

TAR HEEL TIDBITS

Sunday's Match at #12 Alabama

- This will be UNC's fourth top-12 matchup this season, as the team faced No. 10 Penn State, No. 8 Arkansas and No. 10 South Carolina.
- Sunday will also be Carolina's third straight game against an SEC opponent.
 - » In the SEC Preseason Coaches Poll: Arkansas was No. 1, Alabama was No. 2 and South Carolina was No. 3.
- Sunday will be the third road game for the Tar Heels this year. After opening their season at Penn State, they played five straight home games.
- This will be just the third meeting between North Carolina and Alabama in program history.
- North Carolina leads the series at 2-0, out-scoring the Crimson Tide 14-0 all-time.
 - » UNC went on to win the NCAA title both years they played UA in the regular season.
 - » UNC also won the AIAW title in 1981 when they played Alabama Club Team.
 - The last meeting between the two teams was Oct. 3, 1997, in Durham, N.C.
 - » That contest was win No. 400 for head coach Anson Dorrance.
 - » Dorrance has since gone on to win 526 more games (and eight more national titles) in the 9,473 days since the last time the two teams played each other.

Last Time Out

- No. 3 North Carolina posted a 2-1 win over No. 10 South Carolina on Sept. 7 in Columbia.
 - » Avery Patterson scored first in the fifth minute.
 - » Tori Dellaperuta scored the eventual game-winner in the 35th minute.
 - » It was the third goal of the season for both Patterson and Dellaperuta.
- Carolina's back line limited South Carolina to eight shots the entire contest.
 - » It was the fewest shots the Gamecocks had taken all season.
 - » The Tar Heels have held all seven of their opponents so far to under 10 shots: No. 10 Penn State (5), Cal (2), Wisconsin (1), No. 24 USC (5), Gardner-Webb (1), No. 8 Arkansas (10) and No. 10 South Carolina (8).
 - » South Carolina was averaging 20.3 shots per game prior to this game.
- The Tar Heels have only conceded three goals this season, including a 369 minute stretch spanning five games without giving up a goal.

Miscellaneous

- UNC owns half of the ACC's weekly awards so far this season, and all of the defensive honors.
 - » Freshman Savy King was named the ACC Defensive Player of the Week on Aug. 22 after week one.
 - » Senior Sam Meza was named the ACC Defensive Player of the Week on Aug. 29 after week two.
 - » King earned her second ACC Defensive Player of the Week honor on Sept. 5, her second weekly award in her third week of college soccer.
- As elected by the team, this year's captains include Maycee Bell, Talia Dellaperuta, Kai Hayes and Avery Patterson.
 - » Bell was also voted team captain in 2022.
 - » Hayes serves as the team liaison with Team IMPACT. UNC's Team IMPACT teammate is Julia, who joined the Tar Heels in January 2023.
- The national runner-up in 2022, North Carolina checked in at No. 3 in the United Soccer Coaches poll on Sept. 5 after three weeks of play.
 - » Ranked No. 2 in the preseason poll, UNC has been in the top-4 all season.
 - » Sam Meza earned a spot on the United Soccer Coaches Midfielders to Watch list while Avery Patterson was named a forward to watch during preseason.
- The conference runner-up a season ago, UNC was picked first in the ACC preseason coaches poll with 10 first-place votes and 166 points.

Chasing 23 in '23 ... "Chasing 23 in '23." That's the motto in 2023 for the University of North Carolina women's soccer program. The Tar Heels are seeking their 23rd national title (they currently have 21 NCAA, one AIAW) in program history, all under head coach Anson Dorrance. The number 23 is legendary at UNC, especially in 2023 – dubbed the "Jordan Year" as a tribute to UNC basketball legend and NBA Hall of Famer Michael Jordan.

A national championship this season would be all the more meaningful for the Tar Heels, who came within 16 seconds of clinching No. 23 last season. The most dominant women's soccer program in history, the Tar Heels own 21 of the NCAA's 41 titles since the event's inception in 1982. UNC's last national crown came in 2012.

Shoot Your Shot, Or Not ... Through the first seven games of the 2023 season, North Carolina has allowed its opponents a combined 32 shots, for an average of just 4.6 shots allowed per game. The Tar Heels' defense has also held all opponents to 10 shots or fewer: #10 Penn State (5), Cal (2), Wisconsin (1), #24 Southern Cal (5), Gardner-Webb (1), #8 Arkansas (10) and #10 South Carolina (8).

Furthermore, UNC's stalwart defense -

anchored by regular starters Maycee Bell, Emerson Elgin, Savy King and Emily Moxley – has typically prevented their opponent from shooting until late in the game. UNC's back line did not allow a Cal shot until the 85th minute. The Tar Heels also prevented Gardner-Webb from taking a shot until the 72nd minute, Wisconsin until the 61st minute, USC until the 52nd minute and Penn State until the 38th minute.

Wisconsin, #24 USC and Gardner-Webb were held shotless in the opening half in three straight contests. UNC had not allowed a goal in 369 minutes between the 14' on Aug. 20 vs. Cal to 23' on Sept. 3 vs. #8 Arkansas.

Carolina's defense has also limited SEC powerhouses: Arkansas had been averaging 4.25 goals/game heading into the contest, but could only break through to score once. South Carolina averaged 20.3 shots per game before the Tar Heels came to town (and 9.3 on goal) but could only attempt eight (and two on goal).

Further proving its defensive prowess, UNC owns all of the ACC's Defensive Player of the Week awards this season: Savy King (Aug. 22, Sept. 5) and Sam Meza (Aug. 29).



time making a name for herself, as the freshman was named the ACC Defensive Player of the Week on Aug. 22 after opening weekend. She became the first true UNC freshman to earn a league weekly honor since fellow defender Maycee Bell in 2019.

She then earned her second weekly award in her third week of collegiate soccer on Sept. 5, as UNC has gone 3-for-3 for ACC Defensive Player of the Week honors to start the season.

Starting at center back, King leads the team with 586 minutes and has logged a full 90 in five of seven matches. She has anchored UNC's rock-solid back line that has conceded only three goals and limits opponents to an average of under five shots per game.

Head coach Anson Dorrance had high praise for the rookie after her UNC debut: "Savy King had one of the best first game performances by a freshman in the history of our program." Dorrance also described King as "an uber-competitive athlete" and stated that she "continues to be the final bastion of the UNC defense...and she is an absolute magnificent defender."

Meza in the Middle ... A Third Team All-America in 2022, midfielder Sam Meza is picking up right where she left off. The senior was named the ACC Defensive Player of the Week on Aug. 29. It was the second ACC defensive weekly honor bestowed on her in her career, as she also received the award on Sept. 13, 2022.

A native of Dallas, Texas, Meza has anchored Carolina's midfield unit that has made it difficult for the opposing team to create any feasible scoring opportunities, let alone even cross into their attacking third.

With Meza on the pitch, UNC has limited their opponents to eight shots or fewer: #10 Penn State (5), Cal (2), Wisconsin (1), #24 Southern California (5) and #10 South Carolina (8). Meza was unavailable for Gardner-Webb and #8 Arkansas.

Largely in part due to Meza's efforts in midfield, Carolina held both Wisconsin and USC shotless during the first half in back-toback games. (UNC also held Gardner-Webb shotless during the first half, but Meza did not play in that contest).

The Badgers were only able to take one shot

the entire game, while the Trojans - which were coming off a 3-1 win over No. 4 Duke just three days prior - could only break through to attempt five.

Brace Yourself ... Six current Tar Heels have at least one brace in their UNC career:

Evelyn Shores is the first, and only. Tar Heel to record a brace so far this season. She achieved the feat in her second career appearance vs. #24 USC on Aug. 27, during just 27 minutes on the pitch. Her goals game in the 66th and 69th minutes.

No current player on UNC's roster has recorded a hat trick yet. The last UNC hat trick came on March 27, 2021, from both Ruby Grant and Brianna Pinto.


Sister, Sister ... North Carolina has a pair of sisters on the team in Talia Dellaperuta (senior co-captain) and Tori Dellaperuta (sophomore) from Cumming, Ga.

Both sisters scored against Gardner-Webb on Aug. 31. As of Sept. 5, they join Colorado's Faith and Hope Leyba (twin freshmen), as well as Purdue's Nicole and Victoria Kevdzija (twin seniors), as the only set of sisters in Division I who have scored in the same contest.

The Dellaperutas are also one of five sets of sisters in the ACC: Dani and Ally Lynch of Clemson; Delaney and Mackenzie Evers of Pitt; Brooklyn and Brianna Holt of NC State; and Nadia and Olivia DeMarinis of Wake Forest.

Fierce Freshmen ... The top-ranked class according to Top Drawer Soccer – with six of the seven ranked in the top 25 - Carolina's freshman class impressed from the get-go.

Ten different Tar Heels have scored so far this season, including four rookies: Mia Oliaro (1), Melina Rebimbas (2), Evelyn Shores (2) and Olivia Thomas (1). Six of UNC's 17 total goals have been scored by freshmen.

Defender Savy King has twice been named the ACC Defensive Player of the Week. UNC's starting center back, she leads the team in minutes. King, Shores and Thomas have all earned at least one start, while six of the seven rookies have seen the pitch.

Preseason Praise ... North Carolina was picked to finish first in the ACC Preseason Coaches poll, topping the rankings with 166 points and 10 first-place votes. Florida State garnered 146 points and two first-place nods to be chosen second, followed by Virginia (139), Notre Dame (134) and Duke (126). The Cavaliers and Blue Devils both received one first-place bid.

Maycee Bell, Sam Meza and Ally Sentnor were all selected to the Preseason All-ACC

Team, as voted on by the league coaches. UNC's three picks are the most of any school in the conference.

Meza was named to the United Soccer Coaches Midfielders to Watch list, while Avery Patterson was named to the Forwards to Watch List. Additionally, Meza was one of 56 players in Division I tabbed to the prestigious MAC Hermann Trophy Watch List.

Wealth of Experience ... Of the 11 starters in the 2022 national championship game, nine have returned in 2023 – the most returners of any of the four teams (Alabama, Florida State, UCLA) in the College Cup.

Three Tar Heels on the current roster have been part of three College Cup teams – Maycee Bell, Isabel Cox and Julia Dorsey – who were also on the 2019 ACC championship team. Talia Dellaperuta, Sam Meza, Avery Patterson, Riley Quinlan and Paige Tolentino have been members of two College Cup squads.

In 2023, North Carolina is returning 69.8% of its goals scored from a year prior, as well as 85.7% of its assists and 74.7% of its points. UNC is also returning 84.6% of its shots and 81.7% of its shots on goal.

First Class ... Carolina's freshman class, which signed back in November 2022, is the top-ranked cohort in the country according to Top Drawer Soccer. Led by associate head coach and lead recruiter Damon Nahas, the Tar Heels have signed a top-four recruiting class for six consecutive years and have had a top-five class in eight of the last nine seasons.

The class includes forward Melina Rebimbas (No. 3), defender Evelyn Shores (No. 6), defender Savy King (No. 10), forward Olivia Thomas (No. 12) forward Mia Oliaro (No. 18) and goalkeeper Abby Gundry (No. 24), as well as midfielder Ella Smith.

Gundry, King, Oliaro and Rebimbas played together on the 2022 United States U-17 Women's Youth National Team that won the Concacaf Women's U-17 Championships

to clinch its berth in the 2022 FIFA U-17 World Cup. All four were selected to the World Cup roster, but Oliaro withdrew due to injury.

Fit(ness) Check ... Twenty Tar Heels passed UNC's preseason fitness test standards, the most in program history.

Tessa Dellarose, a sophomore, broke her own program record with a score of 63 on the beep test. She crushed her previous record of 57 from last year when she first broke the school record as a freshman.

Only five Tar Heels had a score of 50+ on the beep test, with Dellarose doing six more than freshman runner-up Mia Oliario's 57.

Olivia Thomas, a freshman, set a new team standard for fastest speed after clocking in at 7.54 m/s. That equates to approximately 4.8 seconds in the 40-yard dash. Thomas also had the quickest acceleration on the team at 6.17 m/s.

Maycee Bell, a redshirt senior, broke the program record for the vertical jump with a height of 34.5 inches. That's an impressive 8.5 inches higher than her mark of 26.0 inches she recorded in 2022, which was right before her season-ending injury.

Maddie Dahlien, a sophomore, owns the program record for agility at 13.87 set in 2022 as a rookie. Her time of 14.14 this year still ranked No. 1 on the team.

Avery Patterson, a senior, ranked in the

team's top-5 in three categories. She tied for second with a vertical jump of 26.5 inches, tied for fifth with an agility time of 14.61 and was fifth with a beep test score of 50.

O Captain! My Captain! ... This year's team captains, as voted on by the team, include redshirt-senior Maycee Bell, senior Talia Dellaperuta, senior Kai Hayes and senior Avery Patterson. Now a two-time team captain, Bell also served in the same role in 2022.

Hayes also acts as the liaison for UNC women's soccer and Team IMPACT, a non-profit organization that matches children facing serious illness and disability with college sports teams. UNC's Team IMPACT match, Julia, has been part of the Tar Heel family since January 2023.

Right On Track ... Anyone watching North Carolina women's soccer can see the serious speed the Tar Heel players posses.

Savy King, a freshman defender, provides UNC's stalwart back line with explosive speed. She owns the school track and field records at Agoura High School (West Hills, Calif.) in the 200m (25.49) and 400m (56.87). The previous 400m record was around for over 30 years before she broke it in 2021.

Maddie Dahlien, a sophomore forward, brings true speed up top for UNC with a graceful and powerful stride. She was voted Miss Soccer and Miss Track for the state of Minnesota during her senior year at Edina High School (Edina, Minn.) in 2021. She was the state champion in the 100m, 200m and 400m as a junior, also winning the 200m and long jump as a senior. Dahlien also owns her high school's records in the 100m (11.81), 200m (23.80), 400m (54.76), long jump (18' 8.5) as well as several relays. She was hotly recruited in both sports, ultimately choosing to focus on soccer in college.

Olivia Thomas, a freshman forward, has also broken school track and field records at

University Liggett School (Grosse Pointe Woods, Mich.). She owns her high school's marks in the 100m (12.41), 200m (25.58) and 400m (58.88). She finished in the top-8 in all three events at the Michigan Lower Peninsula DIII State Championships as a junior.

During UNC's preseason fitness tests, Thomas broke the program record for fastest speed at 7.54 m/s (about 4.8 seconds in the 40-yard dash). She also clocked the quickest acceleration on the team at 6.17 m/s.

Home Sweet Home ... UNC won't have to pack its bags often this season, as 10 of its 18 regular season matches will be played at Dorrance Field (both of their preseason exhibition contests were played at home, too). Furthermore, three of their eight road games are in the state of North Carolina: NC State (Sept. 30), Duke (Oct. 8) and Wake Forest (Oct. 13). For postseason competition, both the ACC Championship and the NCAA College Cup will be held in

nearby Cary at the WakeMed Soccer Park.

The Tar Heels are 403-32-18 at home, a winning percentage of .910. UNC has outscored its opponents 1,679-224 all-time in Chapel Hill in its 455 home games since the program started in 1979.

Of the 44 completed seasons in program history, 25 of them have seen the Tar Heels go undefeated at home. Carolina has never lost more than three games at home in a single season. Only four losses have happened at Dorrance Field since its opening in 2019.

Competitive Schedule ... North Carolina has no shortage of top-tier teams to face throughout the 2023 season. The Tar Heels are set to face nine teams during the regular season that finished in the top-25 of the final United Soccer Coaches poll last year. Those teams include Florida State (No. 3), Alabama (No. 4), Notre Dame (No. 5), Duke (No. 6), Virginia (No. 7), Arkansas (No. 8), South Carolina (No. 9), Penn State (No. 13) and USC (No. 24).

Of UNC's 18-game regular-season slate, 13 of its opponents competed in the 2022 NCAA Tournament. Florida State and Alabama also played in the College Cup, while Arkansas, Notre Dame, Duke and Virginia advanced to the quarterfinals.

According to head coach Anson Dorrance, "We want to schedule great teams early. We want to play the best schedule in the country. We want our young women to



get better every single season. So for us, playing the best schedule in the country every year is not just an ambition for us, it's a requirement."

At the conclusion of the 2022 campaign which saw the Tar Heels earn a national runner-up finish, Carolina ranked third in NCAA DI women's soccer for its RPI. That ranked second in the ACC behind Florida State. Nine of UNC's opponents this season ranked in the top-25 for PRI last year, including six in the top-10.

Red, White & Carolina Blue ...

Sophomores Maddie Dahlien, Tessa Dellarose, Ally Sentnor and freshman Savy King represented Team USA on the 21-player roster at the 2023 Concacaf Women's U-20 Championship, held in the Dominican Republic from May 24-June 3. Sentnor was one of four players on the U.S. squad with a previous U-20 Women's Youth National Team cap.

The foursome led Team USA to a runner-up finish in the Dominican Republic. Sentnor—the team's co-captain—and Dahlien were the USA's leading scorers with four goals each. Dellarose scored once while King started all five matches, and Dahlien and Dellarose accounted for all four goals in a 4-0 win over Jamaica.

Sentnor was also part of the USA's FIFA U-20 Women's World Cup roster in 2022. She played in all three matches at the U-20 World Cup in Costa Rica, even scoring against Ghana. King was part of the U.S. 2022 FIFA U-17 Women's World Cup team.

Current freshmen Abby Gundry, Mia Oliaro, Melina Rebimbas and King played together on the 2022 United States U-17 WYNT that won the Concacaf U-17 Championships in the Dominican Republic.

Additionally, Dellarose, Nona Reason, Sentnor, King, Oliaro, Rebimbas and Evelyn Shores were called in for the 2023 WYNT U-18/U-19 combined training camp at the U.S. Soccer National Training Center in California back in January. All of them are age-eligible for the 2024 FIFA U-20 Women's World Cup next summer.

University of National Champions ...

Across all sports, North Carolina has the eighth-most titles in NCAA history with 49 (13 men and 36 women). The women's soccer program owns 21 of them, plus an

AIAW title in 1982 for 22 total national championships. No other Division I women's soccer team has more than three.

One of the preeminent programs across all of college sports, North Carolina's unrivaled women's soccer dominance saw nine straight NCAA titles between 1986-1994. The team's 21 NCAA championships are tied for the fifth-most by any program in DI history.

Carolina is the only team in the country to appear in all 41 NCAA Women's Soccer Tournaments since the first one was held in 1982. The Tar Heels have appeared in 31 NCAA Women's College Cups, 18 more than the second closest team.

The Tar Heels have also won 289 ACC championship titles (148 men and 141 women), 137 more than any other current ACC school. The women's soccer program has won 22 conference titles (plus 25 regular season titles). No other ACC women's soccer team has more than nine conference championships (no one else has more than five regular season titles, either).

World Cup ... Seven Tar Heel alumnae participated in the 2023 FIFA Women's World Cup and Australia and New Zealand this summer.

Crystal Dunn and Emily Fox were selected as part of the 23-person roster for the United States. Dunn made her second consecutive World Cup appearance while Fox was one of 14 players making their debut.

Playing for one of the host countries was Katie Bowen for New Zealand with her third straight World Cup appearance. Lucy Bronze, Lotte Wubben-Moy and Alessia Russo, as well as manager Sarina Wiegman, represented England. Bronze competed in the World Cup for the third time while Wubben-Moy and Russo made their first appearance.

England advanced to the semifinals after Russo netted the game-winner during the quarterfinals. The Lionesses then advanced to the finals for the first time in history, with Russo having an assist and a goal during the semifinals. England fell to Spain, 1-0, in the final.

When reflecting on her time as a Tar Heel, Wiegman told the Wall Street Journal: "Playing with the Tar Heels totally changed my mind-set...When I went to Carolina, it was like a soccer paradise for young women." Wiegman went on to say how, during her time in Chapel Hill, she picked up on "a philosophy of winning behaviors that she preaches to the Lionesses."



- Inducted in the National Soccer Hall of Fame on 8/2/08 on the "Builders of the Game" ballot, being inducted in his first year of eligibility.
- Winner of the prestigious Werner Fricker Builder Award in 2016 from U.S. Soccer, given to an individual who has dedicated at least 20 years of service to the sport, working to establish a lasting legacy in the history and structure of soccer in the United States.
- Has one 921 games as head coach of the UNC women's program. He is No. 1 all-time in wins in the sport's history.
- Won his 1,000th game as a collegiate head coach (including 172 wins as UNC's men's head coach from 1977-88) when he won his 828th women's game against Ohio State on 8/18/18.
- Carolina's 2012 NCAA Championship was his 20th NCAA title, making him the first coach in NCAA history to win 20 NCAA championships in a single sport.
- Is the all-time leader in Division I NCAA championships in any sport with 21. UCLA men's volleyball coach Al Scates and Arkansas men's indoor track and field coach John McDonnell are second with 19. Dorrance is tied for second in all-time NCAA titles with 21 (all divisions).
- Has accounted for 21 of North Carolina's 46 total NCAA championships.
- UNC women's soccer's 21 NCAA championships are tied for the fifth-most by any program in Division I history. Oklahoma State wrestling has 34, Southern California men's outdoor track and field 26, Denver skiing 24, Iowa wrestling 24 and UNC women's soccer, USC men's tennis and Yale men's golf have won 21.
- In 2020, the Tar Heels went undefeated in the regular season, advanced to the ACC title game and made its unprecedented 30th appearance in the NCAA College Cup. Five Tar Heels, representing three nations, played in the 2020 Olympics in Tokyo (played in 2021).
- Beckett Entertainment named the 1982-2000 Tar Heels the sixth-most successful sports dynasty of the 20th century, trailing only the 1957-69 Boston Celtics, 1947-62 New York Yankees, 1963-75 UCLA men's basketball, 1991-98 Chicago Bulls and 1953-60 Montreal Canadians.
- Led Carolina to a 103-game unbeaten streak (97-0-6) from 1986 to 1990 and a 101-game unbeaten streak (99-0-2) from 1990 to 1994.
- Head Coach of the United States Women's National Team from 1986-94, leading Team USA to the title in the first-ever Women's World Cup in China in 1991.
- Led the Carolina men's soccer team to the 1987 NCAA Final Four.
- Coached 19 different players to National Player-of-the-Year honors, including three-time recipient Cindy Parlow (current president of U.S. Soccer) and Mia Hamm, who was selected the Greatest Female Athlete in the ACC's first 50 years.
- Seven-time National Coach of the Year (1982, 1986, 1997, 2000, 2003 and 2006 with the women and 1987 with the men).



DAMON NAHAS ASSOC. HEAD COACH



Damon Nahas is beginning his eighth complete season as a full-time assistant women's soccer coach at the University of North Carolina in the fall of 2023. He officially joined the Tar Heel staff in November 2015.

Nahas brought with him an extensive background from 15 years in player development, club coaching and national team coaching. In 2000, he developed a U7-U11 technical academy, Next Level Academy (NLA), which not only played a major role in his development as a coach but, along with the NLA staff, continues to be a leader in player development in the Triangle area. He served as the technical director of one of the most successful youth clubs in the country, Capital Area Soccer League (CASL), in Raleigh since 2000.

He also served as head coach of the U.S. U15 Girls National Team from 2011-14 and began a stint as an assistant coach for the U.S. U17 Women's National Team in 2014.

Nahas attended and played soccer at NC State from 1992-96 and then played professionally with the Wilmington Hammerheads and Capital Express. Among his past head coaching experiences have been stints with Cary Clarets PDL (head coach), Carolina RailHawks (assistant coach 2007-09) and Cardinal Gibbons High School in Raleigh (men's head coach 1999-2002).

A native of East Northport, N.Y., Nahas earned his bachelor's degree from Southern New Hampshire University in 2021. He and his wife, Nicole, have two sons, Crew and Grayson, and a daughter Harper.

NATHAN THACKERAY ASST. COACH



Nathan Thackeray was hired as an assistant coach at North Carolina during the 2021 season and is responsible for working with the Tar Heel goalkeepers.

Thackeray simultaneously serves as a firstteam assistant and goalkeeper coach for the North Carolina courage of the NWSL. He joined the Courage in 2017, while concurrently serving as the Director of Goalkeeping for the USL's North Carolina FC.

He spent five years with North Carolina FC (2016-21) and during his time with the organization, NCFC developed 24 goal-keepers into intercollegiate players, had six players sign home grown contracts and eight had regular integration with either men's or the women's professional teams.

Thackeray was responsible for overseeing the largest goalkeeper program in the United States. With more than 300 goalkeepers. He also served as an assistant coach for both boys' and girls' U15 – U19 academy teams.

He joined the staff of the North Carolina FC in 2016 after serving as Head of Academy Goalkeeping with Major League Soccer's Houston Dynamo for four seasons.

In addition to serving as an assistant coach with the Dynamo, Thackeray was responsible for overseeing the development of all goalkeepers from age levels U11 to U23.

He earned his bachelor's degree in communications and media studies from William Woods University in 2010.

ALEXANDRA KIMBALL ASST. COACH



Alex Kimball was hired as director of team development for UNC women's soccer in 2022 after serving as a volunteer assistant coach. In Summer 2023, she was elevated to assistant coach.

As the director of team development, Kimball oversaw community outreach programs, harvested relations with local youth soccer programs and promoted the sale of tickets for home matches. She also assisted head coach Anson Dorrance with player development and associate head coach Damon Nahas with recruiting operations.

A four-year letterwinner for Dorrance, Kimball played in 91 games during her UNC career and helped the Tar Heels reach two College Cups (2016, 2018) and captured two ACC regular season championships. She finished her career with nine goals and seven assists with more than 2800 minutes played.

Kimball began her professional career in January 2019 when she was selected by Utah Royals FC in the fourth round of the NWSL College Draft.

After suffering an injury during the 2019-20 season, Kimball work as an individual skilled trainer at GL Soccer training facility in Salt Lake City before becoming the director of development at Sporting io.

Kimball represented Peru in the Copa America tournament in Cali, Colombia in summer of 2022.

She graduated from UNC with a bachelor's degree in sports administration.






