## POST-GAME NOTES: ARKANSAS STATE 45, ULM 23

### TEAM/GAME NOTES

- ULM Captains: Brent Leonard (Offense), Joey Gautney (Defense) and Brandon Hardy (Special Teams)
- ULM won the opening coin toss and defered to the second half.
- With the loss, ULM is now 6-4 overall and 4-2 in conference play.
- Official Attendance: 30,243 (Second largest crowd in Liberty Bank Stadium history - Record: 30,427 vs. Memphis, Sept. 18, 2004)

### OFFENSE NOTES

- Monterrell Washington's first quarter TD reception was the first of his career... The 27-yard pass from Cody Wells to Washington gave ULM a 7-0 lead with 10:05 to play in the first quarter.
- Monterrell Washington's 30-yard run in the first quarter was the third longest rush of his career.
- On ULM's first possession of the second half, Rashon Ceasar caught his second career TD pass... The 37-yard pass from Cody Wells to Rashon Ceasar evened the contest at 17-all with 13 minutes remaining in the third quarter.
- Cody Wells finished 37-of-53 for 357 yards with two TDs and one interception.

### DEFENSE NOTES

- Henry Mitchell's interception in the second quarter was the second of his career... He returned the Aplin interception 18 yards (career-long).
- Cordero Smith led the Warhawk defense with a career-high 12 tackles.

### SPECIAL TEAM NOTES

- Justin Manton connected on a 37-yard FG in the second quarter... It was his longest made FG of the 2012 season.
- Justin Manton's consecutive PAT streak ended Thursday night, after hitting his first two, Manton slipped on his final attempt... His streak, dating back to last season, ended at 49 straight... He finished six shy of tying the career mark of 55 straight.
