Stony Brook Game Storylines

✓Maine (5-4, 4-2 CAA) goes for its fourth-straight road win when it travels to take on Stony Brook (5-4, 4-2 CAA) in a late season, key league match-up.

✓The Black Bears had their five-game win streak snapped a week ago when they dropped a 26-7 decision to No. 10 Villanova. Earnest Edwards was the highlight of the day, returning the opening kickoff of the second half 97-yards for a score. The flashy play of the freshman earned him CAA Special Teams Player of the Week. Pat Ricard added a career-high 5.0 TFLs in the set back.

✓Maine and Stony Brook will be meeting for the sixth time in history with the Black Bears taking the most recent meeting by a score of 23-10 last season. The home team has won all five meetings in the series. Stony Brook captured the first ever meeting, 30-23, in a 2007 double overtime contest.

✓Stony Brook has lost two-straight, including a 14-7 stumble last weekend at home against William & Mary. The Seawolves, averaging just 11.5 points in their last two outings, are 3-2 at home. Stony Brook began CAA play 4-0, including a 42-14 victory over Richmond, but have stumbled in its last two conference outings. The Seawolves are tied for the second most turnovers (21) in the league. Maine has forced nine turnovers in the last three weeks.

✓A week after facing the CAA's top defense (Villanova), Maine meets Stony Brook who ranks second in total defense (277.8 ypg) and second in rush defense (98.8). Maine totaled 334-yards against Villanova's defense and will put its second-ranked pass offense (224.1 ypg) up against Stony Brook's seventh ranked pass defense (179.0).

Black Bear Bites

- Preseason all-conference and STATS All-American selection Pat Ricard looks to pick up where he left off in 2015; in the opposition's backfield. Ricard led the CAA in TFLs (16.5), ranked sixth in sacks (7.0) and second with three forced fumbles. Ricard notched five games with 2.0 or more TFLs, including a career-high 4.5 at Albany, and record 2.0 or more TFLs in five of his last six games.
- It's a whole new look in the Maine sideline with five new coaches and a total of nine in new roles. It all starts at the top with first year head coach Joe Harasymiak, who takes over after Jack Cosgrove stepped down following a 23-year head coaching career. Both coordinators are fresh to their roles, beginning with first-year coach Liam Coen (OC) and defensive coordinator Corey Hetherman, who is in his second year on staff and first as coordinator.
- Maine's OL made huge strides in 2015 as it ranked fourth in the CAA in fewest sacks allowed (18), down from 23 a year ago in 2014. The loss of Rimington Award winning center Bruce Johnson to graduation will be a key spot for replacement. Maine returns four starters on its OL but will be hampered by an injury to junior Jamil Demby. Max Andrews steps in alongside third year veterans Isaiah Brooks (22 games), John Reddington (13) and Dan Burrows (19).
- Maine received a pair of all-conference selections at wide-out in Micah Wright (So., 6-1, 190) and Jordan Dunn (Sr., 6-2, 200). The top-flight duo become one of only two receiver units in the CAA to receive a pair of all-conference performers. After showing promise in his first season but falling to injury early, Wright battled back to record one of the best statistical seasons for a freshman receiver in Maine history. The redshirt freshman recorded 61 receptions for 818-yards and five touchdowns. Wright ranked third in the CAA with 5.55 receptions per game and third in receiving yards (74.4 ypg). Dunn, who averaged 10.6 yards per catch, totaled 56 receptions for 595-yards and three scores. Dunn finished the year with 5.09 catches per game; fourth best in the league.
