THE ROOS' NEWS

- Kansas City Men's Soccer is in Palo Alto, Calif. for the second round of the NCAA Tournament, the second-consecutive year and the third time in program history that the Roos have moved past the first round. KC will be tasked with playing 12th-seeded Stanford, looking to match the 2024 team's round of 16 qualification for the best postseason result in program history.
- The Roos' first round match came against Lindenwood in the first-ever NCAA Tournament game played at Durwood Soccer Stadium. KC earned a 1-0 win in front of 809 fans, the highest attended match on record since Durwood opened in 2009.
- Kevin Nkumu scored the game-winner against the Lions in the 54th minute, assisted by Joackim Betina and Mathias Baucher. The goal was the first of Nkumu's collegiate career, having attempted just five shots on the season. Three of his five shot attempts have come in KC's last four contests.
- Kansas City is 1-1 all-time in the NCAA Second Round. The Roos fell to fourth-seeded Saint Louis, 2-1, in the team's first-ever tournament appearance in 2001. Last year, the Roos defeated 15th-seeded Missouri State in a 2-1 thriller on goals by Sora Shibata and Ales Kohoutek.
- Jeremy Francou remains just one goal away from tying the single-season program record. The junior striker is at 11 goals on the year and attempted a game-high four shots in the first round win over Lindenwood, matching the Lions' shot total by himself.
- Kansas City is in the NCAA Tournament for the second-straight year, the first time in program history that the Roos have qualified to the national tournament in consecutive seasons. This also marks the first time in school history that the Roos have earned an at-large bid to the NAAs.
- The Roos' resume includes the 20th-best RPI in the nation and a regular season title in the Summit League, the nation's 7th RPI rated conference. Kansas City faced the 23rd toughest schedule in the nation, piecing together an 12-3-5 overall record with an 11-0-1 record against teams outside of the RPI top-75.
- This is the fifth NCAA tournament appearance in Kansas City's history, adding to the legacy of the 2001, 2003, 2008 and 2024 squads. KC has a 4-4 all-time record in NCAA tournament games,

A LOOK AT THE CARDINAL

- Stanford is the 12th-seeded team in the NCAA Tournament and was ranked eighth in the final United Soccer Coaches' poll of the regular season.
- The Cardinal enter the NAAs with a 13-3-2 record and have not played since a Nov. 9 loss to SMU in the second round of the ACC Tournament.
- Stanford's Rowan Schnebly has played 1607 minutes on the season and conceded just 16 goals, ranking fourth in the ACC and 39th in the nation with a 0.896 goals against average.
- As a team, the Cardinal rank third in the nation in shot attempts per game (18.9) and fifth in shots on goal per game (7.4).
- Head Coach Ryan Pore is no stranger to Stanford. While at Tulsa, Pore defeated the Cardinal as a player in 2002 and 2003 and as a coach in 2017. In '02 and '17, Stanford was No. 1 in the nation.

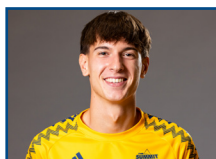

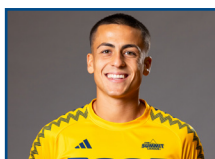

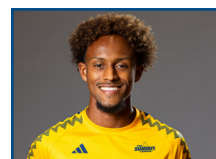

including a program-best Round of 16 appearance last season.

- Head Coach Ryan Pore is no stranger to the national tournament, qualifying two times as a player at Tulsa, two times as an assistant coach at Tulsa and twice now as a head coach in KC. He tallied a 3-2-1 tournament record as an athlete and currently has a 3-3-1 record as a coach.
- The Roos were able to shut out the nation's top scoring offense in the Summit League semifinal round, defeating third-seeded Delaware, 2-0, before falling to #1 Denver in the finals.
- Kansas City saw many postseason awards come its way, led by a second-straight Coach of the Year honor for head man Ryan Pore. He has won the award three times in his career and has KC with back-to-back 10-win seasons for the first time in program history.
- Bryce Outman pulled in Newcomer of the Year and First Team All-League honors, starting in 11 of KC's final 12 games. He has a team-leading five assists on the year and is the first Kansas City freshman to earn first team honors since Jordan Rideout in 2011.
- Jeremy Francou also earned a First Team nod, leading the Roos with eight goals and 19 total points on the season. He has four game-winners, eighth-most in the nation.
- Guille Munoz rounds out KC's First Team All-League honorees, tallying a goal and an assist in conference play while playing the full 90 minutes in four-of-six conference games.
- Representing KC on the All-League Second Team: Joackim Betina, Bryson Gosch and Raphael Kistmann.
- Representing KC on the All-League Honorable Mention: Miguel Fernandez, Elie Kisoka and Timothy Ospina.
- The Roos closed the regular season with a thrilling draw against Delaware, erasing a two goal deficit and then salvaging the draw with an 89th-minute penalty kick from Raphael Kistmann.
- Kansas City made a flurried comeback in their final road game of the regular season, defeating UMass, 3-2. The Roos fell behind 2-0 in the game's first 25 minutes, ending the match with three unanswered goals to keep their Summit League title hopes alive.
- The Roos' final game of non-conference play resulted in the program's second-ever win over a Big 10 team, dispatching Michigan State, 2-0 on Oct. 26. Raphael Kistmann scored the game-winner in the 50th minute, his third-straight game with a goal.
- Head Coach Ryan Pore's 100th career game as a head coach resulted in a meaningful victory, defeating Tulsa, his alma mater. The Roos were led by a Jeremy Francou game-winner, his seventh goal of the year.
- Kansas City notched a Senior Night victory over St. Thomas on Oct. 18, defeating the Tommies in a 3-1 decision. Three of the honored seniors - Wade Muttitt, Raphael Kistmann and Timothy Ospina - accounted for all three of Kansas City's goals.
- Elie Kisoka made his presence known in Kansas City's 1-0 win over Oral Roberts on Oct. 11, scoring his first goal of the year. The senior found the back of the net in the 87th minute, giving the Roos their second-straight victory.
- The Roos picked up their first win of Summit League play on Oct. 4 with a 1-0 victory over Omaha. KC found the back of

SENIOR SPOTLIGHT



Kansas City celebrated Senior Night on Oct. 18 with a 3-1 win over St. Thomas. In appropriate fashion, three of the honored players - Wade Muttitt, Raphael Kistmann and Timothy Ospina - were responsible for KC's goals.

Brandon McGaugh

McGaugh came to Kansas City after an all-conference career at Johnson County CC and was a large part of the Roos' NCAA run last season. He started in 21 games, ranking second in the Summit in goals-against average and saves per game en route to two Summit Peak Performer of the Week awards and an All-Newcomer honor.

Joackim Betina

Betina began his collegiate career at Florida International and came to KC for his final year, where he has been a starter in 12-of-13 games and has played 1026 minutes. Betina has tallied one goal and two assists on the year, accounting for the first points of his collegiate career.

Elie Kisoka

The reigning Summit League Offensive Player of the Year, Kisoka rewrote the record books in his first year with the Roos, claiming program records with 12 goals and 33 overall points. His efforts led the Roos to an NCAA Round of 16 appearance and he has battled back from an offseason surgery to score his first goal of 2025, a game-winner on Oct. 11 at Oral Roberts.

Mateus Moura

Moura spent the last two seasons in Kansas City after spending time at Lincoln Trail College, appearing in 17 games and making a pair of starts in 2024. He appeared in all four of KC's postseason games last year and has made appearances in six games this season.

Raphael Kistmann

A 2024 Second Team All-Summit Leaguer, Kistmann came to KC from Saint Louis CC and made an immediate impact. He scored eight goals last season and tallied 22 total points, ranking third in the Summit. He has made four starts this year, notching a pair of assists in the Roos' win over SIUE.

Timothy Ospina

After a three-year career at Incarnate Word, Ospina came to Kansas City this past offseason and has been a key player for the Roos. He has appeared in 12 games, making four starts and playing 467 minutes with a season-high of 90 minutes in the Roos' win over St. Thomas.

Wade Muttitt

Wade Muttitt came to Kansas City after three years at Saint Mary's, where he was a three-time All-WCC player. He has made five starts in 12 appearances this year, three goals and notching a pair of assists. He currently ranks second on the team with eight overall points.

- Kansas City went 2-0 with a pair of shutouts against SIUE and Western Illinois in the week of Sep. 15-21. Jeremy Francou and Marc Popow swept the Summit League weekly awards for their efforts in the victories.
- The Roos nabbed their third result against a ranked opponent on Sep. 13 with a 1-1 draw at No. 25 San Diego. After falling behind in the 72nd minute, Bryson Gosch scored the equalizer just 74 seconds later.
- Kansas City picked up its second win of the season on Sep. 1 thanks to a Jeremy Francou brace, the first of his career. KC was able to pick up the win despite being out-shot, 18-9.
- Kenny Yedmel was named the Summit League's Defensive Peak Performer of the Week on Sept. 2, earning the first weekly award of the season for a Kansas City player. He was the first non-goalie from Kansas City to earn defensive player of the Week honors since Seth Kacich in 2022.
- The Roos' first win of the year came in the form of a 2-1 victory over No. 24 Missouri State on Aug. 25. It was KC's third win over the Bears in the last two years and gave the Roos a program record four ranked wins over the past two seasons.
- Kansas City opened the year with a 2-2 draw against No. 5 SMU, the third time in program history that the Roos have notched a top-25 draw in their season opener. The other two were also ended in 2-2 results: against No. 16 UIUC in 2008 and against No. 15 Virginia Tech in 2021.
- The Roos' No. 18 ranking in the preseason United Soccer Coaches poll marks the first time in program history that KC has entered a season in the top 25.
- Coming off their first Summit League Championship since 2008, the Roos were selected for a second-place finish in the 2025 Summit League Preseason Coaches' Poll.
- The Roos return eight players that started at least 10 games last season: Kisoka (22 GS), Miguel Fernandez (21), Bryson Gosch (21), Brandon McGaugh (21), Brevyn Cole (20), Raphael Kistmann (15), Guille Munoz (13) and Mathias Baucher (11).
- Alongside the veterans, the Roos are adding 15 new student-athletes. That group includes four Division One transfers: Joackim Betina (FIU), Wade Muttitt (SMC), Timothy Ospina (UIW) and Ethan Schaefer (Drexel).
- Kansas City has a Dallas flair to it this season. The Roos' roster includes four players from the FC Dallas Academy: Ospina, Adam Lansdown, Bryce Outman and Ian Witis-Hughes.
- The KC roster continues to span across the world. Coach Pore and staff have constructed a team that represents 12 different nations and five of the seven continents.
- After earning Summit League Offensive Player of the Year, Newcomer of the Year, and United Soccer Coaches Second Team All-West Region honors last season, Kisoka enters the 2025 campaign with lofty expectations. TopDrawerSoccer has named him a "Forward to Watch," placed him at No. 7 on the preseason National 100 and gave him a spot on the Preseason Best XI First Team.
- The Summit League has given preseason expectations for a different pair of returners: Jeremy Francou and Bryson Gosch. The pair were each Honorable Mention All-League players last

year and started in all four of the Roos' postseason matches.

- The Roos schedule will be sure to challenge, featuring five contests against preseason ranked opponents. After starting the year against No. 5 SMU and No. 24 Missouri State, KC will also play No. 10 San Diego, No. 4 Denver and No. 8 UMass.
- Last season, Kansas City established themselves as one of the best road teams in the nation, posting a 9-3-2 record away from home. That marked the most road wins in the NCAA last season and the most in program history.
- KC finished 2025 as one of just six teams in the NCAA with multiple top-12 RPI wins, taking down Missouri State twice and Denver twice.
- The Roos' offense was a standout last season, finishing the year top-five in the nation in goals per game (2.55, T3rd), assists per game (2.73, 5th) and points per game (7.82, 2nd).
- Kansas City carried a six-game streak of two-plus goals into the 2025 season, three away from tying a program record. KC was shut out just twice in 2024, ending the season with at least one goal in each of the last 16 games.
