POST-GAME NOTES: ULM 38, SOUTH ALABAMA 24

TEAM/GAME NOTES

- ULM Captains: Kolton Browning (Offense), DaCorris Ford (Defense) and Cortney Davis (Special Teams)
- South Alabama won the opening coin toss and defered to the second half.
- ULM was held scoreless in the first quarter for the second consecutive week.
- Official Attendance: 14,556

OFFENSE NOTES

- Brent Leonard's second quarter touchdown was his fourth of the season and 11th of his career... Leonard caught his second TD pass of the game later in the second quarter for his first multi-TD game of the season... With six seconds remaining in the first half, Leonard caught his third TD pass of the game -- marking the first time in his career he caught three touchdowns... In the fourth quarter Leonard caught his fourth touchdown pass of the game, tying a single game school-record for touchdown receptions in a game (Stepfret Williams, at Nevada, Oct. 14, 1995).
- Mitch Bailey's third quarter TD run was his first rushing TD of the season... The TD run covered 32 yards and was a career-long rush for Bailey.
- Monterell Washington led the Warhawks with 59 rushing yards (19 attempts).

DEFENSE NOTES

- Gerrard Johnson led ULM with eight tackles... Malcolm Edmond and and Isaiah Newsome added seven tackles each.
- In the fourth quarter, DaCorris Ford recorded his third interception of the season.

SPECIAL TEAM NOTES

- Justin Manton connected on his second field goal of the season (four attempts) with a 35-yard field goal in the fourth quarter... Manton also hit all five PATs Saturday and now sits 42-for-42 on the year and dating back to 2011, he has hit 44 straight.
