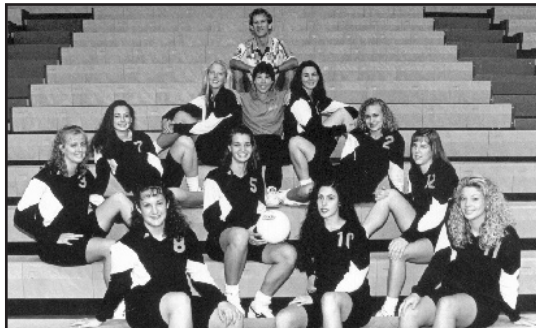
Postseason Teams

1991 - NCAA REGIONALS



For the first time in school history, the 1991 UMSL volleyball team advanced to the NCAA national tournament and earned a top-20 national ranking. Led by UMSL Sports Hall of Famer Sharon Kampwerth, the Tritons finished the year with a 39-11 record, the second most wins in a season in school history. UMSL had three All-MIAA selections in first team selection Kristen Burkemper and second team selections Wendy LaRose and Sharon Kampwerth. Pam Paule earned All-South Central Region honors as well.

1995 - NCAA REGIONALS



In their last season in the MIAA, the 1995 UMSL volleyball team went out with a bang, finishing with a 25-11 overall record and a 14-4 conference record. The team qualified for the NCAA national tournament for the second time in the school's history. UMSL had two players, Tricia Clendenen and Jeana Carrico, both named to the All-South Central Region team. In addition, three players earned all-conference honors as Clendenen was a first team selection, Debbie Boedefeld was a second team selection, and Sheri Grewe was an honorable mention selection.

2010 - NCAA REGIONALS



Following a 14-year absence from the NCAA field, the 2010 UMSL volleyball team returned to the national scene. Finishing with a 20-9 record and a 10-4 GLVC mark, the team also spent nine weeks in the AVCA Division II Coaches Poll, debuting September 13 at No. 25, marking the first national ranking for the program since 1993. UMSL reached a high ranking of No. 19. Four players earned all-GLVC honors, including Weslie Gaff, a first team all-Midwest Region honoree.

2019 - NCAA REGIONALS



An outstanding season was capped with a trip the NCAA Tournament in 2019. The Tritons finished one of the program's most successful seasons with a 29-5 record after beginning the year 12-0 for the first time ever. The 29 wins were the most since 1991. UMSL also advanced to the GLVC Tournament championship game for the first time in program history after going 12-3 in league play. Head Coach Ryan Young was named the GLVC Coach of the Year, while sophomore Megan Woll was tabbed as the Libero of the Year. Woll was one of three players to earn AVCA All-America honors.

2021 - NCAA REGIONALS



The Tritons advanced to the NCAA Tournament for the second time in three seasons as they finished the season with a 25-9 record and advanced to the GLVC Tournament Championship match for the second time in three years. The Tritons picked up their first ever NCAA Tournament win defeating Lewis in five sets at Ferris State. UMSL had four players earn All-GLVC honors including senior Charlotte Richards who was named GLVC Player of the Year for the second consecutive season. Seniors Kaileen Herman and Megan Woll were First Team All-GLVC picks while junior Mya Elliott landed on the All-GLVC Second Team.

2022 - NCAA CHAMPIONSHIPS



The Tritons advanced to the NCAA Tournament for the third time in four seasons as they finished the season with a 25-7 record and won a share of the GLVC Regular Season title. The Tritons won their first regional championship in program history rallying for a 3-2 win over Ferris State. The Tritons advanced to the Division II Fall Festival defeating second seeded Barry (Fla.) in the national quarterfinals before falling to third seeded West Texas A&M in the semifinals. Charlotte Richards was named the GLVC and AVCA Midwest Region Player of the Year and head coach Ryan Young was the GLVC and AVCA Midwest Region Coach of the Year.

Postseason Teams

2023 - NCAA CHAMPIONSHIPS



The 2023 season was one for the recordbooks as the Tritons won their first 30 matches to begin the season and finished with a record of 34-2 and achieved a number five ranking in the final AVCA Poll. The Tritons defended their Midwest Regional title on its home court defeating Ferris State 3-1 in a rematch of the 2022 regional championship match. The Tritons advanced to the Division II Championships and were second seeded. They defeated seventh seeded Anderson in the quarterfinal contest but lost to sixth seeded Cal State LA in the semifinals. Caitlin Bishop was named the GLVC and D2CAA Midwest Region Player of the Year and head coach Ryan Young was the GLVC and AVCA Midwest Region Coach of the Year.

2024 - NCAA REGIONALS



The Tritons tied a program record with their sixth straight winning season in 2024 and advanced to the NCAA Tournament for the fifth straight year. UMSL started off the season winning 15 of its first 17 matches. The season was highlighted by a five-set win over then No. 9 West Texas A&M at the Colorado Premiere Challenge and sweep of Drury in its final regular season match that saw them overcome eight set points to win the opening set. Alayna Santel was named the GLVC and AVCA Midwest Region Freshman of the Year while Caitlin Bishop garnered AVCA All-America honorable mention honors.

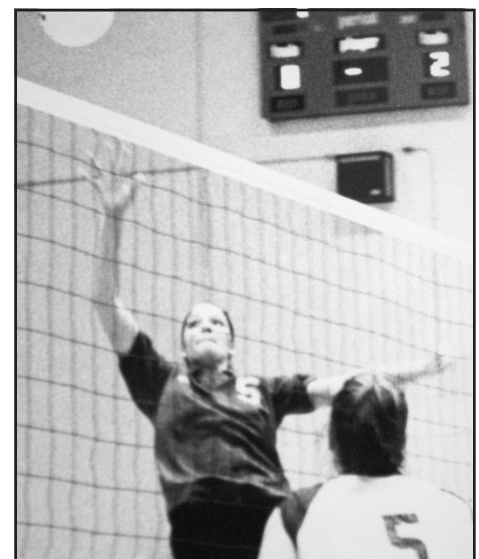

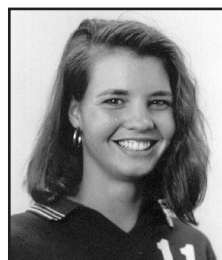

UMSL Sports Hall of Famers

JUDY BERRES



Judy Berres, one of the inaugural members of the UMSL Sports Hall of Fame, was instrumental in building the women's athletic programs at UMSL. She coached three of the four women's teams in 1974-75. Berres started the women's volleyball program and guided the team to a 74-21 record over its first three seasons. Berres was also the coach of the women's field hockey

team in 1974 that recorded the first ever win for an UMSL women's varsity team.

WESLIE GAFF SAWYER



The only player in program history to be named All-GLVC all four years, Sawyer left her mark on the Tritons program. She graduated ranking fourth all-time in career kills (1,140) and was also second in career hitting percentage (.331) and block solos (101), third in block assists (275) and fourth in total blocks (376). She earned First Team All-GLVC honors in each of her first three seasons and

was also an AVCA All-Midwest Region pick each of those years, including a first team honoree as a freshman and junior. As a freshman, Sawyer was tabbed the AVCA Midwest Region Freshman of the Year and the GLVC Freshman of the Year. As a junior, she helped lead the team to the NCAA Tournament, which was just the program's third.

SHARON KAMPWERTH



Sharon Kampwerth became the first volleyball player to be inducted into the UMSL Sports Hall of Fame in 2004. She was an all-conference selection in the MIAA in both seasons at UMSL, and was an all-region selection in 1992. She was named to the MIAA Academic All-Conference team and was a CoSIDA Academic All-District Second Team selection. In 1991, Kampwerth helped lead the

volleyball program to its first ever appearance in the NCAA Regionals.

DENISE SILVESTER



Denise Silvester is the longest-tenured volleyball coach in program history, serving on the sidelines from 1986-2003. She posted a career record of 403-250 (.617 winning percentage) and had 12 winning seasons in her 18 years. In her first season (1986), Silvester led UMSL to a 28-14 record and a second place finish in the MIAA after the team had gone 9-34 the

previous year. For her efforts, she was named the MIAA Coach of the Year. In her second season (1987), Silvester led UMSL to a 49-4 record, a program-best win total. In 1991, she directed the program to its first NCAA Tournament appearance along with its first-ever top-20 national ranking. They finished with a 29-11 record, the second-most wins in a season. Silvester also took the 1995 team to the NCAA Tournament during their last year in the MIAA.
