CHARLOTTE 49ERS (2-5; C-USA: 1-2)
at MARSHALL THUNDERING HERD (2-4; C-USA: 1-1)
GAME 8



The Charlotte 49ers (2-5; 1-2) travel to Marshall (2-4; 1-1) with an opportunity to even their Conference USA record at 2-2. Charlotte is looking for win #3 of the year, which would be the most as an FBS school. Both Charlotte and Marshall have picked up league wins over Florida Atlantic. QB **Hasaan Klugh** has started the last two games, leading Charlotte to it's first C-USA win and a one-point loss to FIU.

Charlotte is in season four of football and season two at the FBS level. The 49ers 19-member red-shirt senior class makes up the 49ers' First Class, which helped start the program in 2012 before the 2013 inaugural season. Seven projected starters (OL **Casey Perry**; OL **Thomas La Bianca**; H **Justin Bolus**; WR **Austin Duke**; DL **Larry Ogunjobi**; DL **Brandon Banks**; LB **Daquan Lucas**) come from that first class, in addition to two others that joined the senior class (RB **Kalif Phillips**; LB **Nick Cook**). Five other starters are enjoying their first playing season with the 49ers: QB **Hasaan Klugh**, LB **Tyriq Harris**; S **AJ McDonald**; S **Ben DeLuca** and CB **Kedrick Davis**.

In the last four games, RB **Kalif Phillips** (40 car. TDs) has surpassed 100 yards from scrimmage (rush/rcv) four times (174 at FAU; 109 vs. ODU; 126 at Temple; 112 vs. FIU) with three games of 99+ yards rushing (132, FAU; 114, Temple; 99, FIU). Over the last six games, the 49ers have had seven 100-yard efforts, including Fr. **Robert Washington** (120 ru. vs. Eastern Michigan) and R-Sr. **Austin Duke** (103 rec. vs. Elon; 111 at FAU.). Charlotte averages 185.3 yds on the ground (3rd, C-USA) and 200.1 in the air (10th, C-USA). The 49ers put up 400 yds of total offense in 3 of the last 4 games.

On defense, 2015 top tackler **Nick Cook** leads the 49ers again with 61 tackles (7th C-USA; 8.7/gm) and was the 49ers top tackler in a school-record five straight games. The secondary, with first-year 49ers **Kedrick Davis** (3 INT), **Ed Rolle** (2), **Ben DeLuca** (2) and **Alex Duncan** (1), is first in C-USA with 8 picks. R-Sr. **Larry Ogunjobi** had a season-hi 10 tackles in each of the last two games adding 7.0 TFL and 1.5 sacks. Ogunjobi ranks 2nd in C-USA with 9.5 TFL this year, 0.5 shy of his third straight season with 10.0 TFL. Charlotte ranks fourth in C-USA in rushing defense 153.0 ru yd/gm. and held FIU to just 39 rushing yards, the fewest allowed to an FBS foe and the third this season below 100.

CHARLOTTE 49ER NOTES:

WHO'S HOT: In 4 games since return from inj. (vs. EMU), **Kalif Phillips** has 4 straight 100+-yd games from scrimmage including three 99+-yd rushing games ... Fr. S **Ben DeLuca** has an INT in each of the last two games and had 14 tackles, the most by a 49er this season (w/ an INT), at FAU ... DL **Larry Ogunjobi** had back-to-back games vs. FAU and FIU with double-digit tackles (10 in each) and matched his career-high school-record with 4.5 TFL vs. FIU ... **Austin Duke** had a 111-yd game that included a 69-yd TD pass at FAU ... **Hasaan Klugh** ranks 4th in C-USA in pass efficiency (153.0).

BEDNARIK AWARD; OUTLAND TROPHY LISTS: R-Sr. DL **Larry Ogunjobi** is on the Watch List for the the Bednarik Award (top college defender) and the Outland Trophy (top interior lineman) -- the first 49er to be named to the Watch List for a major national award. A second-team all-Conference USA selection, he was second in the league with a school-record 14.5 TFL last year. His 45.0 career TFL are another school-record and rank 7th in the NCAA among active FBS players (1.10/gm).

DUKE RANKS AMONG FBS TOP 5: R-Sr. WR **Austin Duke** ranks 5th in career receiving yards (3,089), 5th in car. receptions (229) and 8th in car. rec. yds/gm (75.3) among active FBS players.

GOLD NUGGETS: Charlotte has thrown a TD pass in 11 straight games, one shy of the school record ... Austin Duke's last 6 TD catches, dating back to last year, have come from five different QBs ... Charlotte has passed for over 170 yards in six straight games with Hasaan Klugh passing for a career-high 223 yards at FAU ... Charlotte ranks 7th in C-USA in total offense (385.4/gm) ... Charlotte has had at least one INT in 6 of 7 games ... the 49ers 8 INTs rank T1st in C-USA.

KLUGH NAMED C-USA POTW: Oct. 10, Hasaan Klugh became the first 49er to earn C-USA Offensive Player of the Week honors after throwing for a season-high 223 yards (3 pass TD; 1 rush TD) at FAU in the 49ers first-ever C-USA victory. He ran for 54 yards and threw to 3 different receivers for TDs.

TAKEAWAYS: The 49ers rank 1st in C-USA with 8 INTs and T3rd in TO margin (E) ... Charlotte has had at least one takeaway in 6 of 7 games (O at Temple) ... S **Ben DeLuca** has an INT in each of the last 2 games and shares the team lead with 3 takeaways ... CB **Kedrick Davis** leads the 49ers and is T2nd in C-USA with 3 picks ... his 3 INTs are one shy of the 49ers school record (4, **Terrance Winchester**, 2015) and land Davis 3rd all-time on the 49ers career INT charts ... **Davis** and **DeLuca** are 5th on the career takeaway list ... the 8 INTs are all from first-year 49ers (Davis; Rolle; Duncan; DeLuca) ... the 49ers turned fumble recoveries into TDs in the first two games (**Anthony Covington**, recovered muffed punt in endzone at UL; **Ben DeLuca** returned fumble 59 yards for TD vs. Elon) ... DeLuca's 59-yard TD is the longest fumble return in school history.

PHILLIPS BREAKS FREE: all-C-USA Sr. RB **Kalif Phillips** continues to impress with his hard-pounding style. Phillips has surpassed 3,500 career rushing yards, notched his 40th career TD vs. Old Dominion

and has a four 100-yard performances from scrimmage in the last four games. His 3,548 career rushing yards rank 9th among active FBS rushers. His 40 career TDs are a school record. Since returning from injury he has posted 4 straight 100-yard games from scrimmage and two 100-yard rushing outings to give him 13 in his career. His 132 rushing yards at FAU are the most by a 49er this season. At Temple he broke off a 66-yard TD run on his way to 114 rushing yards. The TD run is the longest TD run of the season and the 49ers 4th longest TD run in school history. Against ODU, he caught a 42-yard TD pass. It is the second straight year that Phillips rushed for 100+ vs. Temple (125, last year).

DUKE STARTS SHARP: R-Sr. WR **Austin Duke**, the 49ers all-time leading pass catcher, caught a TD pass in the first two games and has led the 49ers in receiving in five games. Through 7 games, he has over 450 rec. yds (455; 10th C-USA, 65.0/gm), three TDs and two 100-yard performances. He has surpassed 3,000 car. rec. yds (3,089). His 76-yd TD vs. Elon is the longest TD of the season and the fourth longest TD catch in school history while his 69-yard catch and run at FAU helped propel the 49ers to their first-ever C-USA win. He finished with 103 yards vs. Elon and 111 at FAU, his 11th career 100-yard game. His 24-yd TD pass from Kevin Olsen at #19/#23 Louisville was the 49ers first score of 2016, the 49ers first

score against a nationally-ranked FBS foe and the first TD thrown by new QB Olsen. Among FBS active players, he ranks 5th in career rec. yds (3,089) and car. receptions (229) and 8th in car. rec. yds/gm (75.3).

LARRY O BRINGS THE D: DL Larry Ogunjobi, who tied for 2nd in C-USA in tackles for loss with a school-record 14.5 (1.21/gm), last year, ranks 2nd with 9.5 TFL (1.36/gm), again this year. The biology/computer science double major matched his school record with 4.5 TFL vs. FIU. He ranks 8th in the NCAA among active FBS players with 45.0 career TFL (1.10 TFL/gm). Ogunjobi has double-digit tackles in the last two games. He holds the 49ers career record with 189 tackles. His 11.5 career sacks are another school mark.

AND THEN THERE WAS ONE ALL-TIME STARTER: DL Larry Ogunjobi made his 41st career start against ODU. He is the only player that has started every game in 49ers history. OL Danny Book graduated, last season, after starting all 34 games in the first 3 years. **Brandon Banks** (38) and **Austin Duke** (36) rank 2nd and 3rd to Ogunjobi in career starts.

COOK SPICES UP DEFENSE: Last year's leading tackler, r-Sr. ILB **Nick Cook**, led the 49ers in tackles in the first five games, this year. With a team-high 61 tackles, he's on pace to break the 49ers single-season record and ranks 7th in C-USA with 8.7 tkl/gm. He's had two games with double-digit tackles. Earlier this year, Cook registered his 100th career tackle in his 14th game - the fastest 49er to 100 tackles in 49ers history. He's moved quickly to 4th in program history with 136 career tackles.

FANTASTIC DEBUT FOR KLUGH: R-So. QB **Hasaan Klugh**, who sat out last year as a transfer from NC A&T, made his first start as a 49er at FAU, leading Charlotte to its first-ever C-USA victory. He connected on 14-of-17 passes (school-record 82.4%) and threw for a 49ers' season-high 223 yards and 3 TD's (to three different receivers). He had TD passes of 69 yards (Austin Duke), 37 yards (TL Ford II) and 3 yards (Justin Bolus). He also rushed for 54 yards, including a 28-yard scamper and a two-yard TD run. He was named C-USA co-Offensive Player of the Week for his efforts -- the 49ers first Offensive POTW and the second C-USA POTW in school history (Blake Brewer, Special Teams, 2015).

FROSH RUNS WILD: True Fr. RB **Robert Washington** has passed 300 rushing yds as a freshman (326 yds) and leads the team in rushing TDs (4). He ran for 120 yards on 20 carries vs. Eastern Michigan -- the 2nd-most by a freshman in 49ers history (Kalif Phillips, 132 v. Coastal Carolina, 2013). It was Washington's first 100-yard rushing day and he became the fifth 49er runner and 2nd freshman to run for 100 yards. It was Charlotte's 17th 100-yard rushing game, in history.

OFFENSE LIGHTS UP ELON: Charlotte had a season-high 506 yards of total offense in the win over Elon - the 11th game all-time with at least 500 yards of total offense ... the seven TDs scored vs. Elon rank tied for 2nd in program history ... the four receiving TDs vs. Elon are tied for 3rd all-time ... the 49ers tied a record vs. Elon with four players (**TL Ford II**, **Kyle Hoffman**, **Justin Bolus**, **Austin Duke**) pulling in TD catches ... QB **Kevin Olsen** threw three TD passes vs. Elon (to three receivers) -- becoming the first QB to throw at least three TDs since 2014 and just the second QB (Matt Johnson) in school history to do so.

TOP RETURNEES: All-C-USA selections **Kalif Phillips** (Sr., RB) and **Larry Ogunjobi** (r-Sr.; DL) top the 49ers returners. Phillips has rushed for over 3,500 yards in his career (9th among active FBS rushers) and Ogunjobi is the 49ers all-time leader in tackles, TFL and sacks. Charlotte also returns r-Sr. ILB **Nick Cook**, who led the 49ers in tackles; R-Sr. CB **Terrance Winchester** (inj.), who broke the single-season school record with a C-USA-leading 4 INTs; R-Sr. WR **Austin Duke**, who has over 3,000 career receiving yards; and four O-Line returning starters: R-Sr. **Jamal Covington** (inj.); R-Sr. **Casey Perry**; R-Sr. **Thomas La Bianca**; R-So. **Nate Davis**, who have combined for 112 career starts.

WHAT'S NEW: Two starting QBs are both new to the team: **Hasaan Klugh** sat out last year as a transfer from NC A&T while **Kevin Olsen** transferred in from Riverside (Calif.) City C.C. ... R-Sr. **Matt Johnson**, the 49ers all-time passing leader, has been moved to running back ... three newcomers: CB **Kedrick Davis** (North Carolina), Fr. S **Ben DeLuca** (Orlando, Fla.) and r-Fr. S **AJ McDonald** (Bamberg, S.C.) start in the secondary while r-Fr. **Tyriq Harris** has taken over as a starting outside linebacker ... **Dean Hood** was hired as Assistant Head Coach following the 2015 season ... five full recruiting classes (2012-2016) are in camp for the first time in program history ... 2016 is the first year of bowl eligibility.

EVERY GAME PLAYED: Nine 49ers have played every game in 49ers history: **Lee McNeill; Austin Duke; Daquan Lucas; Keaston Sinicki; Jarred Barr; Larry Ogunjobi; Blake Brewer; Zach Bumgarner and Tanner Fleming.**

WHAT'S OLD: The 49ers roster includes 19 RS seniors that were part of the program's First Class in 2012. That year, they practiced amid construction vehicles without a game to be played. In 2013, they enjoyed the inaugural season and in 2015, they celebrated the program's FBS debut. They helped establish what head coach Brad Lambert refers to as a "rock-solid foundation" ... of 748 starts made over the program's first three years, 51% return for 2016 ... Four players started each game in which they played in the first three years: DL **Larry Ogunjobi**, 34; DL **Brandon Banks**, 32; WR **Trent Bostick**, 32; OL **Jamal Covington**, 30. Ogunjobi started each game (34) in the program's first three years.

SECONDARY SWITCH: Charlotte looks to replace three starters from 2015 in the secondary. R-Sr. **Terrance Winchester (out-inj)** returns at one cornerback slot after sharing the league lead with a school-record 4 INTs, last year. Winchester holds the 49ers career records for INT's (7) and take-aways (9: 7 INT; 2 FR). Three newcomers are earmarked for the other starting slots including North Carolina transfer **Kedrick Davis** (S), junior college transfer **Ed Rolle** (CB) and r-Fr. **AJ McDonald** (S). In addition, returnees **Markevis Davis** (S), **Anthony Covington** (CB) and **Denzel Irvin** (CB) give the 49ers more experience in the secondary. Also keep your eye on Navy transfer **Alex Duncan**, who had a strong spring after sitting out the 2015 campaign and true freshman **Ben DeLuca**, who has started the last three games with picks in the last two.

BACKFIELD DEPTH: **Kalif Phillips** (190 ru. in 2015) was one of three players in Conference USA with 190 or more rushes, last year (Kenneth Dixon, La. Tech, 197; Ray Lawry, ODU, 194). He averaged 20.7 carries through the first nine games and was on pace for over 240 carries, before injury limited him to four carries over his last two games played. His 35 rushes at ODU were the most in the league, last year. In 2016, the 49ers expect to give their workhorse more rests, thanks to returner **Bradán Smith** and newcomers **Matt Johnson** (converted QB); four-star recruit **Robert Washington** and three-star recruit **Ben LeMay**.

DEBUTS: Several 49ers made their debuts in the season-opener at #19/#23 Louisville. Here's a look at a few:

O-LINE EXPERIENCE: Charlotte returns four starters who combined for 90 career starts on the O-Line over the first three years. Three of them: **Jamal Covington** (30 starts), **Casey Perry** (25) and **Thomas La Bianca** (25) started each of the 49ers first three years and **Nate Davis** (10) moved into the starting lineup as a red-shirt freshman last year. **Chris Brown** made one start as a red-shirt freshman last year. Back-ups like **Jarred Barr**, **Wolfgang Zacherl** and **Eugene German** combined for 15 starts over the first three years, giving the 49ers their strongest dose of O-Line depth.

D-LINE STRONGHOLD: The D-Line includes the 49ers career record holder in tackles, tackles for loss and sacks (**Larry Ogunjobi**), last year's sack leader (**Zach Duncan**, 4.0) and three-year starter **Brandon Banks**. Like the O-Line, the 49ers have improved their depth with the return of R-Sr. **Tanner Fleming**, a three-year back-up to Ogunjobi, R-Jr. **Nick Carroll** and R-Fr. **Randy Suydam**, who have both made starts in 2016.

IMPACT LINEBACKERS: 2015 leading tackler **Nick Cook** (73 tackles) anchors the linebacking corps that includes **Karrington King** (53 tackles in 2015), who was 4th on the team in tackles despite making just three starts. On the outside, senior swiss army knife **Daquan Lucas** had 48 tackles, was second on the team with 10.0 TFL and 2.5 sacks and led the team with 7 PBU. The other OLB spot will be locked down by R-Jr. **Jordan Starnes** and/or R-Fr. **Tyriq Harris**. R-Fr. **Jeff Gemmell** could make an impact while upperclassmen **Justin Bridges-Thompson (Sr.)** and **Garrison Duncan (R-Jr.)** offer experienced depth on the inside.

PRESEASON ALL-CONFERENCE USA: Charlotte is led by a pair of preseason all-Conference USA selections who were both named 2nd-team all-C-USA, last year: Sr. RB **Kalif Phillips**; R-Sr. DL **Larry Ogunjobi**. Phillips, a two-year starter, has rushed for over 3,500 yards in his four-year career. In 2015, he rushed for 961 yards and 5 TDs despite getting just four carries for 10 yards over the final three games due to injury. Phillips ranked fifth in C-USA in rushing and was among the league leaders with 190 carries. Ogunjobi, who has started all 41 games in school history and holds career records for tackles, tackles for loss and sacks, is on the Watch Lists for the Bednarik Award (nation's top defensive player) and the Outland Trophy (nation's top interior lineman). He was second in C-USA with 14.5 TFL, last year.

ALL IN THE FAMILY: Charlotte has three sets of brothers on the roster: **Uriah and Ben LeMay**; **Garrison and Zach Duncan** and twins **Darius and Denzel Irvin**. In addition, slot receiver **Nate Mullen** is the son of Offensive Coordinator **Jeff Mullen**.

STEPS TO MAKING THE LEAP TO THE FBS:

In 1946, the two-year Charlotte Center of the University of North Carolina (CCUNC), was established to handle the influx of servicemen returning from the war. In 1949, a successful push by community leaders, including recognized founder Bonnie Cone, made the school a permanent institution of higher education in the Charlotte area. In 1965, the school earned university status and became part of the UNC system. In 1970, UNC Charlotte joined the ranks of NCAA Division I institutions. In 1976, the 49ers became charter members of their first athletic conference: The Sun Belt Conference (and won that league title in men's basketball to earn an NCAA Tournament bid -- one that the 49ers took all the way to the 1977 Final Four.) In 2013, the 49ers enjoyed their first NCAA FCS football season and, in 2015, the 49ers made their FBS debut.

The 49ers, who were charter members of Conference USA in 1995, returned to the league in 2013, bringing with them the promise of an upstart football program. Now, that football program has completed its first season of Conference USA and its first season at the FBS level.

"We've had a lot of firsts in starting this program, but this probably the biggest," said head coach Brad Lambert.

CONFERENCE USA, 2015:

The 49ers, who held their inaugural game Aug. 31, 2013, made the move to Conference USA in 2015 with an opportunity to gain full FBS member status with bowl eligibility in 2016. Charlotte was invited to join the league in 2012 -- before the 49ers had played their first game or even held their first practice.

49ERS GOLD RUSH, 2015: Sr. RB **Kalif Phillips** ranked 5th in Conference USA in 2015 in rushing (87.4/gm) despite combining for just 10 yards on 4 rushes over the last three games (injury) .. His 99.0 rushing average against C-USA schools ranked 6th ... **Phillips** rushed for over 100 yards in 3 games (159 vs. FAU; 125 vs. Temple; 204 at ODU) with 99 (Marshall) in a fourth ... his three 100-yard games came consecutively and he averaged 162.7 yards over that span ... his 204 yards at ODU are a new school record and the first over 200 yards ... his 36-yard TD run at Old Dominion was the 49ers longest TD run of the season ... he had 35 rushes in the ODU game, the most in C-USA last year and one shy of his school-record of 36 ... he rushed for two TDs at ODU, which was his first multiple TD game of the year and the 12th of his career ... he has 11 career 100-yard games and he owns the 49ers top eight single-game performances ... with 961 yards, he was just 39 shy of his 2nd straight 1,000-yard season ... His 3,146 career yards are 11th among active FBS rushers. He has been hampered by a hamstring injury suffered vs. Elon. He missed the EMU game.

DEFENSE: In 2015, Charlotte set single-season records for sacks (21) and TFL (85), breaking the marks set in the program's final year of FCS play .. the 49ers ranked 4th in C-USA in pass defense (228.4 yds/gm) and 6th in third-down defense (38.7% conversion allowed) ... three foes (Presby; FAU; Temple) were held below their season average in total yards ... 5 teams were held below 140 yds rushing and 5 below 150 yds passing.

19 FORM ROCK-SOLD FOUNDATION:

Charlotte has 19 players on the roster that have been with the program since day one, practicing throughout the 2012 season and taking part in each of the program's first three competitive campaigns. These trailblazers are back for a fifth and final year with the program:
