## POSTGAME QUOTES

### On the line of scrimmage ...

"We hoped it could be this type of game for us, and I thought we controlled some things really well. Defensively, I thought we had another outstanding effort other than one big play that we gave up. Offensively, other than the two turnovers in the end zone, I thought we had a fine day and were very productive."

### On Jalen Daniel's performance ...

"He felt really good, and after that last pass of the half, we wanted to give him one more series before he left the game, and he hit the big play, the explosive play that Emmanuel. He was very much in command, had a couple plays he'd like to have back, but I thought he had an excellent day."

### On Emmanuel Henderson's play ...

"Yeah, heck of a day for him. We know he has a chance to be an explosive player, and he showed that tonight many different ways."

### On defensive line and depth at the defensive tackle position tonight ...

"The ability to rotate there is key for us right now to I think wore them down, especially in second, third quarters.
