FIRST AND TEN

• The Warhawks open 2016 with an entirely new coaching staff, led by head coach **Matt Viator**, who becomes the 16th head coach in ULM history. Viator joined ULM in December 2015 after 10 years at the helm of Division I FCS McNeese State. At McNeese, he posted a .703 winning percentage and is tied for the program lead in all-time wins. Over the course of his 10 seasons, Viator averaged just under eight wins per season and never had a losing season. He also coached three different teams to 10-win seasons.

• Despite the new coaching staff, there are several familiar names for ULM fans that will be wearing the headsets. Assistant Head Coach/Defensive Coordinator **Mike Collins** is in his third stint with the Warhawks having previously served as a Graduate Assistant (1983-84) and in several capacities from 1998-2002 (Linebackers Coach and Defensive Coordinator), including serving as the teams interim head coach for the final seven games of the 2002 season. Defensive Line coach **Manny Michel** is in his second stint in Monroe, having previously served in the same capacity at ULM from 1999-2008. Running Backs coach **Alan Ricard** played for the Warhawks from 1995-1999 before his Super Bowl-winning NFL career, while Monroe native **Rob Sale** is also on the ULM staff, coaching the Offensive Line.

• A pair of seniors, wide receiver Ajalen Holley and safety Tre' Hunter, were each selected as members of the Sun Belt preseason second team, while the outside publication College Sports Madness placed both on its preseason all-Sun Belt team as well. Holley was named to the publications' second team while Hunter was selected as a member of the third team. Holley led the Warhawks with 709 receiving yards (11.8 per catch) while placing second in all-purpose yards (727) as he started 10 of the 12 games he played in last season. Hunter led the team with three interceptions and his 55 tackles are the most for any returning Warhawk this season.

• The 2016 season opener marks the first-ever meeting between ULM and Southern. ULM is 6-0 all-time against SWAC schools, including a 3-0 records against Southern's archrival Grambling. The Warhawks last faced a SWAC opponent in 2013 when they beat Grambling 48-10 inside JPS Field at Malone Stadium.

• Saturday night will be the second time ULM has opened at home inside JPS Field at Malone Stadium in the past three seasons. The last time the Warhawks kicked off a season in front of the home fans was in 2014 when they beat Wake Forest (17-10). Prior to 2014, ULM had opened the season on the road the previous six seasons.

• In the past five seasons, the Warhawks have registered an even .500 record (12-12) at home inside JPS Field at Malone Stadium.

• ULM posted a multi-year Academic Progress Rate (APR) of 967 to best all other schools in the Sun Belt Conference (SBC) as well as the APR national average of 959 (964 FBS).

--All interviews with ULM student-athletes must be arranged through Nick Phillips in the ULM Athletic Media Relations Office. In-person interviews are preferred but phone interviews may be arranged. All interviews, in-person or otherwise, will be scheduled by Phillips and will not interfere with a student-athlete's class, study or practice schedule. When visiting practice sessions on Thursdays, media interviews with players will be conducted prior practice from 3:00-3:30 p.m. Please communicate requested players before 12:00 noon on Wednesday to Phillips.

--Media are strongly encouraged to attend the Monday press conferences of head coach Matt Viator. Viator and other members of the coaching staff will also be available prior to Thursday practices. Please communicate requested coach(es) with Phillips before 12:00 noon on Wednesday. Additional interview times may be arranged at other times during the week by contacting the ULM Athletic Media Relations Office.

HOLLEY AT HOME

Until leaving the Appalachian State game due to injury in the first half (Oct. 17, 2015), ULM junior wide receiver Ajalen Holley had been running rampant on the field [against the Mountaineers, Holley tallied two catches for 11 yards]... During his first two home games last season (Nicholls State and Georgia Southern) he had amassed 324 receiving yards on 16 catches for a yards per reception total of 20.25.

In ULM's homecoming contest against Georgia Southern on October 3, 2015, Holley hauled in a career-long 69 yard reception that highlighted a three-play, 80 yard scoring drive in the third quarter... He went on to finish with 166 yards (20.75 yards per reception) against the Eagles... In the home opener against Nicholls State, Holley finished with eight receptions for 155 yards (19.38 yards per reception) and two touchdown receptions.

Between the 2014 conference opener against Idaho (Sept. 6, 2014) and the homecoming contest against Georgia Southern (Oct. 3, 2015), Holley tallied 100 or more receiving yards in five of the eight home games he has played in... The only outliers - an 89 yard receiving night against Texas State (Oct. 25, 2014), the Appalachian State contest (Oct. 17, 2015 - injury) and a four catch, 25 yard game against New Mexico State (Dec. 5, 2015).

PICK SIX

Former ULM cornerback Junior Williams intercepted Georgia Southern quarterback Kevin Ellison and returned it 56 yards to the endzone. on October 3, 2015.. With his interception return for a score, the Warhawks have now recorded at least one interception return for a touchdown in four consecutive seasons.

DEFENSIVE SHUTOUT

ULM picked up a 47-0 win over Nicholls State in its 2015 home opener on September 12, 2015... It was the first shutout win for the Warhawks since December 3, 2011 when ULM blanked Florida Atlantic, 26-0, in Boca Raton, Fla... The 47-0 win over Nicholls State was the first shutout win at home for the Warhawks since a 58-0 win over Texas Southern on September 12, 2009.

STREAK ENDED

ULM's streak of defeating at least on power five team each season came to an end last year when the Warhawks fell at No. 12 Alabama on September 26, 2015... The Warhawks streak stood at three consecutive seasons after power five wins over No. 8 Arkansas (2012) and Wake Forest (2013 & 2014)... The streak was the second longest active streak among non-power five programs... ULM trailed only BYU who currently has defeated at least one power five team in 10 straight seasons.

ON THE ROAD

The Warhawks have a pretty even split among their 12 total games this season with five games at home and seven on the road...Of the seven road contests, ULM will play in the Eastern Time Zone (3 times), Central Time Zone (3 times) and Mountain Time Zone (1 time). Via Google Maps the distance from JPS Field at Malone Stadium to all seven road venues comes to a total of 4,900 miles and that is just one direction -- double that amount and the round trip from ULM to each road venue comes to 9,800 miles.

The Warhawks play three-straight road games for the second consecutive season, however, this year there will be a bye week tucked between the first two road trips (at Oklahoma, at Georgia Southern) and the third game (at Auburn).

BACK-TO-BACK AT HOME

After being one of six teams in FBS that did not play back-to-back home games last season (only Sun Belt School on the list) the Warhawks will host two consecutive home games inside JPS Field at Malone Stadium when they host Idaho (October 8) and Texas State (October 15 / Homecoming).

NEW FIELDHOUSE FACILITY

ULM officially unveiled the new Football Fieldhouse Facility to the public on August 2. The 11,750 square foot facility, which cost \$4.1 million, was funded entirely by 31 private donors. It is the first athletic facility in ULM history to be completely funded by private donations and was the first new athletic facility built at ULM since 1983.

NEW TURF, NEW NAME

Thanks to a generous donation of \$450,000, the largest single gift in ULM athletics history, the Warhawk football team is in year three of playing on FieldTurf Revolution... The donation from JPS Aviation/JPS Equipment Rental covered the cost of the new FieldTurf Revolution and for the donation, the name of the field will now be JPS Field at Malone Stadium... The length of the naming rights was set at a minimum of eight years... The new FieldTurf stretches wall-to-wall and totals 78,000 square feet... It is the same playing surface the Warhawks played on at Wake Forest in 2013 and other notable FBS schools that have the FieldTurf Revolution are: Louisville, Michigan, Nebraska, Ohio State, Ole Miss, Oregon, Texas, Texas Tech and Wisconsin... There are also 23 NFL football teams that have the FieldTurf Revolution.
