## TOP STORYLINES

## QUICK HITS

### LIONS PICKED 6TH & 7TH IN ASUN PRESEASON MEDIA AND COACHES POLL

University of North Alabama Women's Basketball were picked to finish 6th & 7th in the 2023 ASUN Preseason Media and Coaches poll, respectively. The Lions received 234 votes in the media poll, while UNA also received 72 votes in the coaches poll. Florida Gulf Coast was selected as the favorite to win the ASUN in both polls, receiving 142 total votes with 10 first place votes in coaches poll and 500 total votes with 38 first place votes in the media. Lipscomb and North Florida were the only two teams to receive first place votes, as the Bison received two first place votes in the coaches poll while the Ospreys received two first place votes in the media.

### TIBER ENTERING 11TH SEASON AT UNA

2023-24 will represent North Alabama head coach Missy Tiber's 11th season at the helm of the women's basketball program. Tiber turned in a 15-15 record in 2022-23, bringing her career record at UNA to 155-129 in her 10 seasons with the Lions.

### EXPERIENCE IS THE BEST TEACHER

The Lions return two starters from the 2022-23 season: Emma Kate Tittle and Alexis Callins. Tittle and Callins both picked up 13 starts last season, the most among any UNA returners for 2023-24. North Alabama also brings back five others with starting experience, including Ruth Balogun, Alyssa Clutter, Olivia Jones, Rhema Pegues and Cameron Jones.

### 2023-24 SCHEDULE FEATURES TWO SEC MATCHUPS

- They have 18 intercollegiate athletic programs.
- They began playing women's basketball in 1969 and have an all-time record of 699-781.
- This is the 20th official meeting between the two programs and first meeting in 21 years with the last meeting resulting in a 73-67 win for UT Martin on Jan. 23, 1992 at home. UNA leads the all-time series 14-5.
- In their last outing on the court, the Skyhawks were defeated at home by the South Dakota State at home by a score of 55-38 in the Kathleen and Tom Elam Center on Nov. 18.

## ROSTER MAKEUP

The Lions have 13 players on the 2023-24 roster, including eight returning lettermen and eight newcomers. Of this group, there are three freshmen, five sophomores, one junior and four seniors.

## SECOND IN ASUN VICTORIES SINCE 2018-2019

Since North Alabama made the jump to Division I in the 2018-19 season, the UNA Women's basketball program is second among all ASUN Schools in conference wins with 45. The Lions trail just FGCU with 79 wins in that time frame. The Lions are just ahead of Stetson (41) and North Florida (38).

## CURRY RANGE

The University of North Alabama women's basketball team can put up points in a hurry, as they finished the 2022-23 season ranked in the top 10 in both three-point attempts and three pointers per game among all Division I schools. The Lions were fifth in attempted three pointers with 28.0 per contest and sixth in made threes with 9.3 per game. UNA was second in the ASUN in both categories, trailing just FGCU in both.

## OPENING DAY MAGIC

With the game against Tennessee Southern, North Alabama will look to start a streak of three straight opening night wins. The Lions had season-opening wins against Blackburn College, 114-52, on Nov. 9, 2021 and Christian Brothers, 78-68, on Nov. 7, 2022. UNA has also been the victors of seven of its last eight home openers dating back to 2016.

## HOME SWEET HOME

The University of North Alabama women's basketball team boasted a 10-5 record in games played in Florence last season. The Lions put together a 5-1 record in non-conference play in CB&S Bank Arena and followed up with a 5-4 record in ASUN matches.

QUICK HITS

DOUBLE TROUBLE

Senior guard Sara Wohlgemuth displayed senior leadership on the big stage, earning her first career double-double against Missouri. Wohlgemuth finished with an 11-point, 10-assist performance against the Tigers, leading all players in assists and setting a new career high.

CALLINS COMES INTO FORM

Senior guard Alexis Callins scored a season-high in points against the Southern Miss Lady Eagles, finishing the game with 19 points on 7-12 shooting and hitting five of her nine attempted threes. In a week where she faced the SEC's Missouri (Nov. 14) and the Sun Belt's Southern Miss (Nov. 18), Callins averaged 14.5 points on the week.

SIEGEL STRIKES

The bright lights of Mizzou Arena did not faze freshman guard Chloe Siegel, who erupted for a team-high 15 points against the Tigers on Nov. 14. The Tuscumbia native scored all her points behind the arc, hitting five threes on 45 percent shooting and equalling the three-point total of Missouri's entire team.

# HEAD COACH

## MISSY TIBER



Melissa "Missy" Tiber enters her 11th season as head women's basketball coach at North Alabama. After becoming the program's eighth head coach in the summer of 2013, she owns a 155-129 record with the Lions.

With more than 20 years collegiate coaching experience, including 20 seasons as a collegiate head coach, Tiber owns a 341-285 career record. She won her 300th game on Feb. 3, 2020, with a 57-55 road win at NJIT. Earlier in the season, she won her 100th game at UNA with a record-breaking 128-26 home victory over Virginia-Lynchburg.

Tiber led North Alabama as the school began its transition to NCAA Division I basketball in the 2018-19 season as

a member of the ASUN Conference. The Lions posted a 21-9 record during its first Division I season, earning a No. 4 seed in the ASUN Tournament with a 10-6 league record after being picked to finish eighth in the preseason coaches' poll. The following season, the Lions posted a 21-9 mark, giving UNA three straight 20-win seasons for the first time in program history.

Following a successful debut at the Division I level, Tiber's second Division I team at UNA continued to reach new heights. Led by a senior class that won a school-record 85 games and included the top two scorers in program history, the Lions set 14 school records at the single-season and career levels. Ivy Wallen became the program's all-time leading scorer with 1,762 career points. Her sister, Emma, finished a close second with 1,640 points. Brittany Panetti also reached the 1,000-point club and finished her career with a program-record 113 blocked shots.

Tiber's 2017-18 season at UNA broke or tied five individual and four team school records, including the most regular season wins in school history. The team returned to the NCAA Division II tournament for the first time since 2013 and also cracked the NABC Top 25 Poll for the first time in 24 years.

Tiber came to UNA after serving as the head women's basketball coach at NCAA Division I Southern Illinois University from 2009-13. She also has 15 years of experience at the NCAA Division II level at West Liberty State College, Belmont Abbey College and Tusculum College.

From 2005-2009, Tiber was the head women's basketball coach at Tusculum where she took a program at the bottom of the South Atlantic Conference and compiled a record of 86-34 and a conference mark of 40-20. Over her last two seasons there, Tusculum was 52-11 overall and 26-4 in conference play, winning back-to-back conference championships and twice playing in the NCAA Tournament. The NCAA Tournament appearance (2008) was the first in school history. The team's first NCAA Tournament victory in 2009 was also a landmark for the Pioneer women's basketball program.

Prior to her time at Tusculum, Tiber spent four seasons as the head coach at NCAA DII Belmont Abbey College. During that time, her teams compiled an overall record of 81-36 and a conference mark of 61-19. Under her leadership the 2001-2002 team posted a 22-8 record, won the Carolinas Virginia Athletic Conference Regular Season Championship, the Carolinas Virginia Tournament Championship and advanced to participate in the NCAA Division II Tournament.

Tiber began her coaching career as an assistant women's basketball coach at her alma mater, West Liberty (W.V.) State College. During her six years

as an assistant, West Liberty was one of the most successful Division II basketball programs in the East Region. The Bears won four West Virginia Conference Tournament Championships, three West Virginia regular season championships and participated in four NCAA Division II Tournaments. West Liberty averaged over 20 wins per season during her time there.

During her coaching career, Tiber has coached numerous players who have received conference, regional and national awards, and every player that has exhausted their eligibility playing for her has gone on to earn their degree.

Tiber is a 1994 graduate of West Liberty State with a Bachelor of Science degree. She also has a Master's degree in Sport Leadership from Virginia Commonwealth University.

Tiber lives in Florence with her son, Ezekiel and daughter, Lola.

## ASSISTANT COACH: ADRIENNE HARLOW

Adrienne Harlow is in her 11th season as women's basketball associate head coach at North Alabama. She has 20 years of college coaching experience and came to UNA after serving with head coach Missy Tiber in coaching stops at Southern Illinois, Tusculum and Belmont Abbey. Harlow spent four seasons as assistant coach at Southern Illinois, including the final 15 games of the 2012-13 season as the team's interim head coach.

Prior to her time at SIU, Harlow was instrumental in a dramatic turnaround at Tusculum College, helping guide the Pioneers to four-consecutive winning campaigns, including back-to-back 26-win seasons and South Atlantic Conference Championships in 2007-08 and 2008-09.

At Belmont Abbey, she helped guide the Crusaders to an average of 20 wins per season, including the 2004-05 team's 22-8 record with an appearance in the Carolinas Virginia Athletic Conference (CVAC) Tournament championship game. Her first season at Belmont Abbey was a memorable one, as the Crusaders won 22 games and captured a share of the conference championship, en route to a CVAC Tournament title and a berth to the NCAA Division II East Regional. The Tip-ton, Ind., native played her collegiate career at West Liberty State College, where she was a three-time All-West Virginia Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (WVIAAC) standout. Harlow was also the NCAA Division II National Statistical Champion in assists per game twice in her career. She averaged 8.0 assists per game in 1999-2000 and averaged 8.5 per game the following season. Her 843 career assists are third all-time at West Liberty and fifth most in NCAA Division II history.

Harlow led the Hilltoppers to a pair of WVIAAC Championships, three WVIAAC Tournament titles and three NCAA Div. II Tournament berths. She was also a three-time WVIAAC All-Tournament and Second-Team NCAA All-East Region selection. In 2001, she was also selected to the Daktronics All-East Region squad and earned the WVIAAC Tournament Heart and Hustle Award. Harlow ended her career with 1,005 points, 405 rebounds and finished third in program history with 185 steals and fourth in free throw percentage (74.1 percent). She was also the East Region Scholar Athlete of the Year. In 2006, Harlow was named to the West Liberty State College Sports Hall of Fame. In March 2007, Harlow was named one of the top 25 women's basketball players in the history of the West Virginia Intercollegiate Athletic Conference.

Harlow earned a bachelor's degree in 2001 from West Liberty with a specialization in administrative mathematics. She is a certified strength and conditioning specialist and founder of Hoops



## ASSISTANT COACH: JOSH ASHLEY

Josh Ashley enters his seventh season as assistant women's basketball coach at North Alabama. He came to UNA after spending two seasons as an assistant coach at West Texas A&M, where he helped lead the Lady Buffs to an appearance in the NCAA Division II Elite Eight.

While at WTAMU, Ashley helped with recruiting and scouting reports as the Lady Buffs won a conference championship in the 2015-16 season before winning the NCAA South Central Region title the following year.

Ashley was also an assistant coach at Eastern Oklahoma State College in August 2012 and helped lead the Lady Mountaineers to a 21-12 record in the 2014-15 campaign.

From 2010-12, he spent two seasons as the men's basketball graduate assistant at Angelo State, where he helped with on-the-floor recruiting and administrative duties. He also assisted the men's basketball strength and conditioning program. He earned his master's degree in coaching, sports recreation and fitness administration in August of 2012.

Ashley graduated from Tarleton State with a bachelor's degree in exercise and sports studies in December of 2008. While at TSU, he interned with the strength and conditioning program and worked with track and field, basketball, baseball and football.



## ASSISTANT COACH: KENYSHA COULSON

Former UNA player Kenysha Coulson enters her first year as an assistant coach after her promotion on September 12, 2023.

Coulson joined the staff as a graduate assistant following her playing career for both the 2020-21 and 2021-22 seasons. For the 2022-2023 season, she served as the Director of Operations and now takes on a full-time assistant coaching role.

Lettering from 2017-20, Coulson was a part of a senior class that won more games than any group in program history. The three-year letterman played in 82 games with 60 starts during her career. She scored 648 points, pulled down 458 rebounds and dished out 232 assists.

The Huntsville, Ala. native began her college career at Lawson State Community College before transferring to North Alabama as a sophomore in 2017-18. In three seasons with the Lions, Coulson had the unique experience of playing with the Lions in the last season of Division II play and two years into the university's transition to the full Division I level.

She graduated from UNA in 2020 with a degree in exercise physiology and received her master's degree in sports management in 2022.
