


Carolina Crossword presented by Lowes Foods

- First Tar Heel basket in Smith Center scored by this big man. (**martin**)
- Women's basketball's opponent in the 1994 NCAA Championship (**louisiana tech**)
- Played tackle for the Redskins, later was first director of the Rams Club. (**ernie**)
- Only Tar Heel to earn All-Final Four honors in two seasons (**berry**)
- Wrestling move resulting in two points (**takedown**)
- Only Tar Heel to earn regional MVP honors as a non-starter (**luke maye**)
- Interim coach for Tar Heels in 1998 Gator Bowl, later named head coach. (**torbush**)
- Only MBB honored jersey currently on Tar Heel staff (**may**)
