## TICKET INFORMATION

## AROUND THE SUN BELT

The 2012-13 Sun Belt Conference Women's Basketball season got underway Friday (Nov. 9) night with SBC teams going a combined 5-2, highlighted by Middle Tennessee's victory over Kennesaw State in the first round of the WNIT and WKU's win over Murray State.

## QUICK LOOK AT WARHAWKS

The Warhawks will need to replace a 1,000 point scorer in Larrie Williams, Elizabeth Torres, who finished with the second most assists (452) in program history and Marion Zollicoffer, who appeared in 102 games during her career. ULM will attempt to improve upon a 9-21 season including a 7-9 mark in Sun Belt play. Jasmine Shaw, Alexar Tugler and Ashleigh Simmons will be asked to lead the Warhawks. ULM led by as many by 11 at Stephen F. Austin in the first half on Friday night in the season-opener but a 51-point second half from the Ladyjacks would erase the advantage and SFA cruised to the 80-55 victory. Jasmine Shaw led the Warhawks with 12 points. ULM shot 53.6% (15-for-28) in the first half and just 25.9% (7-for-27) in the second. Four Ladyjacks scored in double-figures, led by 17 from Kali Jerrell.

## TONIGHT'S OPPONENT

Tulane is coming off of a 23-11 season where the Green Wave lost to UTEP in the C-USA Championship game. Tulane was invited to the 2012 WNIT and beat Mississippi Valley State in New Orleans before falling at Texas Tech to end their season. This team returns four starters and 10 letterwinners. Tulane opened the season with a home win over Louisiana Tech, 66-59.

## SCOUTING THE GREEN WAVE

In the season-opening win over Louisiana Tech, Tyria Snow led the Green Wave with 18 points. Also, in double-figures were Olivia Grayson (12) and Janique Kautsky (11). Prior to the season, Tulane was picked to win C-USA and Grayson was named to the C-USA Preseason Team. Head Coach Lisa Stockton (Wake Forest, 1986) is in her 18th season with the Green Wave with a 373-184 record.



## WARHAWK TO WATCH

Junior guard Jasmine Shaw (Flower Mound, Texas / Flower Mound HS) was named to the 2012-13 Preseason All-Sun Belt Third Team. Shaw is the team's leading returning scorer (7.0 PPG) and rebounder (4.8 RPG). Last season, Shaw scored in double figures on eight occasions and led the team in scoring once. Shaw scored a season-high 18 points against Nicholls State and pulled down a team-high rebounds on five occasions. She appeared in all 30 games, making 29 starts and averaging 29.0 minutes per game. In Sun Belt play, the 5-10 versatile guard averaged 7.0 points and 4.9 rebounds per game while shooting 33% from the field. In the exhibition game, Shaw flirted with a triple-double as she scored 22 points with eight rebounds and seven assists. In the season-opener, she led the Warhawks with 12 points.

### TULANE VS. ULM SERIES

Monday will be the 16th meeting between ULM and Tulane with the Green Wave holding a 9-6 advantage including the last six meetings. The last Warhawk win was in Dec. 21, 2003 in Monroe, 70-67. The series began in 1975 with ULM winning, 59-39, during the Southeastern Louisiana Tournament held in Lafayette, La. ULM won the first three ever meetings and four of the first five. In 1994, the two teams met in the WNIT where Tulane won 78-75 in Amarillo, Texas. The Green Wave are 2-3 in Fant-Ewing Coliseum.

## THE LAST TIME OUT

Stephen F. Austin (1-0) handed ULM (0-1) a season-opening loss on Friday night, 80-55. The win for SFA was its fifth straight in the all-time series.

Jasmine Shaw led the way for ULM with 12 points. Four Ladyjacks scored in double-figures led by 17 points from Kali Jerrell.

The Warhawks and its full-court pressure led to an early 6-1 lead on a jumper from Shaw at the 17-minute mark. The lead was stretched to 12-3 on a well-executed inbound play leading to layup from Shaw with 14:39 left in the opening half. ULM led by as many as 11 before a 51-point second half from Ladyjacks allowed SFA to cruise to the victory.

## REPLACING THREE SENIORS

The Warhawks will need to replace 1,000-point scorer (1,078) Larrie Williams, the second most assists in a career (452) from Elizabeth Torres and 28 career starts and the teams leading rebounder (6.2 per game) in 2011-12, Marion Zollicoffer.

## INCONSISTENT PLAY

Last season, the Warhawks started 0-8 before picking up its first win at home against Nicholls State on Dec. 3. After that slow start, ULM went 8-13 the rest of the way including a three-game winning streak to end 2011. Towards the end of the season, the Warhawks won four of six including a 66-35 thrashing of UL-Lafayette on Jan. 28.

## SUN BELT CHANGES

This season, the Sun Belt schedule structure will change as Denver exits to join the WAC, leaving the Sun Belt with 10 members. Each team will play 20 SBC games, twice against each member. The Sun Belt will change again in 2013-14 as Georgia State, UT-Arlington and Texas State join the league.

## DOUBLE-DOUBLES

Three Warhawks turned in four double-doubles last season. Elizabeth Torres tuned in two, the first at Grambling State on Nov. 22 with 13 points and 10 assists and the second against UMKC on Nov. 26 with 15 points and 11 assists. The other two came in the same game as Alexar Tugler (18 points/10 rebounds) and Larrie Williams (25 points/10 rebounds) collected the statistical honor at Northwestern State on Dec. 21.

## WARHAWK NEWCOMERS

The ULM roster will welcome three newcomers for the 2012-13 season. Alayshia Hunter, Ashley Aune and Jasmine Taylor will wear Maroon & Gold for the first time. Hunter joins the team out of Killeen, Texas and Ellison High School where she was an All-State selection in 2011 and 2012. Aune is from Church Point, La. and Sacred Heart High School where she finished her prep career with 1,158 points. Taylor is from Denton, Texas and Denton High School where she averaged 14.0 points per game and was a First Team All-District selection. All three made their debut at SFA.

## SUN BELT IN POSTSEASON

Four Sun Belt teams played in postseason tournaments in 2011-12. UALR won the league's

## COACH MARTIN AT HAWK TALK

Head Coach Mona Martin will be on the weekly radio show with the voice of Warhawk Basketball, Nick White, on ESPN 97.7 FM. automatic bid by winning the Sun Belt Championship, 71-70, in overtime against Middle Tennessee. The Trojans fell in the first round to three seed Delaware, 73-42. Middle Tennessee also made the tournament as an at-large team and lost to seven seed Vanderbilt, 60-46. Both FIU and Florida Atlantic appeared in the WNIT and combined for a 1-2 record with the Panthers defeating Stetson, 75-47. The Sun Belt has 64 total NCAA Tournament wins including a national championship (Old Dominion, 1985) and has sent at least two teams to the NCAA Tournament four out of the last six years, including the last two seasons.

## 2011-12 HIGHLIGHTS

The Dec. 29 victory over Western Kentucky was just the fourth time in 11 attempts that the Warhawks have beaten the Hilltoppers and just the second time since 1986. The 58-54 win over Sun Belt Tournament Champion UALR on Jan. 12 was just the third ever over the Trojans and the first since 2006. The biggest win in terms of points came at home against UL-Lafayette on Jan. 28 with a 66-35 win over the Ragin' Cajuns.

Larrie Williams had her share of individual highlights last season including surpassing the 1,000 point barrier. She scored 28 points at Southern Miss on Dec. 10, the team-high for the season. She eclipsed the 20-point mark on five occasions in 2011-12.

Marion Zollicoffer pulled down a season-high 13 rebounds at UL-Lafayette on Feb. 25 and Elizabeth Torres dished out a season-high 11 assists against UMKC on Nov. 26. Jasmine Shaw collected a season-high five steals against UL-Lafayette on Jan. 28.

## OVERTIME SUCCESS

ULM played in two overtime games last season, losing to UMKC and winning at North Texas, moving its all-time overtime record to 18-16. The Warhawks are 17-15 in single-overtime games and 1-1 in double-overtime contests. At home, ULM is 5-6 in overtime games and 13-10 on the road.

## SEASON OPENERS

In the Mona Martin era, ULM is 7-11 in season openers including 5-3 at home and 2-8 on the road. One season-opening loss was in overtime in Coach Martin's second season at South Alabama, 70-67. Dating back to its first season in 1974-75, ULM is 22-18 in season-openers. The Warhawks won eight straight games to begin the season from 1984 to 1990. The longest season-opening losing streak is five from 1998 to 2002 and now have lost their last two.

**MONROE, La.** -- ULM defeated Louisiana College Monday night, 110-96, inside Fant-Ewing Coliseum.

Four Warhawks finished in double-figures led by 24 from Ashleigh Simmons.

Jasmine Shaw finished with 22 points, eight rebounds and seven assists. Also in double-figures were Alayshia Hunter (18) and Jae Shin (15).

The Warhawks started out with 9-5 lead as ULM's press caused three consecutive turnovers near the 17-minute mark. Jenna Lee accounted for four early points.

Khloe Mims knocked down a jump shot to bring the Lady Wildcats within one, 17-16, with 12:32 left before halftime.

Shaw hit a baseline jumper to stretch the home lead before cleaning up a loose ball underneath the basket to give ULM a 21-17 lead with just over 11 minute left in the half.

Louisiana College took the lead on two Skylar Chenevert free throws before Simmons converted a three-point play to give ULM a 26-25 lead with 9:12 remaining in the first stanza.

The Lady Wildcats took advantage of two Warhawk turnovers to convert easy layups, giving LC a 31-30 lead at the seven-minute mark. Natasha Gottlieb hit a triple to extend LC's lead to 39-34 with 4:43 left before the break.

At the break, Louisiana College led 49-47, powered by 10 points from Neka Jones. Ten of 13 players on LC's roster scored in the first half. ULM was paced by 17 points from Simmons.

Mims hit a three-point to give LC a 54-51 advantage two minutes into the second half.

Shaw went coast-to-coast for a fast break layup to give ULM a 55-54 lead and followed with a three-point play stretching the lead to 58-55 with 16:36 left in the game.

The Warhawks began to take control and led 72-65 on a Tyler Holley bucket. With nine minutes left, ULM held onto a 78-71 lead.

The Lady Wildcats pulled within three at the six-minute mark after two fast break layups, the second from Jones. LaToya Jones hit a triple to tie the game at 88-88 at the five-minute mark.

ULM pulled away towards the end of the contest powered by better ball control. Shin found Alayshia Hunter down the middle of the paint to give the Warhawks a 100-92 lead with 2:33 left.

The game ended with ULM winning 110-96, marking the first time since Dec. 13, 1997 against Grambling State (101-75).

SFA took its first lead of the night at the 16:16 mark in the second half, 36-35, on a jumper from Antionette Carter. The Ladyjacks kept the momentum out of the locker rooms and extended its lead to 44-39 after a three-point play from Porsha Roberts at the 13-minute mark.

Carter finished a three-point play to extend SFA's lead 54-46 with 10:40 on the clock and two Ladyjack free throws pushed the lead to double-digits on the following play.

The Warhawk deficit ballooned to 17, 63-46, with 8:35 left in the game forcing head coach Mona Martin to call a timeout.

SFA would cruise to the 80-55 victory.

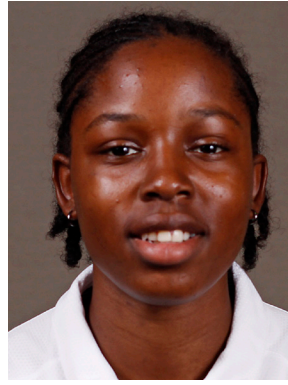

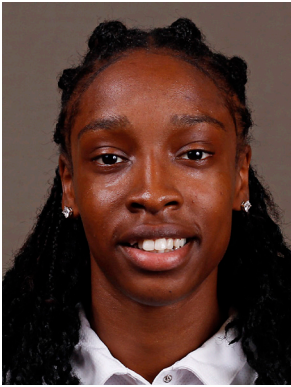
