THE KU WIN...

- Gives Kansas its 53rd-consecutive home opening win, a streak that began in 1973-74
- Makes Kansas 1-0 all-time against Green Bay and 9-0 versus current membership of the Horizon League.
- Makes Kansas 1-0 in Allen Fieldhouse this season and 870-121 all-time in the venue, including 332-21 under Bill Self
- Makes Self 610-156 while at Kansas, 817-261 all-time and 1-0 versus Green Bay
- Makes Kansas 2,415-909 all time.

TEAM NOTES

- The Jayhawks had nine players make their Kansas debut in Monday's win. All nine players scored in the victory. The players making their debuts included: Peterson (21 points), Melvin Council Jr. (10), Tre White (9), Bryson Tiller (7), Kohl Rosario (6), Jayden Dawson (5), Nginyu Ngala (5), Samis Calderon (1) and Paul Mbiya (1).
- Kansas allowed 51 points in the season opener, marking the fewest allowed in a season opener since allowing 50 to Western Michigan 69-50 in 1993.
- Kansas outscored Green Bay 24-2 in fast break points and 17-2 in points off turnovers. The Jayhawks also outscored Green Bay 38-16 in points in the paint.
- Kansas shot 56.9 percent from the floor in the win, which marked the team's best percentage in a game since shooting 60.9 percent in a 86-51 win over Furman on Nov. 30, 2024.
- The Jayhawks finished with 20 assists to just three turnovers in the win. It marks the first time Kansas registered 20 or more assists with three or less turnovers since at least the 1989-90 season.
- Kansas' three turnovers were its fewest since KU had two turnovers against Oklahoma on Jan. 13, 2024 and is tied for the program's second-fewest turnovers in a game in the Big 12 era. The Jayhawks also turned it over three times against Texas in 2015 in Austin.

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

- Sophomore Flory Bidunga recorded his first 20-point game and set a new career high with 23 points on 9-11 shooting from the field. Bidunga also led the team with six rebounds and shot 5-6 from the free throw line. Bidunga made his first nine shots.
- Bidunga registered three blocks in the win, marking the 14th time in his KU career that he has multiple blocks in a game.
- Freshman Darryn Peterson's 21 points is the most points in a Kansas debut by a freshman since Gradey Dick had 23 against Omaha (11-7-2022).
- Darryn Peterson and Flory Bidunga combined for 34 points in the first half of Monday's win. The duo combined to shoot 12-16 from the floor and 8-8 from the free throw line.
- Flory Bidunga's 23 points and Darryn Peterson's 21 points is the first time two Kansas players both scored 20-plus in a season opener since 2023 with Kevin McCullar (22) and Hunter Dickinson (21) against North Carolina Central.
- Senior Melvin Council Jr. recorded his 58th game with 10-plus points in Division I after scoring 10 points on 4-5 shooting from the field. Council finished the game with five rebounds and led the team with four assists.
- Freshman Kohl Rosario led the team with three offensive rebounds. Rosario finished the game with six points, three assists, and five total rebounds.
