JUST ULM, PLEASE

Though the ULM Department of Athletics is a proud and integral part of the University of Louisiana Monroe, it desires to be recognized simply as **ULM** (acronym only) Athletics. Therefore we respectfully urge that the university's teams be identified with an appropriate appellation - ULM. In subsequent references of the same presentation, the team may be referred to by nickname - Warhawks.

OPENING DRIVE

- The ULM football team (3-1, 1-0 SBC) will play its final nonconference game against Northwestern (2-2, 1-1 Big Ten) on Saturday (Oct. 4) at 2:30 p.m. CT in Martin Stadium. The Warhawks are looking to find success after a strong conference start, winning against Arkansas State for the first time since 2009.
- The Warhawks most recently defeated Arkansas State in their first conference game of the season, a 28-16 homecoming victory. This is the first win over the Red Wolves since 2009 to get to an early 1-0 start in Sun Belt play. After a 10-0 deficit early, the Warhawks scored 21 unanswered points to capture the lead. ULM's defense held Arkansas State to 12 rushing yards, posting six sacks, an interception and a fumble recovery in the win.
- Saturday's game marks the first meeting between the Wildcats and the Warhawks. Along with Northwestern, ULM will also face Saint Francis (Pa.) and Old Dominion for the first time ever this season. The last time the Warhawks faced three new opponents in a single season was 2020, facing Army, Liberty and UTEP for the first time.
- ULM has competed against three other Big Ten teams in its history, most recently facing lowa in 2011. The Warhawks are 0-5 against Big Ten teams, also facing Minnesota and UCLA. In the Power Five, ULM last defeated a Power Five program in 2014, a 17-10 win over Wake Forest.
- The Warhawks open Sun Belt competition 1-0 for the second-consecutive season, defeating Troy last season to get to a 1-0 start. The last seasons that ULM opened Sun Belt play 1-0 twice in a row were the 2021 and 2022 seasons.
- On the road against UTEP, the Warhawks defeated their first nonconference opponent on the road since 2018. The victory also marks the team's third road win since 2020, also finding victory in 2024 at Troy and in 2022 against Georgia State.
- In the season opener against Saint Francis, ULM claimed a 29-0 shutout win. This is the first shutout win in over a decade for the Warhawks, the last coming against Nicholls in 2015 (47-0). Nine other teams in FBS secured a shutout in Week 1, including local foe Louisiana Tech.
- The Warhawks lead the Sun Belt in numerous categories, including kickoff return defense (9.41, fourth nationally) and red zone offense (1.000). ULM is one of 13 teams to remain 100% in the red zone, and the only Sun Belt team to remain 1.000.

Defensive back **D'Arco Perkins-McAllister** sits at first in the Sun Belt in passes defended (1.50), ranking seventh in FBS. Defensive lineman **Dylan Howell** also leads the conference, in sacks (1.00), sitting at seventh in FBS as well.

• ULM's 12-game football schedule features five home games, four being conference opponents. According to ESPN, the Warhawks have the second-toughest schedule in the Sun Belt and the eighth toughest in the Group of Five.

- ULM's 2025 opponents went a combined 69-81 (.460) in 2024, with five opponents going over .500. In addition, six foes also participated in postseason bowl games a year ago: Alabama (ReliaQuest Bowl), Coastal Carolina (Myrtle Beach Bowl), South Alabama (IS4S Salute to Veterans Bowl), Arkansas State (68 Ventures Bowl), the Ragin' Cajuns (Isleta New Mexico Bowl) and Texas State (Servpro First Responder Bowl).
- ULM defensive back D'Arco Perkins-McAllister was voted Sun Belt Conference Defensive Player of the Week after a media member panel vote on August 31. Perkins-McAllister played lights out for the Warhawks in week one, leading the defense in the team's first shutout in a decade. His two sacks are second in the Sun Belt Conference. The Nashville, Tenn., native claimed five solo tackles on the evening and three assists in a game where the opponent only crossed the 50-yard line once.
- Aidan Armenta remains the starting quarterback for the Warhawks, completing 45 of 77 passes for 444 yards and five touchdowns. The redshirt sophomore tied his career high with 17 completions against Arkansas State (Sept. 27), last recording 17 in the momentous win over James Madison last season.
- Monroe native Landon Graves has also seen action at quarterback this season, throwing four-forseven across three games and collecting a touchdown in his first career drive. Hunter Herring also saw action in a unique position, appearing in multiple positions on the field to push the Warhawks ahead. Herring scored the first touchdown of the season for the Warhawks and posted another against UTEP.
- The running back room in Monroe has proven to be deep, as five RBs have seen action so far this season. **Braylon McReynolds** has claimed four starts thus far, leading the team with 309 yards from 48 attempts and two touchdowns. McReynolds notched his first touchdown as a Warhawk against Saint Francis, a 13-yard reception into the end zone.

Four other running backs contributed to the 853 rushing yards this season, the team averaging 5.7 yards per rush. Dorian Lewis has posted 131 yards on 14 carries, including a 72-yard rush to get to the red zone at UTEP (Sept. 20). Freshman D'Shaun Ford has seen nine carries and 42 yards and Zach Palmer-Smith has recorded 125 yards off 24 carries, including his first ULM rushing touchdown against Arkansas State (Sept. 27). **Tyrell Reed Jr.** has collected 55 yards, averaging 3.9 yards per carry.

- Veteran **Jake Godfrey** leads receivers, notching 110 yards off seven receptions, getting a touchdown reception from Armenta into the end zone at UTEP (Sept. 20) and his fourth career touchdown reception vs. Arkansas State (Sept. 27). Tyler Griffin has claimed 92 yards from eight receptions, including a touchdown reception from quarterback Graves in the season opener. **Jonathan Bibbs** sits at third so far this season, posting 66 yards off six receptions and a touchdown. Bibbs also posted a career-high four receptions against the Red Wolves.
- Tight end **Julian Nixon** has also seen action, registering 29 yards off four receptions and scoring the first touchdown against Arkansas State. The touchdown was the tight end's second of his career and first of the season.
- Noah Flemmings leads the team defense with 23 tackles, logging four tackles for loss through four games. A career-high stat line of 2.0 TFLs, a sack, a forced fumble and a fumble recovery came for Flemmings against Arkansas State (Sept. 27). Carl Fauntroy follows closely behind with 21 tackles (11 UA, 10 A), along with a tackle for loss and a pass breakup.

Former Sun Belt Defensive Player of the Week D'Arco Perkins-McAllister continues finding success with the Warhawks, posting 19 tackles, three tackles for loss and three sacks across four games. Perkins-McAllister also blocked a field goal against Arkansas State, ULM's first blocked field goal since 2023.

David Godsey Jr. and Lynard Harris are credited with two of the four interceptions on the season, both coming in the final two minutes against UTEP to prevent a last-minute comeback from the Miners. Kristopher Robinson also got in on the action, recording an interception against the Red Wolves. Robinson also logged a career-high eight tackles and a tackle for loss in the contest. Cliff Mosley also contributed to the defensive effort, catching his first career interception against the Red Flash to force another turnover.

A few Warhawks saw career games against the Red Wolves, especially on the defensive side. **Jaeden** Calender posted his first career sack, one of six against Arkansas State. Godsey Jr. notched a careerhigh two pass breakups and **Kelbee Holmes** saw his first career quarterback hurry. **Dylan Howell** saw two sacks on the day, a career high for the ULM veteran. Newcomer **Tae Woody** also posted a career game with four tackles, 1.0 TFL and a quarterback hurry.

• Offensive lineman Elijah Fisher was recognized on multiple preseason watch lists, including the All State Wuerffel Trophy Watchlist and the Earl Campbell Tyler Rose Trophy Watchlist. The Wuerffel Trophy recognizes college football players who exemplify community service, academic excellence and athletic achievement. The Earl Campbell Tyler Rose Trophy recognizes the top offensive player who exhibits the enduring characteristics that define Earl Campbell: integrity, performance, teamwork, sportsmanship, drive, community and tenacity.

- Seven Warhawks were named to the Phil Steele Preseason Sun Belt teams. On the Phil Steele Preseason All-Sun Belt Third Team were offensive lineman Elijah Fisher, defensive lineman Kevontay Wells, defensive back D'Arco Perkins-McAllister and placekicker Max Larson. On the fourth team were offensive lineman Jay Mickle, linebacker Billy Pullen and linebacker Seidrion Langston.
- **Kevontay Wells** was also named to the Preseason All-Sun Belt First Team Defense, as voted on by the conference's coaches. In his first season with the Warhawks, Wells led the team with 11.0 tackles for loss, which ranked tied for sixth in the Sun Belt. He added 50 total tackles and three sacks in a breakout junior season. Wells is the first Warhawk to be named to a Preseason All-Sun Belt team since 2020, when ULM placed a trio of players (Josh Johnson, Josh Pederson and Corey Straughter) on the preseason first team.
- ULM added 40 new players to its 2025 roster in the offseason. Head coach **Bryant Vincent** and his staff signed 13 new Warhawks on the first day of the early signing period in December, featuring eight defensive players and five on offense. In total, ULM signed nine junior college transfers, 23 transfers from four-year colleges and six high school recruits. The Warhawks lost six starters on offense and six on defense from the 2024 squad.
- Phil Steele Preseason All-Sun Belt Third Team member **Kevontay Wells** returns to ULM after a stellar 2024 campaign, tallying 50 tackles, 11 tackles for loss and three sacks while earning All-Sun Belt Second Team Defense honors. **Dylan Howell** returns for his third Warhawk season, after totaling 23 tackles and two quarterback hurries in 2024. **Billy Pullen** returns for his second season, named to the Phil Steele Preseason All-Sun Belt Fourth Team, after starting in all 12 games and awarded All-Sun Belt Third Team last season.
- Newcomers in the defense include **Zy Jackson**, a two-time all-conference defensive back at Copiah-Lincoln CC, totaling 10 tackles, a fumble recovery and 586 return yards in 2024. Defensive back **Kamrin Canterbury** led West Florida with 49 tackles and 4.5 tackles for loss last season before transferring to ULM for the 2025 season.
- The Warhawks return both starting guards from last season. **Elijah Fisher** is set for his sixth season in Monroe and has earned All-SBC Honorable Mention in back-to-back seasons. Fisher was voted Phil Steele All-Sun Belt Preseason Third Team. **Jay Mickle** started all 12 games for ULM last season and is back for his final season. The graduate student from Picayune, Miss., was voted Phil Steele Preseason All-Sun Belt Fourth Team. Also returning for the Warhawks' offensive line is **Que McBroom** and **Reese Steele**, both of whom made starts last season.
- Special teams players **Max Larson**, **Makenzie Ryan**, **Andrew Wells** and **Nolan Wilson** are all back on ULM's 2025 roster. Larson went 14-for-17 on field goal attempts and 27-for-28 on PATs in his first season with the Warhawks and was named Phil Steele Preseason All-Sun Belt Third Team. Ryan booted 58 punts with an average of 39.2 yards per punt, downing 18 inside the 20-yard line. Wells served as the team's holder and Wilson was the long snapper for all games last season. ULM signed West Monroe native **Peyton Todd** to the roster. Todd appeared in all 13 games last season at LSU and averaged 41.3 yards per punt on 19 punts for the Tigers.
- ULM's coaching staff features four new faces in 2025, including running backs coach and run game coordinator Hindley Brigham, wide receivers coach Kishawn McClain, defensive ends coach Jontavius Morris and offensive assistant coach Cody Wells. Brigham arrives after nine seasons at UAB, McClain joins the staff after stops at ETSU and Gardner-Webb and Morris was added after being on staff at Louisville and Purdue. Former ULM quarterback Wells returns to Monroe after a few seasons at Evangel University.
- Family connections on the ULM football coaching staff include **Bryant Vincent**'s son, **Brady Vincent**, as the team's Tight Ends Coach. **Bret Vincent** makes it three Vincents featured in the ULM football program, with Bret playing wide receiver for the Warhawks. The Vincent family is not the only family tie for ULM. Defensive Coordinator **Earnest Hill** enters his second season on the staff, with his son **Bryan Hill** working as a defensive assistant coach.

LAST TIME OUT -

ULM 28, Arkansas State 16 (Sept. 27, 2025 in Monroe, La.) – The ULM football team (3-1, 1-0 Sun Belt) picked up a resounding victory over the Arkansas State Red Wolves (1-4, 0-1 Sun Belt) on Saturday afternoon (Sept. 27) at Malone Stadium. The 28-16 homecoming win is the first for ULM in the series since 2009. After falling down 10-0 early, the Warhawks battled back with four touchdowns to claim the victory.

"The focus, the preparation, it was tremendous," said head coach **Bryant Vincent**. "I thought our coaching staff and our players really owned their preparation going into this game."

Aidan Armenta led the offense, completing 16 of 25 passes (64%) for 175 yards and two touchdowns. **Jonathan Bibbs** led with 28 yards over four catches. **Jake Godfrey** had the long 37-yard touchdown reception to add to his two catches for 40 yards.

The Warhawks led the Red Wolves in total yards (392), putting up 217 rushing yards. **Zach Palmer-Smith** led with 84 yards from eight carries, scoring a touchdown and averaging 10.5 yards per carry. **Braylon McReynolds** also posting a rushing touchdown, totaling 73 yards on 13 carries.

The defense had a day of their own, as ULM held Arkansas State to just 17 rushing yards, registering six sacks, 11 tackles for loss, an interception, a fumble recovery and a blocked field goal. **Kristopher Robinson** led in tackles with eight, also picking up the interception and a tackle for loss. **Dylan Howell** posted two sacks in the contest, while **D'Arco Perkins-McAllister**, **James Smith**, **Kevontay Wells** and **Jaeden Calender** each also snagged one.

The first drive for the Warhawks turned into a scoring opportunity for the Red Wolves, as **Brandon Greil** intercepted Armenta's pass for a pick-six and the 7-0 lead with 13:28 remaining in the first quarter. The ULM offense got the ball back, but a quick three-and-out returned the ball back to Arkansas State. ULM's defense then returned the turnover favor, with Robinson intercepting **Jaylen Raynor**'s pass.

The Warhawks and the Red Wolves continued to trade punts before Arkansas State was able to add to the tally, getting close enough for a **Clune Van Andel** 51-yard field goal. Another punt for the Warhawks concluded the first quarter, with the Red Wolves leading 10-0.

"We were down 10-0 and we didn't blink," said Armenta. "That says a lot about our culture and the guys we have on our team."

Two sacks for ULM—by Howell and Wells—opened the second quarter to shut down the Arkansas State offense and force a punt. With 12:28 remaining in the half, ULM picked up the momentum, McReynolds quickly posting a 24-yard carry. **Tyler Griffin** followed things up with a 16-yard reception to enter opponent territory, slowly marching toward the end zone. A penalty for the Red Wolves further advanced the Warhawks, with a pass to **Julian Nixon** getting the Warhawks on the board.

The ULM defense continued to force three-and-outs for Arkansas State, as the Red Wolves were unable to fire back after the touchdown. The Warhawks regained control of the ball with just under three minutes left in the half, quickly marching downfield and setting up another score. Armenta launched the ball 37 yards to Godfrey for the 14-10 lead at halftime, a lead they would maintain through the second half, with Perkins-McAllister blocking Van Andel's field goal attempt.

The second half began just as strong for ULM's defense, with Flemmings forcing and recovering a fumble to put the ball back in Warhawk hands. A 19-yard rush by **Brandon Buckhaulter** set up another play in the red zone. McReynolds carried the ball 18 yards up the middle for the third touchdown of the day and picking up the 21-10 lead with 9:57 remaining in the third quarter.

A four-minute drive for Arkansas State had the opponent slowly marching downfield. ULM's defense kept battling, preventing the touchdown. The Red Wolves settled for another Van Andel field goal for the 21-13 score.

After another punt from **Makenzie Ryan**, the fourth quarter picked up for Arkansas State, as the Red Wolves pushed to close the gap in the score. After fumbling the ball—and recovering it themselves—Howell sacked Raynor for the fifth sack of the game. The Red Wolves settled for another field goal with 12:09 left in the contest.

The Warhawks, determined to extend their lead, quickly got to work, **Jonathan Bibbs** recording an 11-yard reception and building momentum. Back-to-back penalties on the ULM offense could have slowed the tempo, but it only pushed the home team. Palmer-Smith and McReynolds traded carries, Godfrey then exploding on a 20-yard rush to reach the two-yard line. Palmer-Smith ran it in for his first Warhawk touchdown to extend the lead to 12.

Arkansas State did not quit, however. Raynor led his offense down to the seven-yard line, looking for another touchdown to make it a one-possession game. In the red zone, the Warhawk defense lit up, with Perkins-McAllister sacking Raynor again to bring up fourth down. The Red Wolves turned over the ball on downs with just 1:20 remaining, as ULM looked to cement the victory.

Palmer-Smith added an accent to the final drive, breaking loose and running for 56 yards to get just outside the red zone. The explosive run set up a victory formation for ULM as the clock ran out, relishing in a snapped 16-year streak.

BRYANT VINCENT

SECOND SEASON AT ULM (8-8) THIRD SEASON OVERALL (15-14)

Bryant Vincent, known for his strong leadership and expertise in creating powerful offensive schemes in college football, was named the 17th head football coach in University of Louisiana Monroe history on Wednesday, December 6, 2023. Vincent was also named Interim Athletic Director for ULM on August 5, 2025.

In his first season as head coach of ULM football, Coach Vincent began establishing a culture of grit and resilience that propelled the Warhawks to one of their most successful starts in nearly four decades. ULM opened the 2024 season 5-1, the program's best start in 37 years, and Vincent was the only Sun Belt Conference Coach named to the 2024 Paul "Bear" Bryant Coach of the Year Award Watch List.

Vincent secured his first victory as head coach with a 30-14 win over Jackson State on August 29, 2024. In week two, the Warhawks stunned UAB with a dominating 32-6 win after shutting out the Blazers in the second half inside Malone Stadium. After defeating Troy on the road 13-9 in the Sun Belt Conference opener, Vincent led the Warhawks to a signature victory over JMU by a score of 21-19 to give ULM its first 4-1 start in the FBS era. ULM completed the 5-1 start with a 38-21 win over Southern Miss in week six.

Under Vincent's direction, the Warhawks led the SBC in several statistical categories, including passing yards allowed (183.9), blocked kicks (3) and few-

est penalty yards per game (43.25).

He developed 2024 Sun Belt Conference Freshman of the Year Ahmad Hardy, who led the league with 1,351 rushing yards and 13 rushing touchdowns as a true freshman. Hardy was named ULM's first FWAA Freshman All-American in program history and was also voted Louisiana Freshman of the Year by the Louisiana Sports Writers Association.

Including Hardy, nine Warhawks garnered SBC postseason honors for the first time in over five seasons including All-Sun Belt Second Team defensive lineman Kevontay Wells and All-Sun Belt Third Team defensive stars Billy Pullen, Carl Glass Jr., and Wydett Williams Jr. Additionally, two of Vincent's players went on to compete at the professional level after senior cornerback Car'lin Vigers signed an undrafted free agent contract with the NFL's Washington Commanders and senior offensive lineman Sam Carson was drafted by the CFL's Ottawa Redblacks.

Off the field, Vincent's leadership produced unprecedented academic results. ULM football recorded the highest term GPA in program history in Fall 2024, and the team's 84% graduation success rate (GSR) led all Sun Belt programs. Additionally, major facility upgrades were completed at Malone Stadium, including renovations to the team room, locker room and main athletics lobby.

Before arriving in Monroe, Vincent served as the Offensive Coordinator at the University of New





Mexico during the 2023 season. Under Vincent's offensive schemes, the Lobos earned national top-20 rankings in red zone offense (14th) and rushing offense (19th). Additionally, Vincent coached running back Jacory Croskey-Merritt to a record-breaking season. The New Mexico running back was the first Lobo to ever have back-to-back 200-yard rushing games and finished with 17 rushing touchdowns, which is third all-time in New Mexico football history.

Prior to New Mexico, Vincent served as the Interim Head Coach at UAB following the retirement of Bill Clark and led the Blazers to a 7-6 season and a win in the 2022 Bahamas Bowl. UAB's offense generated 30.1 points per game and 438.2 yards per game, which was the 33rd highest mark in the country. Vincent spent four seasons as UAB's offensive coordinator/quarterbacks coach and was a key figure in elevating the program since its reinstatement in 2017. In all, Vincent helped lead UAB to a pair of Conference USA Championships and bowl game victories.

UAB has been the winningest team in Conference USA since returning to the playing field and collected 42 wins since Vincent returned as OC. The Blazers won the 2018 CUSA title game 27-25 over Middle Tennessee State, winning on the road, and the 2020 CUSA title game, that one 22-13 over Marshall, again on the road.

UAB also made it to the 2019 championship game as champions of their division. Since the reinstatement of the program in 2017, Vincent coached in five bowls games, qualifying for six. UAB won the 2018 Boca Raton Bowl 37-13 over Northern Illinois, the 2021 Independence Bowl 31-28 over BYU and the 2022 Bahamas Bowl. UAB also played in the 2017 Bahamas Bowl against Ohio and the 2019 New Orleans Bowl against App State, and the team qualified for the 2020 Gasparilla Bowl against South Carolina, before being canceled due to COVID-19.

With Vincent at offensive coordinator, the Blazers set FBS-program records for wins in 2018, going 11-3. Vincent never had a losing season with Blazers, going 7-6 as head coach and going 48-27 overall in his six years with UAB. The 2018 Blazers had the best offensive season in program history which resulted in 21 school records, including the aforementioned 11-3 overall record and winning the program's first Conference USA title and

bowl game.

Among the school records that fell in 2018 included total points (418), total touchdowns (53), rushing touchdowns (32), total yards (5,680) and rushing yards (2,818). Additionally, UAB set the single game school record for total yards (668) and rushing yards (419) in a 52-3 victory over UTSA on Nov. 3, 2018

Vincent is no stranger to the Sun Belt Conference and spent six years in two separate stints with South Alabama. He served as the offensive coordinator and quarterbacks coach from 2015-17 and was an assistant coach from 2011-13 for the Jaguars' football program. Vincent helped guide the Jaguars to the 2016 Nova Home Loans Arizona Bowl led by record setting quarterback Dallas Davis. In Vincent's offense, Davis threw for the most yards in school history (2,706) and his 2,951 total yards of offense are second most in program history.

Before entering the collegiate ranks, Vincent was a successful high school football coach in Alabama and tallied a record of 49-16 in five seasons at two different schools. In his first season as a head coach, Vincent led Greenville High School to a 10-3 record and was selected as the Class 5A Coach of the Year in 2006. Vincent was at the helm of Spanish Fort High School football for four seasons and produced a record of 39-13. His team captured the Alabama 5A State Championship in 2010.

Vincent is a native of Glasgow, Kentucky. He and his wife Holli have two sons, Brady, a member of the ULM football coaching staff and Bret, a wide receiver for the Warhawks.
