POST-GAME NOTES: UL-LAFAYETTE 40, ULM 24

TEAM/GAME NOTES

- ULM Captains: Brent Leonard (Offense), Gerrard Johnson (Defense) and Preston Coleman (Special Teams)
- ULM won the opening coin toss and defered to the second half.
- The loss snaps ULM's five-game win streak.
- Official Attendance: 20,203 (Second highest total for a Sun Belt Conference game at Malone Stadium [21,209 - Oct. 4, 2008 - vs. UL-Lafayette]).

OFFENSE NOTES

- Kolton Browning's 81-yard TD pass to Tavares Maye in the first quarter was the longest play from scrimmage for ULM this season... It is also tied for the ninth longest pass play in school history.
- Cody Wells 19-yard TD pass to Je'Ron Hamm in the 2nd quarter was the first TD pass of the season for Wells (10th career TD pass)... The TD reception was Hamm's fourth of the season and sixth of his career.

DEFENSE NOTES

- Isaiah Newsome's interception in the first quarter was his third of the season (sixth of his career - he had 3 interceptions in 2011).
- R.J. Young's fumble recovery in the first quarter was his second of the season and fourth of his Warhawk career... The fumble was forced by Henry Mitchell, his first career forced fumble.
- Malcolm Edmond recorded his first career solo sack in the 2nd quarter.

SPECIAL TEAM NOTES

- Justin Manton connected on his third FG of the season with a 23-yard FG in the first quarter... Manton also hit three PATs Saturday and now sits 45-for-45 on the year and dating back to 2011, he has hit 47 straight.
- Cortney Davis recorded a 34-yard kickoff return, it is the second longest of his career (51, at Western Kentucky, Oct. 20, 2012).
