llanova Game Storvlines

✓ Maine (5-3, 4-1 CAA) goes for its sixth-straight win when it hosts Villanova (6-2, 4-1) at Alfond Stadium. A win for Maine would snap a two-game losing skid against the Wildcats.

✓The Black Bears have won five in a row for the first time since 2013 but it has not been easy. For the first time in Maine's 125 year football history, the Black Bears have won five-straight games with each decision being decided by seven or fewer. In Maine's last two games, it has forced eight turnovers including six interceptions.

✓ Maine is coming off a 35-28 road victory at William & Mary. For the second-straight week, a last second defensive turnover sealed the win for Maine. Micah Wright was named CAA Special Teams Player of the Week after returning a punt 67-yards for a score; the first punt return TD for the Black Bears since 2011. Wright also had a receiving touchdown and was one of eight receivers catching a pass for the spread out Maine offense.

✓Villanova, coming off a bye, defeated UAlbany 24-13 in its last outing back on Oct. 22. The Wildcats, who are 2-2 on the road this season, are coached by Andy Talley who is in his 32nd season at Villanova. Maine head coach Joe Harasymiak was not even born when Talley began his reign at

✓ A key matchup today will be Maine's second-ranked CAA pass offense (222.8 ypg) against Villanova's third ranked pass defense (163.8 ypg). Maine, which is averaging 191.3 ypg on the ground over its last three games, meets Villanova's CAA leading rush defense (96.0).

Maine has had one Rimington Award winner, awarded to the top safety in all of FCS football. Bruce Johnson earned the award in 2015.

Maine has won a three conference titles. The Black Bears won the Atlantic 10 title in both the 2001 and 2002 seasons before winning their first ever CAA title in 2013.

Maine has appeared in the NCAA FCS playoffs seven times. The Black Bears earned a spot in the playoff field in 1987, 1989, 2001, 2002, 2008, 2011 and 2013.

Conference Defensive Player-of-the-Year awards, including Stephen Cooper in 2001 and 2002; and Jovan Belcher in 2008.

Stephen Cooper (2001 and 2002), Matt King (2006) and Jovan Belcher (2008) were finalists for the Buck Buchanan Award, which is presented annually to the nation's most outstanding defensive player at the FCS level.

Marcus Williams (TB) finished as a finalist for the Walter Payton Award in 2003, which is presented annually to the nation's most outstanding offensive player at the FCS level.

Maine has had 19 All-Americans in the 2000s, including its most recent All-American, Bruce Johnson (2015).

Maine has had 27 NFL \overline{D} raft picks/rookie free agent signings. Maine currently has one former player (Justin Perillo - TE - Packers) on an NFL roster.

Maine has knocked off two FBS foes; a 9-7 win over Mississippi State in 2004 and a 24-14 win at UMass in 2013.

Maine has recorded 41 first-team all-conference honors, including four in 2011 and six in 2013.

- ✓ Micah Wright enters action 9 receptions from 100 in his career and 223-yards away from 1,500 receiving yards. Wright currently ranks sixth in the CAA in receptions per game (4.5), four in receiving yards (70.2 ypg), fourth in yards per catch (15.6), ninth in total receptions (27), seventh in receptions yards (421) and tied for second in receiving touchdowns (5). Wright was named CAA Special Teams Player of the Week after returning a punt 67-yards at W&M. Wright leads the league at 15.2 yards per punt return, good for eighth nationally.

Black Bear Bites

- Preseason all-conference and STATS All-American selection Pat Ricard looks to pick up where he left off in 2015; in the opposition's backfield. Ricard led the CAA in TFLs (16.5), ranked sixth in sacks (7.0) and second with three forced fumbles. Ricard notched five games with 2.0 or more TFLs, including a career-high 4.5 at Albany, and record 2.0 or more TFLs in five of his last six games.
- It's a whole new look in the Maine sideline with five new coaches and a total of nine in new roles. It all starts at the top with first year head coach Joe Harasymiak, who takes over after Jack Cosgrove stepped down following a 23-year head coaching career. Both coodinators are fresh to their roles, beginning with first-year coach Liam Coen (OC) and defensive coordinator Corey Hetherman, who is in his second year on staff and first as coordinator.
- Maine's OL made huge strides in 2015 as it ranked fourth in the CAA in fewest sacks allowed (18), down from 23 a year ago in 2014. The loss of Rimington Award winning center Bruce Johnson to graduation will be a key spot for replacement. Maine returns four starters on its OL but will be hampered by an injury to junior Jamil Demby. Max Andrews steps in alongside third year veterans Isaiah Brooks (22 games), John Reddington (13) and Dan Burrows (19).
- Maine received a pair of all-conference selections at wide-out in Micah Wright (So., 6-1, 190) and Jordan Dunn (Sr., 6-2, 200). The top-flight duo become one of only two receiver units in the CAA to receive a pair of all-conference performers. After showing promise in his first season but falling to injury early, Wright battled back to record one of the best statistical seasons for a freshman receiver in Maine history. The redshirt freshman recorded 61 receptions for 818-yards and five touchdowns. Wright ranked third in the CAA with 5.55 receptions per game and third in receiving yards (74.4 ypg). Dunn, who averaged 10.6 yards per catch, totaled 56 receptions for 595-yards and three scores. Dunn finished the year with 5.09 catchers per game; fourth best in the league.
