OPENING DRIVE

- The ULM football team prepares for its home opener on September 19, facing the Southeastern Louisiana Lions at 3:30 p.m. in FMOL Health | St. Francis Stadium.
- The Warhawks are finally opening home play at St. Francis Stadium, after two road weeks to open the season. This is the first season since 2022 that the Warhawks have not opened the season at home. ULM is playing in its latest home opener since 2020, when the team played on September 19 as well, facing then-conference foe Texas State. The last season the Warhawks opened play at home after September 19 was 2012.
- ULM is 51-22-2 in home openers since becoming a four-year institution, going 8-2 in the last 10 years. In the Bryant Vincent era, the Warhawks are 2-0 in home openers, defeating Jackson State in 2024 and Saint Francis in 2025. This is the first Vincent-era home opener not played on a Thursday.
- Not only is ULM opening home play later than usual, but is facing a familiar opponent in its home opener. Southeastern Louisiana has been ULM's home-opening opponent five times. The most recent occurrence was 2018, when the Warhawks edged out the Lions, 34-31.
- The home opener marks the first playing in FMOL Health | St. Francis Stadium, the name changed to recognize an expanding partnership with FMOL Health | St. Francis. The new name was announced on August 7, with a press conference held earlier this month. Additionally, the FMOL Health | St. Francis logo will be represented in jersey patches across all ULM women's sports as part of the expanded partnership.
- While the name has been changed, an installation is in progress to recognize the former namesake of the stadium, Coach James Malone, widely revered as the father of ULM Athletics. Malone was Northeast Louisiana's second head football coach, leading the Indians from 1934 to 1953, boasting a 94-64-12 record. With one of the top records of any football coach at ULM, he coached two unbeaten football teams and three bowl teams, leading the 1935 team to the junior college national championship. Malone also led the team from junior college into senior college competition in 1951.
- The Warhawks have seen the Lions 37 prior times since joining the senior college ranks, 48 times when including junior college competition. Since becoming a four-year institution, ULM falls 12-25 against Southeastern all-time. In the last 10 meetings, the teams are tied up, 5-5. The Warhawks hold the two-game victory streak after winning in Monroe in 2010 and again in 2018.
- The last time ULM saw SLU was 2018 in Monroe, in which the Warhawks claimed a 34-31 win in SLU head coach Frank Scelfo's first season. **R.J. Turner** blocked a field goal as time expired to secure the win, quarterback **Caleb Evans** completing 35-of-53 passes for 346 yards. ULM logged 554 yards of offense, along with 31 first downs. **Corey Straughter** recorded a 50-yard interception as **David Griffith** led the team with seven tackles.
- In hosting six opponents at home for the first time since 2024, the Warhawks also host three opponents from the state of Louisiana for the first time since 2002. ULM will host Southeastern Louisiana to open home play, then taking on Louisiana Tech and the Ragin' Cajuns in Monroe.
- The Lions are led by ninth-year head coach Frank Scelfo, who is a then-NLU alum and represented the Warhawks from 1978-81 on the baseball team. Scelfo sits at fourth in the record books with 36 career home runs. He was coached by **Lou St. Amant**, prior to the team becoming a competitor in the Southland Conference.

- On the 2026 roster, ULM welcomes back 49 returners and brings in 56 newcomers, providing an 48% retention rate from 2025. Out of the newcomers, the Warhawks welcome 10 first-years, 23 NCAA transfers and 23 JUCO transfers to the bayou. Out of those returning to Monroe, 20 have played with ULM for one year, 21 for two years, three for three years and four for four years.
- 17 Warhawks on the roster are competing in the 2026 season having already completed a degree. On the defense, **Billy Pullen**, **Kevontay Wells**, **Navarion Benson**, **Cooper Eldridge**, **Kelbee Holmes**, **Levontae Jacobs**, **Marcus Ross** and **CJ Wilson** have already graduated. For the offense, **Brandon Buckhaulte**, **Javon Campbell**, **Don Chaney**, **John Curtis Goodman Jr.**, **Quentis Griffin Jr.**, **Drew Hutchinson**, **Reese Steele** and **Korian Wilson** have collected degrees. **Max Larson** is the lone member of the special teams room to have received a degree prior to the 2026 season.
- ULM's 12-game football schedule features six home games, four being conference opponents. The last time ULM had six home games was the 2024 season, where the Warhawks went 4-2 at Malone Stadium. Overall, it marks the eighth time that the Warhawks have played a six-game home schedule since joining the NCAA Football Bowl Subdivision (formerly known as Division I-A).
- ULM's 2026 opponents went a combined 72-81 (.471) in 2025, with five opponents going over .500. In addition, seven foes also participated in postseason bowl games a year ago: Mississippi State (Duke's Mayo Bowl), Louisiana Tech (Radiance Technologies Independence Bowl), Troy (IS4S Salute to Veterans Bowl), Southern Miss (New Orleans Bowl), Arkansas State (XBox Bowl), the Ragin' Cajuns (68 Ventures Bowl) and App State (JLab Birmingham Bowl).
- Four ULM football players have been recognized on the Preseason All-Sun Belt teams, the most in the Bryant Vincent era and the most since 2020. Two offensive and two defense players were featured on the teams for the Warhawks. **AJ Vinson** and **Noah Flemmings** were recognized on the Preseason All-Sun Belt First Team and **Nic Trujillo** and **Jabari Tiller** were named to the second team.
- ULM has 26 states featured on its roster in 2026. In announcing its roster, ULM Football posts 19 Louisiana players, 11 coming from Monroe's own Ouachita Parish. Louisiana is the state with the most representatives on the team, with Mississippi following close behind with 18. Texas records the third-most with 15 and Alabama records 10. Iowa, Florida, Pennsylvania and Georgia all record a few, while 19 other states are represented with one or two.
- ULM's coaching staff features six new faces in 2026, including offensive coordinator and receivers coach **Jesse Montalto**, special teams coordinator and defensive line coach **Tony McClain**, pass game coordinator **Chris Jones**, running backs coach **Shawn Simmons** and tight ends coach **Gavin Blomberg**. Montalto arrives after eight seasons at the helm of Iowa Central CC, where he claimed the Region XI title and ICCAC Coach of the Year in 2019. McClain makes his ULM appearance after time at East Texas A&M, where he spent two seasons. Jones arrives from a season in the Belichick era at North Carolina as the senior associate director of player personnel. Simmons also arrives from Iowa Central CC, previously playing at Central Methodist. Blomberg rounds out the new staff from Iowa Central.
- Staff updates came in the offseason as well, with **Troy Reffett** taking over duties at defensive coordinator. **Derek Cronenwett** was named the team's general manager as **Micheal Atiyeh** became the director of football operations. **Isaac Lopez** is responsible for strength & conditioning efforts for the team.
- Family connections on the ULM football coaching staff include **Bryant Vincent's** son, **Brady Vincent**, as the team's Tight Ends Coach. **Bret Vincent** makes it three Vincents featured in the ULM football program, with Bret playing wide receiver for the Warhawks.

OFFENSE NOTES

Quarterbacks

- Returning at the quarterback position this season is fourth-year **Aidan Armenta**, who assumed the starting position midway through the 2024 season. In 2025, Armenta completed 148 passes on 253 attempts for a 58.5% completion percentage, posting 12 touchdowns and 1,629 yards. Armenta made his first start of 2026 against the Bulldogs, passing 10 of 16 attempts for 67 yards. The quarterback also rushed for 15 yards in the process.
- Fourth-year **Landon Graves** also makes the return, after appearing in eight games on the offense making a start at Southern Miss last season. Graves totaled 185 yards and two touchdowns in his third season.
- Bryson Kimbrough** returns for his second season in the quarterback room as well, having not seen time in 2025.
- Two more quarterbacks joined the Warhawks entering 2026, in Houston transfer **Austin Carlisle** and Iowa Central transfer **Ty Purdy**.
- Carlisle made his first career start at UAB, completing 10 of 16 passes for 56 yards, also rushing for a team-leading 93 yards and reaching the endzone for a touchdown.

Running Backs

- The Warhawks reloaded at the running back position by adding transfers **Derrick Jameson** (Utah State), **Don Chaney** (Charlotte), **Julian Walker** (Saint Vincent), **CJ Phillip** (Iowa Central CC), **Bryson Roland** (Arkansas Tech), **Trevon Kinchen** (Georgia Military) and **Makin Lenard** (Ouachita Baptist).
- Jameson got the start at Mississippi State, logging 18 rushing yards and 40 receiving yards, including a 40-yard touchdown reception for the team's first touchdown of 2026.
- Walker was named All-PAC Honorable Mention with 564 rushing yards and four touchdowns under his belt for

Saint Vincent in 2025.

- Roland was recognized multiple times in 2025, recognized on D2CCA All-Super Region 4 Second Team, GAC Freshman of the Year, All-GAC First Team. He logged 25 receptions for 396 yards and two touchdowns, averaging 15.8 yards per catch.
- Roland earned the start at UAB, seeing 86 rushing yards from 19 carries. Phillip was credited with a rushing touchdown in Birmingham, also collecting three carries.
- ULM also brought in true freshman RB **Christian Ponti**, a local talent coming from West Monroe HS. **Jaydon Wright** also returns for another season in Monroe, looking to see time in 2026.

Offensive Line

- The Warhawks return two starting guards from last season. **AJ Vinson** and **Kaliem Croswell** are set for their second seasons in Monroe. Vinson was voted to the Preseason All-Sun Belt First Team.
- Vinson and Croswell anchor the line as veterans, Dugery making both starts at center. Also joining are familiar faces in Griffin Jr. and Applewhite to wrap up the O-Line.
- Quentis Griffin Jr.** is back for a third season with ULM, after appearing in three games last season. Also returning for the Warhawks' offensive line is **David Applewhite** and **Drew Hutchinson**, both of whom saw action last season. **Roscoe Tucker** and **Reese Steele** return from injury in 2026.
- Newcomer and transfer from Memphis **Sean Dugery** held strong at center, with Vinson, Applewhite, Croswell and Griffin seeing snaps on the O-Line at Mississippi State. The line allowed for 138 rushing yards and only allowed two sacks.

Receivers/Tight Ends

- Nic Trujillo**, named to the Preseason All-Sun Belt Second Team, is back on the roster and was one of Armenta's top targets last season. After returning from injury midway through the season, Trujillo caught four touchdowns, including two at the Ragin' Cajuns.
- JP Coulter** appeared in all 12 games last season and totaled 234 yards from 21 catches, concluding his year with a career-high 56 yards at Texas State. **Brandon Buckhault** also returns for his second season, collecting 52 yards and a touchdown last season. **Javon Campbell** is also back after being sidelined through injury in 2025, appearing at Texas State to make his return.
- Added to the receiving room are transfers **LT Robinson** (Hutchinson CC), **Demarcco Blanton** (Arkansas State), **Parker Fulghum** (Clemson) and **Marcellus Jackson** (Itawamba CC). Freshmen in **Keidric Osunde-Brown** and **Jaiden Tucker** are also added to the roster.
- Jackson saw the majority of the targets in the season opener at Mississippi State, claiming six receptions for 37 yards to lead receivers. He then led the team with three catches for 21 yards at UAB.
- In the tight end room, **Steven Gorski** makes the return as the Warhawk veteran. In 2025, he saw action in three games, recording a tackle at UTEP. Gorski has primarily seen time in special teams scenarios this season.
- Quad Harrison** returns after competing for the Warhawks in 2024, **Nate Green** claiming a position change at tight end after seeing starts on the offensive line last season.
- Newcomers for the tight end room include Memphis transfer **Bryce Anderson**, Iowa Central transfer **Dalen Huston**, Tennessee State transfer **Jase Hoath** and Merrimack transfer **Cade Callahan**.
- Callahan joined Anderson for the majority of the snaps taken at Mississippi State, Anderson collected three receptions for 22 yards. The Memphis transfer logged a reception for five yards in Birmingham.

DEFENSE NOTES

Defensive Line

- Returning from injury is defensive end **Derek Omoregie**, in his second season in Monroe. Also returning is **James Smith**, for a fifth year at ULM after appearing in 11 games and notching 14 tackles last season.
- Omoregie and Smith both recorded tackles at Mississippi State in the home opener, Omoregie also combining for a tackle for loss at UAB. Nine Warhawks were credited with TFLs against the Blazers.
- **Moses Madubuike** (Navarro JC) and **Marvin Hall** (Garden City CC) both transfer in to add to the defensive ends. Sixth year **Levontae Jacobs** also makes the return on the defensive line, anchoring newcomers such as **CJ Wilson** (Butler), **Zyan Tremont** (Jones College) and **Colton Vatne** (Mississippi Valley State).

Linebackers

- **Noah Flemmings** is back for his second season with the Warhawks after posting 80 tackles, 11.0 tackles for loss, a pass breakup, a forced fumble and two fumble recoveries to receive All-Sun Belt Third Team accolades. Flemmings was recognized in the preseason by multiple watchlists, most notably named to the Chuck Bednarik Award Watchlist, honoring the best college defensive player of the season.
- Joining him is **Marcus Ross**, who registered 35 tackles, two sacks and two forced fumbles in his 2025 campaign. Back for a third year is **Jaeden Calender**, who appeared in all 12 games with 25 tackles and two quarterback hurries under his belt last season. Also returning after seeing action all last season is **Kelbee Holmes**.
- Newcoming linebackers include **Rickey Banks**, who recorded 70 tackles last season at Northeast Mississippi CC. **Jackson Parker** also arrives from Northeast Mississippi. Linebacker **LaZavier Amos** was named an NJCAA All-American last season after registering 125 tackles and five sacks at Trinity Valley CC.

- Flemmings led the team in the season opener with nine tackles, Ross logging six. Holmes and Amos combined for a TFL as well. Flemmings led again at UAB with 11 tackles. He also recovered a fumble in Birmingham, his third while with the Warhawks.

Defensive Backs

- Returning for the defense includes **Jabari Tiller** appears for a second season with ULM after collecting 45 tackles, two sacks, a forced fumble and a pass breakup.
- Also returning is **Zy Jackson**, who totaled 25 tackles, a pass breakup and a tackle for loss last season and **Jay Harper**, who made a start and recorded three tackles. Defensive back **Navarion Benson** remains with ULM as **Korian Wilson** returns from injury to make an impact in 2026.
- Defensive newcomers include **Armoni Rue**, who saw action in five games and posted five solo stops while at UTSA. Other transfers include **RJ Hall** (Hinds CC), **Jonathan Crain** (Co-Lin CC) and **Willie Wilson** (American International).
- Tiller led the defensive backs with seven tackles at Mississippi State, as Rue also led the team with two pass breakups. Tiller co-led the team with Flemmings with 11 tackles at UAB, as Fauntroy logged his second career interception against his former team.

SPECIAL TEAMS NOTES

- Special teams players **Max Larson**, **Makenzie Ryan** and **Nolan Wilson** are all back on ULM's 2026 roster. Larson missed the 2025 season due to injury, but went 14-for-17 on field goal attempts and 27-for-28 on PATs in 2024. Ryan booted 60 punts with an average of 38.8 yards per punt, downing 13 inside the 20-yard line last season. Wilson was the long snapper for all 12 games last season.
- ULM signed long snapper **Matthew Feibush** to the roster, who arrives from Colorado State-Pueblo. **Gavin Polk**, a Monroe native from Ouachita Christian School, joins the special teams room along with California transfer **Abram Murray**. Murray was named to the Phil Steele Preseason Sun Belt Fourth Team.
- Murray was a bright spot for ULM at Mississippi State, knocking back two field goals and collecting four touchbacks on kickoff duty. His 52-yard field goal to break open ULM's scoring was a career high and the first 50+-yard field goal since 2022. He then nailed two field goals to reach 4-of-5 on the season at UAB.
- Ryan notched seven punts against the Bulldogs, two being 50+ yards with a 53-yard long punt and an average of 44.6 yards. Ryan's punt average of 42.4 ranks 38th nationally among punters.

BIRMINGHAM, Ala. – The ULM football team fell to UAB in a 60-minute fight at Protective Stadium. The Warhawks won the first quarter after holding UAB without a score in the opening 15 minutes. But the Blazers outscored ULM 10-0 in the fourth quarter to secure the victory. Combined with 381 yards of total offense to ULM's 257, the Blazers took the lead in the fourth and did not let up. ULM was 4-for-4 in the red zone, with two touchdowns and two field goals. But it was third down that made the difference as the Warhawks were three-of-12 and UAB was 10-for-15. UAB did not ever resign to punt, instead turning the ball over twice and finding scores on every other drive.

The Blazers got possession first, Braylon McReynolds landing two first downs for UAB. Jaeden Calender then hurried quarterback Ryder Burton, the fourth-down pass falling incomplete to turn the ball over on downs. The Warhawks picked up, as Austin Carlisle combined with Bryson Roland for four first downs as the team reached the red zone. On the one-yard line, CJ Phillip crossed into the end zone to score the first touchdown of the game with 5:09 on the clock.

The Blazers worked to find the end zone, hunting from behind. While a few first downs had the home team close, the first quarter came to an end with the Warhawks ahead, 7-0. As the second quarter began, Jonah Delange nailed a 41-yard field goal to cut the lead to four.

ULM picked up possession, a penalty advancing the Warhawks 15 yards to midfield. Roland broke free to collect two first downs, including an 18-yard rush to get ULM knocking at the door. It was Carlisle with the quarterback keeper to score the second touchdown of the game for ULM, making it 14-3. The Blazers picked up the pace in their next drive, the home team marching downfield. Tyrell Brown picked up a sack to force the second-and-long, but UAB converted. McReynolds then broke free for 27 yards to score the first touchdown for the Blazers, making it a 14-10 score.

The Warhawks resigned to a punt in the following drive. The punt was muffed, however, by the home team, Noah Flemmings recovering the ball. After getting a fresh set of downs, the Warhawks were unable to convert, turning the ball over. A false start made it first and long for the Blazers, as quarterback Burton immediately had his pass intercepted by former UAB player Carl Fauntroy. The defense fought back, however, as ULM settled for a field goal as time expired in the half, ahead 17-10.

ULM opened the second half with possession, quickly reaching Blazer territory. After the third down conversion fell short, Abram Murray found the uprights for his second field goal for the 20-10 score. As UAB began its drive, KJ Daniels broke away for 35 yards to enter Warhawk territory, on the hunt to chip at the lead. The Blazers were unable to reach the endzone, settling for a 45-yard field goal. One first down was nailed, but the Warhawks were forced to punt. Tiller racked up some stops to hold the Blazers, but the home team continued to drive. The third quarter ended with UAB on the ULM21, Warhawks ahead 20-13.

Fauntroy continued his command of the ULM defense with a sack of six yards. The Blazers were forced to attempt the field goal, cutting the lead to four. UAB's defense forced the punt from ULM, setting up good field position to try and take the lead. A quarterback keeper converted the third down, Burton then launching a 43-yard pass for the touchdown and the lead, 23-20, with 9:34 left. As the Warhawks took over on offense, back-to-back penalties from the defense placed ULM at midfield. Another penalty had the Warhawks converting on fourth down. Carlisle's pass was then tipped and intercepted, UAB regaining possession with just under six minutes on the clock.

After slowly reaching Warhawk territory, the ULM defense was able to force the field goal, making it a 26-20 score with just over a minute for ULM to make a scoring attempt. The Warhawks then turned the ball over on downs as UAB secured the 26-20 victory.

FMOL Health | St. Francis Stadium stands as a proud symbol of Warhawk tradition and community pride. FMOL Health | St. Francis Stadium has served as the home of ULM football since its opening on September 16, 1978.

Before the stadium was built, the football team played at Brown Stadium, which seated just over 8,000. It was through the vision of local leaders, including former Monroe mayor Jack Howard, that a new facility was made possible.

Originally named Malone Stadium, the stadium held 20,000 fans and debuted with a then-Northeast Louisiana 21-13 victory over Arkansas State. In 1983, seating was expanded into both end zones. The west grandstand features the press box, sky box and ULM's athletic department offices. The east side of the stadium offers additional seating with double-deck bleachers that nearly stretch the full length of the field.

In 2007, the natural grass surface was replaced with a ProPlay synthetic surface, followed by a new FieldTurf installation in 2014. In 2011, ULM introduced a massive HD video scoreboard that measures 23 feet tall by 48 feet wide as well as a sound system.

In 2016, ULM opened a state-of-the-art fieldhouse located in the northwest corner of the stadium. The 11,750-square-foot facility includes a ULM football history display, locker rooms, coaches' offices and a patio with a view of the playing field. A players' lounge that features a full-sized kitchen, gaming tables and couches was introduced in the spring of 2022. New field turf was installed before the 2023 season. The facility was further upgraded in 2024 with enhancements to the team room, locker room and athletic department lobby.

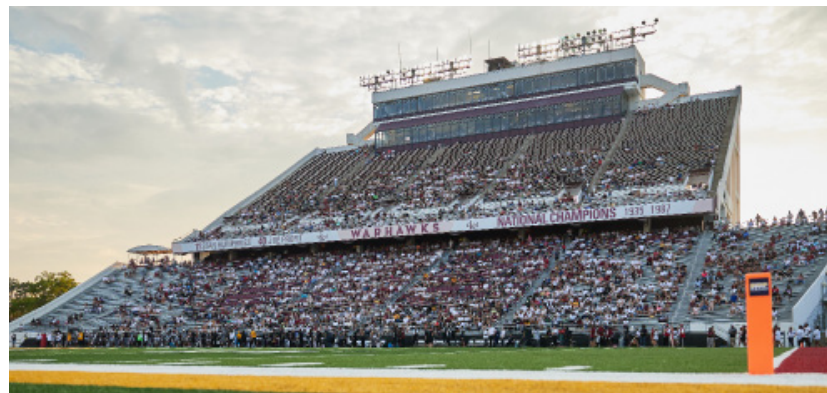
FMOL Health | St. Francis Stadium has been the center stage for some of the most memorable moments in ULM football history, including a record-setting crowd of 31,175 set on September 21, 2012, versus Baylor. Regional rivalries between Louisiana Tech and Grambling State have drawn some of the largest crowds in ULM history.

BRYANT VINCENT

THIRD SEASON AT ULM (8-18) FOURTH SEASON OVERALL (15-24)

Bryant Vincent, known for his strong leadership and expertise in creating powerful offensive schemes in college football, was named the 17th head football coach in University of Louisiana Monroe history on Wednesday, December 6, 2023.

Coach Vincent entered his second season in 2025, leading his team to a 28-16 homecoming victory over Arkansas State, ULM's first defeat of the Red Wolves in over 16 years. Another notable 2025 score was the 29-0 season-opening win over Saint Francis, ULM's first shutout victory in over 10 years.

While managing duties as interim athletic director, Vincent's Warhawks led the Sun Belt and ranked third in FBS in kickoff return defense (13.24) and third in the conference with two blocked kicks. Linebacker Noah Flemmings was placed on the All-Sun Belt Defense Third Team, as senior cornerback D'Arco Perkins-McAllister signed an undrafted free agency contract with the Kansas City Chiefs.

In his first season as head coach of ULM football, Coach Vincent began establishing a culture of grit and resilience that propelled the Warhawks to one of their most successful starts in nearly four decades. ULM opened the 2024 season 5-1, the program's best start in 37 years, and Vincent was the only Sun Belt Conference Coach named to the 2024 Paul "Bear" Bryant Coach of the Year Award Watch List.

Vincent secured his first victory as head coach

with a 30-14 win over Jackson State on August 29, 2024. After defeating Troy on the road 13-9 in the Sun Belt Conference opener, Vincent led the Warhawks to a signature victory over JMU by a score of 21-19 to give ULM its first 4-1 start in the FBS era.

Under Vincent's direction, the Warhawks led the SBC in several statistical categories, including passing yards allowed (183.9), blocked kicks (3) and fewest penalty yards per game (43.25).

He developed 2024 Sun Belt Conference Freshman of the Year Ahmad Hardy, who led the league with 1,351 rushing yards and 13 rushing touchdowns as a true freshman. Hardy was named ULM's first FWAA Freshman All-American in program history and was also voted Louisiana Freshman of the Year by the Louisiana Sports Writers Association.

Including Hardy, nine Warhawks garnered SBC postseason honors for the first time in over five seasons including All-Sun Belt Second Team defensive lineman Kevontay Wells and All-Sun Belt Third Team defensive stars Billy Pullen, Carl Glass Jr., and Wydett Williams Jr. Additionally, two of Vincent's players went on to compete at the professional level after senior cornerback Carlin Vigers signed an undrafted free agent contract with the NFL's Washington Commanders and senior offensive lineman Sam Carson was drafted by the CFL's Ottawa Redblacks.

Off the field, Vincent's leadership produced unprecedented academic results. ULM football recorded the highest term GPA in program history in Fall 2024, and the team's 84% graduation success rate (GSR) led all Sun Belt programs. Additionally, major facility upgrades were completed at the stadium, including renovations to the team room, locker room and main athletics lobby.

Before arriving in Monroe, Vincent served as the Offensive Coordinator at the University of New Mexico during the 2023 season. Under Vincent's offensive schemes, the Lobos earned national top-20 rankings in red zone offense (14th) and rushing offense (19th). Additionally, Vincent coached running back Jacory Croskey-Merritt to a record-breaking season. The New Mexico running back was the first Lobo to ever have back-to-back 200-yard rushing games and finished with 17 rushing touchdowns, which is third all-time in New Mexico football history.

Prior to New Mexico, Vincent served as the Interim Head Coach at UAB following the retirement of Bill Clark and led the Blazers to a 7-6 season and a win in the 2022 Bahamas Bowl. UAB's offense generated 30.1 points per game and 438.2 yards per game, which was the 33rd highest mark in the country. Vincent spent four seasons as UAB's offensive coordinator/quarterbacks coach and was a key figure in elevating the program since its reinstatement in 2017. In all, Vincent helped lead UAB to a pair of Conference USA Championships and bowl game victories.

UAB has been the winningest team in Conference USA since returning to the playing field and collected 42 wins since Vincent returned as OC. The Blazers won the 2018 CUSA title game 27-25 over Middle Tennessee State, winning on the road, and the 2020 CUSA title game, that one 22-13 over Marshall, again on the road.

UAB also made it to the 2019 championship game as champions of their division. Since the reinstatement of the program in 2017, Vincent coached in five bowls games, qualifying for six. UAB won the 2018 Boca Raton Bowl 37-13 over Northern Illinois, the 2021 Independence Bowl 31-28 over BYU and the 2022 Bahamas Bowl. UAB also played in the 2017 Bahamas Bowl against Ohio and the 2019 New Orleans Bowl against App State, and the team qualified for the 2020 Gasparilla Bowl against South Carolina, before being canceled due to COVID-19.

With Vincent at offensive coordinator, the Blazers set FBS-program records for wins in 2018, going 11-3. Vincent never had a losing season with Blazers, going 7-6 as head coach and going 48-27 overall in his six years with UAB. The 2018 Blazers had the best offensive season in program history which resulted in 21 school records, including the aforementioned 11-3 overall record and winning the program's first Conference USA title and bowl game.

Among the school records that fell in 2018 included total points (418), total touchdowns (53), rushing touchdowns (32), total yards (5,680) and rushing yards (2,818). Additionally, UAB set the single game school record for total yards (668) and rushing yards (419) in a 52-3 victory over UTSA on Nov. 3, 2018.

Vincent is no stranger to the Sun Belt Conference and spent six years in two separate stints with South Alabama. He served as the offensive coordinator and quarterbacks coach from 2015-17 and was an assistant coach from 2011-13 for the Jaguars' football program. Vincent helped guide the Jaguars to the 2016 Nova Home Loans Arizona Bowl led by record setting quarterback Dallas Davis. In Vincent's offense, Davis threw for the most yards in school history (2,706) and his 2,951 total yards of offense are second most in program history.

Before entering the collegiate ranks, Vincent was a successful high school football coach in Alabama and tallied a record of 49-16 in five seasons at two different schools. In his first season as a head coach, Vincent led Greenville High School to a 10-3 record and was selected as the Class 5A Coach of the Year in 2006. Vincent was at the helm of Spanish Fort High School football for four seasons and produced a record of 39-13. His team captured the Alabama 5A State Championship in 2010.

Vincent is a native of Glasgow, Kentucky. He and his wife Holli have two sons, Brady, a member of the ULM football coaching staff and Bret, a wide receiver for the Warhawks.

STARKVILLE, Miss. — The ULM football team fell to the Mississippi State Bulldogs in Starkville, to a 62-13 score. The Bulldogs collected 762 total yards, while ULM posted 278, only converting three of 16 third downs. Mississippi State opened the offense, a few long passes from Kamario Taylor reaching the red zone. A final pass up the middle to Sanfrisco Magee gave the Bulldogs the 7-0 lead. Armoni Rue broke up a pass to force a second down, but a 22-yard completion to Zion Ragins had Mississippi State in the end zone for the 14-0 edge.

A quarterback scramble from Taylor got the home team on the board for a third touchdown with 6:05 remaining in the first quarter. A few long passes from Armenta got the Warhawks in Bulldog territory as time expired in the first quarter. The second quarter opened with Abram Murray nailing a 43-yard field goal, as ULM got on the board with the 21-3 score. Taylor for the Bulldogs picked up where he left off, however, a handful of completions setting up Mississippi State for another touchdown. The ULM defense then combined for a couple of stops to force the field goal attempt, completed from 26 yards.

Lewis broke up another pass to force the field goal attempt for a second time, as the home team made it a 34-3 score. Xavier Gayten rushed for 14 yards to score another touchdown for Mississippi State as the clock ran down for the halftime score, 41-3.

ULM opened the second half with a three-and-out, Taylor tossing a 70-yard pass to Marquis Johnson for the touchdown. Austin Carlisle then launched a 40-yard shot to Derrick Jameson, who reached the endzone for ULM's first touchdown of the season, the score 48-10. Carlisle connected with Jackson multiple times before an 18-yard quarterback keeper got ULM into home territory. While the Warhawks could not convert on third down, it was Murray who kicked a career-high 52-yard field goal to add to the board.

A quarterback sneak allowed for the conversion on fourth down, Warhawks knocking on the door. A third attempt at a field goal then failed, as the home team received possession. After a handful of short gains for Mississippi State, a 57-yard rush gave the Bulldogs the 55-13 edge. After getting the ball back with less than seven minutes on the clock, Hill drove the offense to score the final touchdown for the 62-13 final score.

BIRMINGHAM, Ala. — The ULM football team fell to UAB in a 60-minute fight at Protective Stadium. The Warhawks won the first quarter after holding UAB without a score in the opening 15 minutes. But the Blazers outscored ULM 10-0 in the fourth quarter to secure the victory. Combined with 381 yards of total offense to ULM's 257, the Blazers took the lead in the fourth and did not let up.

The Blazers got possession first, Jaeden Calender hurrying quarterback Ryder Burton, the fourth-down pass falling incomplete to turn the ball over on downs. The Warhawks picked up, as the team reached the red zone. On the one-yard line, CJ Phillip crossed into the end zone to score the first touchdown of the game. While a few first downs had the home team close, the first quarter came to an end with the Warhawks ahead, 7-0. As the second quarter began, Jonah Delange nailed a 41-yard field goal to cut the lead to four.

ULM picked up possession, a penalty advancing the Warhawks 15 yards to midfield. Roland broke free to collect two first downs, including an 18-yard rush to get ULM knocking at the door. It was Carlisle with the quarterback keeper to score the second touchdown of the game for ULM, making it 14-3. On the defense, Tyrell Brown picked up a sack to force the second-and-long, but UAB converted. McReynolds then broke free for 27 yards to score the first touchdown for the Blazers, making it a 14-10 score.

The Warhawks resigned to a punt in the following drive. The punt was muffed, however, Noah Flemmings recovering the ball. After getting a fresh set of downs, the Warhawks were unable to convert, turning the ball over. A false start made it first and long for the Blazers, as quarterback Burton immediately had his pass intercepted by former UAB player Carl Fauntroy. The defense fought back, however, as ULM settled for a field goal as time expired in the half, ahead 17-10.

After a third down conversion fell short, Abram Murray found the uprights for his second field goal for the 20-10 score. The Blazers were then unable to reach the endzone, settling for a 45-yard field goal. The third quarter ended with UAB on the ULM21, Warhawks ahead 20-13. Fauntroy continued his command of the ULM defense with a sack of six yards. The Blazers were forced to attempt the field goal. A quarterback keeper converted the third down, Burton then launching a 43-yard pass for the lead, 23-20, with 9:34 left. As the Warhawks took over on offense, back-to-back penalties from the defense placed ULM at midfield. Carlisle's pass was then tipped and intercepted, UAB regaining possession with just under six minutes on the clock.

After slowly reaching Warhawk territory, the ULM defense was able to force the field goal, making it a 26-20 score with just over a minute for ULM to make a scoring attempt. The Warhawks then turned the ball over on downs as UAB secured the 26-20 victory.
