The inaugural 2012 WKU/Kenny Perry Invitational at The Club at Olde Stone in Bowling Green, Kentucky will be held Oct. 13-16, 2012 in Bowling Green, Kentucky.

KENNY PERRY

Kenny Perry was a WKU Men's Golf letterwinner from 1979-1982 before turning pro in 1982. During his illustrious professional career, Perry has tallied 14 PGA Tour wins and over 30 top three finishes and over 100 top ten finishes. His career earnings top \$31 million. His career tournament victories include the 1991 Memorial Tournament, 1994 New England Classic, 1995 Bob Hope Chrysler Classic, 2001 Buick Open, 2003 Bank of America Colonial, the 2003 Memorial Tournament, 2003 Greater Milwaukee Open, 2005 Bay Hill Invitational Presented by MasterCard, 2005 Bank of America Colonial, the 2008 Memorial Tournament presented by Morgan Stanley, 2008 Buick Open, 2008 John Deere Classic, 2009 FBR Open and 2009 Travelers Championship.

Perry also competed on the 2004 U.S. Ryder Cup team and then helped lead the U.S. Ryder Cup Team to victory at Valhalla Golf Club in Louisville in 2008. Perry was encouraged by his father, Kenny, Sr., to start playing the game at the age of seven. Perry is a member of the WKU Athletic (1994) and Kentucky Golf (2004) Halls of Fame.

The Club at Olde Stone is designed by Arthur Hills and opened in 2006. In the spring, WKU hosted the Bowling Green Regional of the 2012 NCAA Division I Men's Golf Championships at Olde Stone Country Club. The school also hosted the regional in 2009.
