish with 11 conference victories, the most by a KU team since 1999-2000.

Schneider led Kansas to the 2022 NCAA Tournament, earning a No. 8 seed in the Spokane Regional. The Jayhawks defeated No. 9-seed Georgia Tech, 77-58, in the opening round before falling to eventual regional champion Stanford in the second round. The tournament bid was the 14th in program history for the Jayhawks and first since 2013.

During his tenure at Kansas, Schneider has coached eight players who earned All-Big 12 postseason recognition. The Jayhawks have also had two players named to the Big 12 All-Freshman Team and one named to the Big 12 All-Defensive Team along with three Big 12 Players of the Week and three Freshman of the Week. Schneider has also coached 30 players who received Academic All-Big 12 recognition, including a program-best seven student-athletes earning a spot on the team in 2022. Additionally, Schneider's program set a new team-record with a 3.44 Team GPA in the 2021 fall semester.

Schneider increased the Jayhawks win total in each of his first five seasons in Lawrence, which culminated with a 15-14 record in 2019-20. That year, the Jayhawks finished with a winning record for the first time in seven seasons and were set to play in a postseason tournament prior to the COVID-19 pandemic cancelling the Big 12 Tournament and beyond.

Prior to Kansas, Schneider had a five-year stint at Stephen F. Austin, where he returned SFA to the top of the Southland Conference. Schneider guided SFA to three 20-win seasons and the Ladyjacks won back-to-back league titles in 2013-14 and 2014-15. SFA made three postseason appearances under

Schneider, including the WNIT in 2015 after he was named the Southland Conference Coach of the Year. As head coach at Stephen F. Austin, Schneider was 95-66 overall in five years and 57-29 in Southland Conference play.

Schneider was named head coach of the Ladyjacks on April 20, 2010. Recognized as one of the top names at the NCAA Division II level, Schneider went to Nacogdoches after a highly successful 12-year stint at Emporia State.

The Canyon, Texas native is the second all-time winningest head coach at the NCAA Division II level. At Emporia State, Schneider guided the Lady Hornets to a 306-72 (.810) record, and the 2010 NCAA Division II National Championship. The school's all-time leader in wins and winning percentage, Schneider ranks among the all-time top 10 in fastest coaches to 100 victories, and third fastest among women's basketball coaches.

Schneider spent 12 seasons at ESU guiding the Lady Hornets to 11 NCAA Tournament appearances. During that stretch, Schneider's teams recorded two 30-win seasons and nine 20-win campaigns. Along with the 2010 national championship, Schneider coached ESU to four NCAA Division II South Central Regional titles, two Final Four appearances, six regular-season conference crowns and three league tournament titles.

Schneider was the first MIAA rookie head coach to win both the MIAA regular-season and tournament titles. In 2006, the Kansas Basketball Coaches Association of four-year colleges voted Schneider as its coach of the year. He was also a three-time MIAA Coach of the Year.

The 2010 Bulletin Women's Basketball National Coach of the Year and the WBCA South Central Region Coach of the Year, Schneider's players have reaped the rewards of his guidance. He coached seven All-Americans, including two NCAA Division II Players of the Year, eight conference MVPs and seven players who have gone on to play professionally, including one in the WNBA.

A 1995 honors graduate of Wayland Baptist, Schneider was a four-year letterman in men's basketball for the Pioneers and the school's first-ever Academic All-American, capturing the honor three times.

Schneider was raised in a coaching family. His father, Bob, was a member of the Women's Basketball Hall of Fame Class of 2022 following a 40-year coaching career at the high school and collegiate levels. Bob Schneider was one of the most successful women's coaches at the NCAA Division II level, having served as the head coach at West Texas A&M from 1981-2006. They became the first father/son combination to take teams to the Elite Eight. In addition, Schneider's brother, Brett, is currently the head women's basketball coach at Frank Phillips College in Borger, Texas.

Schneider and his wife Ali, have two sons, Cash and Cole.
