OPENING TIP

Last Time Out

North Alabama led its opponent wire-to-wire for the third straight game, shutting down a high-powered North Florida offense for an 83-70 win inside CB&S Bank Arena. All five UNA starters scored in double figures, led by junior Jacari Lane with 21 points and double-doubles from senior Taye Fields and redshirt sophomore Corneilous Williams. UNA outrebounded UNF by a 53-30 margin and held the Ospreys to their third-lowest scoring total of the season.

Triple Threat

North Alabama and Jacksonville enter Saturday in a three-way tie for first place in the ASUN with Lipscomb at 10-3. Queens, FGCU and ECU are one game back of the leaders at 9-4.

A Trio of Greatness

For the first time since 1971 and for just the second time ever, UNA has three players with over 1,000 career points as a Lion on the same team. The 1971 group included Larry Smith, Don Faint and Tommy Ledbetter. This year's group includes Jacari Lane, Will Soucie and Daniel Ortiz.

Seven Years In The Making

UNA enters its seventh season of Division I basketball — all of which have been coached by Tony Pujol. In the last three seasons, UNA has enjoyed its most success with a combined record of 51-40. The Lions are 10-3 in conference play for the first time since 2013 as members of the Gulf South Conference. UNA also has 18 wins and 10 ASUN wins to match the most wins in a single season at the Division I level, both set in 2022-23 at 18-15 overall and 10-8 in the ASUN.

Players To Watch

UNA returns six lettermen from last season, anchored by fifth-year senior Will Soucie and junior first team all-conference guard Jacari Lane. Five Lions average double figures, led by Lane with 16.1 PPG. Senior Daniel Ortiz is the primary three-point threat at 11.8 PPG with 76 made three-pointers. Soucie is averaging 12.1 PPG, while jack-of-all-trades Taye Fields stuffs the stat-sheet with 10.7 PPG and 8.9 RPG. Redshirt sophomore Corneilous Williams averages 9.8 PPG and 9.0 RPG. Williams and Fields are first and second in the ASUN in rebounding, respectively.

About The Series

The Lions are 6-4 against Jacksonville, all since 2019. The Dolphins have won three of the last four games, including a 64-60 win just under a month ago on Jan. 16 inside Swisher Gym. However, UNA won the last meeting in Florence with an 80-62 win in 2023. UNA is 5-1 when playing JU at home.

Last Meeting Recap

UNA and Jacksonville traded the lead 17 times in the last meeting on January 16, as Jacksonville proved to be too tough on its home court with a 64-60 win. Down 62-59 in the final seconds, UNA had a chance to tie as sure-handed shooter Will Soucie went to the line for three. He missed the first and the Lions were unable to get a putback on the final attempt.

Notable Lions vs. Jacksonville

Will Soucie has played Jacksonville seven times in his career, including 10 points last meeting.

Senior Daniel Ortiz is averaging 14.0 PPG over three games against JU, while junior Jacari Lane is averaging 13.0 PPG in the same amount of meetings.

High-Ranked Opponents

UNA and JU are two of the top three ASUN teams in the NET, Massey and KenPom Rankings. UNA is second to Lipscomb in all three rankings, while JU is third behind UNA.

Jacksonville At A Glance

The Dolphins are 16-9 overall and 10-3 in conference play, riding a three-game win streak with wins over Stetson, Bellarmine and Central Arkansas. ASUN Preseason Player of the Year Robert McCray V leads with 16.5 PPG. JU is the top three-point shooting team in the ASUN percentage-wise at 36.5 percent. JU is also second in blocks with 4.6 per game.

Lineup Notes

- UNA has deployed the same starters for 21 straight games (Lane, Ortiz, Soucie, Fields, Williams)
- Generally, at least two of these three players are on the floor together at all times this season — Lane, Fields or Williams
- First team All-ASUN selection Jacari Lane was the only player to start every game for UNA last season
- Will Soucie started 52 straight games dating back to the final six games of 2022 before missing the Texas Tech start
 - Soucie has started every game since then and has 98 career starts
- 2 of 5 starters return in 2024-25

The Lions have 15 players on the 2024-25 roster, including six returning lettermen and nine newcomers. Of this group, there are four freshmen, two sophomores, four juniors and five seniors.

Ball Protection

UNA has the 5th fewest turnovers per game in the NCAA with just 9.2 per game. Only 23 teams of 364 in the NCAA can claim fewer than 10 turnovers per game. The only teams ahead of UNA are Marquette, Purdue Fort Wayne, Ole Miss and Houston.

Junior guard Jacari Lane was named to the Lou Henson Award Early Watch List on November 19, which is an award presented annually to the top player in Mid-Major College Basketball. He is leading the team with 16.1 PPG and ranks 2nd in the ASUN with 5.2 APG in ASUN play.

In Memoriam - Leo and Una

For decades, The University of North Alabama boasted the only live Lion mascot in the country living on a college campus.

Leo III, born on November 18, 2002 resided on the UNA campus in the 12,764 square-foot George H. Carroll Lion Habitat to carry on a tradition that has covered more than 40 years until his passing on May 3, 2024. His sister Una, passed away in 2021 after also serving as a mascot at UNA since 2002.

On July 22, 1974, former UNA president Dr. Robert M. Guillot brought a 35-pound lion cub to the campus and Leo spent the next 14 years "roaring" the school to victory. The original Leo died on Jan. 20, 1988, and a great outpouring of support from the Shoals community resulted in Leo II being brought to UNA in July of 1988. Leo II lived in the compound that once housed the original Leo and grew to a weight of more than 600 pounds at eleven years of age. In 1997, Leo II was selected as the nation's "Second Best Mascot" by Sports Illustrated. He died in February of 2000.

In 2012 Leo III and UNA were ranked No. 1 of the 25 Best Real Animal Mascots in College Football by totalprosports.com. UNA was the only non-Division I institution to make the list, joining the company of competitive NCAA teams such as the Baylor Bears, LSU Tigers and Texas Longhorns.

All funds associated with the care and feeding of Leo III, the operation of his habitat, and the conduct of a related educational program were funded exclusively by charitable contributions.

First Half Double-Double

Taye Fields achieved a double-double within 14 minutes of the game against Stetson, grabbing his 10th rebound and then scoring his 11th point at the 6:18 mark of the first half. He finished with 23 points, 17 rebounds, 4 assists, 3 steals, 1 block and 0 turnovers. The only other player to reach double-double totals within 15 minutes is Johni Broome of Auburn vs. Ohio State.

100 and 1000

Senior Taye Fields accomplished a rare feat against Charleston Southern in December, as he scored his 1,000th career point in his 100th career game. Fields is a transfer from Division II Missouri Western, where he was a two-time all-conference selection.

Taye Fields in Interesting Company

Taye Fields isn't the only player to score his 1,000th career point in his 100th career game this season. On November 25, Iowa State senior guard Curtis Jones accomplished the exact same feat against Auburn in Maui. This came one game after UNA played Auburn.

More 100/1000 Facts

Outside of Taye Fields and Curtis Jones, there are no other known players this season to score their 1,000th point in their 100th game. However, a current NCAA coach accomplished this as Richmond's Chris Mooney did this while playing at Princeton in 1994.

Back And Forth We Go

Last season, UNA played 16 conference games and experienced 88 lead changes to average 5.5 per game. In 12 conference games this season, UNA has only had 48 lead changes to average under 4.0 per game. In the last three games, UNA led wire-to-wire without trailing.

Career Guy

Fifth-year senior Will Soucie is the all-time record holder for career-games at UNA, passing Casey Holt this season who played 123 games from 2003-08. Soucie is one of three Lions to play over 100 Division I games at UNA, while current teammate Dallas Howell is two away.

100 Double Digit Scoring Efforts

Over 26 games, UNA has had 100 occasions this season of a player scoring double figures. This averages out to roughly four players per game. Lane leads the clubhouse with 22 games in double figures, followed by Ortiz and Soucie with 17 apiece. Nine Lions have accomplished this at least twice.

Rebound Kings

UNA has had a player finish top-four in the ASUN in rebounding in five of the first six years in the league.

In year seven, UNA has the top two rebounders in the conference in Taye Fields (8.9 RPG) and Cornelious Williams (9.0 RPG). This marks the second time UNA has had two players in the top-five, with Emmanuel Littles leading the league with 9.9 RPG in 2020-21, while Mervin James finished 4th at 7.2 RPG.

Only one other school in the last seven years has had two players finish top-five in rebounding — ECU in 2022-23 when Isaiah Cozart finished tied for first in the league with 7.5 rebounds and Michael Morena finished fifth at 6.5.

High Volume Shooter

Senior Daniel Ortiz is the primary three-point threat for the Lions, ranking 3rd in the nation with 243 three-point attempts. He also ranks 15th in the NCAA with 80 made three-pointers, shooting 32.9%.

Pujol Continues Program Growth

UNA head coach Tony Pujol enters his seventh season at the helm, serving as the first and only coach of UNA's Division I era. Pujol has 95 wins over seven seasons and received a contract extension this past October through 2027 with an option to extend beyond 2027.

Depth Pieces

UNA has had nine different players score double figures in multiple games. Five players are averaging double figures, while eight Lions are above 6.3 PPG.

Lions Have Best Offensive Season of D1 Era

In the 2022-23 season, UNA averaged 74.1 points per game. The Lions also shot 45.8% from the field, a total that hasn't been topped since the 2009-10 season. All of those were Division I era bests.

In the 2023-24 season, UNA topped that scoring with a new DI school record of 76.5 PPG. UNA is on pace to top this record again this season.

New Heights

North Alabama currently has a 122 NET ranking and a 117 KenPom ranking. Both are the highest rankings in program history.

The Lions finished #253 in the NET last season.

The Lions had eight "sub-200" NET teams on the schedule last year. There are currently nine this week. The win over Lipscomb (77) is the best win this season.

Head Coach

Tony Pujol



Tony Pujol enters his seventh season as men's basketball head coach at North Alabama in 2024-25.

The former assistant coach at the University of Wyoming was hired at UNA on April 2, 2018 and has nearly two decades of collegiate coaching experience.

In 2022-23, Pujol led the Lions to their highest win total since 2013-14 with an 18-15 record. The Lions also competed in their first NCAA Division I postseason game with an appearance in the CBI Tournament in Florida. He followed that with a 15-17 record in 2023-24 against a tougher schedule with four Power Four opponents, but led the Lions to the ASUN Semifinal Round after

a thrilling tournament win over Lipscomb at the buzzer. The buzzer shot made by KJ Johnson officially started March Madness, made national headlines and was the top play on SportsCenter and Scott Van Pelt's "Best Thing I Saw Today."

In seven seasons at North Alabama, Pujol has led the Lions to the ASUN Conference Tournament every year, including a berth in the championship game in 2021 and a semifinal run in 2024. During his tenure, UNA has had 12 all-conference selections, including five on the league's All-Freshman Team and two All-Academic picks.

Pujol led North Alabama through its transition to NCAA Division I basketball. Since making the move, which included membership in the ASUN Conference at the start of the 2018-19 season, UNA improved its record each of the first three years. The Lions posted a 10-22 record during their first Division I season, earning a No. 6 seed in the ASUN Tournament with a 7-9 league record after being picked to finish last in the preseason coaches poll. Pujol followed with a three-win improvement in the second year and a No. 5 seed in the conference tourney. Mervin James was also named to the ASUN All-Freshman Team.

In the 2020-21 campaign, North Alabama secured its first winning record at the Division I level, posting a 13-10 mark that included a postseason run. After earning a No. 5 seed, UNA won consecutive ASUN tournament games, knocking off North Florida 68-60 and FGCU 96-81 to earn a spot in the championship against top-seeded Liberty. The Lions held a late lead before falling 79-75.

Payton Youngblood and James earned all-tournament honors. Youngblood later added ASUN All-Academic and CoSIDA Academic All-District honors to his resume while James was a second team all-conference pick. Detalian Brown was also named to the league's All-Freshman Team.

UNA had several standout performances during its inaugural Division I season, including Jamari Blackmon being named the ASUN Freshman of the Year and Christian Agnew also being named to the league's All-Freshman team. Under Pujol, UNA secured the program's first-ever Division I victory with a 72-59 home win over Blue Mountain on Nov. 10, at Flowers Hall. On Jan. 8, Florida Gulf Coast became the first Division I opponent to fall. The 61-56 home victory over FGCU also represented the Lions' first-ever win in ASUN Conference play.

A road game against seventh-ranked Gonzaga, the renewal of the home-and-home rivalry series with Jacksonville State and a No. 2 finish on ESPN's SportsCenter Top 10 Plays were among the other first-season highlights for Pujol and the UNA program.

Pujol also served as an assistant basketball coach at Appalachian State University, Virginia Commonwealth University and the University of Alabama before taking a position at Wyoming in 2016. He became just the

seventh head coach in the 88-year history of the UNA's men's basketball program.

Pujol helped lead Wyoming to a 20-13 record in 2017-18. In 2016-17, Pujol helped lead the Cowboys to the College Basketball Invitational Championship. The Cowboys finished the season 23-15 overall with a 19-3 home record. Pujol helped mentor Mountain West Sixth Man Justin James, as he also was named the Most Valuable Player of the CBI. Junior Forward Hayden Dalton also received Honorable-Mention All-Mountain West honors. The Cowboys set a school and MW record with 369 three-pointers last season.

Pujol coached collegiately at Alabama for five seasons from 2010-2014 under head coach Anthony Grant. Pujol helped the Crimson Tide compile a 99-71 record during his time on the staff, including three-straight 20-win seasons for the first time since 1990-92. Alabama earned two NIT bids and one NCAA bid from 2011-13 and finished runner-up in the NIT in 2011. That 2010-11 Crimson Tide team featured one of the toughest defenses in the nation, as Alabama surrendered only 59.4 points per game, the eighth-lowest average in the nation. Alabama's tenacious defense helped it go 19-0 at home during that season.

On the recruiting trail, he helped the Tide land a 2011 recruiting class that Rivals.com ranked as the fifth best in the nation with four prospects ranked in the top 100 nationally. After the 2013-14 season, Pujol stepped away from collegiate coaching to dedicated more time to his family and has coached the last year and a half in the AAU ranks in New Jersey.

Previously, Pujol served under Grant at VCU from 2006-09 with Edwards. The staff guided the Rams to a 76-25 record in those three seasons, including 45-9 in the Colonial Athletic Association. VCU won three conference regular-season titles and two tournament titles in that span to play in the NCAA tournament twice and NIT once. Two Rams from that team, Eric Maynor and Larry Sanders, would go on to be selected in the NBA draft.

Prior to his collegiate career, Pujol was a high school coach in south Florida for 13 seasons, including nine at Northwest Christian Academy in Miami, where he posted a 250-46 record with state titles in 1999, 2003 and 2004.

He graduated from Sterling College (Kansas) in 1989 with a degree in business administration and was a standout in both basketball and baseball, earning all-conference honors on the diamond in his final three seasons.

Tony and his wife, Mayle, have three daughters, Kasey, Kristen and Mia.

Ahmad Smith was elevated to Associate Head Basketball Coach at UNA in March of 2023. He is in his seventh season on the North Alabama staff, having previously served as an assistant coach. Prior to coming to UNA, he served as Associate Head Coach and Recruiting Coordinator at Charleston Southern. In four seasons at North Alabama, Smith has helped the Lions reach the ASUN Conference Tournament each year, including a berth in the championship game in 2021. During his tenure, UNA has had six all-conference selections, including five on the league's All-Freshman Team and one All-Academic pick. While working with the team post players, Smith has also coached the ASUN's leading rebounder in the 2019-20 and 2020-21 campaigns. He was also invited to participate in the 2019 TopConnect Virtual Seminar, which identifies the top basketball assistant coaches in the country. Smith, a 2004 Appalachian State graduate, was an integral part of one of the best stretches in Charleston Southern history as an assistant coach during his seven years on staff. A former player and coach at Appalachian State, Smith helped CSU go 19-12 in 2011-12 and the Buccaneers won their first Big South Tournament game since 2006. CSU again ranked among the Big South's best rebounding teams in 2013-14, tallying a nearly +3.0 margin on the glass. Smith was promoted to the role of Assistant Head Coach/Recruiting Coordinator at Charleston Southern in August of 2015. Smith returned to college coaching after spending three years in several capacities, including that of head coach, in Ireland. Before leaving for Ireland, Smith was an assistant coach at Appalachian State University from 2004-08.

After spending one season as director of player development for the Lions, Carter Heston was promoted to assistant coach in June of 2022. During his year as director of player development, Heston was responsible for scouting, player development and academic management. Prior to his arrival in Florence, Heston served as an assistant coach at Texas A&M University-Texarkana. While there, he helped lead the Eagles to an 11-4 season, their first national ranking, and a berth in the 2020 NAIA national tournament. In addition, Heston has extended experience with NBA Player Development. He worked for Philadelphia Sixers consultant and longtime NBA trainer Phil Beckner. During this experience, he trained multiple NBA players, including Jeremiah Robinson-Earl, McKinley Wright and Darius Bazley. In the summer of 2021, Heston worked with Beyond Sports Management and Dig Deep Basketball, helping prepare current NBA players Jae'Sean Tate and Isaiah Hartenstein for their seasons. He also worked with multiple players during their NBA pre-draft process. Originally from Milwaukee, Wisc., Heston has additional experience coaching camps in southeast Wisconsin. In addition, he trained multiple college players at the Division I and Division II levels. Heston graduated from the University of Alabama in 2020 with a Degree in finance with a specialization in real estate.

Austin Burnette enters his second season as an assistant coach with UNA Men's Basketball. Burnette joined the Lions after serving as the Director of Player Development/Video Coordinator at Florida International University during the 2022-2023 season. He organized and oversaw player personnel schedules, assisted with travel logistics, supervision of graduate assistants/student managers, provided academic support, coordinated with compliance, led scouting reports and film edits/exchanges during his time at FIU. Before FIU, Burnette was an Assistant Coach of the premier prep school, Hargrave Military Academy. The Tigers finished with a record of 37-5, while finishing ranked #4 nationally amongst all Prep schools. Burnette was no stranger to Hargrave as he returned after winning the 2016 National Championship as a player. Prior to Hargrave Military Academy, Burnette served as a Graduate Assistant at Florida International University under head coach Jeremy Ballard. As a graduate assistant at FIU, he was responsible for game and scouting preparation, oversaw undergraduate managers and assisted in player development. Burnette's previous coaching experience also includes a stint at University of North Georgia (19-20) as an assistant coach. Burnette played collegiately at Campbell University. He finished his career as a 2019 Big South Regular Season Champion and 2018 Jamaica Classic Champion. Only five wings grade above an 80 overall, including Fields (North Alabama), Collin Murray-Boyles (South Carolina), Eric Dailey Jr. (UCLA), Joshua Jefferson (Iowa State) and Michael Rataj (Oregon State).

Two Milestones in One Night

Taye Fields, a former all-conference performer at the Division II level at Missouri Western State, played his 100th career game and scored his 1,000th career point in the same night against Charleston Southern.

Reunited, And It Feels So Good

Taye Fields played high school ball at Lee High School in Huntsville and was a teammate of current UNA standout Jacari Lane. Fields was a two-time ASWA All-State Player in 2020 and 2021, while Lane did it in 2022.

Mo-West Connection

Taye Fields will go down as one of the best players in school history at his last stop, Missouri Western (Division II), where he was an all-conference selection in 2024. 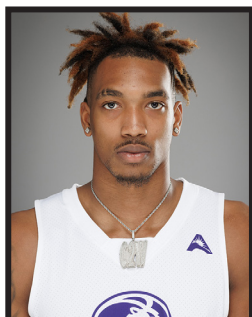
