### What to Note

#### Starting Five

- Kansas City closed out the 2022 year by starting Summit League play with a 2-1 record, and will open 2023 with a meeting at Oral Roberts. In the past five years, Kansas City is 4-1 in its first game after the New Year. All-time, the Roos hold a 16-19 record in such games.
- Shemarri Allen and RayQuawndis Mitchell have established themselves as one of the most dominant scoring duos in America. With five 20-point games each, the pair have the most combined 20-plus point games of any duo in the Summit League. In addition, as of Jan. 3, the pair were one of just 14 duos in the NCAA with five-or-more 20-point games each.
- The three-ball has continued to be a marker of Kansas City's success on the year. When shooting above 30% from three-point range, the Roos hold a 5-2 record. When that mark reaches the 40% threshold, Kansas City owns a 3-0 mark. In games which the Roos shoot under 30% from the three, the team holds a 1-8 mark, with the lone win coming against Indiana State.
- At his current pace, Jeff Ngandu would have one of the best shot-blocking seasons in Kansas City history. The freshman is currently blocking shots at a 1.6 blocks per game rate, ranking third in the Summit League and 75th in the nation. If the season ended today, that mark would be tied for the third-best in program history and the best by a freshman.
- The beginning of conference play has seen an emergence from Tyler Andrews. The freshman is averaging 7.7 points through three Summit League games.

#### Oral Roberts Notes

- ORU is Kansas City's most-played opponent in program history, with Saturday marking the 39th meeting all-time. The Golden Eagles hold a 27-11 advantage in the series, including 17 wins in the last 18 meetings.
- Last season, ORU took a season sweep over the Roos, including a 91-86 decision on Feb. 12, the most points the Roos allowed all season.
- KC's last win over the Golden Eagles came on Jan. 24, 2021, an 81-76 win. The Roos were led by Brandon McKissic, who went for 24 points on 10-of-13 shooting.
- This year, Oral Roberts is out to a 12-3 record, including a 3-0 start in conference play. After beginning the year 3-3, the team has won its last nine games.
- The Golden Eagles are one of the best offensive teams in the nation, ranking first in the Summit in assists, scoring offense and threes per game.
- Max Abmas leads ORU and the Summit League with an average of 19.7 points per contest. In four games against KC, Abmas has averaged 22.5 points per game.

#### Marvelous Resume

- Head Coach Marvin Menzies enters his tenure at Kansas City as the most decorated incoming coach in program history.
- Entering the season with 12 years of DI head coaching experience and 246 wins to his name, Menzies is no stranger to success.

State, he won three WAC regular season championships.

- He also won the WAC tournament championship and qualified for the NCAA Tournament five times, in 2010, and 2012-15. He was named WAC Coach of the Year in 2015.
- During his stint at UNLV, Menzies improved the Runnin' Rebels' final spot in the Mountain West standings each year.

### International Flair

- The Roos are global this year, rostering eight international student-athletes from five different countries.
- Only Maine (11) and California Baptist (9) have more international players on roster.
- Behind Maine (6), the Roos are tied with BYU, Dayton, Hawaii and Utah State and Cal Baptist for most different countries represented.
- Including English, KC's roster can speak 12 different languages. Among the 12 are Arabic, Swahili, Lingala and Wolof.

### Fresh(man) Faces

- In the era of the transfer portal, Kansas City welcomes 11 freshmen to campus this year.
- That mark is tied for the third-most in the NCAA this season, behind Arizona (13) and Dayton (12) and tied with Air Force.
- In addition, the Roos' mark of 14 overall newcomers to the roster is tied with Portland and UT Martin for the most in the NCAA this year.
- The Roos have an average of 1.17 years of Division One experience on the roster, which ranks 308th in the nation.
- KC's 11 freshmen is the program's most since at least the 2002-03 season.

### Big and Tall

- The Roos have a distinct size difference from years previous on the roster this year.

- Kansas City's average height of 78.2 inches ranks 37th in the nation.
- KC has four players (Precious and Promise Idiaru, Sidy Diallo and Jeff Ngandu) on roster that are listed at 6'9 or taller.
- Last year, the Roos had just two players touch that height, and the pair combined for 34 total minutes played on the season.
- The last time Kansas City has four-or-more players standing 6'9 or taller was in 2006-07, when the Roos had five such players.

### Family Ties

- Kansas City has two sets of brothers on roster this season, making the Roos one of just three teams (Seton Hall, Clemson) with two pairs of brothers in the nation.
- Precious and Promise C. Idiaru are twins, hail from Speyer, Germany and played a year of prep ball at LA Premier Prep. The duo are one of just 11 sets of twins on NCAA DI rosters across the nation.
- Allen David and Logan Mukeba are also brothers. Both were born in Charleroi, Belgium to parents Yvonne and David. Logan is a true freshman, while Allen David spent a year at Colby Community College in Kansas.
- Despite sharing a last name and hailing from Dakar, Senegal, Babacar and Sidy Diallo are unrelated.
- Freshman Abdullah Olajuwon comes from royal basketball blood, as his father Hakeem was an NBA MVP and two-time NBA Champion.
- Junior guard Sam Martin shares ties with Kansas City's finest, he and Chiefs quarterback Patrick Mahomes are cousins.

### Stepping Up

- One of just four returners on the Kansas City roster, Shemarri Allen made 30 appearances last season, starting in seven games.
- In those 30 appearances, he averaged 4.8 points per game, scoring in double-digits just once (11 points on

Feb. 5 vs. Western Illinois).

- Allen embraced a leadership role immediately in his senior season, surpassing the 10-point mark in each of KC's first three games.
- After going for 19 points against LSU, he scored 20 points against nationally-ranked Illinois, 21 against Kansas State and a then-career-high 22 against Indiana State.
- Allen set a career-high again in the Roos' game at Green Bay, knocking down 9-of-21 shots and scoring 28 points.

### Finding Their Shot

- Kansas City began the year cold from three-point range, knocking down just 12-of-71 attempts in the first three games, good for a 16.9% clip.
- In the Roos' fourth game, and first win, of the season against Calvary, KC caught fire, knocking down 17-of-32 three-pointers. That tally was good for a 53.1% three-point percentage.
- In addition, the Roos' 17 three-point makes tied a program record, previously reached against Southern Utah on Feb. 6, 2003.
- After zero performances with three-or-more three-pointers through the first three games, Tyler Andrews (4), Emmanouil Dimou (4), Anderson Kopp (3) and RayQuawndis Mitchell (3) all went for at least three triples against the Warriors.

### Proving Analytics Wrong

- The Roos first win against a Division One opponent this year came in a big way, an 83-71 win over Toledo.
- Going into the game, Kansas City was ranked #290 in the KenPom ratings, while Toledo was ranked #73.
- It was the Roos' first win against a KenPom top-100 team since defeating #92 Utah Valley on Feb. 10, 2019.
- It was KC's highest-ranked KenPom victory since a Dec. 12, 2016 win over #78 Mississippi State.
- At the time of the victory, Toledo was ranked No. 5 in the CollegeInsider

- Just one day later, the Roos beat No. 119 ranked Indiana State, KC's first back-to-back wins as 100+ spot KenPom underdogs since defeating Seattle and Utah Valley in back-to-back games in the 2018-19 season.

### They're Free!

- RayQuawndis Mitchell has become one of the best in the nation at getting to the free throw line and taking advantage.
- In his career-high 35-point game against Toledo, he went 18-of-20 from the free throw line, tying Tony Dumas's single game program record for free throw makes.
- The 18 free throw makes are (as of Dec. 28) the second-most by a player in the country this season, trailing only Portland's Tyler Robertson's 22 free throw performance against Portland State.
- As of Nov. 26, Mitchell ranked first in the nation in free throws and free throw makes.

### Magic Number 250

- After entering the season with 246 career head coaching wins, Marvin Menzies's 250th win came against Indiana State on Nov. 22 in the semifinals of the Gulf Coast Showcase.
- Of the over 350 coaches in Division One, Menzies is one of just 102 (as of Jan. 6) that have reached the 250-win threshold.
- Among the 102 that have reached that mark, just four of them are in their 13th-or-fewer season of head coaching. Joining him among those ranks are UC Irvine's Russell Turner (13 years), Georgia's Michael White (12 years) and Boise State's Leon Rice (13 years).

### Marathon Man

- On Dec. 29, 2022, Kansas City fell in a triple-overtime game against Denver, 85-83.

- The game marked just the third time in program history the team had played in a triple OT game, the first since a win over Seattle on Jan. 2, 2020.
- In that game, Shemarri Allen played 53:57 and scored a career-high 34 points, including a game-tying three-pointer at the end of regulation.
- Allen's 53:57 of playing time marked a program record. Previously, no player had ever surpassed the 50-minute mark.
- As of Jan. 6, Allen averaged 35:46 of playing time per game, leading the Summit and ranking 24th in the nation.

### Block Party!

- In the Jan. 29 loss to Denver, Jeff Ngandu logged five blocks, the most by a Roo in a single game since Aleer Leek posted the same mark against SEMO on Dec. 6, 2017.
- Since the start of the 2003 season, a Kansas City player has reached the five-block mark just six times.

### Last Time Out (Recap)

#### KC Runs Past Omaha

12/31/22

OMAHA, Neb. - RayQuawndis Mitchell exploded for 27 points, dropping six three-pointers, as Kansas City Men's Basketball (6-10, 2-1 Summit) ran past Omaha (5-10, 1-2 Summit) to close out the 2022 calendar year. Shemarri Allen added 17 points and Allen David Mukeba Jr. dropped 11 to help aid the Roos' scoring efforts.

Following Thursday's triple-overtime battle in Denver, the Roos showed no signs of fatigue this afternoon. It was a close game deep into the second half, as Kansas City held a four-point edge with just over five minutes remaining in regulation. Then, Allen took over, scoring six straight points and KC ran away with the game in the final minutes.

The Roos shot at a 58.7% clip on the game, including 8-of-19 three-point shooting, the team's third-best three-point shooting percentage on the season and best in 10 games. Mitchell's six three-point makes tied a career-high, previously reached in the Roos' Dec. 3 win over Lindenwood.

#### KEY MOMENTS

1H - 17:21 / 6-3 | A pair of baskets by Mukeba got the Roos going, then Tyler Andrews put on a spin cycle and finished near the rim to give KC an early lead.

1H - 11:00 / 13-6 | After a three-plus minute scoring drought, Jevin Sullivan got the Roos scoring with a second chance bucket. On the next trip down the court, Babacar Diallo dishd to Mitchell in the corner, who nailed the Roos' first three of the game and extended the lead to seven.

1H - 5:28 / 21-19 | Omaha went on an eight-point run across a two-minute span to take the lead, but Mitchell was there for the response, hitting another three on the assist by Allen.

2H - 17:36 / 33-31 | The Mavericks opened the second half on a four-point run to take the lead, a dunk by Jeff Ngandu brought the Roos within a point. On the next Omaha possession, Mukeba got a steal, drove the other way and threw down an and-one dunk

to reclaim the lead.

2H - 13:46 / 44-38 | Kansas City hit on back-to-back three-pointers, first by Mitchell, then on a shot clock buzzer-beater by Diallo that put the Roos ahead by six.

2H - 7:47 / 58-51 | The Mavericks drew within a point, but Kansas City scored the next six using an and-one three-pointer by Mitchell and a strong drive to the bucket by Sullivan.

2H - 0:41 / 75-59 | The Roos ended the game on a 17-4 run over the game's final five minutes, beginning with six straight points from Allen, and ending with a wide open three by Mitchell to finish the game with 27 and send KC into the new year with a road win under its belt.

#### STATS TO NOTE

Kansas City's 58.7% shooting clip marked a season-high, and was the best by a Roo team against Division One competition since the 2020-21 squad shot at a 65.9% clip in an 81-76 win over Oral Roberts on Jan. 24, 2021.

To start Summit League play, the Roos are shooting the three at a 35.4% rate. That clip is a substantial increase over the team's 27.0% three-point clip in non-conference play.

With today's 27-point performance, Mitchell has surpassed the 20-point mark five times, including in three of the past six games. His 17.9 point per game scoring average ranks second in the Summit League.

The Roos dominated the paint, outscoring the Mavericks 34-18.

After swatting five shots at Denver on Thursday, Ngandu blocked away two shots today, giving him 25 total on the season. At his current rate, he would finish the regular season with 47 blocks, which would be the third-best single-season total in program history.

Posting eight steals tonight, KC has reached that mark in four of the past five games. In the first 11 games of the year, the Roos notched that many steals just once.

Today's win is Kansas City's first road win of the season. Previously, the Roos had been 0-6.

#### COACH MARVIN MENZIES, QUOTED

"Effort and energy was there on both sides of the ball tonight. I was obviously pleased with getting a victory in the last game of the year, but it's just another brick in the wall as it relates to our journey and our goals."

"(Allen) is a soldier. He's one of those guys that's able to fight with mental toughness when the physical toughness starts to diminish because you get tired."

Marvin Menzies was officially announced as the eighth head coach in Kansas City Men's Basketball history on April 26, 2022. Menzies comes to KC as a proven coach with more than 30 years of college coaching experience, 246 head coaching wins, five NCAA Tournament appearances and six McDonalds All-American signees as head coach at New Mexico State and UNLV.

"I am beyond excited to take over the helm for the Roos. I've been patiently looking for the right opportunity to give back to the game I love!" Menzies said. "After sitting with Chancellor Agrawal and Dr. Martin, it was clear that this would be an excellent new home for Tammy and I. The alignment at UMKC is exactly what we were looking for. We are extremely blessed and fortunate to join the Kansas City Athletics family. We can't wait to get started and get a chance to meet all the fans, alumni, faculty, students, and faithful supporters! Kansas City is clearly a special place with a rich athletic pride and commitment. My staff and I will work relentlessly to bring conference championships to Kansas City. I'm looking forward to taking Kansas City basketball to the NCAA Tournament."

A prolific recruiter and builder of championship culture, Menzies has 12 years of head coaching experience, including a nine-year run at New Mexico State and a three-year tenure at UNLV. During his time at NMSU, his teams won the WAC regular season title three times and took the postseason crown five times to advance to the NCAA Tournament. In addition, he was named the WAC Coach of the Century by BustingBrackets.com.

"We are thrilled to welcome Marvin and his wife Tammy to our Kansas City Athletics family," Martin said. "Coach Menzies's body of work in college basketball has been noteworthy, particularly in the areas of program academic success, player development, recruiting and establishing championship-level culture and standards. His postseason appearances and success are laudable and I hope to duplicate them in Kansas City. Coach Menzies will undoubtedly contribute to our mantra of comprehensive excellence."

Menzies was most recently an Associate Head Coach at Grand Canyon University during the 2019-20 season, manning the sidelines alongside Head Coach Dan Majerle. During his season with the Lopes, Jovan Blacksher Jr. was named WAC Freshman of the Year, while Carlos Johnson, Alessandro Lever and Mikey Dixon were all named to All-Conference teams.

Prior to his stint at GCU, Menzies held the reins at UNLV from 2016-19. During his time with the Runnin' Rebels, he stabilized the program, beginning with just two scholarship players and building a team that won 20 games and held a 3.0 team GPA in back-to-back years for the first time in program history. Across his three years, Menzies's teams notched five Mountain West Player of the Week honors, had five players named to All-Mountain West squads and saw Brandon McCoy named Freshman of the Year in 2018.

UNLV moved up in the Mountain West Conference standings each year while Menzies was on the sidelines, beginning with an 11th-place finish in the 2016-17 season, moving up to seventh place in 2017-18 and culminating with a fourth-place finish in the 2018-19 season. The Runnin' Rebels won 11 Mountain West games in the 2018-19 season, the program's most in nine years.

The 2017-18 Runnin' Rebels squad won 20 games for the first time in four seasons, a nine-win improvement over the previous year. The team finished ranked 10th in the NCAA in rebounding (40.5 per game) and 13th in scoring (83.4 points per game), leading the Mountain West in both categories.

Following his first season at UNLV, Menzies brought in one of the highest-ranked recruiting classes in program history, ranking as high as No. 12 in the country and No. 2 in the Mountain West. Among that class were McDonald's High School All-American Brandon McCoy and National Junior College Player of the Year Shakur Juiston.

Menzies's first head coaching gig came at New Mexico State, where he led the Aggies for nine years, compiling a 198-111 overall record and a 103-37 mark in Western Athletic Conference play. His squads earned either a regular season or postseason conference title in seven of his nine years, including each of the final five seasons. He left Las Cruces with the third-most wins in programs history and the third-best winning percentage in WAC history. He was named the WAC Coach of the Year in the 2014-15 season.

Menzies brought and developed talent during his nine-year tenure at New Mexico State, highlighted by 2016 first round NBA draft pick Pascal Siakam. He saw two Aggies named AP Honorable Mention All-American, Siakam in the 2015-16 season, and Daniel Mullings in the 2013-14 year. Additionally, during his time on the sidelines the Aggies had 12 All-WAC First Teamers, 21 All-WAC selections overall, two WAC Freshman of the Year winners, two WAC Player of the Year winners and five WAC Tournament MVPs.

In the 2015-16 season, Menzies led the Aggies to their fifth-straight 20-win season, the seventh in eight years, and the second-straight WAC regular season title. The team went 13-1 in conference play and extended the NMSU in-conference home winning streak to 35 games, the second-longest streak in the nation at the time.

Menzies's 2014-15 team was a defensive-minded group, ranking top-25 in the nation by allowing just 59.8 points per game. The team won 19 of its final 22 games, including a 13-game win streak to claim the regular season conference title, the third-longest winning streak in program history. His squad won the WAC Tournament for the fourth-straight year and were the first team in conference history to win more than two tournament titles in a row.

The Aggies won 26 games in the 2013-14 season, tied for their winningest season under Menzies. They became the first team to win three-straight WAC Tournament titles, led by Sim Bhullar, who was named tournament MVP for the second-straight year.

In the 2012-13 season, the Aggies broke school records for blocked shots in a season (193) and field goal percentage in a game (68.6% against UTSA). The squad won 18 of its final 21 games, earning the second-straight NCAA Tournament appearance.

Menzies's 2011-12 squad began NMSU's streak of NCAA Tournament appearances, winning 26 games, the team's most since the 1992-93 season. The Aggies had four all-conference selections, and Wendell McKines became just the second player in program history and the 12th in WAC history to surpass the 1,000-point and 1,000-rebounds marks.

The Aggies won their second-ever WAC Tournament title in 2009-10, posting a 22-12 overall mark. It was the program's first NCAA Tournament bid since 2007, earning a No. 12 seed in the Midwest regional.

Menzies saw immediate success after taking over the helm at New Mexico State, claiming a share of the Aggies' first-ever WAC regular season title in 2007-08. His squad won 12 conference games and ranked second in the country in rebounding margin.



Prior to his success as a head coach, Menzies rose to prominence as one of the best recruiters in the nation, spending time as an assistant coach as Louisville, UNLV, USC, San Diego State and Cal State Sacramento.

In his two seasons at Louisville, the Cardinals made two postseason appearances, including an NCAA Tournament Second Round qualification in 2006-07. That team also finished the year ranked No. 20 in the final USA Today/ESPN Coaches Top-25 poll.

Menzies was at UNLV for a year prior to his time at Louisville, assisting Head Coach Lon Kruger to bring in the fourth-best recruiting class in the nation.

In the 2003-04 season, Menzies was an assistant at Southern California. The Trojans brought in one of the best recruiting classes in the nation with his help, ranking third overall.

Menzies spent four years on the sidelines at San Diego State from 1999-2003, helping to guide the Aztecs to back-to-back postseason appearances for the first time since 1975-76. He helped ink top-25 (2001) and top-40 (2000) recruiting classes, including the program's first-ever McDonald's All-American.

Menzies began his collegiate coaching career at Santa Monica (Calif.) College as an assistant coach under John McMullen. Menzies spent six seasons as an assistant and associate head coach (1991-94, 1995-96 and 1997-99) there. He was the team's head coach for a year (in 1994-95) and guided the Corsairs to a 24-8 record. Menzies led Santa Monica to the Western States Conference title while he earned conference coach of the year honors.

With Menzies on the staff, the program was a collective 181-46. During his tenure, 38 players went on to NCAA schools. In 1996, the Corsairs produced a school-record 27-game winning streak and a school-best 32-2 finish. Menzies recruited the top three scorers in the school's history.

Between his time at Santa Monica, he was as an assistant coach at Cal State Sacramento (1996-97). He coached under Don Newman as the program transitioned from Division II to Division I.

Beginning his coaching career at his prep alma mater, Hamilton High School in Los Angeles, Calif., Menzies was an assistant coach for eight years. A California native, Menzies was a letter-winner in three sports at Hamilton.

Menzies earned a bachelor's degree in economics from UCLA in 1987 and a master's degree in education from Cal State Sacramento in 2003. In 2016, Menzies was recognized by President Barack Obama with a "Lifetime Achievement Award in Service."

He and his wife, Tammy, have a daughter, Andreanna, a son, Andre, and a niece, Aja Stankevich, who they consider another daughter.

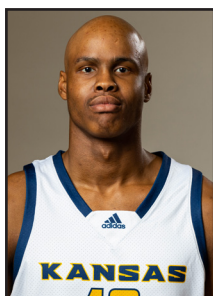

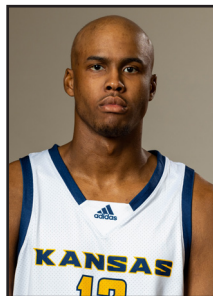
