Toledo Game Storv lines

✓ Maine meets Toledo for the first time in history and will be looking for its third FBS victory (Mississippi St. 2004 - UMass 2013) in school history. ✓ This will be the first meeting between Maine and Toledo. The Black Bears are 3-3 against teams in the Mid-American Conference (MAC), with all six meetings coming against Buffalo. In a most recent meeting with a MAC member, Maine defeated Buffalo 30-13 in 1998 after also winning in 1997 (52-13).

Maine's last win against a team in its first meeting was in 2014 when it defeated Elon, 24-14.

Last time out, Maine led at UConn with under seven minutes to play but a Husky field goal with 11-seconds left proved to be the game-winner as UConn escaped with a 24-21 win.

Maine's Black Hole defense notched 10 TFLs in its opener at UConn. It is the second-straight year Maine has started a season with 10 TFLs against an FBS opponent (Boston College - Sept. 5, 2015). Maine also recorded 10 TFLs last year against Rhode Island. The Black Hole has tallied 8+ TFLs in

TFLs last year against Khode Island. The Black Hole has tallied 8+ 1 FLs in seven of its last 12 games.

The Black Bears did not allow a sack in the opener against UConn, marking the fifth time in their last 11 games without allowing a sack. It is also the second-straight FBS game that Maine did not allow a sack (Tulane - 9/19). Maine has allowed just 13 sacks over its last 11 contests.

The Black Bears return 43 letterwinners (18 off., 23 def., 2 specialists), including 17 who started 5+ games, from its 2015 squad which finished 3-8 overall and 3-5 in Colonial Athletic Association action.

Toledo, a year removed from a 10-2 season and a victory in the Marmot Boca Raton Bowl, enter at 1-0 after starting its season with a 31-10 win at Arkansas State.

Black Bear Bites

- Preseason all-conference and STATS All-American selection Pat Ricard looks to pick up where he left off in 2015; in the opposition's backfield. Ricard led the CAA in TFLs (16.5), ranked sixth in sacks (7.0) and second with three forced fumbles. Ricard notched five games with 2.0 or more TFLs, including a career-high 4.5 at Albany, and record 2.0 or more TFLs in five of his last six games.
- It's a whole new look in the Maine sideline with five new coaches and a total of nine in new roles. It all starts at the top with first year head coach Joe Harasymiak, who takes over after Jack Cosgrove stepped down following a 23-year head coaching career. Both coodinators are fresh to their roles, beginning with first-year coach Liam Coen (OC) and defensive coordinator Corey Hetherman, who is in his second year on staff and first as coordinator.
- Maine's OL made huge strides in 2015 as it ranked fourth in the CAA in fewest sacks allowed (18), down from 23 a year ago in 2014. The loss of Rimington Award winning center Bruce Johnson to graduation will be a key spot for replacement. Maine returns four starters on its OL but will be hampered by an injury to junior Jamil Demby. Max Andrews steps in alongside third year veterans Isaiah Brooks (22 games), John Reddington (13) and Dan Burrows (19).
- Maine received a pair of all-conference selections at wide-out in Micah Wright (So., 6-1, 190) and Jordan Dunn (Sr., 6-2, 200). The top-flight duo become one of only two receiver units in the CAA to receive a pair of all-conference performers. After showing promise in his first season but falling to injury early, Wright battled back to record one of the best statistical seasons for a freshman receiver in Maine history. The redshirt freshman recorded 61 receptions for 818-yards and five touchdowns. Wright ranked third in the CAA with 5.55 receptions per game and third in receiving yards (74.4 ypg). Dunn, who averaged 10.6 yards per catch, totaled 56 receptions for 595-yards and three scores. Dunn finished the year with 5.09 catchers per game; fourth best in the league.
