Women's Soccer UMSL Hall of Famers

KEN HUDSON



INDUCTED: 2002

Ken Hudson was the first head coach of the women's soccer program at UMSL, guiding the team for 16 seasons. Hudson finished with a career record of 192-96-23, for a winning percentage of .654. Hudson led the team to a school record 16 wins on two occasions, in his first year in 1981 and again in his final season in 1996.

He had just one losing season during his career and eclipsed the 10-win mark in 14 of his 16 seasons. He guided UMSL to the AIAW tournament in 1981 and two straight NCAA Tournaments in 1982 and 1983, including a trip to the final four in the 1982 NCAA Tournament. That same season he was named Regional Coach of the Year by the NSCAA. Hudson coached 15 All-Americans, 55 all-region players and three Academic All-

JANGETTEMAYER-SANSONE



INDUCTED: 2001

Jan Gettemeyer-Sansone was a member of the school's first varsity team in 1981. She was a three-time All-American selection in 1981, 1982 and 1983, and was a four-time All-Region selection. Gettemeyer ranks first in assists in a season (18), second in career assists (28), second in career shots (259), third in points in a season (50), fourth in career goals (44) and fifth in career points (116).

JOAN GETTEMAYER



INDUCTED: 2001

Joan Gettemeyer was a starter on the team from 1981 to 1984. She finished her career with 121 points, which ranks third on the UMSL all-time scoring list. She is fourth in career goals scored with 47 and fourth in career assists with 27. Gettemeyer was a four-time all-region selection and was a three-time All-American. In 1984, she was selected as an Academic All-American for her accomplishments off the field.

LAURIE ALDY-KUCHNO



INDUCTED: 2002

Laurie Aldy-Kuchno was a two-sport athlete at UMSL in softball and soccer. She became the first female athlete in UMSL history to receive All-American honors, achieving that feat in softball during the 1987 season.

As a soccer player, Aldy-Kuchno was a first-team all-region selection in 1988. She ranks 10th in career goals with 26 and 10th in career points with 68 points on her 26 goals and 16 career assists.

KATHY CASSO



INDUCTED: 2005

Kathy Casso was a starter from 1984 to 1987. She was a second team all-region selection in 1986 and 1987 and was a third-team All-American selection in 1987 as well. She played in 72 games in her career, starting in 68. She scored five career goals and had seven career assists for a total of 17 career points.



STEPHANIE GABBERT

INDUCTED: 2005

Stephanie Gabbert played three years at UMSL. She scored 17 goals in her career, with 16 assists and 50 career points. She ranks 18th in career points and recorded six gamewinning goals. Gabbert was a three-time all-region selection in 1986, 1987 and 1988, and was an All-American selection in 1988. Gabbert served as head coach at Iowa, where she was named Big 10 Coach of the Year in 2000, and later coached at Iowa State. Currently, Gabbert is the Region II National Staff Coach for the U.S. Soccer Women's National Team.



JENNIFER (BURTON) ANDER-

INDUCTED: 2007

Jennifer (Burton) Anderson played for three years, earning all-region honors all three years and was named an All-American selection in 1995.

She is UMSL's all-time scoring leader with 151 career points on 65 goals and 21 assists. Her 65 career goals are a school record and she holds the school record with



CARRIE MARINO

INDUCTED: 2010

Carrie played five seasons at UMSL, from 1995-1999, and was a two-time all-Great Lakes Valley Conference honoree, earning first team honors as a freshman in 1996 and second team honors as a junior in 1998. She was also named to the first team all-central region team by the NCSAA in 1996. Carrie ranks second all-time at UMSL in scoring with 148 points, scoring 51 goals and recording 46 assists. She is the all-time leader in assists and ranks second in goals. Carrie also ranks fourth all-time in shots (215) and is tied for sixth in game-winning goals (12).

Women's Soccer UMSL Hall of Famers



BETH GOETZ

INDUCTED: 2014

Beth Goetz spent 11 seasons (1998-2007) as head coach of the UMSL women's soccer program, producing a 120-90-9 record, which included eight winning seasons. During her tenure, she led UMSL to 10 straight Great Lakes Valley Conference Tournaments, including an appearance in the 2007 championship game during her last season, where UMSL fell in penalty kicks to Drury, ending their season with a 12-7-3 mark. From 2000 to 2003, Goetz directed UMSL to the GLVC Tournament semifinals and twice appeared in the championship game (2000 and 2002).

Under Goetz's guidance, UMSL had 26 players earn all-conference recognition, including 10 players who were first team selections. Each of those 10 players were in her final six years on the sidelines. Goetz also coached eight all-region players. She was named the GLVC Co-Coach of the Year in 2000 after leading UMSL to a third place finish, four spots higher than the seventh place finish the year before.

Goetz served as interim coach in 1997 and was named the head coach in March 1998, becoming the second head coach in program history. She took over as interim coach after Ken Hudson, another UMSL Sports Hall of Fame member, resigned just prior to the start of the 1997 season. She had served as an assistant for Hudson during the 1996 campaign.



RUTH HARKER

INDUCTED: 2020

A four-time All-Region selection as goalkeeper, Harker remains the program's career leader in shutouts with 38. She also ranks third all-time in career goals-against average (0.75) and fourth in career saves (255). During the 1982 season, Harker recorded 12 shutouts, which still ranks as a single season record. She also owns the second most in a single season with 11 in 1985. Harker was a member of the 1982 women's soccer team, which were inducted into the UMSL Sports Hall of Fame in 2014.

1981 & 1982 TEAMS

INDUCTED: 2014

1981

Coached by Ken Hudson, UMSL's first intercollegiate women's soccer team burst onto the scene, dominating their competition by winning a school record 16 straight wins including a 15-game undefeated regular season in which they outscored their opponents 92 to 6. They finished with an overall record of 16-2. Included in their regular season schedule were victories over The University of Cincinnati and two wins over the University of Wisconsin. In the first-ever women's soccer national poll, UMSL ranked fifth and by the end of the regular season they ranked second behind the University of North Carolina. The team received a bid to participate in the Association of Intercollegiate Athletics for Women or AIAW national championship soccer tournament, where UMSL earned a first round bye before beating previously undefeated Texas A&M University, 2-1, in the second round. The team lost its semifinal game to the University of Central Florida and went on to finish fourth overall after falling in the consolation game to the University of Connecticut. The team produced five All-Region players and three All-Americans (Joan Gettemeyer – first team; Cindy Deibel – second team; Jan Gettemeyer – third team).

1982

Coached by Ken Hudson, UMSL finished with a 16-2-1 record in its first season as an NCAA team. They ranked as high as second in the national poll, finishing the year ranked fourth, and still hold the school record of a 17-game unbeaten streak. During regular season competition, UMSL defeated 1981 national champion the University of North Carolina, 2-1, at a tournament in Florida. The team received a bid to the NCAA Tournament, placing fourth. They defeated Harvard, 2-1, before North Carolina avenged its earlier season loss with a 2-1 victory. UMSL then lost a 2-1 decision to the University of Connecticut in the consolation game. The 1982 team had four players earn All-America honors, including Joan Gettemeyer, Jan Gettemeyer, Patty Kelley and Sue Richert.
