FIRST PITCH

WAIT DIDN'T WE JUST DO THIS?

- > The Diamond Heels, a week removed from taking the road series against the Blue Devils, will play host to Duke once again for a non-conference one-off matchup as both teams come off their finals weeks.
- > Carolina took two of three against Duke in Durham last weekend (more on that on pg. 7) to claim its seventh straight ACC series and seventh straight series over their Tobacco Road rivals.
- > Sunday will make for the first time UNC and Duke face off more than three times in the same season since 2009, when the teams split 2-2 but the Heels won their game in the ACC tournament.
- > They've only faced off four or more times in the same year 18 times since their mutual history began in 1891 and this will be the first time with all four happening in the regular season since 1952. They played five games in 1944, 1950, and 1953.

APPOINTMENT TELEVISION

- > The series opener against Louisville was Carolina's first game of the season to appear on linear TV. The team is currently scheduled for 11 cable network selections, 10 on ACC Network and one appearance on ESPN2.
- > With a wild card pick up for the Friday night game against NC State, Carolina now surpasses Clemson for the most selections in the conference.
- > It is already the most TV slots in program history before you factor in "Wildcard" spots and postseason fixtures that could add to that number.
- > Last season, the Heels held a 12-4 record in TV games and were 8-1 in the regular season in such fixtures.
- > This year they are 6-2 in their network contests so far.

HEELS OFF TO HOT START

► Carolina is officially off to one of its best starts in program history, through 46 games it is the eighth best position they've won for themselves.

ROAD DAWGS GOT BITE

► You can't get off to one of the best starts in program history without being road warriors.

► The Diamond Heels have matched their best start away from home since 2017, going 11-2 on the road so far in 2026. '17 was also the last time Carolina won all five ACC road series in the same year.

► They got to this point in large part thanks to sweeps in their first two ACC series on the road. It was only the second time the program had done that since the three-game series format was adopted in 1990.

► Previously, UNC had lost its first true road game of the year in each season from 2018-2024.

NEW FACES SAME STANDARD

► The Carolina offense heavily features new faces, as the team looks to replace 76.3% of its scoring from 2025. Gavin Gallaher (more on him later) is the only returner to have started more than half the games.

► So far, 75.9% of the 373 runs produced by the Heels have come from newcomers.

► The first to make his name was Jake Schaffner, the new starting shortstop in from North Dakota State, who's bat has popped in the leadoff spot. He leads the team in total bases and steals.

► He currently sits eighth in the nation and second in the ACC in triples with five. The UNC record is eight from Brian Goodwin in 2010. Kane Kepley came one shy of that mark in 2025.

► Erik Paulsen, new from Stony Brook, brings both elite bat and glove to first base. He is more than halfway to his previous career home run total (13) with seven this year alone.

► He and Schaffner both won Defensive Player of the Year awards from their respective conferences in 2025.

► George Mason transfer outfielder Owen Hull started slowly at the plate, but has been a man on fire recently. Since his three hit outing against NC A&T (38 games ago), Hull is slashing .423/.508/.611 with 20 extra base hits, 33 runs, and 54 RBIs.

► Duke transfer Macon Winslow has also quickly gotten comfortable in the better blue. He leads the team with games reaching base safely, doing so in all but three of the Tar Heels contests so far.

► Hull just overtook Winslow for longest on-base streak on the team with a 31 game streak.

► Winslow was also responsible for an 11th inning homer in the finale against Indiana that gave UNC its first opening-weekend walk-off win since 2020.

► His catching partner Colin Hynek has started almost every game, switching with Winslow between DH and C.

► Hynek is second on the team in extra base hits and knocked what he described as "the first triple I've had in my life" against Indiana before adding another on Friday night against Le Moyne.

DYNAMITE BEHIND THE DISH

► Carolina's dynamic duo at catcher have been elite offensively and defensively, living up to the billing Coach Forbes gave as one of the best one-two punches behind the plate since Cody Roberts and current undergraduate assistant Brandon Martorano in '17/'18.

► Through 46 games, Winslow and Hynek have allowed just 15 steals on 25 attempts. That is tied with 2016 for the fewest stolen bases surrendered in that amount of games by UNC this century.

► Their 25 attempts faced in that stretch is the least since 2012.

► And its not like they've faced teams that don't run. The Heels have faced the ACC's top-3 in stolen bases: Duke, Boston College, and Louisville.

► Those three teams, who have over 430 attempts between them, went a combined 3-7 against Carolina.

► It was BC's only blank weekend of 2026 and it was the fewest for Louisville since 2024. Both BC and Duke went on to set their program's single season records for steals.

► Carolina leads the ACC in SBA by a wide margin. Louisville has the second fewest allowed with 29.

DOUBLE 'EM UP

► Carolina's defense has been one of its biggest strengths in the 2026 season, as the Heels hold the ACC's best fielding percentage (No. 19 NCAA).

► One of their biggest weapons this year has been the double play. UNC currently has the 8th most DPs in the NCAA with 42, second only to Pitt (44) in the conference.

► Three games this season the Heels have successfully turned two three times in one contest. They have converted multiple in 10 games.

► A lot of credit for the defensive efficiency can be given to the men up the middle in Gallaher and Schaffner who have been a part of 24 and 22 of the double plays respectively.

► Carolina has also gotten seven DPs from their outfield, including a rare unassisted two-out play from Owen Hull on a line drive to center against Cal.

GOT THE BOSH BUMPIN

► It was an electric atmosphere at Boshamer Stadium the weekend the Heels took on Georgia Tech.

► Friday night's crowd of 4,357 was the largest in the regular season in the stadium's history.

► Coaches and players alike gave credit to the energy the fans brought to helping them win the series. All three games were sold out and it showed.

► The combined attendance of 11,720 across the three days was the program's best over a weekend since 2009 when the stadium reopened after being renovated.

► That number came just 11 people shy of the record set in '09 during a sweep of No. 7 Miami.

► On the field, it was the first top-3 series for UNC since 2008 when it had two. No. 2 ranked Carolina won weekends against No. 2 Florida State in Cary and at No. 1 Miami in Coral Gables that year.

► With the Heels' '08 contests being played in Cary at the USA Baseball National Training Complex, the series against GT became the highest ranked regular season match up in the Bosh's storied history.

AROUND THE HORN

GLOBE LIFE

► True freshman Caden Glauber (nicknamed “Globe” by his teammates) has quickly emerged as a go-to arm for Forbes and his staff.
► The barely 18 year old, who should still be getting ready for his senior prom right about now, leads the relievers in innings pitched, strikeouts, and is tied with McDuffie for saves.
► Forbes has described him as a “future Friday guy” with elite velocity for a kid his age, topping out at 97. He’s the only Carolina pitcher that has cracked the top-25 hardest pitches thrown by the team this year that isn’t named Ryan Lynch or Cam Padgett.
► His performance has turned some heads on the national stage, earning him a spot on Baseball America’s Freshman of the Year Watch List.
► UNC has a reputation for trusting young arms (see below). DeCaro also graduated high school early.

GOLDEN GLOBE WINS ACC PITCHER OF THE WEEK

► The hero of Carolina’s 14-inning marathon win against Clemson, true freshman reliever Caden Glauber earned the team with the conference’s best ERA their first ACC Pitcher of the Week award of 2026.
► He entered a tie game on the road in the bottom of the ninth and pitched all the way through the final out of the 14th to help the Heels pick up a crucial victory to even the series.
► The Fort Mill, S.C., native, who should still be in his senior year of high school, threw a career-high 6.0 high-leverage, shutout innings with six strikeouts while allowing just five hits and three walks.
► He is the first true freshman to claim a weekly award for the program since Jason Decaro did so in 2024. He is also the first underclassman to win one for any team this season.

YOUNG BUCKS BRING THE HEAT

► Carolina called upon three true freshman arms to deliver in big spots last season, each becoming vital members of an elite 2025 arm barn.
► First to appear was the Lee County legend Walker McDuffie, who eventually earned himself the team’s closer role on his way to Freshman All-America honors.
► His first save was the first by a UNC true freshman since Shawn Rapp’s against Elon on Feb. 18, 2020.
► McDuffie finished 2025 leading the team in saves with seven. The last true freshman Heel to record more than one in a season was Trent Thornton, who had eight in 2013.
► Flamethrower Ryan Lynch led the regular relievers in ERA with 2.93 and was one behind McDuffie for the most appearances. He had two saves and a 5-1 record on 73 strikeouts.
► It was the first time UNC had multiple freshmen with more than one save in a season since at least 1997.
► Lynch’s seven strikeouts in his collegiate debut were the most by a Carolina pitcher since Max Carlson racked up eight on Feb. 20, 2021.
► In the ACC tournament final against Clemson, Lynch got his first collegiate start and delivered in a big way. His final line had him at 4.0 IP of shutout work with seven strikeouts and just two hits.
► The highest ranked recruit of the trio was Ellerbe, N.C. native Camron Seagraves, the first of the trio to get a start.
► Punching out two to finish off history, he is the first freshman on record to be involved in a UNC no-hitter.
► The trio, alongside the young Jason Decaro, owned 18 of the Tar Heels’ 44 wins. Lynch is the oldest of the group while DeCaro, the sophomore, was the youngest player on the 2025 team.

THAT DUDE DECARO

► Carolina’s superstar junior has carried the weight of high expectations since the then 17 year old made his first start in the first midweek of 2024 before moving into the weekend rotation by week three. Eventually elevating himself to be the Friday guy.
► Named a Freshman All-American with a 3.81 ERA and a 6-1 record as he helped the team to Omaha. He got the start for UNC’s College World Series opener against Virginia, striking out six and giving up just one run as the Heels took a 3-2 victory.
► He was just as dominant in 2025, earning second team All-ACC honors for the second straight year.
► The North Port, N.Y. really turned it on down the stretch. He was sensational, going 6.0 IP with just one run allowed, in an 11-1 run-rule at No. 2 Florida State. Then, two weeks later, he would out duel eventual top-10 pick Kyson Witherspoon to lead Carolina to a pivotal 11-5 win over Oklahoma in the regional.
► To start 2026 he became just the sixth Tar Heel to start back-to-back Opening Day games since 1999.
► In week two against ECU, he tossed a complete game, eight-inning shutout with seven strikeouts while only allowing five hits and one walk. Only two ECU runners even managed to reach third.
► It was the team’s first eight inning complete game since Kent Emmanuel against Miami in May 2013 and only the second time over the last 12 seasons a Carolina pitcher has thrown eight or more shutout innings on the road (Austin Bergner, May 2019).
► DeCaro set a new career high in strikeouts when he took out nine on the road at No. 23 Notre Dame earlier this season.

NO PLACE LIKE THE BOSH

► The Tar Heels have won 77.0 percent of their home games under Scott Forbes, going 165-49-1.
► The 2025 squad racked up a 29-9 (.763) home record, winning five of seven series.
► The Tar Heels boasted a 37-3 record at Boshamer Stadium in 2024, winning a program record 92.5 percent of its games at home.
► It was the 13th time in program history the Tar Heels won 30 or more home games.
► Originally opened in 1972 before reopening in 2009 after a \$26 million renovation, the Bosh has been the site for many magical memories. Since ‘09, the Heels have hosted 10 regionals and eight supers in their palace affectionately referred to as the “Augusta National of College Baseball.”

POTENT (P)NOTABLES

► Carolina had four triples in their first two games of the season, it was the team’s most in back-to-back contests since March of 2015 in a pair of games against Duke and the most triples they’ve had in a single series since Long Beach State in March 2017.
► Jake Schaffner had two of those triples, the first Heel to have a three-bagger in back-to-back games since Danny Serretti did it against Georgia Tech in April 2022.
► The series finale against ECU was the first tie for UNC since April 17, 2005 when a 10th inning game against Miami was called early due to a set curfew. Before that, the most recent draw was back in 1989.
► At one point between games three and four, Macon Winslow had three straight swings go home run, double, home run.
► At the time it happened, 68 relievers had faced Georgia Tech’s Drew Burress and Vahn Lackey in the same game. Cam Seagraves is the only one to K both (s/o Pat James, D1Baseball for the note).

► The Heels have compiled a 120-36-1 (.768) record in games against non-ACC opponents under Forbes. This team is currently 19-2-1 out of conference.

► Last season, they were 25-4 against out of conference foes. The 2024 team was 24-6.

► Since 2020, UNC has won (or split) 13 of its 14 three-game non-conference weekend series with a 33-7-1 mark in that span.

GAVIN GALLAHIM

► The junior star Gavin Gallaher is the biggest returning piece on the offensive end for the Tar Heels. The now captain has earned a reputation for coming through in big moments throughout his career.

► He is the reigning back-to-back Chapel Hill Regional Most Outstanding Player thanks to a pair of unbelievable performances in those vital weekends.

► His 2024 regional was punctuated by the moment of the season in a year that was full of magic for the Heels, blasting a walk-off grand slam against LIU in the team's opening round win.

► 2025's regional saw him go nuclear, averaging .722 at the plate with 13 hits, seven runs, three doubles, his first career triple, three home runs, and 10 RBIs.

► The hits and RBIs were the most by a Heel in a regional this century and the three homers were the most since 2006. He failed to reach safely just four times all weekend.

► He finished the season with team highs in hits (77) and RBIs (68) while being second in home runs (17). Those totals were enough to see him into third in the ACC in RBIs and eighth in home runs.

FULL CIRCLE FOR WINSLOW

► He may be new to the Heels, but his connections to this team run deep.

► Winslow spent the final two seasons of his high school career at Pro5 Academy under coach Sean Gallaher (Gavin's dad) while living with the Gallaher's throughout that time. Gavin and Macon are living with each other once again in Chapel Hill.

► Going even further back, Macon's father Leary played for Heels' assistant coach Scott Jackson when they were both at Barton.

JUST A COUPLE OF WEST DES MOINES HOOPERS

► Suddenly a hot bed of high-level athletes, Dowling Catholic High School has produced our own Cooper Nicholson as well as only slightly more famous women's basketball superstar, Caitlin Clark.

► As a freshman, Nicholson was on the men's team at Dowling. Part of the routine would be for his freshmen squad to practice against the varsity women's team.

► In these scrimmages, it was often Nicholson's unfortunate assignment to have to guard the two-time Gatorade Player of the Year. Safe to say this didn't go particularly well for the young Nicholson.

► "She's basically what made me realize basketball wouldn't be my sport."

HULL FAMILY HISTORY IN SOUTH BEND

► Starting outfielder Owen Hull has an athletic bloodline that run deep, all the way back to his grandfather who played running back at Notre Dame.

► George Hull, Owen's father's father, was a member of the Fighting Irish football team "sometime in the early 1940s" for what ended up being a brief time, spending only his freshman year in South Bend before he enlisted in the U.S. Navy to go fight in World War II.

► Owen credits his athleticism to his grandfather, who was known as a "physical player with a lot of speed."

FORBES AGREES TO CONTRACT EXTENSION

► Carolina baseball head coach Scott Forbes, who has led his team to five NCAA Regionals, three Super Regionals and one College World Series during his five-year tenure, has agreed to terms on a new contract extension.

► He is in the midst of another successful campaign in his sixth year in charge of the Heels since taking the head coaching reigns from the Hall of Famer Mike Fox.

► Forbes has led Carolina to the NCAA postseason in all five seasons of his tenure, the first coach in program history to do so.

► Named the ACC Coach of the Year in 2024, Forbes has also had tremendous success in conference competition. He has led the Heels to a pair of ACC Tournament championships (2022, 2025) and an ACC Coastal Division championship (2024).

► An incredible developer of talent, Forbes and his staff have coached nine All-Americans, had 26 named to an All-ACC team, and seen 21 taken in the MLB Draft.

► In his 25 years as a member of the Tar Heels' coaching staff, Forbes has helped lead UNC to 19 NCAA Tournament appearances, eight trips to the College World Series, eight ACC division titles, and five ACC Tournament titles.

HEELS EARN PRESEASON HONORS

► A number of Tar Heels have been tabbed for big things this season, receiving a litany of preseason honors to reflect the high expectations.

► Four stars in Jason DeCaro, Gavin Gallaher, Ryan Lynch, and Walker McDuffie were named preseason All-Americans by various outlets.

► DeCaro and Gallaher made all three lists. McDuffie clocked in with the NCBWA and D1Baseball while Lynch was honored by Perfect Game.

► The duo of Decaro and Gallaher were also named to the Golden Spikes Preseason Watch List, recognizing the best players at any position heading into the season.

► Macon Winslow was one of just 10 in the nation to be named to the Buster Posey Catch of the Year preseason watch list.

2025 REWIND

UNC PUNCHES 37TH NCAA TOURNEY TICKET

- ▶ North Carolina qualified for the NCAA tournament for the 37th time in its history and for the eighth year in a row, the longest active streak in the ACC.
- ▶ The Heels were tabbed as the No. 5 national seed, the first they had ever been given that particular number and the second straight top-5 seeding. It was the 10th time in program history earning a top-10 seed.
- ▶ Carolina leads the nation in the number of times hosting regionals since 2006, sitting in a tie with Florida State at 13 in that span. It marked the 14th overall time hosting a regional and sixth in the last eight seasons.
- ▶ Forbes has lead the Tar Heels into the postseason each of his first five seasons, the only coach in program history to do so.
- ▶ UNC would go 3-1 in the Chapel Hill Regional to advance to the program's 12 all-time super regional. It was the ninth time Boshamer Stadium played host in the super regional round.
- ▶ The postseason run came up one win shy of Omaha, as the Heels couldn't quite get past Arizona in the three-game Chapel Hill Super Regional.

TAR HEEL'S CLAIM NINTH TOURNAMENT TITLE

- ▶ The Diamond Heels ran away with a 14-4 win over Clemson to earn the program's ninth ACC tournament championship, their first since 2022 and second under head coach Scott Forbes.
- ▶ UNC's offense exploded to amass the program's largest ever margin of victory in a title game. They now sit in a tie for the second most tournament titles in conference history.
- ▶ Sophomore standout Luke Stevenson earned ACC Tournament MVP honors after mashing two crucial home runs in the first two games of the weekend. Jake Knapp and Jackson Van De Brake joined him on the all-tournament team. Van De Brake's towering three-run shot highlighted an eight-run fifth that sealed the game.
- ▶ Cardiac Carolina was alive and well in Durham as the team battled back from deficits in both of their final two contests.
- ▶ The Heels rallied late on Friday night to take a 7-2 win over Boston College in the quarterfinals.
- ▶ UNC put up seven unanswered runs across the seventh and eighth innings to overcome a two-run Eagles advantage. The crushing blow came once again from Van De Brake, who delivered a two-strike, two-RBI double that tied the game in the seventh.
- ▶ The team then needed some ninth inning heroics on Saturday night, but came out on top of a back-and-forth affair with Florida State 7-5. Eventually Carolina got a two RBI single from Kane Kepley in the top of the final frame to take their third win over the Noles in the last 10 days.

KNAPP NAMED NATIONAL PITCHER OF THE YEAR

- ▶ Captain Knapp, back from a season-ending elbow injury the year prior, put together arguably the greatest single season on the mound in program history.
- ▶ He finished 2025 with a UNC record, perfect 14-0 record to go with a ACC best 2.02 ERA and 88 strikeouts with just 16 walks.
- ▶ His phenomenal year earned him the College Baseball Foundation's National Pitcher of the Year award as well as ACC Pitcher of the Year honors.
- ▶ He is the first Tar heel to be named the nation's top arm since Andrew Miller in 2006 and the fifth to win the conference's honor, the first since J.B. Bukauskas in 2017.

FOUR EARN ALL-AMERICA HONORS

- ▶ Knapp and Stevenson highlighted the postseason awards for Carolina, becoming the program's 67th and 68th All-America award winners.
- ▶ Knapp was a unanimous selection across all six national lists, earning four first-team nods. He and Vance Honeycutt are the only two six-team honorees in Forbes tenure at the helm.
- ▶ Freshman phenoms Ryan Lynch and Walker McDuffie were also recognized for their incredible debut seasons, giving Carolina two Freshman All-Americans in back-to-back season for the first time since 2007-08.

HISTORY ON THE HILL

- ▶ Against Gardner-Webb North Carolina baseball did what it had not done yet this century, throwing a no-hitter in its run-rule 11-1 win.
- ▶ It was the program's first combined no-no since Chris Elmore and Ryan Earey kept Towson off the board in March of 1999. It's just the program's third no-hitter of any kind since at least 1978.
- ▶ UNC is now one of just three schools to have thrown a no-hitter in both baseball and softball in 2025.
- ▶ Forbes was a volunteer assistant for UNC's last no-no in 1999. It was the first time being a part of one for pitching coach Bryant Gaines.
- ▶ Folger Boaz (3.0), Olin Johnson (3.0) and Camron Seagraves (1.0) were phenomenal, recording eight strikeouts and just one walk on the historic night.
- ▶ While the pitchers were busy shoving on the mound, the Carolina bats were carrying their weight to wrap this game up in seven on Tuesday night. 11 runs on 10 hits powered the Heels to their third run-rule win of the season.

THREE STRAIGHT 40 WIN SEASONS FOR FORBES

- ▶ Sixth year head coach Scott Forbes has his program in a great place, securing 40+ win seasons in three consecutive years for the first time in his tenure.
- ▶ UNC has won 40 or more games in seven of the last nine seasons and in 17 of Forbes' 25 years as a member of the Tar Heels' coaching staff.
- ▶ The program now has 27 40-win seasons in its history with its first 40-win season posted in 1983 (42-10).

FOUR HEELS TAKEN IN 2025 MLB DRAFT

- ▶ North Carolina had two players selected on day one and two more on the final day to give Forbes 21 draftees as head coach.
- ▶ Stevenson's first round selection highlighted the bunch. Taken 35th by the Seattle Mariners, his selection gave Carolina 26 first-round picks in program history, including 13 since 2006.
- ▶ He was also the first Carolina catcher to be taken in the first since College Baseball Hall of Famer B.J. Surhoff went 1.01 in 1985.
- ▶ Kepley followed close behind with an early second round selection by the Cubs. The pair are the first Heels to be selected in the first two rounds of the same draft since 2019.
- ▶ Aidan Haugh and Knapp followed in the 6th and 8th to the Rays and Cubs respectively. Their selections made it the most Tar Heels taken in the first eight rounds of a draft since 2015.

► Carolina faced off against their historic rivals Duke over the weekend in Durham and came away with their seventh straight ACC series victory thanks to wins on Thursday and Saturday.

► Jason DeCaro dazzled on Thursday to lead UNC to a 3-1 win. His second longest outing of the year, DeCaro finished his 7.2 IP with seven Ks, three hits and only one unearned run, scored on an error after he'd left the game. Including his last start vs. Georgia Tech, he's thrown 12.2 innings while giving up just one earned run.

► Friday saw another brilliant performance from the Carolina starter as Ryan Lynch racked up a career-high nine strikeouts in a loss where he gave up no earned runs. All three Blue Devil runs were scored on one error.

► Saturday was an offensive explosion, as the Heels won 22-5 in their highest scoring game since 2010 and the most they'd put up in an ACC contest since 2000 against Maryland.

► After a pair of scoreless frames to start, Carolina put up a crooked number in five straight innings to run away with the game. Duke deployed nine pitchers to try and slow them down, the most UNC had seen this year.

MADE A STATEMENT ON A NATIONAL STAGE

Georgia Tech | 4.17-19 | Chapel Hill

► Over the weekend it was a battle of No. 3 and No. 2 as Carolina hosted Georgia Tech in the highest ranked matchup of the season in college baseball and the highest in Boshamer Stadium history.

► The Heels emerged victorious with wins in the first two games to take the monumental series.

► In Friday's bounce back game, UNC took an early lead off early RBIs from Jake Schaffner and Gavin Gallaher and never looked back. The trio of Jason DeCaro, Caden Glauber, and Walker McDuffie held BC without a hit until 7.2 innings of this game had already been thrown and just three total on the day.

► Down four in the finale, Carolina needed five unanswered runs and lockdown pitching down the stretch to take the series. Owen Hull knocked the game winning single in the seventh that rewarded excellent work from Jackson Rose and Walker McDuffie who threw the final 3.2 frames and combined to surrender just one hit and no runs with four strikeouts.

► Carolina traveled to the heart of the Midwest of the weekend for a showdown with the newly ranked No. 23 Notre Dame Fighting Irish. ► The Heels put up 41 hits across the three games in South Bend, their most in a weekend since May 2024 against Louisville and the most on the road since putting up 45 against Boston College in 2017.

► The first game of the doubleheader was the closest of the weekend, finishing 6-5 after a wild pitch scored Tyler Howe in the top of the eighth for what would be the game winning run. Howe and Nicholson hit solo homers while starter Jason DeCaro racked up a career high nine strikeouts.

► A six run sixth propelled UNC to a 13-7 win in game two on Saturday. Erik Paulsen led the way in that one, going 4-6 with two doubles, two RBIs, and two runs scored.

► In the series finale, Jake Schaffner set the tone with a leadoff homer and the offense ran from there. Carolina put up 15 runs on 15 hits to complete the sweep.

► The Tar Heels faced DI debutants Le Moyne over the weekend and put together their most dominant weekend series this century, winning all three games via run-rule for the first time in program history.

► Carolina has won four straight via mercy rule, also the first time in program history accomplishing that feat.

► The 49 total runs was the most UNC has scored in a weekend series since at least 1990.

► It also reset the clock on a slew of series best number. UNC's .412 batting average was its best ever in a weekend under Forbes. The 35 hits is the most since 36 in the Louisville series in 2024.

► Seven Heels hit over .400 in their ABs against the Dolphins, led by Jake Schaffner (.625), Colin Hynek (.625), and Erik Paulsen (.600). That trio combined for 18 runs, eight extra base hits, and 18 RBIs.

► Sunday's finale especially brought the fireworks, as Carolina ran away with a 21-1 victory to secure the sweep. It was the most runs the team had scored in a game since a 21-6 win over Duke in 2021 and the 20-point margin was the largest since a 20-0 win over Virginia Tech in May of 2017.

► Biggest highlight was the sixth inning grand slam from Jadyn Nunez, his first collegiate hit. Carolina had not had a pinch-hit grand slam since Jackson Hesterlee did it against Georgia Tech on April 21, 2008.

► The weekend started strong for Carolina with a 10-0 eighth inning run rule in the Jungle in Greenville.

► Everyone in the lineup recorded a hit and Cooper Nicholson especially was on top of his game, reaching safely in every plate appearance via a home run, a two-RBI double and two HBPs.

► But the real star was Jason DeCaro, who was sensational in enemy territory, tossing a complete game shutout with seven strikeouts while only allowing five hits and one walk. Only two ECU runners reached third.

► It was the team's first eight inning complete game since Kent Emmanuel against Miami on May 23, 2013.

► Saturday's game went ECU's way. Gavin Gallaher's three-run blast to tie it in the third was the highlight, but the Pirates got the runs down the stretch to take a 10-3 victory at the Durham Bulls Athletic Park.
