» **Higgins Named Manning Award Star of the Week**
Louisiana Tech quarterback Ryan Higgins recorded his third 400-yard game of the 2016 season in the Bulldogs' 55-52 C-USA victory over WKU Thursday, while the senior also registered his personal-best for touchdown passes with five against the Hilltoppers. In his last 17 quarters (did not play 4th quarter against South Carolina State), Higgins is 118-of-181 passing (65.1 pct.) with 1,615 yards, 15 touchdowns and no interceptions.

» **Henderson Enjoys Career Night vs. the Hilltoppers**
Carlos Henderson returned from injury to have a career night in LA Tech's 55-52 conference win over WKU Thursday night – eight catches for 232 receiving yards (career high) and three touchdowns (career high). The 232 receiving yards by Henderson tied for the eighth most in school history and the most since Quinton Patton had 233 yards receiving on Oct. 13, 2012 versus Texas A&M in Shreveport. Henderson now has six games of 100+ receiving yards in his career, which is tied for ninth in school history. He now has five receiving touchdowns on the season and 14 in his career. The junior is averaging 111.6 receiving yards in five games this season.

When wide receiver Trent Taylor had to make a decision on where to play college football, the decision was easy. The Shreveport, Louisiana native only had one college scholarship offer from any level - Louisiana Tech. Consider the find by Tech's coaches a hidden gem. "We couldn't even get Division II schools to offer Trent Taylor because of his height," Taylor's high school coach Byron Dawson told The Shreveport Times in November 2014. "Trent Taylor had one offer, and that was Louisiana Tech."

Four years later, Taylor - a preseason Biletnikoff Award Watch List honoree - is ranked very high nationally in several categories and will leave Louisiana Tech ranked in the Top 10 in program history in six different categories.

33 STRAIGHT AND COUNTING...

Trent Taylor is as close to a sure thing as Skip Holtz and Bulldog fans have these days, and to prove that, the senior wideout has registered at least one reception in 33 straight games dating back to the first game of his sophomore season in 2014. With a reception in each game over a three-year span, Taylor is tied for 10th in the country in most consecutive games with a catch.

MOVING UP THE RANKINGS IN RECORD TIME

Just five games into his senior season, Trent Taylor has already cemented his spot as a **#LATechLegend** throughout his Bulldog career. Entering Week 7 of the season, Taylor is ranked in the Top 10 in school history in six different categories, including ranking in the top five in career touchdown receptions (2nd - 28) and 100-yard receiving performances (3rd - 14). The senior recently moved into the top five in program history in career yards with 3,237, while he is ranked fourth all-time for career receptions at LA Tech with 257 catches over four years.

A MACHINE AGAINST POWER 5 OPPONENTS

In Trent Taylor's last four games versus Power 5 opponents, the 5-foot-8-inch wideout has shown he has what it takes to shine on the big stage. In games against Kansas State, Mississippi State, Arkansas and Texas Tech, Taylor is averaging 9.25 receptions per game and 130.5 receiving yards with four touchdowns.

With 257 career receptions, Taylor ranks fourth among active career leaders in the NCAA. The senior also ranks third in the NCAA among active career leaders with 3,237 receiving yards in his four years with the Bulldogs.

MORE NOTES

HIGGINS AMONG BEST IN THE COUNTRY IN PASS ATTEMPTS TO INTERCEPTION RATION

Dating back to Sept. 10 versus South Carolina State, Louisiana Tech quarterback Ryan Higgins has gone 181 consecutive passes without an interception. Despite throwing two interceptions in the first half of that game, Higgins has kept the ball out of danger from that point on - 17 consecutive quarters without an interception to be exact. Over that span, the senior is 118-of-181 passing (65.1 pct.) with 1,615 yards, 15 touchdowns and no interceptions.

HIGGINS NAMED MANNING STAR OF THE WEEK

Louisiana Tech quarterback Ryan Higgins recorded his third 400-yard game of the 2016 season in the Bulldogs' 55-52 C-USA victory over WKU Thursday, while the senior also registered his personal-best for touchdown passes with five against the Hilltoppers. In his last 17 quarters (did not play 4th quarter against South Carolina State), Higgins is 118-of-181 passing (65.1 pct.) with 1,615 yards, 15 touchdowns and no interceptions.

BARNES PERFECT ON LAST EIGHT FIELD GOALS

Louisiana Tech kicker Jonathan Barnes accounted for 13 points, including going 2-for-2 on field goal attempts, in LA Tech's 55-52 win over Conference USA foe WKU last Thursday night, bringing his season total to 10-of-12 and his career total to 44-of-55. He has now made eight straight field goals on the season dating back to two missed field goals in the season opener at Arkansas, including a career-long 54-yard field goal last Thursday against the Hilltoppers. Barnes also went 7-of-7 on extra-point attempts, making it 94 straight for the redshirt junior. Against WKU, Barnes hit a career-long 54-yard field goal, giving the Bulldogs a 55-38 lead with 11 minutes to go in the game. It tied for the third longest field goal in program history and was the longest field goal since Chris Boniol in 1991.

HENDERSON SHAKES OFF INJURY TO SHINE VS. WKU



Louisiana Tech wide receiver Carlos Henderson returned from injury to have a career night in LA Tech's 55-52 conference win over WKU Thursday night – eight catches for 232 receiving yards (career high) and three touchdowns (career high). The 232 receiving yards by Henderson tied for the eighth most in school history and the most since Quinton Patton had 233 yards receiving on Oct. 13, 2012 versus Texas A&M in Shreveport. Henderson now has six games of 100+ receiving yards in his career, which is tied for ninth in school history. He now has five receiving touchdowns on the season and 14 in his career. On the season, Henderson has 30 receptions, 558 receiving yards and five touchdown catches. The redshirt junior is averaging 111.6 receiving yards in five games this season.

Louisiana Tech wide receivers Trent Taylor and Carlos Henderson have made quite the pair for the Bulldogs early in the season as well as making waves nationally. Here's a look at some of the video game-like numbers Taylor and Henderson have put up this season thus far:

- › Taylor and Henderson are currently tied for first in the nation with 13 receiving touchdowns combined.
- › Taylor and Henderson have the second most combined receptions in the nation (96).
- › The two receivers are ranked first in the country in combined receiving yards (1,419).
- › Taylor and Henderson are in rare company on a national level as the two are one of seven wide receiver duos on the FBS level with at least 1,500 receiving yards each (5,138 receiving yards combined). The LA Tech dog catchers rank second in the nation in that category among active career leaders.

BULLDOG OFFENSE RANKED AMONG BEST IN THE COUNTRY

Through the first six games of the 2016 season, Louisiana Tech's offense has yet to miss a beat when it comes to putting up big numbers week in and week out. Entering the seventh week of the season, the Bulldogs are ranked in the top 15 in the nation among FBS teams in passing offense (5th - 365.0 YPG) and total offense (13th - 526.7 YPG), while LA Tech ranks fifth nationally in first downs offense and ninth in third down conversion percentage.

THIRD-BEST OFFENSIVE START FOR THE BULLDOGS THROUGH SIX GAMES

Seeing as the 'Dogs enter this week ranked 13th in the nation in total offense per game, Louisiana Tech's average of 526.7 yards registered through the first six games this year is not just impressive by where the Bulldogs rank nationally, but also where they rank historically. That average is the third-best offensive start in school history since the program made the move to Division I in 1975.

NFL DRAFT

LA Tech had three players drafted, the most since 1993. This marked the third straight year the Bulldogs have had at least two players selected in the NFL Draft. It also equaled WKU for the most players drafted from Conference USA. The Bulldogs had more players drafted than teams such as Oregon, Florida State, Arizona, Miami, Virginia Tech, Iowa, Louisville, Oklahoma State, Texas and Wisconsin.

BULLDOGS AMONG THE BEST IN C-USA

LA Tech has finished first in Conference USA in rushing defense and fourth down conversions each of the last two seasons. The Bulldogs have also finished in the top three both years in scoring offense and total defense.

Individually, senior wide receiver Trent Taylor has finished in the Top 10 in receptions per game and receiving yards per game each of the last two seasons in Conference USA.

BULLDOG DEFENSE STIFLES ARKANSAS IN SEASON OPENER

Last Saturday, the Bulldog defense held the Razorbacks to 297 yards of total offense (-4 yards alone in the third quarter). Only Alabama was able to hold Arkansas to under 300 total yards last season.

Additionally, LA Tech registered two interceptions in the game. The Bulldogs had five games last season with multiple interceptions. It was the first time an opponent had picked off Arkansas more than once in a single game since Oct. 18, 2014.

LA Tech also registered four total sacks in the game. That was the most sacks by an opponent versus Arkansas since Alabama recorded four on Oct. 11, 2014.

LOUISIANA TECH AMONG LEAST EXPERIENCED TEAMS IN FBS

Last weekend at Arkansas, Louisiana Tech opened the 2016 campaign ranked 123rd out of 129 FBS teams (according to Phil Steele) in terms of experience heading into the season, which is no surprise considering the Bulldogs lost 13 starters (5 offense, 8 defense) from last year's team. 2016 GAME RECAPS

ARKANSAS 21, LA TECH 20 SEPT. 3 IN FAYETTEVILLE, ARKANSAS

FAYETTEVILLE, Ark. - Missed opportunities spelled doom for Louisiana Tech (0-1) in the season opener as Arkansas (1-0) edged the Bulldogs, 21-20, Saturday afternoon in front of 69,132 in attendance at Donald W. Reynolds Razorback Stadium in Fayetteville.

LA Tech was hanging on to a 20-14 lead with under seven minutes remaining in the game when Arkansas quarterback Austin Allen orchestrated a 13-play, 77-yard scoring drive that ended with a four-yard touchdown pass to Jeremy Sprinkle to give Arkansas a one point lead.

Louisiana Tech had an opportunity to stop the Razorbacks with 3:35 left in the fourth, but a fourth-down conversion with a minute and a half allowed Arkansas to run out the clock and clinch the victory over the Bulldogs.

In his first career start, redshirt freshman J'mar Smith was 19-for-31 passing for 212 yards and a rushing touchdown. Smith became the first freshman quarterback to open the season for LA Tech since 2011.

On the ground, LA Tech was led by Jarred Craft, who rushed for 68 yards on 12 attempts and a touchdown against the Razorbacks. Both Trent Taylor and Carlos Henderson combined for 14 catches and 149 receiving yards on the afternoon.

Defensively, the Bulldogs held Arkansas to 297 total offensive yards and had four sacks in the game, which marks the first time since Oct. 11, 2014 that Arkansas has allowed four sacks in a game. Jordan Harris had a team-high 11 tackles in the game, including 1.5 tackles for loss. Xavier Woods tied a career-high with 10 total tackles (1.0 TFL), while also recording a sack and an interception against the Razorbacks.

LA TECH 53, SC STATE 24 SEPT. 10 IN RUSTON, LOUISIANA

RUSTON, La. - Louisiana Tech overcame a four-hour weather delay and Ryan Higgins passed for 409 yards and four touchdowns in his first start since 2013 to lead the Bulldogs to a 53-24 win over South Carolina State before just over 16,000 rain-soaked fans at Joe Aillet Stadium Saturday.

The second half was much crisper as Tech scored on its first four possessions after intermission and didn't commit a second half turnover.

Trent Taylor led the Bulldog receiver with seven catches for 166 yards and two touchdown receptions, while Carlos Henderson also impressed with nine catches for 130 yards and a touchdown catch.

MURFREESBORO, Tenn. - Middle Tennessee scored 31 points in the second-half alone while Louisiana Tech failed to complete a last-minute comeback as the Blue Raiders defeated the Bulldogs, 38-34, Saturday night at Floyd Stadium in Murfreesboro.

In the conference opener, Louisiana Tech led 34-31 with under four minutes left in the game thanks to Kam McKnight's 1-yard touchdown rush, but Middle Tennessee used a 5-play, 75-yard scoring drive that ended with a 23-yard touchdown pass from Brent Stockstill to Ty Lee to put the Blue Raiders ahead, 38-34.

Ryan Higgins became the third quarterback in Louisiana Tech history to throw for over 500 yards as the senior notched a new career-high with 504 passing yards and three touchdowns. He was 36-for-59 throwing the ball.

Trent Taylor also enjoyed a career day for the Bulldog offense with 17 catches for 210 yards and two touchdowns. Jarred Craft ran the ball 20 times for 91 yards.

Defensively, Jordan Harris led the Bulldogs with nine tackles (five solo), while Jaylon Ferguson had two sacks on the night for a loss of 12 yards.

RUSTON, La. - After surrendering 97 points over the past two weeks, the Louisiana Tech defense had something to prove Saturday night.

They did. The Bulldogs bend-but-don't-break defense held UTEP to only one score and Louisiana Tech capitalized on a 70-yard TD run from Jarred Craft -- his second score of the night -- to defeat UTEP 28-7 before 22,101 fans at Joe Aillet Stadium.

Craft rushed for 146 yards on only 13 carries, outperforming UTEP's Aaron Jones, who entered the game as the Conference USA rushing leader. Jones was held in check all night, totaling only 94 yards on 20 carries with a long of 9 yards.

"You know the tailback -- Aaron Jones coming in here, that was rushing for 150 yards a game, averaging seven and a half yards carries, and that's against some pretty good football teams, as well," said Tech head coach Skip Holtz. "For our defense to hold him to 94 and four yards to carry, I'm just really proud of them."

Tech took an early two touchdown advantage in the opening quarter. Craft took a swing pass from Ryan Higgins and scampered 17 yards to paydirt with 8:19 to play in the first quarter. The play capped a seven-play, 84-yard drive that took 2:42 off the clock.

RUSTON, La. - WKU is not a fan of Joe Aillet Stadium.

For the second time in three seasons, WKU came to Ruston and left on the short end of the scoreboard, this time a 55-52 loss to Louisiana Tech in front of 17,978 fans on Thursday night.

In between those two losses? WKU won 13 straight Conference USA games.

"We knew we were playing the defending champion coming in here," said Tech head coach Skip Holtz. "We knew it was going to be a challenge: 13-game winning streak, longest conference win streak in the country. We knew they wouldn't go away. We talked to our players about it was going to be a 12-round heavyweight fight, and it's not going to be over till the very end. And you know, I'm just really proud of our players the way they were able to compete in there and they were able to get the win."

Louisiana Tech quarterback Ryan Higgins threw for 454 yards and five touchdowns to lead the Bulldogs to the C-USA shootout, snapping the Hilltoppers 13-game league winning streak. The last time WKU lost in Conference USA play prior to Thursday night was in 2014 in a 59-10 loss to LA Tech at The Joe.

LA Tech (3-3, 2-1 C-USA) built a 21-point fourth quarter lead but saw WKU (3-3, 1-1 C-USA) storm back to cut the deficit to 55-52. The Hilltoppers even had a chance to win in the final three minutes after stopping LA Tech on a third-down-and-one play and forcing a Bulldog punt.

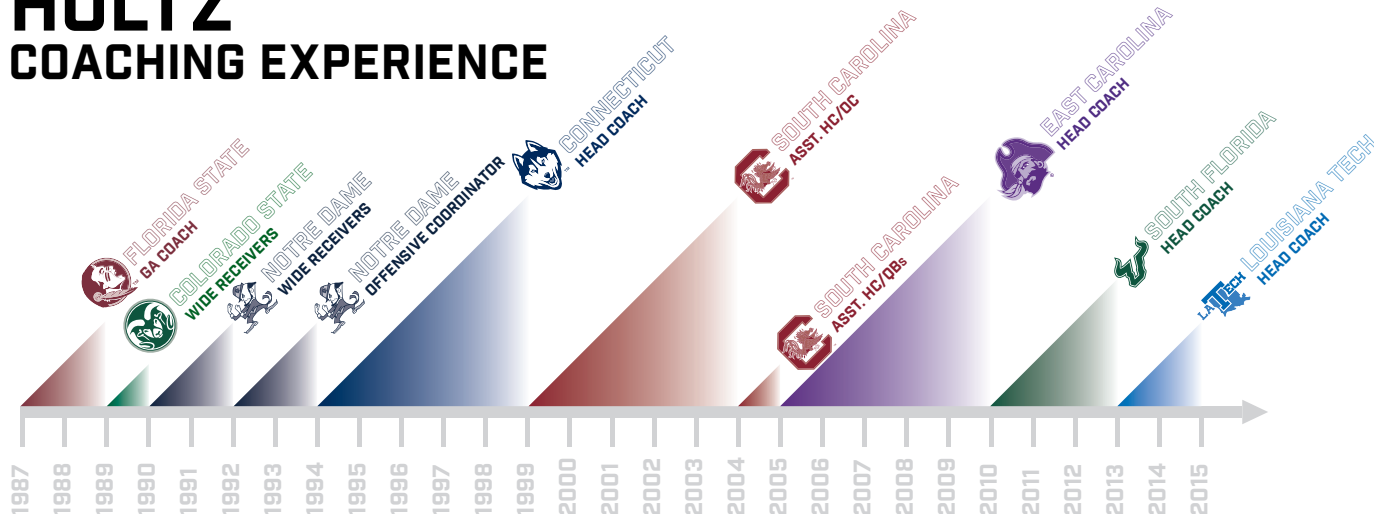

Skip Holtz enters his fourth year as the head coach at Louisiana Tech after former Louisiana Tech University President Dr. Dan Reneau introduced former University of South Florida coach Skip Holtz as the 33rd head football coach of the Bulldogs during a press conference on Friday, Dec. 14, 2012 in the Jarrell Room of the Charles Wylly Athletic Center.

Holtz led the 2015 team to several firsts in school history including the first time the Bulldogs have won back-to-back bowl games behind one of the most potent offenses in school history. Louisiana Tech recorded more than 400 offensive yards through its first 10 games of the season, the first time any Bulldog team has achieved such a feat. Tech went on to a 9-4 record after dismantling Arkansas State, 47-28, in the R+L Carriers New Orleans Bowl.

HOLTZ COACHING EXPERIENCE



In just his second season at the helm of the Bulldogs, Holtz enjoyed a five-win improvement from his inaugural campaign as the 15-year coaching veteran led LA Tech to a 9-5 record and a Conference USA West Division title in the team's second year as a member of the league. Holtz and the Bulldogs capped off the 2014 season with a 35-18 win over Big Ten opponent Illinois in the Zaxby's Heart of Dallas Bowl at Cotton Bowl Stadium on Dec. 26, 2014.

In 2014, Holtz engineered an offense that was ranked fourth most improved with an average of 37.4 points per game, while Louisiana Tech was the national leader in points off of turnovers on the defensive side of the ball.

In his first season he inherited a team that lost 35 seniors with seven being invited to NFL camps (two through the NFL Draft) and brought together the team as it entered a new conference (Conference USA) under a new President and new Athletics Director, going 4-8.

Holtz had spent the past three seasons as the head football coach at the University of South Florida. He has also served as the head coach at the University of Connecticut and East Carolina University where he won back-to-back Conference USA titles with the Pirates in 2008 and 2009. He also led his teams to five consecutive post-season bowl games between 2006 and 2010.

Holtz has participated in 16 postseason games in his coaching career, including eight as a head coach and eight as an assistant coach. Of the eight games as head coach, six occurred in the Football Bowl Subdivision (FBS) and two occurred in the Football Championship Subdivision (FCS). In all, he has been involved in eight New Year's Day bowl games during his coaching career.

He attended Holy Cross Junior College in South Bend, Ind., for two years before transferring to Notre Dame in 1984. Holtz earned his bachelor's degree in business management in 1986 and was a football letterwinner for the Irish that same year, appearing in all 11 games as a special teams member and backup flanker.

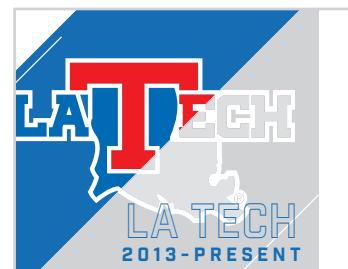

It always nice to be home and Louisiana Tech has experienced recent success in the friendly confines of Joe Aillet Stadium. LA Tech has posted an 85-38 record at home since joining the ranks of Division I-A/FBS, a winning percentage of over 69 percent.

JOE AILLET STADIUM FUN FACT

NFL Hall of Famer and four-time Super Bowl Champion Terry Bradshaw threw the first touchdown pass in the history of Joe Aillet Stadium connecting with Buster Herren from 5-yards out against East Carolina on Sept. 28, 1968. Tech went on to win the game 35-7.

HOME OPENERS AT THE JOE

Since Joe Aillet Stadium opened in 1968, Louisiana Tech has won 39 home openers at "The Joe" with a record of 39-8-1 over that span. If you go back to 1988 when the Bulldogs made the transition to Division I, LA Tech has dominated when playing on its home turf with a record of 24-4 in home openers at The Joe since the 1988 season.

AVERAGE ATTENDANCE TOPS OVER FIRST THREE GAMES

Through the first three home games in the 2015 season, Louisiana Tech averaged 24,942 fans per game, marking a record. That number is the highest average attendance over the first three home games in a season in Joe Aillet Stadium history.
