Previous Matchup

BANGOR, Maine -- The University of Maine men's basketball team was defeated by the Central Connecticut State Blue Devils, 64-56, on Tuesday evening at the Cross Insurance Center.

Steph Ingo led the way for Maine as the forward finished with 14 points and four rebounds. LeChaun DuHurt added eight points, three rebounds, and two steals, while Ata Turgut chipped in six points and two rebounds.

Maine saw nine of its players find their way into the scoring column as the Black Bears finished the contest 17-of-43 from the floor while hitting 18-of-24 free throws. On the boards, Maine grabbed 26 total rebounds and blocked three Blue Devil shots.

At the 11:33 mark of the first half, the tides changed for the Black Bears. Trailing 18-9, LeChaun DuHurt hit a deep three-pointer. It was the start of a 5-0 run for Maine. The Blue Devils took control, once again, of the first half. Five points were as close as Maine would get in the opening half. CCSU held a 31-21 lead at the half.

Trailing by 10 at the break, the Black Bears came out a different team. Fofo Adetogun pulled his squad to within one bucket when he converted both free throws, 36-34. Unfortunately, it was as close as the home team would get. CCSU extended their lead to as much as 12 points in the second half. Steph Ingo's nine second half points were not enough to pull Maine ahead. The Blue Devils held onto win by a score of 64-56.

The Black Bears are back in action on Friday when they travel to Peoria, Illinois to take on Bradley University. Tip-off is scheduled for 3:00 pm.

A LOOK AT THE BLACK BEARS:

The Black Bears head to Illinois coming off of a loss against the Central Connecticut Blue Devlis, 64-56 at the Cross Insurance Center. Maine stands at a 2-1 home record to begin the year. The Black Bears have been one of the most efficent teams at converting their free throws on the season, as they come in ranked 84th in the country and 2nd in America East with a 74.1% at the line.

Maine has been the best in America East with stealing the ball, avergaing 9 steals a game, which also ranks them 64th in the country. As a result of the high amount of steals, the Black Bears find themselves ranked 73rd in the country in turnovers forced, along with being ranked 2nd in America East.

A LOOK AT BRADLEY

Bradley comes in on a 3-game losing streak, with their most recent contest being a 78-70 loss against Duquesne. They were led by the scoring of Terry Roberts (17), Henry Ja'Shon (14) and Connor Hickman (14). Ja'Shon also paced his team with 11 rebounds. Mikey Howell dished out 4 assists in the contest.

HISTORY AGAINST BRADLEY

Maine and Bradley meet for the third time in history, and the first since 1993. Maine won the first-ever meeting in the series, 56-54, back on Nov. 23, 1992 in Orono. The two teams met in the season opener a year later, with Bradley scoring the win on its home court, 71-60, on Nov. 27, 1993.



Richard Barron HEAD COACH 4th **Season** KENYON 91

Richard Barron, the 22nd head coach of Maine men's basketball enters his fourth season at the Prior to his time coaching the Sewanee women, Barron was the helm in 2021-22. This will be Barron's his 21st season as a head coach.

Barron previously served as a Special Assistant to the Director Athletics at UMaine since December 1, 2017. He was the head coach of the UMaine women's basketball team from 2011 to 2017 before taking a medical leave of absence in January 2017.

The 2018-19 season was not Barron's first coaching men. His first collegiate coaching position from 1991-95 was an assistant coach for the University of the South-Sewanee men's team. He took his first head coaching position the following season in 1996, taking the helm of the University of the South-Sewanee women's team, where he posted a 77-48 record.

As head coach of the UMaine women's team, he brought the program back to its winning ways, putting together a winning season in his third season in 2013-14. Barron put together back-to-back 20 win seasons in 2014-15 and 2015-16, and was named the America East Coach of the Year after the 2015 season.

The Black Bears went to the postseason for three consecutive seasons after going 4-24 in 2013-14. In seven seasons at Maine, Barron compiled a record of 85-89, along with an overall head coaching record of 232-228. In the America East, Barron owns a record of 46-34 and two regular season championships (2014-15 and 2015-16).

It was upward and onward in 2015-16 under Barron's leadership as the Black Bears continued the climb to greatness. The team that had regained respect throughout the Northeast was now opening eyes on a national level as Maine earned a No. 14 ranking in the College Insider Mid-Major Top-25. Barron's defensive philosophy proved to be one of the top in the country as Maine finished the season ranked as the No. 5 rated team in terms of scoring defense, limiting opponents to just 51.1 points per game. The Black Bears built off their defensive success as Barron guided Maine to its first back-to-back 20+ win season since 2003-04, 2004-05

The year would see Maine reach the America East Championship game and once again return to the WNIT after a 26 win campaign, one short of the school record. The Black Bears went undefeated on their home court, moving their home win streak to 19-0. The home crowds continued to grow as Maine was top in the conference and second in New England, only to UConn, in attendance (2,008).

Barron's mentoring throughout the 2014-15 season guided the Black Bears to their highest achievement of success in over 10 years as Maine reached the 20-win plateau for the first time since 2004-05 and totaled its highest amount of wins (23) in 11 years. The success of 2014-15 brought Maine back into the national picture as it reached a #19 ranking in the College Insider Mid-Major Top-25, returned to the WNIT for the first time since 2005 and captured the 2015 America East Regular Season Co-Championship.

It took Barron just three year's to return the Black Bears to the winning ways which they were so used to in year's past. In his third season at the helm of the team, Barron led Maine to a 17-15 record, a 10-6 league record and its first postseason win since 1999; a 77-47 home drubbing of Bucknell in the opening round of the Women's Basketball Invitational (WBI). Maine's 17 wins was a +13 over the previous season; one of the top three turnarounds in the country in terms of win totals. Maine's total wins (17) and America East conference victories (10) were its most since the 2004-05 season. The Black Bears finished fourth in the league standings; their highest regular season finishing mark since placing first in 2005..

Following the 2011-12 season, Coach Barron proved to Black Bear nation why he is known for his fantastic recruiting. Coach Barron, along with his staff, introduced a nine-member 2012-13 signing class to the University of Maine, which received national attention as the class was ranked 36th best in the nation by Blue Star Basketball's National Scouting director Chris

Barron came to the University of Maine women's team after a two-year stint at North Carolina State where he served as an assistant coach under Kellie Harper. In Barron's first year with the Wolfpack, the Tennessee native helped guide the team to the NCAA Tournament with a 20-14 record. A team that was predicted to finish ninth in the preseason, ended up finishing tied for fifth in the ACC standings while making it to the 2010 ACC Tournament Finals.

Barron is well renowned for his fantastic recruiting as he spent two seasons at Baylor prior to his time at NC State as the associate head coach and recruiting coordinator with the Bears. During his time at Baylor, Barron was responsible for landing the consensus top-ranked player (Brittney Griner) and the top ranked recruiting class of 2009 while also assisting in coaching the Bears to the Big 12 Tournament Championship.

Baylor compiled a 54-13 record to go along with two trips to the NCAA tournament, including a run to the Sweet 16 in 2008-09; in the two seasons Barron was with the Bears' staff.

Barron began his Division I head coaching career at Princeton as he spent six seasons at the

helm of the Tigers' program. After taking over the program fresh off a 2-25 season prior to his arrival, Barron guided the Tigers to an 11-16 record in his first season, making Princeton one of the most improved teams in the country that year. During his six years at Princeton, Barron managed the Tigers to an lvy League title in 2005-06, setting a school record for overall wins (21-7) and conference wins (12-2). Barron mentored five different players to All-lvy League honors while at Princeton.

Before his time at Princeton, Barron spent five seasons at the University of the South in Sewanee, Tenn, compiling a 77-48 record during his tenure. In his final season at the University of the South, Barron guided the squad to its first ever conference championship and a No. 8 national ranking in Division III.

Barron, who grew up in both Florida and Tennessee, graduated from Kenyon College with a B.S. in biology. He graduated cum laude after being named to the dean's list all eight semesters. Barron played both basketball and baseball while at Kenyon.

Barron and his wife, Maureen, a former Princeton softball coach, are the proud parents of twin daughters, Lane and Rae, and younger son, Billy.

ASSISTANT COACH, First Season

Jason "Jai" Steadman comes to Maine from the University of Texas - Rio Grande Valley where he served as the men's basketball team's interim head coach for the 2020-21 season after serving as the team's assistant coach since 2014. Steadman's resumé is thorough, as he spent three seasons with the Houston Rockets' NBA G-League affiliate, the Rio Grande Valley Vipers, from 2009-12 and also served as an assistant coach for the 2010 NBA D-League All-Star Game, and the NBA D-League Select team during the 2010 NBA Summer League in Las Vegas. Steadman has previous head coaching experience with Rander Cimbria in Denmark, where he led the team to their first playoff appearance in 2003-04. He also spent the 2013-14 season as the head coach at Westwind Preparatory Academy in Phoenix, Ariz. before returning to Rio Grande Valley.



KYLE DRENNEN

ASSISTANT COACH, First Season

Kyle Drennan joins Coach Barron's staff from the University of Illinois - Chicago where he served as the director of operations a season ago. Drennen previously served as the head coach at McCook Community College for a season, guiding the men's team to their first home playoff game in 13 years, first playoff win in 20 years, and the team GPA climb above a 3.0 for the first time in 12 years. He started his career in marketing with the Fenway Sports Group and the Salem Red Sox, a minor league baseball affiliate of the Boston Red Sox, and has made basketball stops with JUCO Advocate, McNeese State, Labette Community College, and the Texas Top 100.



MICHAEL STRICKLAND

ASSISTANT COACH, First Season

Michael Strickland arrives in Orono from Tuskegee University where he served as an assistant coach for a pair of seasons after working at The Citadel as their director of basketball operations for a season. His coaching career has also led him to stops at Roanoke College, Gonzaga High School, and Benedictine College Prep where he got his start as a coach in 2010.

Asked about Strickland, Barron said "Michael comes from a basketball family and has experience coaching at multiple levels of basketball having worked with elite prep schools, small colleges and Division I Universities. Michael has great energy and will work primarily with our point and combo guards."



LANCE RICHARDSON

DIRECTOR OF OPS, First Season

Lance Richardson, who will serve as the Black Bears' Director of Quality Control and Operations. Richardson comes to Maine with a 20-year coaching resume that stretches from high school to Division I, with his most recent stop being at Verrado High School in Arizona where he served as the program's head coach. His journey has also included assistant coaching stops with Oregon State, Union University, and his alma mater Samford University.




