What to Note

Starting Five

- After an 0-3 start to the year, Kansas City got into the win column on Monday with a 113-54 win over Calvary. It was the Roos' second win in as many years against the Warriors, winning by an average margin of 60.5 points.
- Kansas City began the year by shooting a combined 12-of-71 (16.9%) from three point range in its first three games of the season. The Roos picked up the pace against Calvary, knocking down 17-of-32 triples, good for a 53.1% clip. The mark of 17 made threes tied a program record previously reached on Feb. 6, 2003.
- Anderson Kopp missed the first three games of the season due to a slight leg injury, but made his presence immediately felt in his return. He earned the 27th start of his Kansas City career in the win over Calvary, scoring 13 points, knocking down 3-of-3 three-pointers and nabbing two steals in just 14 minutes of play.
- A team without much college basketball experience, turnover woes have been an issue for the Roos through four games. Kansas City is averaging 20.0 turnovers per game, which have been converted into an average of 17.0 points.
- Freshmen have played a large role already in the Roos' lineup, as six listed first years have seen the court through four games. Precious C. Idiaru has made three starts, and his brother Promise C. Idiaru has averaged 16.5 minutes per game. Emmanouil Dimou has seen major minutes in the past two contests, averaging 17.0 minutes.

Kansas State Notes

- The Wildcats are in their first year of leadership under Head Coach Jerome Tang, and have started the year with a pair of wins.
- Most recently, KSU traveled to Berkeley, Calif. and took town Cal, 63-54 behind 16 points from Keyontae Johnson.
- All-time, the Wildcats hold a 19-1 advantage over the Roos, including wins in each of the past five meetings.
- The Roos' lone win against K-State came in 2003, by way of a 93-52 blowout in Municipal Auditorium.
- Prior to the 2003 win, 7-of-15 meetings had been played in Kansas City. Including Thursday's matchup, the past six meetings have all been played in Manhattan.
- The last meeting between the two teams was played at Bramlage on Nov. 30, 2020, a 62-58 win for the Wildcats. KSU jumped out to a 17-point lead in the first eight minutes of the game, and despite 24 points from Brandon McKissic, the Roos were unable to complete the comeback.

Marvelous Resume

- Head Coach Marvin Menzies enters his tenure at Kansas City as the most decorated incoming coach in program history.
- Entering the season with 12 years of DI head coaching experience and 246 wins to his name, Menzies is no stranger to success.
- During his time at New Mexico State, he won three WAC regular season championships.



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Notes (cont.)

- He also won the WAC tournament championship and qualified for the NCAA Tournament five times, in 2010, and 2012-15. He was named WAC Coach of the Year in 2015.
- During his stint at UNLV, Menzies improved the Runnin' Rebels' final spot in the Mountain West standings each year.

International Flair

- The Roos are global this year, rostering eight international student-athletes from five different countries.
- Only California Baptist has more international players on roster, with nine.
- The Roos are tied with BYU, Dayton, Hawaii and Utah State for the most countries represented, with five.
- Including English, KC's roster can speak 12 different languages. Among the 12 are Arabic, Swahili, Lingala and Wolof.

Fresh(man) Faces

- In the era of the transfer portal, Kansas City welcomes 11 freshmen to campus this year.
- That mark is tied for the third-most in the NCAA this season, behind Arizona (13) and Dayton (12) and tied with Air Force.
- In addition, the Roos' mark of 14 overall newcomers to the roster is tied with Portland and UT Martin for the most in the NCAA this year.
- KC's 11 freshmen is the program's most since at least the 2002-03 season.

Big and Tall

- The Roos have a distinct size difference from years previous on the roster this year.
- KC has four players (Precious and Promise Idiaru, Sidy Diallo and Jeff Ngandu) on roster that are listed at 6'9 or taller.
- Last year, the Roos had just two players touch that height, and the pair combined for 34 total minutes played on the season.

- The last time Kansas City has four-or-more players standing 6'9 or taller was in 2006-07, when the Roos had five such players.

Family Ties

- Kansas City has two sets of brothers on roster this season, making the Roos one of just three teams (Seton Hall, Clemson) with two pairs of brothers in the nation.
- Precious and Promise C. Idiaru are twins, hail from Speyer, Germany and played a year of prep ball at LA Premier Prep. The duo are one of just 11 sets of twins on NCAA DI rosters across the nation.
- Allen David and Logan Mukeba are also brothers. Both were born in Charleroi, Belgium to parents Yvonne and David. Logan is a true freshman, while Allen David spent a year at Colby Community College in Kansas.
- Despite sharing a last name and hailing from Dakar, Senegal, Babacar and Sidy Diallo are unrelated.
- Freshman Abdullah Olajuwon comes from royal basketball blood, as his father Hakeem was an NBA MVP and two-time NBA Champion.

Stepping Up

- One of just four returners on the Kansas City roster, Shemarri Allen made 30 appearances last season, starting in seven games.
- In those 30 appearances, he averaged 4.8 points per game, scoring in double-digits just once (11 points on Feb. 5 vs. Western Illinois).
- Allen embraced a leadership role immediately in his senior season, surpassing the 10-point mark in each of KC's first three games.
- After going for 19 points against LSU, he scored a career-high 20 points against nationally-ranked Illinois.

Finding Their Shot

- Kansas City began the year cold from three-point range, knocking down just 12-of-71 attempts in the first three games, good for a 16.9% clip.

- In the Roos' fourth game, and first win, of the season against Calvary, KC caught fire, knocking down 17-of-32 three-pointers. That tally was good for a 53.1% three-point percentage.
- In addition, the Roos' 17 three-point makes tied a program record, previously reached against Southern Utah on Feb. 6, 2003.
- After zero performances with three-or-more three-pointers through the first three games, Tyler Andrews (4), Emmanouil Dimou (4), Anderson Kopp (3) and RayQuawndis Mitchell (3) all went for at least three triples against the Warriors.

Last Time Out (Recap)

Roos Pick Up First Win of Menzies Era

11/14/22

KANSAS CITY, Mo. - Kansas City Men's Basketball entered the win column for the first time this season on Monday evening, dismantling Calvary, 113-54. Six Roos scored in double-digits, led by RayQuawndis Mitchell with 18. Allen David Mukeba Jr. dropped a near-triple-double, finishing with 14 points, 11 rebounds and eight assists.

KEY MOMENTS

1H / 14-0 | The Roos jumped on the Warriors early with a 14-point run, led by eight points from Jeff Ngandu.

1H / 37-9 | Kansas City went on another big run, scoring 17-straight points, capped by a steal and transition dunk from Anderson Kopp.

1H / 68-21 | A second-chance bucket by Ngandu as the horn sounded took Kansas City into halftime with a 47-point lead.

2H / 90-39 | Both teams traded buckets to open the second half, but a three-pointer by Jevin Sullivan broke the seal and gave KC a 51-point lead.

2H / 100-46 | Mukeba found Sam Martin in the corner for a triple that put the Roos at the century mark.

2H / 111-51 | Tyler Andrews hit his third three-pointer in a span of two minutes, giving the Roos a 60-point lead that would carry them to the finish line.

STATS TO NOTE

The win is the 247th of Head Coach Marvin Menzies head coaching career, and is the first on the sidelines at Kansas City.

Mukeba's eight assists are the most by a Kansas City player since Evan Gilyard II went for eight in a win over Western Illinois on Jan. 31 of last

season.

After shooting 12-of-71 from three-point range in the first three games combined, the Roos knocked down the triple at a 53.1% (17-of-32) clip tonight.

Kansas City's 17 three-pointers ties a program record, previously reached against Southern Utah on Feb. 6, 2003.

Marvin Menzies was officially announced as the eighth head coach in Kansas City Men's Basketball history on April 26, 2022. Menzies comes to KC as a proven coach with more than 30 years of college coaching experience, 246 head coaching wins, five NCAA Tournament appearances and six McDonalds All-American signees as head coach at New Mexico State and UNLV.

"I am beyond excited to take over the helm for the Roos. I've been patiently looking for the right opportunity to give back to the game I love!" Menzies said. "After sitting with Chancellor Agrawal and Dr. Martin, it was clear that this would be an excellent new home for Tammy and I. The alignment at UMKC is exactly what we were looking for. We are extremely blessed and fortunate to join the Kansas City Athletics family. We can't wait to get started and get a chance to meet all the fans, alumni, faculty, students, and faithful supporters! Kansas City is clearly a special place with a rich athletic pride and commitment. My staff and I will work relentlessly to bring conference championships to Kansas City. I'm looking forward to taking Kansas City basketball to the NCAA Tournament."

A prolific recruiter and builder of championship culture, Menzies has 12 years of head coaching experience, including a nine-year run at New Mexico State and a three-year tenure at UNLV. During his time at NMSU, his teams won the WAC regular season title three times and took the postseason crown five times to advance to the NCAA Tournament. In addition, he was named the WAC Coach of the Century by BustingBrackets.com.

"We are thrilled to welcome Marvin and his wife Tammy to our Kansas City Athletics family," Martin said. "Coach Menzies's body of work in college basketball has been noteworthy, particularly in the areas of program academic success, player development, recruiting and establishing championship-level culture and standards. His postseason appearances and success are laudable and I hope to duplicate them in Kansas City. Coach Menzies will undoubtedly contribute to our mantra of comprehensive excellence."

Menzies was most recently an Associate Head Coach at Grand Canyon University during the 2019-20 season, manning the sidelines alongside Head Coach Dan Majerle. During his season with the Lopes, Jovan Blacksher Jr. was named WAC Freshman of the Year, while Carlos Johnson, Alessandro Lever and Mikey Dixon were all named to All-Conference teams.

Prior to his stint at GCU, Menzies held the reins at UNLV from 2016-19. During his time with the Runnin' Rebels, he stabilized the program, beginning with just two scholarship players and building a team that won 20 games and held a 3.0 team GPA in back-to-back years for the first time in program history. Across his three years, Menzies's teams notched five Mountain West Player of the Week honors, had five players named to All-Mountain West squads and saw Brandon McCoy named Freshman of the Year in 2018.

UNLV moved up in the Mountain West Conference standings each year while Menzies was on the sidelines, beginning with an 11th-place finish in the 2016-17 season, moving up to seventh place in 2017-18 and culminating with a fourth-place finish in the 2018-19 season. The Runnin' Rebels won 11 Mountain West games in the 2018-19 season, the program's most in nine years.

The 2017-18 Runnin' Rebels squad won 20 games for the first time in four seasons, a nine-win improvement over the previous year. The team finished ranked 10th in the NCAA in rebounding (40.5 per game) and 13th in scoring (83.4 points per game), leading the Mountain West in both categories.

Following his first season at UNLV, Menzies brought in one of the highest-ranked recruiting classes in program history, ranking as high as No. 12 in the country and No. 2 in the Mountain West. Among that class were McDonald's High School All-American Brandon McCoy and National Junior College Player of the Year Shakur Juiston.

Menzies's first head coaching gig came at New Mexico State, where he led the Aggies for nine years, compiling a 198-111 overall record and a 103-37 mark in Western Athletic Conference play. His squads earned either a regular season or postseason conference title in seven of his nine years, including each of the final five seasons. He left Las Cruces with the third-most wins in programs history and the third-best winning percentage in WAC history. He was named the WAC Coach of the Year in the 2014-15 season.

Menzies brought and developed talent during his nine-year tenure at New Mexico State, highlighted by 2016 first round NBA draft pick Pascal Siakam. He saw two Aggies named AP Honorable Mention All-American, Siakam in the 2015-16 season, and Daniel Mullings in the 2013-14 year. Additionally, during his time on the sidelines the Aggies had 12 All-WAC First Teamers, 21 All-WAC selections overall, two WAC Freshman of the Year winners, two WAC Player of the Year winners and five WAC Tournament MVPs.

In the 2015-16 season, Menzies led the Aggies to their fifth-straight 20-win season, the seventh in eight years, and the second-straight WAC regular season title. The team went 13-1 in conference play and extended the NMSU in-conference home winning streak to 35 games, the second-longest streak in the nation at the time.

Menzies's 2014-15 team was a defensive-minded group, ranking top-25 in the nation by allowing just 59.8 points per game. The team won 19 of its final 22 games, including a 13-game win streak to claim the regular season conference title, the third-longest winning streak in program history. His squad won the WAC Tournament for the fourth-straight year and were the first team in conference history to win more than two tournament titles in a row.

The Aggies won 26 games in the 2013-14 season, tied for their winningest season under Menzies. They became the first team to win three-straight WAC Tournament titles, led by Sim Bhullar, who was named tournament MVP for the second-straight year.

In the 2012-13 season, the Aggies broke school records for blocked shots in a season (193) and field goal percentage in a game (68.6% against UTSA). The squad won 18 of its final 21 games, earning the second-straight NCAA Tournament appearance.

Menzies's 2011-12 squad began NMSU's streak of NCAA Tournament appearances, winning 26 games, the team's most since the 1992-93 season. The Aggies had four all-conference selections, and Wendell McKines became just the second player in program history and the 12th in WAC history to surpass the 1,000-point and 1,000-rebounds marks.

The Aggies won their second-ever WAC Tournament title in 2009-10, posting a 22-12 overall mark. It was the program's first NCAA Tournament bid since 2007, earning a No. 12 seed in the Midwest regional.

Menzies saw immediate success after taking over the helm at New Mexico State, claiming a share of the Aggies' first-ever WAC regular season title in 2007-08. His squad won 12 conference games and ranked second in the country in rebounding margin.



Prior to his success as a head coach, Menzies rose to prominence as one of the best recruiters in the nation, spending time as an assistant coach as Louisville, UNLV, USC, San Diego State and Cal State Sacramento.

In his two seasons at Louisville, the Cardinals made two postseason appearances, including an NCAA Tournament Second Round qualification in 2006-07. That team also finished the year ranked No. 20 in the final USA Today/ESPN Coaches Top-25 poll.

Menzies was at UNLV for a year prior to his time at Louisville, assisting Head Coach Lon Kruger to bring in the fourth-best recruiting class in the nation.

In the 2003-04 season, Menzies was an assistant at Southern California. The Trojans brought in one of the best recruiting classes in the nation with his help, ranking third overall.

Menzies spent four years on the sidelines at San Diego State from 1999-2003, helping to guide the Aztecs to back-to-back postseason appearances for the first time since 1975-76. He helped ink top-25 (2001) and top-40 (2000) recruiting classes, including the program's first-ever McDonald's All-American.

Menzies began his collegiate coaching career at Santa Monica (Calif.) College as an assistant coach under John McMullen. Menzies spent six seasons as an assistant and associate head coach (1991-94, 1995-96 and 1997-99) there. He was the team's head coach for a year (in 1994-95) and guided the Corsairs to a 24-8 record. Menzies led Santa Monica to the Western States Conference title while he earned conference coach of the year honors.

With Menzies on the staff, the program was a collective 181-46. During his tenure, 38 players went on to NCAA schools. In 1996, the Corsairs produced a school-record 27-game winning streak and a school-best 32-2 finish. Menzies recruited the top three scorers in the school's history.

Between his time at Santa Monica, he was as an assistant coach at Cal State Sacramento (1996-97). He coached under Don Newman as the program transitioned from Division II to Division I.

Beginning his coaching career at his prep alma mater, Hamilton High School in Los Angeles, Calif., Menzies was an assistant coach for eight years. A California native, Menzies was a letter-winner in three sports at Hamilton.

Menzies earned a bachelor's degree in economics from UCLA in 1987 and a master's degree in education from Cal State Sacramento in 2003. In 2016, Menzies was recognized by President Barack Obama with a "Lifetime Achievement Award in Service."

He and his wife, Tammy, have a daughter, Andreanna, a son, Andre, and a niece, Aja Stankevich, who they consider another daughter.

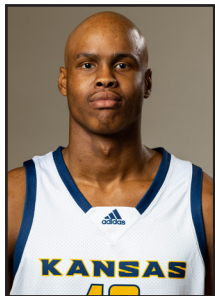

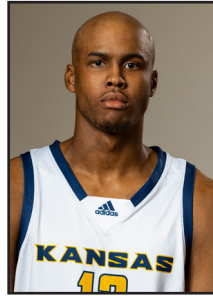

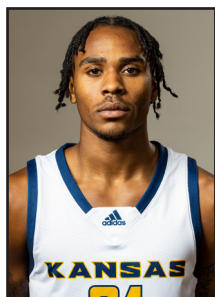
