- No. 21 Kansas (6-2) will host No. 5 UConn (6-1) on Tuesday, Dec. 2. Tip from Allen Fieldhouse is set for 8 p.m. (Central) and the game will be televised on ESPN2.
- Tuesday's contest will recognize Hoops4ALS. Hoops4ALS is dedicated to uniting basketball coaches, players, and fans to raise awareness for amyotrophic lateral sclerosis (ALS) – also known as Lou Gehrig's Disease.
- Kansas is coming off an 81-76 win against No. 17 Tennessee in the third-place game at the Players Era on Nov. 26 in Las Vegas. KU went 3-0 in the event. UConn defeated No. 13 Illinois, 74-61, on Nov. 28 at Madison Square Garden in New York City.
- Kansas leads the all-time series with UConn, 4-0. In the last meeting, then-No. 5 Kansas defeated then-No. 4 UConn, 69-65, on Dec. 1, 2023, in Allen Fieldhouse.
- Under Bill Self, since the 2003-04 season, Kansas is 12-1 against Associated Press top-five teams in Allen Fieldhouse.
- Kansas has won 23-straight non-conference games at Allen Fieldhouse beginning on Nov. 7, 2022. Kansas is 162-6 (96.4%) against non-conference foes inside Allen Fieldhouse under Bill Self.
- Kansas leads the Big 12 and is seventh nationally in blocked shots per game at 6.5. KU also leads the conference and is seventh nationally in 3FG percentage defense. The Jayhawks are second in the league in field goal percentage defense at 37.4 percent, which is 23rd nationally. Sophomore Flory Bidunga leads the Big 12 with 21 blocked shots this season and his 2.6 blocks per game are first in the Big 12 and 11th nationally. Bidunga also leads the league with a 62.8 field goal percentage, which is 29th nationally.

ABOUT KANSAS

No. 21 Kansas (6-2) finished 3-0 and in third place at the Players Era, Nov. 24-26, in Las Vegas after its 81-76 win against No. 17 Tennessee on Nov. 26. Through eight games, Kansas is averaging 76.3 points per game and has a plus-11.8 scoring margin. The Jayhawks pull down 39.8 rebounds per contest with a plus-7.0 rebound margin. KU averages 15.1 assists, 4.8 steals, and 6.5 blocked shots per contest. KU leads the Big 12 blocked shots (6.5), which is seventh nationally, and in 3FG Percentage Defense (24.5%), which is seventh nationally, and is second in FG Percentage Defense (37.4%), which is 21st nationally and

Sophomore center Flory Bidunga scores 15.8 points per game and leads KU with 8.4 rebounds per outing. He leads the Big 12 with a 62.8 field goal percentage, which is 29th nationally, and in blocked shots per game at 2.6, which is 11th nationally. Bidunga has a team best two double-doubles this season.

Senior guard Tre White is scoring 14.4 points per contest and his 6.4 rebounds per game are tied for second on the team. White has 42 rebounds in his last five games.

Senior Melvin Council Jr. (10.8 ppg) leads KU with 42 assists. His 4.2 assist-to-turnover ratio is third in the Big 12 and 25th nationally.

Redshirt-freshman forward Bryson Tiller (9.5 ppg) has scored 34 points in his last three game. He pulls down 6.4 rebounds per game and has 26 boards in his last three outings.

Redshirt-sophomore guard Jamari McDowell (3.4 ppg) has started the last two games, while redshirt-sophomore guard Elmarko Jackson (4.3 ppg, one start) is coming off a career-high 17 points against Tennessee (11/26). Freshman Kohl Rasario (6.4 ppg) has started four games this season.

Other KU regulars include senior guard Jayden Dawson (4.3 ppg, five threes), graduate guard Gee Ngala (4.0 ppg, 4-6 3FGs), and freshman guard Samis Calderon (6.8 minutes per game). Freshman guard Darryn Peterson leads Kansas with a 21.5 ppg. He has missed the last six contests.

ABOUT UCONN

Located in Storrs, Conn., No. 5 UConn is 6-1 on the season after its 74-61 win against No. 13 Illinois on Nov. 28, in Madison Square Garden. The Huskies are coached by Dan Hurley who is 171-70 in his eighth year at UConn and 322-175 in his 16th year as a college coach.

UConn averages 82.4 points per game and has a plus-21.1 scoring margin. The Huskies pull down 36.4 rebounds per contest with a plus-5.7 rebound margin. UConn averages 18.9 assists, 8.7 steals and 5.4 blocked shots per game.

Senior center Tarris Reed Jr. leads UConn with a 15.5 scoring average and an 8.3 rebound average. Reed is tied for the team lead with eight blocked shots. Junior guard Solo Ball is next in scoring at 14.3 points per game and he is second on the team with 12 three-pointers made. Redshirt-senior forward Alex Karaban leads UConn with 16 threes made and he averages 14.0 points and 5.7 rebounds per game. Junior guard Silas Demary Jr. (12.0 ppg) leads the

In the first week of the season, Peterson finished with 22 points at No. 25 North Carolina Friday after scoring 21 in the opener versus Green Bay on Nov. 3. The Canton, Ohio, guard is the first KU freshman to have back-to-back 20-point games since Ochai Agbaji (2/9/19 and 2/11/19). He's also the first KU player, regardless of class, to open the season with back-to-back 20-efforts since Agbaji did it in the first two games of the 2021-22 season.

PETERSON ON NATIONAL PLAYER OF THE YEAR WATCH LISTS

Kansas freshman Darryn Peterson was named to the 50-member 2026 Naismith Trophy Division I Player of the Year Watch List, the Atlanta Tipoff Club released Nov. 3. PETERSON AND BIDUNGA NAMED NAISMITH STARTING FIVE TOP 20 WATCH LISTS

In late October, freshman Darryn Peterson was named to the 20-member Bob Cousy Point Guard of the Year Watch List, while sophomore Flory Bidunga was named to the 20-member Kareem Abdul-Jabbar Center of the Year Watch List.

Peterson is looking to become the second Jayhawk to win the Bob Cousy Award joining Frank Mason III, the 2017 recipient. The only other Jayhawk to win a Naismith Starting Five award was Jalen Wilson in 2023 when he won the Julius Irving Small Forward of the Year Award.

PETERSON, PRESEASON BIG 12 FRESHMAN OF THE YEAR

Kansas freshman sensation Darryn Peterson has been named the Big 12 Preseason Player of the Year and preseason all-conference as the league announced its coaches' preseason honors today.

Historically, Peterson is the 10th Jayhawk to be named Big 12 Preseason Freshman of the Year in the 30-year history of the conference. He joins Quentin Grimes (2018-19), Jackson (2016-17), Cheick Diallo (2015-16), Cliff Alexander (co-2014-15), Wiggins (2013-14), Josh Selby (2010-11), Julian Wright (2005-06), David Padgett (co-2003-04), and Nick Collison (1999-2000).

Kansas is 1-2 against Associated Press Top 25 teams in 2025-26. KU went 4-4 versus AP ranked foes in 2024-25. In 2023-24, Kansas went 7-5 against AP ranked opponents, including 4-2 versus top 10. In the Bill Self era, KU is 132-83 against AP-ranked opponents, including 53-35 versus Top-10 foes. Entering 2025-26, Self's KU teams have collected seven or more wins against ranked foes in four of the last five and five of the last seven seasons.

Kansas' record against top-10 ranked opponents in Allen Fieldhouse is even more impressive. KU is 25-18 against foes ranked inside the top-10 of the AP poll since 2013-14. Since Bill Self's first season, 2003-04, the Jayhawks are 26-6 against AP top-10 teams, 12-1 versus top-5 foes, inside Allen Fieldhouse and have won 10 of their last 12 meetings against top-10 teams.

With its 2022-23 championship, Kansas claimed its 21st Big 12 regular-season title. KU's 63 all-time conference titles are the most in NCAA Division I history. Kentucky is second with 53. The Jayhawks have claimed 16 outright or shared league titles since 2003-04 (i.e. the Bill Self era).

Dec. 2, 1957: Behind 30 points from junior Wilt Chamberlain, Kansas opened the 1957-58 season with a 63-56 win at Oklahoma State. Junior guard Ron Loneski scored 14 points for KU. Kansas finished the season 18-5 and would win the Big Seven Holiday Tournament and place second in the league race with an 8-4 record.

KANSAS NOTABLES

- Kansas is 220-2 under Bill Self, since 2003-04, when holding foes to 59 or less points, including 2-0 this season.
- Kansas allowed 51 points in the season opener against Green Bay (11/3), marking the fewest allowed in a season opener since allowing 50 to Western Michigan 69-50 in 1993.
- Kansas has won 23-straight non-conference games at in Allen Fieldhouse beginning on Nov. 7, 2022. Kansas is 162-6 (96.4%) against non-conference opponents inside Allen Fieldhouse under Bill Self.
- Against Princeton (11/15), Flory Bidunga went 10-11 FGs and was the first Kansas player to have 10 makes in 11 or less attempts since Udoka Azubuike went 10-for-11 on 2-16-18 against Texas and is only the third player in the Bill Self era to accomplish this (Azubuike and Julian Wright).
- Kansas is 134-24 (84.8%) following a loss in the Bill Self era (2003-04 to present), including 2-0 this season.
- For 55 weeks, from the first poll of the 2021-22 season until Feb. 26, 2024, KU was ranked in the Associated Press Top 10.
- Under Bill Self, Kansas is 24-4 (85.7%) in Allen Fieldhouse against teams ranked higher than KU. The losses were March 1, 2025 vs. Texas Tech (78-73), Jan. 25, 2025 vs. Houston (92-86 2OT) and Dec. 1, 2005 vs. Nevada (72-70) and KU has won 16 of the last 18 in that scenario.
- Under Bill Self, Kansas is 26-6 (81.3%) against AP top-10 teams in games played in Allen Fieldhouse, including 2-2 in 2024-25. KU has won 10 of its last 12 against AP Top-10 foes in AFH dating back to Feb. 27, 2021. KU is 12-1 versus AP top-5 teams in that span.

- Kansas has won its eight of its last 10 games against Blue Blood schools. The wins include: North Carolina and Duke in 2024-25; Indiana, UConn and Kentucky in 2023-24; Kentucky, Indiana and Duke in 2022-23; and North Carolina in the 2022 NCAA title game.
- Kansas is 92-8 in its last 100 games when outrebounding its opponent, including 6-2 this season. Included was a 61-game streak when KU outrebounded its opponent.
- KU has won 85 of its last 87 games in Allen Fieldhouse when leading at halftime, dating back to the beginning of the 2018-19 season.
- Kansas is 118-18 (86.8%) in the month of December under coach Bill Self (since 2003-04). KU has won 26 of its last 29 games in the month of December beginning with the final game of the 2019-20 season.
- Kansas men's basketball posted a 3.12 grade point average in the spring 2025 semester.
- With the 86-51 win against Furman on Nov. 30, 2024, Kansas won its 2,400th all-time game, becoming only the second school to achieve 2,400 wins at that time - 1. Kentucky (2,427); 2. KANSAS (2,420); 3. North Carolina (2,401).
- Kansas has been ranked in 314 of the last 321 Associated Press polls dating back to Feb. 2, 2009. Included was a streak of 231 polls from 2.2.2009 until 2.1.2021. Kansas' 80 consecutive weeks from 2.15.2021 until 2.16.25.
- Kansas' 2002 team remains as the only team in Big 12 history to go undefeated in Big 12 play. Kansas went 16-0 in 2002.
- Kansas has won 10 or more home games for 39 of the last 40 seasons, beginning in 1983-84. KU has won 12 or more in Allen Fieldhouse for 25 of the last 26 seasons beginning in 1999-2000 (9-3 in 2018 due to vacated wins).
- Kansas won its mind-boggling 52nd-straight home opener with an 87-57 win against Howard on Nov. 4, 2024. The streak began in 1973-74 under head coach Ted Owens. KU coaches Larry Brown (5-0) and Roy Williams (15-0) never lost a home opener. KU is 22-0 in home openers in the Bill Self era.
- Kansas has won 33 of its last 34 conference openers, beginning in 1991-92 under head coach Roy Williams. The 33-game streak ended with a KU 62-61 loss to West Virginia on 12/31/24.
- Beginning in 1983-84 under coach Larry Brown, Kansas has not lost a home finale which is a span of 42 seasons.

ELEVEN JAYHAWKS ON NBA OPENING DAY ROSTERS

A proud NBA tradition continued this season as Kansas men's basketball had 11 players on NBA opening day rosters heading into the 2025-26 season.

Three Jayhawks have won NBA titles in the last four seasons with Andrew Wiggins of the Golden State Warriors in 2022, Christian Braun of the Denver Nuggets in 2023 and Sviatoslav Mykhailiuk, who won the 2024 title with the Boston Celtics.

On Oct. 20, 2025, Braun signed a five-year contract extension with the Nuggets after a strong three-year start to his professional career. Wiggins currently plays for the Miami Heat, while Mykhailiuk plays for the Utah Jazz.

Two NBA teams have Jayhawk teammates entering the 2025-26 season with Joel Embiid and Kelly Oubre Jr. of the Philadelphia 76ers and Ochai Agbaji and Grady Dick on the Toronto Raptors. Additional Jayhawks on opening day rosters included: Hunter Dickinson (New Orleans Pelicans), Johnny Furphy (Indiana Pacers), Kevin McCullar Jr. (New York Knicks) and Jalen Wilson (Brooklyn Nets).

WINNING THE BIG 12 IS NO CAKEWALK

The Big 12 has led all conferences in average NET ranking in four of the last five seasons and has been the top ranked Conference in NET/RPI (prior to 2019) in nine of the past 12 seasons.

The stoutness of the Big 12 is also highlighted by KU's strength of schedule during this stretch, which has been among the toughest every season. The Jayhawks have posted a top-10 strength of schedule 14 times in Bill Self's 22 seasons at KU, which includes the nation's strongest schedule six times - 2004-05, 2013-14, 2014-15, 2018-19 and 2022-23.

- With the 77-69 win versus Michigan State on Nov. 12, 2024, Bill Self became the winningest head coach in Kansas history, surpassing Phog Allen’s 590 mark.
 - With the 84-66 win against UNCW on Nov. 19, 2024, Bill Self won his 800th career game.
 - Self was named the eighth coach in Kansas basketball history on April 21, 2003.
 - In September 2017, Self was inducted into the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame in Springfield, Massachusetts.
 - Self earned career win No. 800 with an 84-66 win over UNCW on Nov. 19, 2024. Self is the fourth-fastest coach of all time to reach the 800-win milestone and just the 16th ever to reach the feat.
 - Self won his 700th career game on Feb. 8, 2020, with KU’s 60-46 win at TCU. He became the 31st coach in NCAA Division I to accomplish the feat, the second youngest and the sixth fastest.
 - While at Kansas, Self has won two national championships (2008, 2022), 16 regular-season Big 12 Conference titles, including a KU- and NCAA-record-tying 13-straight titles from 2005-17, and eight league tournament titles.
 - At Kansas, Self has won 16 regular-season league titles with just 18 losses in Allen Fieldhouse. With KU’s win versus Siena (11/18/16), Self became the winningest coach in Allen Fieldhouse, posting his 207th victory in the venue.
 - In his first trip to the Final Four in 2008, Self’s Kansas team won the title. Self is one of three active coaches in NCAA Division I to have won multiple national titles (Rick Pitino and Dan Hurley) and one of 17 all-time with multiple titles.
 - While at Kansas, he has coached 13 NBA Lottery selections including Andrew Wiggins and Joel Embiid, the No. 1 and No. 3 overall selections in the 2014 NBA Draft. Wiggins was the second-ever Jayhawk to go No. 1 with the other being Danny Manning in 1988.
 - Self has guided his teams to 23-win seasons in 24 of the last 26 seasons dating back to 1998-99.
 - Self’s teams have won 20 regular-season league crowns in the last 25 years. His teams have never finished lower than third in the conference.
 - Self’s 10 career 30-win seasons are tied for third most in NCAA history - Mike Krzyzewski (16), Roy Williams (12), John Calipari (10); and is tied for No. 1 on the active coaches’ list. Nine of his 10 30-win seasons have been at Kansas.
 - Self was the head coach for Team USA’s U18 team that competed and won gold at the 2018 FIBA Americas Championship held in St. Catharines, Canada, in the summer of 2018.
 - Self is one of five coaches in NCAA Division I history to have led three different teams - Tulsa, Illinois and Kansas - to the NCAA Elite Eight, including eight times with KU (2004-07-08-11-12-16-17-22). The other coaches are: Gene Bartow, John Calipari, Rick Pitino and Eddie Sutton.
 - A 1985 graduate of Oklahoma State, Self began his coaching career as a graduate assistant at Kansas in 1985-86 under head coach Larry Brown. He then returned to his alma mater as an assistant for seven seasons under coaches Leonard Hamilton and Eddie Sutton. His first head coaching job was at Oral Roberts in 1993-94, then Tulsa (1997-98), Illinois (2000-03) and Kansas (2003-present).

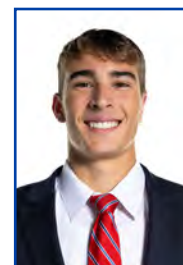

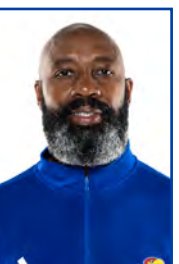

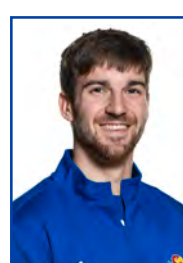
