## POST-GAME NOTES: ULM 31, MIDDLE TENNESSEE 17

### TEAM/GAME NOTES

- ULM Captains: Jonathon Gill (Offense), Kentarius Caldwell (Defense), Henry Mitchell (Special Teams)
- ULM won the opening coin toss and deferred to the second half.
- Saturday's game marked the second time in the 13-game series that the team scoring first did not win the game (other occurrence - 2009 - Middle Tennessee 38, ULM 19 (Monroe, La.).
- ULM has now won two straight in series with Middle Tennessee (first time ever)... The 31-17 win is ULM's fourth win all-time vs. Middle Tennessee and second in Murfreesboro, Tenn.
- Official Attendance: 21,067

### OFFENSE NOTES

- With a 26-for-38 effort for 285 yards as well as 44 rushing yards on 10 attempts, Kolton Browning now ranks second in career completions, third in career pass attempts, third in total offense and fourth in career passing yards.
- With two rushing touchdowns, Jyruss Edwards is now tied for fourth in program history with 21 career rushing TDs (Steven Jyles, 2002-05).

### DEFENSE NOTES

- Isaiah Newsome's fourth-quarter interception was the first of the season and the fourth of his career.
- R.J Young and Cordero Smith each forced a fumble Saturday... It was Young's third career forced fumble and Smith's second career forced fumble.
- R.J. Young recovered the fumble he forced for his second career fumble recovery, while Rob'Donovan Lewis recovered the other fumble (his first career fumble recovery).
- Cordero Smith and Rob'Donovan Lewis led the team with six tackles each.

### SPECIAL TEAM NOTES

- Justin Manton connected on first FG of season... His 33-yard FG, gave ULM a 10-3 lead with 11:42 to play in the second quarter.
- Cortney Davis set career highs in kickoff return yards (106) and a long return (30 yards)
- In the fourth quarter, Justin Manton completed a jump pass on a fake punt to TE Keavon Milton.
