- ➤ The Tar Heels travel to the Bluegrass State for their first weekend road trip of the year, where they will face Louisville in Jim Patterson Stadium.
- ▶ It is the program's third ever trip to Louisville since the Cardinals joined the ACC in 2015. UNC is 9-7 against them as conference foes and enters this weekend on a three game win streak after sweeping last year's matchup in Chapel Hill.
- ➤ Carolina is 2-4 in games played in the shadow of Churchill Downs. Their last trip Louisville won the series with back-to-back wins in extra innings.

EXTRA EXCITEMENT IN WILMINGTON

- ➤ Speaking of extra innings, North Carolina comes into the weekend off a tenth-inning, come from behind 7-3 victory over UNCW on Tuesday night.
- ➤ Two separate two-run deficits had the Tar Heels down before a trio of solo home runs tied the score.
- > Preseason All-American Luke Stevenson had the first two, giving him his fourth career multi-homer outing and his second of the season. His latest blast was immediately followed by one from Gavin Gallaher, giving the Heels their first back-to-back home run sequence of the year.
- ➤ It was the second time in their young careers that the pair smashed homers in consecutive trips to the plate.
- > The real dramatics came in the top of the tenth when captain Jackson Van De Brake stepped up with the bases loaded and two outs. He proceeded to crush a line drive to the wall in right-center to clear the bags and record the first triple of his Carolina career. He later scored on a wild pitch to give UNC all the runs it needed.

AROUND **THE HORN**

STOKING THE FLAMES

- > First baseman Hunter Stokely has come out of the gates absolutely on fire to start the year.
- ➤ He has five home runs already this year. His most in a season prior was six in 2023.
- ➤ Three of those long balls have been to the opposite field. He only had one oppo homer in his three previous seasons combined.
- ➤ On the season, he leads the team in batting average (.403, 10th in the ACC), hits (25, 11th ACC), and total bases (43, 13th ACC).
- ➤ The veteran had easily the best week of his collegiate baseball career from 2/24-3/2, earning him ACC Player of the Week.
- ➤ In six games played, the Wilson, N.C. native slashed .524/.621/1.143 while racking up 11 hits. 11 RBIs, 10 runs, and 24 total bases.
- ➤ It is the best batting average and on-base percentage of any six game stretch in his career.

KING KANE

- ➤ The Tar Heels' leadoff man has been everything you could want from that position this season, leading the team in OBP (.512) and making the most of it.
- ➤ He has started Carolina off with a base runner in eight of their games so far this year. 4 HBP, 2 1B, 1 3B, and 1 BB. He's scored on all eight occasions.
- ➤ He leads the team in runs scored (21, 6th ACC) and free passes (24) while sitting in a tie with Stokely and Stevenson for the most extra base hits (8).
- ➤ With 13-13 stolen bases (most in the ACC) through 17 of 55 games, he is on pace to have the most SBs in a season since Brian Roberts broke the record in 1998 with 63.
- ➤ It's the most bases stolen by a Tar Heel through 16 games since Russ Adams had 18 in 2002 and he's the only one to have that many without being caught since at least 1998.
- ➤ Kepley ripped his fourth triple of the year against Stanford. He is now half way to the Carolina singleseason record (8, Brian Goodwin, 2010) and is one shy of being the first to hit five since 2017.

YOUNG BUCKS BRING THE HEAT

- ➤ Carolina has called upon three true freshman arms to deliver in big spots this season.
- ➤ First to appear was the Lee County legend Walker McDuffie. He has thrown seven times already and only allowed a run on one occasion. He has struck out 24 batters, earned two wins, and logged one save.
- ➤ McDuffie's save is the first by a Carolina true freshman since Shawn Rapp's against Elon on Feb. 18, 2020.
- ➤ Ellerbe, N.C. native Camron Seagraves has six appearances under his belt and has recorded a win, 11 strikeouts, and a .269 opponent bating average.
- > Flamethrower Ryan Lynch turned heads in his first outing, picking up the win. 4.0 innings of seven K and zero walk work is quite the first impression.
- ➤ Lynch's seven strikeouts were the most by a Carolina pitcher in their collegiate debut since Max Carlson racked up eight on Feb. 20, 2021.
- ➤ The trio. alongside the young lason Decaro, own seven of the Tar Heels' 15 wins so far this year. Lynch is the oldest of the group as the lone 19 year old.
- > Seagraves and Lynch are responsible for the 11 fastest pitches thrown by a Tar Heel this year. Seagraves' outing against Stanford accounting for seven of the top-eight, topping out at 98.1.

SCOUTING THE CARDINALS

- ➤ Louisville enters conference play with a 14-2 record and currently riding a seven game wining streak.
- ➤ Coach McDonnell's team made a splash opening weekend by walking off No. 7 Texas 4-3 (10) in extras and then run-ruling No. 12 Arizona 13-1 (8).
- ➤ The team owns the second best batting average in the country (.348), behind only UCF (.363).
- > They have accounted for three walk-off wins and three run-rules already this season.
- ➤ McDonnell has been at the helm for every occasion in which the Cardinals have beaten the Tar Heels.

HISTORY MADE LAST TIME AGAINST LOUISVILLE

- ➤ In last season's series against the Cardinals, the Tar Heels had two separate nights to remember.
- ➤ The first came on Friday night, when Vance Honeycutt smashed two long balls to become North Carolina's all-time home run leader, breaking Devy Bell's record from 1987 of 57.
- ➤ He finished his career with 65 homers.
- ➤ Then on Sunday, Carolina ran out to a 16-7 win to claim their eighth Coastal Division championship. Their first since 2018.
- ➤ Luke Stevenson hit a pair of three-run homers and collected a career-high eight RBIs.

RETURN OF THE KNAPP

- > The impact of the return of Jake Knapp to the Carolina starting rotation cannot be overstated.
- ➤ The Greensboro, N.C., native was slated to be the Friday starter for the Tar Heels going into the 2024 season before sustaining a season-ending arm injury in the preseason.
- ➤ "Coach Knapp," as Forbes affectionately calls him, stayed locked in with the team despite his situation, attending every practice, game, and meeting. The coaching staff credits his leadership as a key factor in their run to Omaha in 2024.
- ➤ 623 days since his last appearance, the secondyear captain retook the mound on opening day 2025. He threw three innings, allowing only two hits and racking up three strikeouts.
- ➤ In just his fourth appearance since the surgery, he threw his first career complete game in a careerlong 7.0 innings outing against Stanford. The veteran racked up seven strikeouts with only one walk, one run, and four hits on 111 total pitches.

ARM TALENT

- > Forbes' team came into the season with a highly acclaimed pitching staff that has done nothing but live up to the billing thus far.
- ➤ Carolina hurlers have recorded 183 strikeouts on the year, the most the program has put up 17 games into a season since at least 2010.
- ➤ UNC put up games with 17 and 14 strikeouts backto-back twice in week two alone. The last time the team had 14+ Ks in back-to-back games more than once in the same season was 2008.
- ➤ The Tar Heels' staff is 13th in the country in walks per nine (2.98) and strikeout-to-walk ratio (3.57), best in the ACC in both categories.
- > Sunday starter Aidan Haugh leads the conference in batter struck out looking (14) and has been tremendous in his last three outings. 23 Ks in 16.1 IP with only five walks and five earned runs.

POTENT (P)NOTABLES

- ➤ Matt Matthijs is third in the country and first in the ACC in appearances with 10.
- ➤ Luke Stevenson leads the ACC in walks with 20 and is second in home runs with seven.

AROUND THE HORN

DREAM DEBUT

- ➤ In Carolina's game against NC A&T, yet another true freshman entered the fray and made an instant impact.
- ➤ The Peachland, N.C., product Perry Hargett made his debut as a pinch hitter in the fourth and produced three hits, four RBIs and two runs highlighted by an eighth inning, three-run blast to deep left field.
- Next game up and he finds himself in the starting lineup. He did not wait long to repay Forbes' faith in him, as he sent a moonshot to left in his first at-bat.
- ➤ The first 400 footer of the year for the Tar Heels made him the first to go yard in back-to-back at-bats this season, last done by Vance Honeycutt in last year's Super Regional wins.
- ➤ Hargett is also one of two Tar Heel freshmen to have homered in their collegiate debut since 2011, the other being Honeycutt on Feb. 18, 2022 (who hit two long balls that day).

NO PLACE LIKE THE BOSH

- ➤ The Tar Heels boasted a 37-3 record at Boshamer Stadium last season, winning a program record 92.5 percent of its games at home.
- ➤ The previous highest complete season winning percentage at Boshamer Stadium was 92.3 in 2011 (36-3) and 1985 (24-2).
- ▶ UNC opened the season with 23 consecutive wins at Boshamer Stadium before suffering its first home loss (4/16 vs. Coastal Carolina), setting a program record for most consecutive home wins to start a season.
- ▶ The 23 victories were a part of a school record 27 straight wins at Boshamer Stadium, including the final four games of the 2023 campaign.
- ➤ Only Tennessee (40) had more home wins than the Tar Heels in 2024, and only UC Santa Barbara and Oregon State had fewer losses (2).
- ➤ It was the 13th time in program history the Tar Heels won 30 or more home games.
- ➤ The Tar Heels have won 77.8 percent of their home games since 2021, going 126-36.

RUNNING THE GAUNTLET

- ➤ Never one to shy away from a challenge, Forbes and company have laid out yet another stacked schedule in front of them.
- ➤ 19 of the 28 opponents the team is set to face finished 2024 inside the top-100 of the RPI, 13 were inside the top-65.
- ➤ 11 of the teams made the NCAA postseason, four advanced to the Super Regionals, and two more (Florida State and NC State) joined the Heels in Omaha for the College World Series.
- ➤ According to D1Baseball, the Tar Heels have the toughest non-conference schedule of anyone in the ACC by Quad Score.
- ➤ 20 of those 25 non-con matchups will be played in the friendly confines of Boshamer Stadium.
- ➤ Carolina holds a 448-118 record all-time against its 28 scheduled foes.

NON-CON COMBAT

- ➤ The Heels have compiled an 89-30 (.748) record in games against non-ACC opponents under Forbes. The 2024 team was 24-6 outside of conference play.
- ➤ Since 2020, UNC has won 11 of its 12 three-game non-conference weekend series with a 29-6 mark in that span.

FORBES INKS EXTENSION

- ➤ Back in November, the reigning ACC Coach of the Year agreed to terms on a new five-year contract that will keep him at the helm of the Tar Heels through at least June 30, 2029.
- ➤ Since taking over for the newly inducted Hall of Famer Mike Fox, Forbes has amassed a 154-89 (.643) record on his way to winning both ACC Coastal and ACC tournament titles.
- ➤ He was also named the ABCA Atlantic Region Coach of the Year, the third Carolina coach to receive the accolade alongside Fox and Mike Roberts.
- ➤ In his time as head coach, Forbes has coached seven All-Americans, 16 All-ACC honorees, and seen 17 players taken in the MLB Draft.

A FACE BOTH OLD AND NEW

- ➤ This offseason, old friend Scott Jackson returned to the program as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator.
- ➤ Jackson spent the last eight seasons as the head coach at Liberty. There he lead the Flames to three NCAA Regional appearances (2019, 21, 22), including at-large selections in the final two trips.
- ➤ In 2019, he was named ASUN Coach of the Year after leading his team to 43 wins and their first ASUN Championship.
- ➤ He returns to a role for Carolina that he held from 2009-2016 under Hall of Fame coach Mike Fox and alongside Forbes.
- ➤ Fellow assistant Bryant Gaines spent three seasons (2017-2019) as the pitching coach at Liberty before returning to UNC.
- ➤ During Jackson's first stint in Chapel Hill, the Tar Heels posted a record of 379-180 (0.678), made seven NCAA Tournament appearances and advanced to the College World Series on three occasions (2009, 2011 and 2013).

ROSTER REVIEW

KEY RETURNERS

- ➤ Carolina brings back 17 letter winners from a team coming off an incredible run to the College World Series, eight position players and 15 pitchers.
- > A veteran starting infield highlight the position players, led by:
- > Gavin Gallaher: Forced his way onto the field as a true freshman, eventually landing as the regular third baseman. He made 45 starts in his true freshman season and was fifth on the team in BA with a .314. He earned the Most Outstanding Player award in the Chapel Hill regional after blasting a walk-off grand slam in the team's opening round win over LIU.
- > Alex Madera: Started every game at second except for the opener due to injury. Moves to short this year. Hit .303 with nine doubles and 34 RBIs while also boasting a .991 fielding percentage. Another regional round hero, he drove in the winning run with a single in the top of the 10th against LSU.
- > Luke Stevenson: The No. 1 catcher prospect heading into the 2025 draft, the Wake Forest native certainly turned heads in his debut campaign. The freshman All-American and All-ACC freshman team selection slashed .284/.420/. 536 with 14 homers, 58 RBIs and a team-best 48 walks, playing in all 64 games.
- > Hunter Stokely: Missed most of 2024 with an injury picked up in the third game of the year. In 2023 he had the team's third best BA (.317) and slugging percentage (.492).
- > lackson Van De Brake: The 2023 second team All-ACC honoree is back and looking to build off the momentum he built late in 2024. His game-tying run in the bottom of the ninth helped the Heels to a win over LSU in the regional championship game. He enters 2025 as a captain for the second straight
- ➤ The strength of this 2025 squad, however, lies with its arms, led by:
- > Folger Boaz: Made nine starts in 2024 before sustaining a season-ending injury. Became the first Carolina pitcher to make his debut as the opening day starter since Ryan Snare in 1998.
- > Jason DeCaro: The star that emerged in 2024, the freshman All-American and All-ACC second teamer stepped up as the Friday starter in Boaz's absence. He ranked seventh nationally among DI first-years with a 3.81 ERA, sixth best overall in the ACC while also leading the conference in starts (18).
- > Aidan Haugh: Started 2024 in the bullpen before moving into a starting role late in April. He compiled a 4-3 record across 22 appearances with a 4.83 ERA. He was taken in the 16th round of the 2024 MLB Draft by the Minnesota Twins, but did not sign.
- > Jake Knapp: Injured in the preseason in 2024. The second-year captain led the Tar Heels' regular starters in ERA (5.04) in 2023 while recording 65 strikeouts with a 5-4 record in 16 starts, tied for the most in the ACC.
- > Matthew Matthijs: The third team All-American and all-acc honoree was an animal out of the bullpen for the Carolina in 2024. He led the ACC and ranked second among all D1 pitchers in victories with 12, the first Tar Heel to hit that number since 2013. He appeared in a team and conference-high 36 games while recording a 3.72 ERA.

PROMISING NEWCOMERS

- ➤ The Tar Heels will also have to rely heavily on a number of their 22 new faces in 2025 if they want to reach the heights of last season. Some of the new names to know:
- > Tyson Bass: A graduate transfer from Forbes' alma mater N.C. Wesleyan, Bass came to Chapel Hill as arguably the best player in the Bishops' history. The schools 2024 Male Athlete of the Year, he broke the program's single season (21) and career (48) home runs records as well as the career runs mark with 227. He helped Wesleyan to back-toback conference championships and three regional appearances in his four years.
- > Kane Kepley: A transfer from Liberty, Kepley played two years under Scott Jackson before following him to Chapel Hill this offseason. A 2024 CUSA All-Conference Second Team honoree as a sophomore, he hit .332 with 31 RBIs and 54 runs scored as the leadoff hitter for the Flames. In his second season, he led the conference in walks (47) and stolen bases (23). He was also named a 2023 ASUN All-Freshman team member
- > Rom Kellis: A transfer from Florence Darlington, Kellis dominated at the NJCAA level. The Gilbert, S.C. native can play any position, expecting to see most of his time in Chapel Hill in the outfield but capable of getting behind the dish or manning the infield. He was named the 2024 NJCAA Region X Player of the Year and was a NJCAA second team All-American. In 104 games for the Stingers, he hit .388 with 20 home runs. 24 doubles and 112 RBIs.
- > Sam Angelo: A graduate transfer from D3 Montclair State, Angelo is expected to spend a good amount of time at DH for the Tar Heels and its not hard to see why. The two-time ABCA All-American hit .416 in his four years with the Red Hawks while racking up 181 hits, 45 doubles, 35 homers and 151 RBIs. He was the first player in the program's history to earn multiple conference player of the year
- > Macaddin Dye: Another of the three incomers from Liberty, Dye earned CUSA All-Freshman team honors in 2024 under Jackson. Starting all but one game for the Flames behind the plate, he hit .273 with six home runs and a team-leading 49 RBIs. He finished third on the team with 60 hits, but really showed his mettle in crunch time. He led the squad with a .321 batting average with two outs, bringing in 23 runs in those at bats.
- > Perry Hargett: The true freshman outfielder from Peachland, N.C. has impressed in preseason work and is pushing to be one of the first off the bench early in the season for Forbes' squad. The 2024 Max Preps Baseball Player of the Year for North Carolina was a four-time MAC All-Conference selection and an ABCA High School Baseball All-American.

2024 **REWIND**

TAR HEELS RUN TO PROGRAM'S 12TH CWS

- ➤ North Carolina returned to the College World Series for the first time in six years, sweeping West Virginia in the NCAA Chapel Hill Super Regional to earn its 12th trip to Omaha.
- ➤ The team posted their most wins, 48, since 2017 and registered an ACC-high 22 victories en route to their eighth Coastal Division title.
- ➤ Closed the season with a program record 115 home runs, scoring 541 runs, the second-most in program history while leading the ACC with a 4.30 earned run average.

CARDIAC CAROLINA

- ➤ Four of the Heel's six wins in the NCAA tournament came in their last at-bat with three different players (Gallaher, Madera, Honeycutt x2) driving home the game-winning run.
- ➤ They became the first team in postseason history with a walk-off win in their opening game of a regional, Super Regional and College World Series.
- ➤ UNC hosted and won both the Regional and Super Regional rounds in Chapel Hill.
- ➤ Went 3-1 in the regional, opening with a walk-off win over LIU before taking two wins from the then reigning champion LSU Tigers to advance.
- ➤ Swept West Virginia in the supers, highlighted by a two-out, two-run bomb from Honeycutt to win game one.
- ➤ The Heels kept the magic going with a 3-2 walk-off win over Virginia in their opening game of the CWS. Honeycutt was once again the hero, smacking a two-out walk-off single to bring in Jackson Van De Brake.
- ➤ UNC then lost to eventual champion Tennessee and ACC compatriot Florida State to bring their postseason run to an end.

TAR HEELS MAKE NCAAs FOR 36th TIME

- ➤ North Carolina made its 36th NCAA Tournament appearance and seventh consecutive, the longest active streak among all ACC schools.
- ➤ North Carolina was tabbed as the No. 4 national seed for the 2024 NCAA Tournament. It was the Tar Heels' highest seed since they were the No. 2 overall seed in 2017.
- ➤ UNC hosted a regional for the second time in the last three seasons and fifth time in the past seven.
- ➤ Head coach Scott Forbes has led the Tar Heels into the postseason each of his first four seasons, the only coach in program history to do so.

CAROLINA WINS THE ACC COASTAL

- ➤ North Carolina won its eighth ACC Coastal Division championship on the penultimate weekend of the regular season with its three-game sweep of UofL.
- ➤ UNC (22-8) finished four games ahead of preseason Coastal division favorite Virginia (18-12) to win its first division title in six years. Carolina claimed the conference's overall best record by two games in front of Clemson (20-10), capturing the ACC's unofficial regular season championship.
- ➤ With the addition of Cal and Stanford to the ACC in 2025, last year was the final season of divisional play in the conference. UNC's eight division titles are twice as many as the second-closet team, Miami (4).

ANOTHER 20-WIN ACC CAMPAIGN

- ➤ With their win in the series finale against Louisville, the Tar Heels recorded their 20th conference win of the season, reaching the mark for the first time since 2018 (22-8).
- ➤ UNC finished ACC play with a 22-8 record.
- ➤ This was the ninth time in school history that UNC has won 20 or more ACC games in a season.

HONEYCUTT WRAPS LEGENDARY CAREER

- ➤ Vance Honeycutt finished his Carolina career as one of the best to ever do it and racked up the records and awards to reflect that.
- ➤ Earned spots on six All-America teams, including four first-team selections. Just the third Tar Heel alltime to receive six nominations.
- ➤ He was named 2024 ACC Defensive Player of the Year, earning the award for the second straight year. The first player to be named ACC Defensive Player of the Year twice.
- ➤ His 16.85 defensive runs saved was the second highest of any player Division I player and tops among all outfielders, earning him a spot on the ABCA/Rawlings Gold Glove team, the first Tar Heel to be recognized for the award.
- ➤ Posted a 20-20 season for the second time, mashing 28 homers and stealing 28 bases. The 28 home runs reset the school's single-season record, which he had broken previously as a freshman.
- ➤ Set the school record for runs in a season with 88. ➤ Became the first player in NCAA history to hit over 60 homers (65) and steal more than 70 bases (76).

FORBES NAMED ACC COACH OF THE YEAR

- ➤ Scott Forbes was voted ACC Coach of the Year after leading UNC to its first division title in six years.
- ➤ Carolina won seven of its 10 ACC series without being swept - and posted a 14-1 ACC record at The Bosh, a record for most home ACC wins.
- ➤ He is the fourth UNC coach to win the award, joining Walter Rabb (1964), Mike Roberts (1989) and Mike Fox (2018).

FIRST 40-WIN REGULAR SEASON FOR FORBES

- ➤ Carolina posted a 41-12 record during the regular season, collecting over 40 wins before the start of the postseason for the first time since 2017 (44-11).
- ➤ UNC has won 40 or more games in five of the last seven seasons and in 15 of Forbes' 23 years as a member of the Tar Heels' coaching staff.
- ➤ The program has 25 40-win seasons in its history with its first 40-win season posted in 1983 (42-10).

BOSH BOMBERS

- ➤ Carolina closed the season with 115 home runs, breaking the school record of 108 set in 2002.
- ➤ The Tar Heels belted 94 home runs over the last 43 games, accounting for 81.4 percent of their season total. UNC began it launch parade on St. Patrick's Day with seven homers at Miami.
- ➤ Hit four or more home runs in a game seven times with eight additional three homer games.

SIX HEELS TAKEN IN 2024 MLB DRAFT

- ➤ North Carolina had three players selected in the first two days and three more on the final day to give Forbes 17 draftees as head coach.
- ➤ Honeycutt's first round selection highlighted the bunch. Taken 22nd by the Baltimore Orioles, he was the first UNC player taken in the first since 2020 and the first chosen inside the top 25 since 2017.
- ➤ His selection gave Carolina 25 first-round picks in program history, including 12 since 2006.


