The Black Bears open the Tulane Holiday Classic on Wednesday when they meet Duquesne in the second meeting between the two programs in history. Maine will play either Tulane or Arkansas Little Rock on day two of the tournament, with a time still to be determined.

LAST TIME OUT:

Orono, Maine -- Anne Simon matched her career-high with 34 points, including a new career-best eight three pointers made, in Maine's 78-71 loss to James Madison on Sunday afternoon.

BLACK BEARS VS. DUQUESNE

Player **G** **PPG** **RPG** **APG**

No current Black Bears have played against Duquesne, Arkansas Little-Rock, Tulane.

Simon, who extended her double-digit scoring streak to five in a row and now has 27 or more points in three of her last five outings, finished the afternoon 11-of-27 from the floor. The graduate student guard his 8-of-18 from long range while adding seven rebounds, four assists, and a pair of steals. Simon continued to climb the all-time ranks at Maine as she moved into seventh on Maine's all-time steals list (224) and ninth on the all-time three-point field goals made list (152).

Adrianna Smith added 19 points, nine rebounds, and five assists as she ran her double-digit scoring streak to eight in a row, while Jaycie Christopher contributed 11 points in 32 minutes off the bench.

As a unit, the Black Bears posted a season-high 13 triples and set a new school record with 43 attempts from beyond the arc. Maine also set a season-low in turnovers as it gave it away just five times.

A LOOK AT THE BLACK BEARS:

Maine continues its challenging non-conference slate as it has faced the 116th toughest schedule (according to WarrenNolan.com), tops in America East, this season. The Black Bears rank fourth in the America East in scoring (62.3) but are averaging 74.7 points per game over their last three outings. Maine, which has hit 10 or more triples in each of its past three games, lead the America East and check in 16th nationally with 26.9 three-point attempts per game and rank second in the conference at 7.5 triples made per game. The Black Bears have also been impressive in taking care of the ball as they rank second in the America East at 14.1 giveaways per game including just five turnovers in their outing against

LAST 5 MEETINGS

Duq. 76, Maine 38 (12/20/11)

James Madison. Maine has been impressive on the boards this season, outrebounding the opposition in seven of its first 11 games. Anne Simon, the reigning America East Player of the Week and four-time recipient of the award this season, leads Maine and the conference in scoring at 20.3 points per game. Over her last four outings, Simon is averaging 28.0 points per game including a pair of career-high matching 34 point performances. Simon's 223 points this season are the 19th most in the nation. Simon has been impressive on both sides of the court, ranking second in the league at 2.4 steals per game. Adrianna Smith, who has registered double-doubles in five of her last six games and is coming off a season-high 19 point outing, ranks among the top-10 leaders in the America East in scoring (8th-13.2), rebounding (1st-10.8), assists (3rd-4.1), and double-doubles (1st-7). Her seven double-doubles place her fourth nationally in the category while she ranks 13th in the nation in rebounding.

A LOOK AT DUQUESNE:

Duquesne enters the tournament winners of three of its last four outings but most recently saw its three-game win streak snap with a loss to America East foe Vermont, 77-61. Much like Maine, the Dukes rely on the three-point shot as they check in sixth in the nation in three-pointers made per game (10.1) and 10th with 28.3 triple attempts per game. Duquesne is averaging 69.7 points per game but rank 11th in the A-10 in scoring defense, allowing 69.3 points. Megan McConnell leads the Dukes in scoring (12.6), rebounding (8.2), and assists (4.4) while Nae Bernard is adding 12.2 points. Tess Myers, the reigning A-10 Player of the Week, is chipping in 10.8 points and 5.0 rebounds while Amaya Hamilton rounds out Duquesne's four double-digit scoring averages at 10.1 points.

SERIES WITH THE TOURNAMENT FIELD:

Duquesne marks Maine's sixth A-10 opponent of the season as the Black Bears enter play with a 4-1 mark against A-10 members this season. Maine and the Dukes meet for just the second time in history as the Black Bears fell to Duquesne, 76-38, in 2011. That game was also a neutral site affair as it took place in Gainesville, Fla. in the opening round of the Gator Classic.

Maine has never played Arkansas-Little Rock.

The Black Bears are 1-3 all-time against Tulane, with the last meeting coming in 2017. Maine won the first-ever meeting between the two programs, 65-57, in a game played in Portland, Maine in 1987. Tulane has won each of the last three showdowns including a 42-34 victory in the latest meeting (2017) in Bangor, Maine. Maine has played at Tulane twice, losing 85-76 in 1998 and again dropping a decision, 77-62, in 2016.

SEASON BEAR TRACKS:

HEAVY ON THE THREE:

Maine's offense is run heavily through the three-point shot. Maine, which has hit 10 or more triples in each of its last three games, ranks first in the America East and 16th nationally with 26.9 three-point attempts per game. Maine's 7.5 triples per game are second best among America East leaders.

RARE AIR FOR NUMBER 3:

Anne Simon is just one of four players in school history to total 1,500+ points, 500+ rebounds, 200+ assists, and 200+ steals. The other three being Cindy Blodgett, Liz Coffin, and Blanca Millan.

SIMON - 4X AE PLAYER OF THE WEEK:

Anne Simon has won four America East Player of the Week honors this season. Simon has produced double-digits in nine of Maine's 11 games including a career-high 34 point, 11 rebound effort against #17 Indiana. Simon matched her career-high with another 34 point outing against James Madison (12/17). Simon leads the AE in scoring (20.3); 26th best in the country. Over her past four games, Simon is averaging 28.0 points, 8.5 rebounds, and 2.8 steals.

DEFENSE:

Maine has held eight of its last 24 opponents to 50 points or fewer and 12 of the last 22 under 60 points. Maine ranks sixth in the America East in scoring defense (62.3) and has held four of its 11 opponents to 54 points or fewer with three of the 10 held to 48 points.

GRAB THAT BOARD:

Maine has won the rebounding battle in seven of its first 11 games in the 2023-24 season, narrowly being bested in the category by #17 Indiana (36-35) in that contest. Maine is 20-5 when controlling the boards over the past two seasons. Maine has won the rebounding battle in 22 of its last 31 outings. Maine is 11-1 when winning the rebounding battle in league play and currently has a +3.7 rebounding margin on the season, first in the league. Maine ranks third in the AE with 37.6 rebounds per game. Smith's 10.8 rebounds per game rank her 14th in the country.

ADI - 30+ Four-Times:

Adrianna Smith, who led the conference in scoring (17.9) and rebounding (9.5) and was named the America East Player of the Year in 2023. Last season, Smith became the first America East player to post 30+ points in back-to-back games since Blanca Millan and the first to do so against America East competition since Shereesha Richards (UAlbany) did so in 2016. Smith's career-high 34 points against NJIT were the most by a Black Bear since Millan tallied 34 in December of 2020. The junior tallied 30+ points four times last season with the latest coming in a 31 point production against Binghamton (2/25).

ADI IS PLAYER OF THE YEAR:

A year after averaging 2.1 points and 7.2 minutes per game, Adrianna Smith was named the America East Player of the Year in 2023. Smith became the ninth Black Bear in program history to earn league Player of the Year honors. Maine has won the last three Player of the Year awards with Blanca Millan and Anne Simon each earning the crown in the prior two seasons.

DOUBLE TROUBLE:

A year after tallying more double-doubles (16) than any other team in the America East, Smith has begun the season with seven double-doubles. Smith currently ranks fourth in the country in double-doubles, with double marks in five of her last six outings.

ADI DOES IT ALL:

Adrianna Smith ranks in the top 10 among America East leaders in points per game (8th - 13.8); rebounding (1st - 10.8); assists (3rd - 4.11); assist/turnover ratio (1st - 1.6); blocks (10th - 0.7), field goal percentage (7th - 44.3), and double-doubles (1st - 7). Smith has tallied double-digit scoring in 30 of her last 32 outings, with double-doubles in 18 of her last 29 and five of her last six.

SIMON - 1,500th POINT CLUB

With a 34 point effort against #17 Indiana, Anne Simon became the ninth player in program history to join the 1,500 point club. Previously, Simon became just the 10th player in school history to eclipse 1,000 points in just three seasons. Anne now stands 9th on Maine's all-time scoring list (1,580), 91 points from moving into eighth (Sigi Koizar - 1,671).

VACHON THE VET - QUICK TO 100:

Despite being in just her seventh year as the helm of the Black Bears, head coach Amy Vachon is the longest-tenured coach in the America East. Vachon, a four-time America East Coach of the Year, has guided Maine to the America East title game in each of her first five seasons. Vachon picked up her 100th career win with a victory over New Hampshire on Jan. 13, reaching the mark in just her 151st game at the helm of the program. Vachon's four Coach of the Year honors tie her for most in league and program history with Joanne Palombo McCallie. Vachon is currently at 136 career wins, second on Maine's all-time head coach wins list. Palombo-McCallie ranks first with 167 wins during her time at Maine.

LONG TIME NO THREE:

The Black Bears have made at least one three pointer in 358-straight games. The last time Maine did not cash in from 3-point range was Feb. 11, 2012 when it went 0-3 against UAlbany.

HOME SWEET HOME:

Over the past five seasons, Maine has built a 53-25 overall record at home and a 54-9 record in league play.

CONFERENCE TIDBITS:

- Over the past five seasons, Maine has gone 78-18 in America East play.
- Maine, which has captured two titles in the past five seasons, has earned seven consecutive appearances in the America East title game.
- Maine has registered double-digit conference win totals in nine of its last 10 seasons - and each of the last six.
- Maine has captured four of the past six AE regular season titles.

FACTOR OF 60:

Over the past eight seasons, Maine is 171-29 when holding its opponent to 60 or fewer points. The Black Bears are 113-19 in the Vachon era when limiting teams to 60 or less. Over the past nine seasons against league competition, Maine is 107-13 when holding America East opponents to 60 points or fewer.

60 OR MORE:

On the flip-side, Maine is 168-33 over the past eight seasons when it scores 60 or more. In league play, Maine has a 108-10 record when scoring 60 or more points.

DECIDED AT THE HALF:

Maine is 85-10 when leading at halftime over the past three seasons and 113-16 when taking a lead into the half under Vachon.

FROM DOWNTOWN:

Over the last five years, Maine is 31-9 when it records double-digit 3-point makes in a single game.

INTERNATIONAL VIBE:

As has been the norm over the last few seasons for the Black Bears, Maine features numerous players from around the globe. This season, Maine features players from six different countries including players from Luxembourg (Simon); Spain (Gallego, Soler), Finland (Kahelin), Denmark (Bornemann), Canada (Nenadic), and Israel (Shlush).

AMY VACHON, HEAD COACH

Amy Vachon, currently in her seventh full season at the helm of the Black Bears and her 13th year on staff, signed a new agreement to serve as Maine's head coach on March 24, 2021. The new agreement will run from July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2025.

Vachon, who spent the final 18 games of the 2016-17 season at the helm of the Black Bears' staff, was officially named the interim head coach for the 2017-18 season on April 5 of 2017.

A champion as a player and coach with the Black Bears, Vachon has built a culture of winning at the University of Maine. On the court and in the classroom, year after year, the Black Bears have excelled at all they've done under Coach Vachon's guidance.

Another season, another trip to the America East title game under the guidance of Vachon in 2021-22 as she led Maine to an appearance in the title game for the seventh consecutive season after the Black Bears captured the America East regular season title. Vachon was crowned the America East Coach of the Year for the second consecutive season, and the fourth time in her first five years, to match former Maine head coach Joanne P. McCallie as the only coaches in league history to win the award four times. After a challenging non-conference slate, Vachon guided Maine to a 14-game win streak in conference action. Academically, the Black Bears shined once again with the third highest team GPA in all of Division-I.

Vachon guided the Black Bears through the challenging 2020-21 season, leading Maine to a 17-3 overall mark in the shortened COVID-19 season while earning her third America East Coach of the Year honor. The Black Bears earned their sixth-straight trip to the America East title game after entering the tournament as the number one seed with a 13-2 league mark. Even more impressive was the dedication and commitment to the classroom shown by the Black Bears as Maine earned the highest team cumulative grade point average (3.90) in all of Division-I.

In 2019-20, Vachon and the Black Bears again challenged themselves with a difficult non-conference slate. After suffering key injuries in the early part of the season, Vachon rallied the Black Bears to a return to the America East title game. Although the Black Bears were unable to compete in the Championship game due to COVID-19, Maine ended the season on a high note. Under Vachon's guidance, Maine ended the season riding the nation's eighth-longest win streak (10). The Black Bears capped the season with 12 league wins, marking the third-straight year under Vachon in which the team tallied 12 or more regular season league wins. After losing two starters to injury, Vachon played a key role in the development of several role players into key starting positions, including the development of All-Conference standouts Maeve Carroll and Dor Saar along with the on-court growth of America East Rookie of the Year, Anne Simon. The Black Bears not only finished strong on the court, but off it as well. Maine earned the No. 17 ranking, its highest ranking in school history, on the WBCA Top 25 Academic Honor Roll after compiling a 3.655 cumulative GPA.

Vachon followed up her first full season at the helm by earning her second-straight America East Coach of the Year honor, becoming just the sixth coach in America East history to win the award in back-to-back seasons. After guiding the Black Bears to their second consecutive America East Regular Season and Tournament Championships, Vachon's team earned the league's automatic bid into the NCAA Tournament for the second time in as many seasons. Maine's 25-8 record marked the fourth time in the last five seasons in which it topped the 20-win plateau and also tied for the third-most victories in a single season in UMaine history. The Black Bears were ranked in every edition of the College Insider Mid-Major Top-25 poll throughout the season, ending at No. 13. Maine, which put together a 14-game win streak under Vachon, led the America East in scoring (66.7) while setting new school and league records for 3-point field goals made in a season (273). The Black Bears challenged themselves early in the season, facing the 56th toughest schedule in the nation through their first 13 games, highlighted by an 85-73 victory on the road at North Carolina. Maine finished the season seeded 54th in the Ratings Performance Index (RPI). The Black Bears were dominant in league play, defeating eight conference opponents by 20 points or more with 13 of its 15 regular season league wins coming by double digits. Individually under Vachon's leadership and guidance, the Black Bears earned seven postseason honors including Blanca Millan who was named the America East Offensive and Defensive Player of the Year. All five starters on the 2018-19 team earned all-conference honors.

In her first full season as head coach of the Black Bears, Vachon earned America East Coach of the Year honors after leading Maine to a 23-10 overall mark. Under her guidance, the Black Bears were crowned with their first America East Tournament Championship since 2004, advancing to the NCAA Tournament for the eighth time in school history. Maine entered the America East Tournament as the No. 1 seed after completing a 16-point, come from behind victory over UAlbany in the regular season finale to clinch the regular season title.

The Black Bears ended the challenging campaign with the No. 70 RPI in the country. Maine continued to impress with its home court advantage, leading the America East in attendance for a fourth-straight season after going 12-2 on its home court. Vachon's offensive strategy guided the Black Bears to numerous shooting records including a Maine and America East single season high of 256 three-point field goals made.

Vachon, who took over head coaching duties after Coach Richard Barron stepped aside due to health complications, guided the Black Bears to an 11-7 mark during her time at the helm in 2016-17. Vachon led the Black Bears back to the America East title game, along the way knocking off No. 1 seeded New Hampshire in the America East semifinals.

Vachon also guided UMaine to key wins, including an 84-71 victory over eventual America East Champions UAlbany. Under her guidance, the Black Bears posted an impressive 7-1 record at home.

In addition to the impressive on court statistics under Vachon, the University of Maine Women's Basketball team has excelled in the classroom as well. The 2018-2019 team was first in the America East in with a 3.5 GPA for the season. This is the fourth out of five years in which UMaine women's basketball has been tops in America East. Also, 11 out of 13 players earned UMaine Scholar Athlete awards, each earning a 3.0+ grade point average.

Vachon was promoted to associate head coach in May of 2016. She spent the first six years of her tenure as an assistant before taking over as interim head coach in the winter of 2017. Following the 2011-12 season, Vachon was also promoted to Recruiting Coordinator; a role she served until being named Interim Head Coach in 2017. Vachon was inducted into the Maine Sports Hall of Fame in the spring of 2016.

Former University of Maine women's basketball head coach Richard Barron named Vachon as an assistant coach on May 16, 2011. Vachon, a 2000 graduate of the University of Maine, had a fantastic four-year career as a student-athlete with the Black Bears.

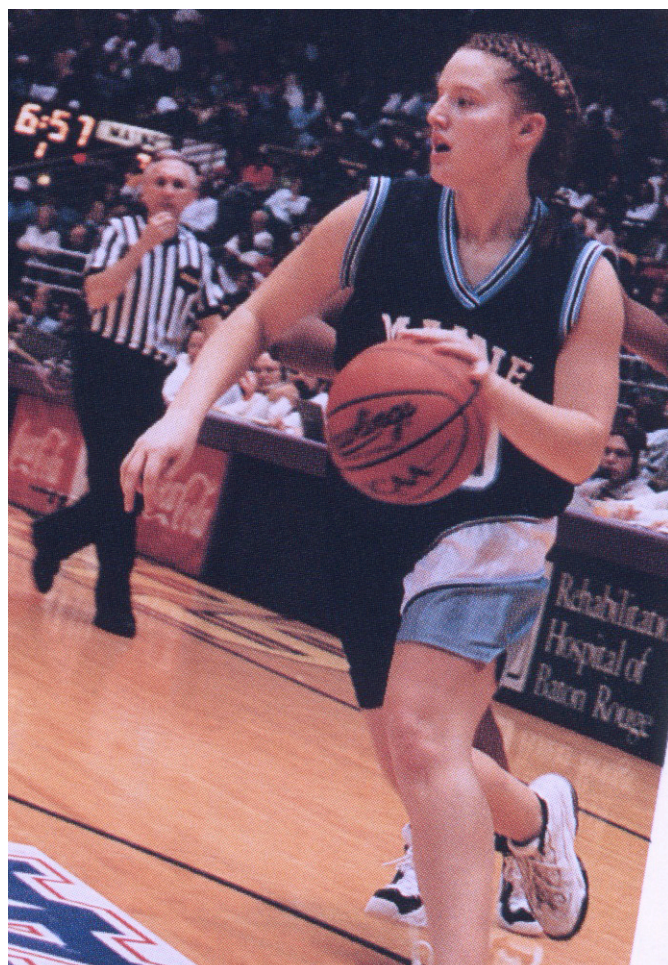
A two-time captain, Vachon led the Black Bears to four-straight NCAA Tournament appearances and was a member of the squad that knocked off Stanford in the first round of the 1999 NCAA Tournament. Maine compiled a four-year record of 87-35 with Vachon on the team, including an impressive record of 61-11 in conference play. She was part of a Maine team that won back-to-back America East Championships in 1996-97 and 1997-98.

Vachon, who was inducted into the UMaine Sports Hall of Fame in 2018, holds Maine records for the most assists in a season (234). She also holds the Maine and America East record for assists in a career with 759. When hired in 2011, she ranked 22nd all-time in NCAA history in career assists. Vachon earned a spot on the America East All-Tournament Team in 1999.

Prior to joining the University of Maine women's basketball staff, Vachon was the head coach at Catherine McAuley High School, located in Portland, Maine. Vachon coached McAuley to the 2011 Maine Class A State Championship. student-athletes, as she also excelled in the classroom. She graduated Magna Cum Laude in 2000 with a degree in elementary education. In 2002, she earned her Master's of Education from the University of North Carolina, Chapel Hill in school counseling. While an undergraduate, she was named: All-Maine Women Honor Society, Dean's List, America East All-Conference Academic Honor Roll, Maine Scholar-Athlete Award winner and also served on the Student-Athlete Advisory Board.

Vachon, a 2021 Maine Basketball Hall of Fame inductee, knows the demands of a Division I student-athletes, as she also excelled in the classroom. She graduated Magna Cum Laude in 2000 with a degree in elementary education. In 2002, she earned her Master's of Education from the University of North

Carolina, Chapel Hill in school counseling. While an undergraduate, she was named: All-Maine Women Honor Society, Dean's List, America East All-Conference Academic Honor Roll, Maine Scholar-Athlete Award winner and also served on the Student-Athlete Advisory Board.



Vachon played point guard at UMaine from 1996-97 through the 1999-2000 seasons, guiding the Black Bears to four consecutive NCAA Tournament appearances.

Courtney (Anderson) England, who began her appointment as an assistant coach at UMaine on July 1, 2017, is in her sixth year on staff with the Black Bears. England was promoted to Associate Head Coach on July 1, 2021.

England, who spent four years as a student-athlete on the University of Maine women's basketball team, returned to her alma mater following a year stint (2016-17) as an assistant coach at Presbyterian University.

Prior to her time at Presbyterian, England spent the 2015-16 season as the Director of Basketball Operations at the University of New Hampshire before stepping into an acting assistant coaching role with the Wildcats.

During her playing time at UMaine, England devoted numerous hours to working camps where she helped develop and mentor local camp attendees. In 2015, England was selected to take part in the Women's Basketball Coaches Association' "So You Want to be a Coach" program.

Gadson (Gaddy) Lefft returned to Maine in an assistant coaching role on May 1, 2022.

Prior to rejoining the Black Bears, Lefft spent the 2021-22 season as an assistant coach on former Black Bear point guard Missy Traversi's staff at Army. During that one-year stint, Army finished 16-13 overall with a 10-8 mark in Patriot League play.

She spent the 2020-21 season as a student assistant coach and an assistant in UMaine's compliance department. In 2020-21, the Black Bears finished the shortened season with a 17-3 overall mark and advanced to the America East title game.

Lefft, who joined the University of Maine in the fall of 2019, played one season for the Black Bears where she appeared in 16 games. Lefft tallied a season-best seven points in Maine's game against Northeastern.

Before attending UMaine, Lefft spent three seasons at the University of Delaware where she appeared in 20 games with two starts during her senior year, leading the team with a 45.7-percent mark from the floor. While at Delaware, she earned two selections to the Colonial Athletic Association Academic Honor Roll.

She began her collegiate career at Clemson where she competed in 21 games for the Tigers, again leading her team with a 46.3 field goal percentage.

Prior to her collegiate career, played two seasons at Heathwood Hall Episcopal School (2012-14), helping to lead the Highlanders to the school's first-ever SCISA State Championship title as a team captain. Lefft scored over 1,000 points and pulled down more than 750 rebounds while at Heathwood.
