- Kansas (5-2) will face No. 17 Tennessee (7-0) in the third-fourth game of the Players Era, Wednesday, Nov. 26. Tip from MGM Grand Garden Arena is set for 6 p.m. (Central) and the game will be televised on TNT.
- Kansas is coming off a 71-60 win against Syracuse in the second round of the Players Era on Nov. 25 at MGM Grand Garden Arena. Tennessee defeated Houston, 76-73, on Nov. 25.
- Kansas leads the all-time series with Tennessee, 5-3. The Jayhawks won the last meeting, 69-60, on Nov. 22, 2023, in the Maui Invitational played in Honolulu. This series dates back to 2009.
- After its win against Notre Dame, Kansas is 134-24 (84.8%) following a loss in the Bill Self era (2003-04 to present), including 2-0 this season.
- Kansas ranks in the top five of the Big 12 and in the top 20 nationally in blocked shots per game at 6.7. The Jayhawks are second in the league in three-point field goal percentage defense at 24.1 percent. Sophomore Flory Bidunga leads the Big 12 with 18 blocked shots this season and his 2.6 blocks per game rank in the top five in the Big 12 and in the top 35 nationally. Bidunga leads Kansas with a 69.0 field goal percentage which ranks in the top five in the Big 12 and in the top 10 nationally.
- Kansas head coach Bill Self is 614-157 in his 23rd season at KU. Last season, Self became Kansas' all-time winningest coach, surpassing Phog Allen, who was 590-129 in 36 seasons on the KU sidelines. Self is in his 33rd season overall with an 821-262 record. He is one of only four active coaches with 800 or career wins - Rick Barnes, John Calipari, and Kelvin Sampson.

ABOUT KANSAS

Kansas (5-2) is coming off a 71-60 win against Syracuse in the second round of the Players Era on Nov. 25 in Las Vegas. Through seven games, Kansas is averaging 75.6 points per game and has a plus-12.7 scoring margin. The Jayhawks pull down 40.1 rebounds per contest with a plus-7.9 rebound margin. KU averages 15.6 assists, 5.0 steals, and 6.3 blocked shots per contest.

Freshman guard Darryn Peterson leads Kansas with a 21.5 ppg. He has missed the last five contests. Sophomore center Flory Bidunga scores 16.1 points per game and leads KU with 8.6 rebounds per outing. He also leads the team with a 69.0 field goal percentage and 18 blocked shots. Bidunga has two double-doubles this season after his 13 points and 14 rebounds against Syracuse (11/25).

Senior guard Tre White is scoring 14.4 points per contest and his 6.4 rebounds per game are second on the team. White has 36 rebounds in his last four games after his 15 points and 10 rebound double-double against Syracuse.

Redshirt-freshman forward Bryson Tiller (10.0 ppg) has scored 28 points in his last two game. He is third on the team with a 6.1 rebound average. Senior Melvin Council Jr. (9.9 ppg) leads KU with 38 assists, while freshman Kohl Rasario (6.6 ppg) has six games this season.

Other KU regulars include senior guard Jayden Dawson (4.3 ppg, five threes), graduate guard Gee Ngala (4.0 ppg, 4-6 3FGs), redshirt-sophomore guard Jamari McDowell (2.9 ppg, 13.3 minutes per game), redshirt-sophomore guard Elmarko Jackson (one start, 2.4 ppg), and freshman guard Samis Calderon (6.8 minutes per game).

THE KANSAS-TENNESSEE SERIES

Kansas holds a 5-3 series advantage against Tennessee in a series that started in 2009. The Jayhawks won four of the first five meetings, then the Volunteer won the next two. KU won the last meeting, 69-60, in the 2023 Maui Invitational played in Honolulu due to the fires in Maui.

- Kansas posted double-digit offensive rebounds in back-to-back games for the first time this season, and recorded a season high 49 rebounds.
- Kansas shot a season-high 90.0 percent (18-of-20) from the free throw line. The last time Kansas shot 90.0 percent from the free throw line with a minimum of 20 attempts was Nov. 8, 2024 vs. North Carolina when Kansas shot 90.3 percent (28-of-31).
- Kansas has won back-to-back games scoring 71 points. The last time Kansas won consecutive games scoring 71 points or less in each game was when they won three straight from Nov. 22-Dec. 1, 2023 (vs. #7 Tennessee, vs. Eastern Illinois, vs. #4 UConn).

White grabbed a season-high 10 rebounds against Syracuse, and notched his first double-double of the season, and seventh of his career. White recorded three assists for the fourth time this season, and the 17th time in his career.
- Senior Melvin Council Jr. scored 14 points for his third-consecutive game with 10 or more points. Council's five assists marks the fifth time this season he has recorded five or more assists in a game. Council recorded a season high seven rebounds, and has now grabbed five or more rebounds for the third time this season, and 46th time in his career.
- Redshirt-freshman Bryson Tiller finished with 11 points on 5-9 shooting, and marked the second consecutive game scoring in double figures. Tiller grabbed eight rebounds marking his fifth-consecutive game with five or more rebounds, and sixth time this season.
- Redshirt-sophomore Jamari McDowell made his first career start against Syracuse and scored a career-high nine points on 3-of-7 shooting. McDowell grabbed a season-high four rebounds and tied a season high with two assists. McDowell tied a career-high in three pointers made with two, a mark he has only hit one other time in his career against Tennessee on 11-22-23. His 34 minutes also marked a career high, surpassing his previous total of 27.

BIDUNGA NAMED ON BIG 12 STARTING FIVE

Sophomore Flory Bidunga was named to the Big 12 Men's Basketball Starting Five, the league announced Nov. 17. This marks the second straight week a Jayhawk has been named to the Big 12 Starting Five after freshman Darryn Peterson was a member of the inaugural selection Nov. 10.

The Big 12 Men's Basketball Starting Five is voted on by a media panel that votes on weekly honors that include the player and newcomer of the week. The five honored highlight additional strong performances from across the conference.

In Kansas' win against Texas A&M-Corpus Christi, Bidunga recorded eight rebounds with 12 points on 6-7 shooting. In KU's win against Princeton, Bidunga scored a new career high with 25 points on 10-11 shooting from the field marking the second time in his career where he has eclipsed 20-plus points.

Bidunga also grabbed 10 rebounds against Princeton and recorded his first double-double of the season and third of his career. Bidunga was the first Kansas player to have 10 makes in 11 or less attempts since Udoka Azubuike went 10-for-11 on 2-16-18 against Texas and is only the third player in the Bill Self era to accomplish this (Azubuike and Julian Wright).

PETERSON ON TSN PRESEASON ALL-AMERICA FIRST TEAM

On Nov. 10, Darryn Peterson was named to his fourth preseason All-America First Team when The Sporting News (TSN) announced its squad. TSN is one of four outlets which make up Consensus All-America, along with Associated Press, USBWA and NABC. Peterson is on the USBWA and NABC national player of the year watch lists.

PETERSON NAMED ON INAUGURAL BIG 12 STARTING FIVE

Freshman Darryn Peterson was named to the inaugural Big 12 Men's Basketball Starting Five, the league announced Nov. 10.

The Big 12 Men's Basketball Starting Five is voted on by a media panel that votes on weekly honors that include the player and newcomer of the week. The five honored highlight additional strong performances from across the conference.

In the first week of the season, Peterson finished with 22 points at No. 25 North Carolina Friday after scoring 21 in the opener versus Green Bay on Nov. 3. The Canton, Ohio, guard is the first KU freshman to have back-to-back 20-point games since Ochai Agbaji (2/9/19 and 2/11/19). He's also the first KU player, regardless of class, to open the season with back-to-back 20-efforts since Agbaji did it in the first two games of the 2021-22 season.

On Oct. 30, Peterson was named to the 20-member NABC 20-member 2026 NABC Division I Player of the Year Preseason Watch List, the National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC).

Peterson is looking to become the third Jayhawk to win the Naismith Division I Player of the Year joining Danny Manning (1988) and Frank Mason III (2017).

Peterson is looking to become the second Jayhawk to win the Oscar Robertson Trophy joining Frank Mason III (2017).

Peterson is looking to become the fourth Jayhawk to win the NABC Player of the Year joining Drew Gooden (2002), Nick Collison (2003), and Frank Mason III (2017).

PETERSON AND BIDUNGA NAMED NAISMITH STARTING FIVE TOP 20 WATCH LISTS

In late October, freshman Darryn Peterson was named to the 20-member Bob Cousy Point Guard of the Year Watch List, while sophomore Flory Bidunga was named to the 20-member Kareem Abdul-Jabbar Center of the Year Watch List.

Peterson is looking to become the second Jayhawk to win the Bob Cousy Award joining Frank Mason III, the 2017 recipient. The only other Jayhawk to win a Naismith Starting Five award was Jalen Wilson in 2023 when he garnered the Julius Irving Small Forward of the Year Award.

PETERSON NAMED PRESEASON BIG 12 FRESHMAN OF THE YEAR

Kansas freshman sensation Darryn Peterson has been named the Big 12 Preseason Player of the Year and preseason all-conference as the league announced its coaches' preseason honors today.

Historically, Peterson is the 10th Jayhawk to be named Big 12 Preseason Freshman of the Year in the 30-year history of the conference. He joins Quentin Grimes (2018-19), Jackson (2016-17), Cheick Diallo (2015-16), Cliff Alexander (co-2014-15), Wiggins (2013-14), Josh Selby (2010-11), Julian Wright (2005-06), David Padgett (co-2003-04), and Nick Collison (1999-2000).

ELEVEN JAYHAWKS ON NBA OPENING DAY ROSTERS

A proud NBA tradition continued this season as Kansas men's basketball had 11 players on NBA opening day rosters heading into the 2025-26 season. .

Three Jayhawks have won NBA titles in the last four seasons with Andrew Wiggins of the Golden State Warriors in 2022, Christian Braun of the Denver Nuggets in 2023 and Sviatoslav Mykhailiuk, who won the 2024 title with the Boston Celtics.

On Oct. 20, 2025, Braun signed a five-year contract extension with the Nuggets after a strong three-year start to his professional career. Wiggins currently plays for the Miami Heat, while Mykhailiuk plays for the Utah Jazz.

Two NBA teams have Jayhawk teammates entering the 2025-26 season with Joel Embiid and Kelly Oubre Jr. of the Philadelphia 76ers and Ochai Agbaji and Grady Dick on the Toronto Raptors. Additional Jayhawks on opening day rosters included: Hunter Dickinson (New Orleans Pelicans), Johnny Furphy (Indiana Pacers), Kevin McCullar Jr. (New York Knicks) and Jalen Wilson (Brooklyn Nets).

CLOSE CALLS

Kansas went 4-3 in games decided by five points or less or in overtime in 2024-25. In 2023-24, Kansas posted a 7-3 record in games decided by five points or less. In 2022-23, Kansas had 11 games decided by five points or less and/or in overtime. KU went 9-2 in those contests. In Kansas' 2021-22 national championship season, KU also played 11 games with the outcome being decided by five points or less or in overtime. KU went 9-2 in those contests.

KANSAS VS. TOP-25 TEAMS

Kansas is 0-2 against Associated Press Top 25 teams in 2025-26. KU went 4-4 versus AP ranked foes in 2024-25. In 2023-24, Kansas went 7-5 against AP ranked opponents, including 4-2 versus top 10. In the Bill Self era, KU is 131-83 against AP-ranked opponents, including 53-35 versus Top-10 foes. Entering 2025-26, Self's KU teams have collected seven or more wins against ranked foes in four of the last five and five of the last seven seasons.

Kansas' record against top-10 ranked opponents in Allen Fieldhouse is even more impressive. KU is 25-18 against foes ranked inside the top-10 of the AP poll since 2013-14. Since Bill Self's first season, 2003-04, the Jayhawks are 26-6 against AP top-10 teams inside Allen Fieldhouse and have won 10 of their last 12 such meetings.

Six Jayhawks scored in double figures, led by senior Richard Scott with 16 points. Three Jayhawks also posted double-doubles in the game: junior Greg Ostertag with 13 points and 12 rebounds, freshman Scot Pollard with 10 points and 11 rebounds and freshman Jacques Vaughn with 11 points and 10 assists. Kansas went on to finish 27-8 that year, advancing to the Sweet 16 in the NCAA Tournament.

WINNING THE BIG 12 IS NO CAKEWALK

The Big 12 has led all conferences in average NET ranking in four of the last five seasons and has been the top ranked Conference in NET/RPI (prior to 2019) in nine of the past 12 seasons.

The stoutness of the Big 12 is also highlighted by KU's strength of schedule during this stretch, which has been among the toughest every season. The Jayhawks have posted a top-10 strength of schedule 14 times in Bill Self's 22 seasons at KU, which includes the nation's strongest schedule six times - 2004-05, 2013-14, 2014-15, 2018-19 and 2022-23.

KANSAS NOTABLES

- Kansas is 220-2 under Bill Self, since 2003-04, when holding foes to 59 or less points, including 2-0 this season.
- Kansas allowed 51 points in the season opener against Green Bay (11/3), marking the fewest allowed in a season opener since allowing 50 to Western Michigan 69-50 in 1993.
- Kansas has won 22-straight non-conference games at in Allen Fieldhouse beginning on Nov. 7, 2022. Kansas is 161-6 (96.4%) against non-conference opponents inside Allen Fieldhouse under Bill Self.
- Kansas is 134-24 (84.8%) following a loss in the Bill Self era (2003-04 to present), including 2-0 this season.
- For 55 weeks, from the first poll of the 2021-22 season until Feb. 26, 2024, KU was ranked in the Associated Press Top 10.

- Under Bill Self, Kansas is 24-4 (85.7%) in Allen Fieldhouse against teams ranked higher than KU. The losses were March 1, 2025 vs. Texas Tech (78-73), Jan. 25, 2025 vs. Houston (92-86 2OT) and Dec. 1, 2005 vs. Nevada (72-70) and KU has won 16 of the last 18 in that scenario.

- Under Bill Self, Kansas is 26-6 (81.3%) against AP top-10 teams in games played in Allen Fieldhouse, including 2-2 in 2024-25. KU has won 10 of its last 12 against AP Top-10 foes in AFH dating back to Feb. 27, 2021.

- Kansas has won its eight of its last 10 games against Blue Blood schools. The wins include: North Carolina and Duke in 2024-25; Indiana, UConn and Kentucky in 2023-24; Kentucky, Indiana and Duke in 2022-23; and North Carolina in the 2022 NCAA title game.

- Kansas is 89-8 in its last 97 games when outrebounding its opponent. Included was a 61-game streak when KU outrebounded its opponent.

- KU has won 85 of its last 87 games in Allen Fieldhouse when leading at halftime, dating back to the beginning of the 2018-19 season.

- Kansas is 118-18 (86.8%) in the month of December under coach Bill Self (since 2003-04). KU has won 26 of its last 29 games in the month of December beginning with the final game of the 2019-20 season.

- Kansas men's basketball posted a 3.12 grade point average in the spring 2025 semester.

- With the 86-51 win against Furman on Nov. 30, 2024, Kansas won its 2,400th all-time game, becoming only the second school to achieve 2,400 wins at that time - 1. Kentucky (2,425); 2. KANSAS (2,419); 3. North Carolina (2,400).

- Kansas has been ranked in 313 of the last 320 Associated Press polls dating back to Feb. 2, 2009. Included was a streak of 231 polls from 2.2.2009 until 2.1.2021. Kansas' 80 consecutive weeks from 2.15.2021 until 2.16.25.

- Kansas' 2002 team remains as the only team in Big 12 history to go undefeated in Big 12 play. Kansas went 16-0 in 2002.

- Kansas has won 10 or more home games for 39 of the last 40 seasons, beginning in 1983-84. KU has won 12 or more in Allen Fieldhouse for 25 of the last 26 seasons beginning in 1999-2000 (9-3 in 2018 due to vacated wins).

- Kansas won its mind-boggling 52nd-straight home opener with an 87-57 win against Howard on Nov. 4, 2024. The streak began in 1973-74 under head coach Ted Owens. KU coaches Larry Brown (5-0) and Roy Williams (15-0) never lost a home opener. KU is 22-0 in home openers in the Bill Self era.

- Kansas has won 33 of its last 34 conference openers, beginning in 1991-92 under head coach Roy Williams. The 33-game streak ended with a KU 62-61 loss to West Virginia on 12/31/24.

- Beginning in 1983-84 under coach Larry Brown, Kansas has not lost a home finale which is a span of 42 seasons.
