DRAMATIC COMEBACK - Charlotte rallied from a 24-point deficit with 14:01 on the second half clock to defeat Oklahoma State (11/10), 66-64. The comeback was the second largest in school history. The school-record comeback was a 26-point comeback victory over Tennessee on the road, November 29, 1995. The 49ers trailed Tennessee, 53-27, with 15:04 on the second half clock.

COACH SANCHEZ FIRST WIN - Charlotte defeated Oklahoma State (11/10), 66-64, for Coach Ron Sanchez's first win as the 49ers head coach.

CONFERENCE USA PLAYER OF THE WEEK - Jon Davis earned his third career Conference USA Player of the Week award (11/12). Davis averaged 29 points in the 49ers' two games capped off by his game-winning three in the 49ers dramatic come-from-behind win over Oklahoma State on Saturday.

PRESEASON ALL-CONFERENCE USA - Senior guard Jon Davis was voted preseason All-Conference USA by the league's 14 head coaches. Last season, Davis finished sixth in Conference USA in scoring at 17.6 points per game and assists 5.5 per game.

1,000 CAREER POINTS - Jon Davis became the 27th player in school history to score 1,000 career points in the Oklahoma State game (11/13). He was the sixth fastest to reach 1,000 career points in school history. Davis currently has 1,561 career points which places him 13th on the 49ers career scoring list. Henry Williams (1989-92) holds the 49ers career scoring record with 2,383 points.

100 ASSISTS SEASON - Jon Davis currently has 449 career assists which moves him into 6th place on the 49ers career assists list. Davis is the fifth player in school history to record at least three 100 assists seasons. Twenty-five players have recorded at least one 100 assists season in school history.

HALTON ARENA SCORING RECORD - Jon Davis scored 31 points in the 49ers season-opener against Chattanooga (11/6) which marked his fourth career 30-plus points scoring game. All four of those games have been in Halton Arena.

Although the university's name remains (UNC Charlotte), please refer to us as simply "Charlotte" or "Charlotte 49ers" in your coverage this season.

Last season, Jon Davis scored 38 points against Marshall (January 11) which set the Halton Arena scoring record by a Niner. The previous record was 36 points scored by Leemire Goldwire against Saint Joseph's (January 16, 2008). Davis scored 37 points against FIU (3/1) which is the second most points scored by a Niner in Halton Arena history. During the 2016-17 season, Davis scored 35 points in Halton Arena against Old Dominion (January 21, 2017) which is tied for the fourth most points scored by a Charlotte player in Halton Arena. Davis's 38 points is tied with Lew Massey (38 points vs. VCU, February 16, 1978) for the seventh most points scored by

Supica Impact Off The Bench - In the 49ers last two games, Milos Supica has recorded a double-figure scoring game off the bench with 10 points against James Madison (11/16). He recorded a double-figure rebounds game with 12 boards off the bench in the 49ers win over

Oklahoma State (11/10).

30-POINT SCORING GAMES - Jon Davis scored 31 points in the 49ers season-opener against Chattanooga (11/6). This marked Davis's fourth career 30-plus points scoring game. Charlotte has had a player score at least 30 points in a game 109 times in school history.

COACH SANCHEZ'S FIRST GAME - The Chattanooga game marked the Charlotte 49ers coaching debut of Ron Sanchez, who is the 11th head coach in the program's history. The 49ers lost to Chattanooga so Charlotte coaches have a 6-5 all-time record in their first game at the helm of the 49ers men's basketball program.

SEASON OPENER- Charlotte posts a 37-17 all-time record in their season openers, and has won ten of their last 13. This year is the 36th season in which the 49ers play their first game at home and they boast a 25-11 record in those previous games.

CONFERENCE USA HISTORY - The 49ers, who were an original member of Conference USA from 1995-2005, are in their sixth year back in Conference USA after spending eight years in the Atlantic 10. During the 49ers time in Conference USA, Charlotte has captured two Conference USA Tournament titles (1999 and 2001) and a share of the 2004 Conference USA regular-season title. During the 49ers' 16 years in Conference USA, Charlotte has made seven trips to the NCAA

Tournament and one trip to the NIT. The 49ers have compiled an overall record of 255-211 and a Conference USA record of 130-112 during their 16 years in Conference USA. Six times the 49ers have won 20 games while a member of Conference USA. Two former 49ers standouts (DeMarco Johnson - 1998 and Eddie Basden - 2005) were named Conference USA Player of the Year. Former 49ers coach Melvin Watkins was named Conference USA Coach of the Year in 1997. Basden earned Conference USA Defensive Player of the Year honors twice (2004 and 2005). Rodney White was the 2001 Conference USA Freshman of the Year and Torin Dorn was 2015 Conference USA Freshman of the Year. Seven different 49ers earned first-team All-Conference USA honors. Galen Young was named Conference USA Tournament MVP in 1999 and Rodney White was named C-USA Tourney MVP in 2001.

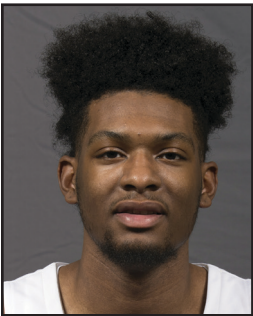

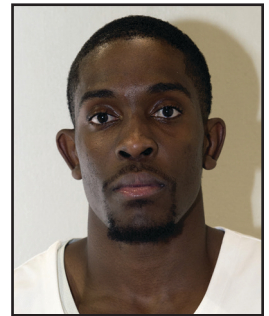

Head Coach Ron Sanchez

First Season

Ron Sanchez is in his first season at the helm of the Charlotte 49ers men's basketball program. He became the 11th head coach in the program's history on March 19, 2018.

"I would like to thank Chancellor Dubois and Director of Athletics Mike Hill for this incredible opportunity," Sanchez said. "I am honored and humbled that they have entrusted me with

their men's basketball program. I have waited a long time for the right fit and I truly believe in the leadership of this department. I cannot be more excited to get started. Obviously, I would not be here without the help of both Dick and Tony Bennett. I learned so much from them during my time at Washington State and Virginia. My wife and children are also very excited to be part of the 49ers family."

Sanchez had been an integral part of three-time National Coach of the Year Tony Bennett's staff for the last 12 years as they built Washington State and Virginia into national powers during their tenures.

"Ron Sanchez embodies everything we could possibly want in a head basketball coach," Charlotte 49ers Director of Athletics Mike Hill said. "His reputation is impeccable as a teacher, leader, assessor and developer of talent, and recruiter. Most importantly, he is a man of high character and integrity. This is a great day for the Charlotte 49ers."

For the last nine years, he has been a part of Bennett's staff at nationally-ranked Virginia, including the past three seasons as associate head coach. During his time at Virginia, the Cavaliers have won 212 games, three ACC regular-season titles and two ACC Tournament titles, while making six appearances in the NCAA Tournament and one NIT Appearance. The Cavaliers have earned an NCAA number one seed, three times. Virginia has won 29 or more games in four of the last five years.

ESPN Insider listed Sanchez among the top recruiters in the nation. CBSSports.com listed Sanchez as one of the top assistant coaches in the country who are likely to be head coaching stars.

In the 2017-18 season, Sanchez played a major role in helping Virginia reach number one in the national polls while winning a school-record 31 games.

Before his time on the coaching staff at Virginia, Sanchez was an assistant coach at Washington State. While at Washington State, the Cougars played in the NCAA Tournament twice and the NIT once. In 2006-07 and 2007-08, the Cougars tied the school-record with 26 wins. In 2008, the Cougars reached the Sweet 16 and played in Charlotte's Spectrum Center. He played a major role in the recruitment of NBA All-Star and former Washington State standout Klay Thompson.

Prior to becoming an assistant coach at Washington State, he spent three seasons as the program's director of basketball operations from 2003-06. Prior to those three years, he spent two seasons as a volunteer assistant coach at the University of Indiana. While at Indiana, Sanchez earned a master's degree in athletic administration/sports management. During his two seasons at Indiana, the Hoosiers reached the NCAA Tournament Championship game in 2002.

Sanchez is a 1997 graduate of the State University of New York College at Oneonta where he starred on the basketball team. He earned State University of New York Athletic Conference Player of the Year and Eastern College Athletic Conference Championship Most Valuable Player honors in 1996.

Sanchez began his coaching career as an assistant coach at his alma mater for the 1998-99 season. Then, he was the associate head coach at Delhi College (N.Y.) for two years (1999-01). In the 2000-01 season, Delhi won 31 games, captured the Region III championship and finished fourth in the National Junior College Athletic Association Championship Tournament.

Not only has he enjoyed success as a college basketball coach but in the summer of 2013, Sanchez was an assistant coach for the Dominican Republic National Team, which finished fourth at the FIBA Americas Championship to qualify for the 2014 FIBA World Championships for the first time since 1978.

Sanchez and his wife, Tara, have a son, Raelon, and a daughter, Rose Marie.

For four seasons, he was head coach of the Cairns Marlins (2006-09) which plays in the Queensland Basketball League. In 2006 and 2007, he earned Queensland Basketball League Coach of the Year honors. In 2007 and 2009, he helped the Marlins capture the league title. In 2007, he guided the Marlins to the Australian Basketball Association National Championship.

Fearne also enjoyed a successful playing career in Australia. From 1998-2005, he played for the Marlins. As a player, he helped the Marlins capture two national championships. From 1999-2001, he played for the Taipans.

Fearne, who is from Cairns, Queensland, Australia, played college basketball in the United States. He played the 1993-94 season at Western Wisconsin Technical College. Then, he played the 1994-95 season at Mid-State Technical College where he earned an associate's degree. He played his final two seasons at Mayville State University in Mayville, North Dakota. In 1997, he graduated from Mayville State with a degree in Business Administration.

Kotie Kimble

Kotie Kimble is in his first season on the Charlotte 49ers coaching staff. Kimble joins the 49ers coaching staff after spending the last seven years as an assistant coach at William & Mary.

During his time on the coaching staff at William & Mary, the Tribe posted three of the program's eight 20-win seasons while capturing the Colonial Athletic Association's regular-season title in 2015 and reaching the CAA Tournament Championship game in 2014 and 2015. During that stretch, William & Mary averaged 16 wins per season.

Kimble helped the Tribe to three-straight 20-win seasons in 2013-14, 2014-15 and 2015-16, a first at W&M since 1949-51. The Tribe offense has ranked among the best in the country during Kimble's tenure. Over the last six years, W&M is one of only two schools (along with Gonzaga) to rank among the top 30 nationally in field goal percentage.

Before joining the coaching staff at William & Mary, Kimble spent three seasons as an assistant coach at UNC Asheville on Eddie Biedenbach's coaching staff. In 2011, UNC Asheville won the Big South Tournament and earned a spot in the NCAA Tournament. In 2011, UNC Asheville defeated Arkansas Little Rock in the first round of the NCAA Tournament. He helped coach and recruit four players that earned All-Big South honors. In each of his three seasons at UNC Asheville, the Bulldogs finished in the top four of the Big South standings and advanced to at least the Big South Conference Tournament semifinals. "It's a great opportunity that Coach Sanchez has given me, and I'm thrilled to pour into our players, this community and Niner Nation!"

Kimble earned a bachelor's degree in history from Coastal Carolina in 2007. At Coastal Carolina, he worked as a student assistant under basketball coaches Pete Strickland and Buzz Peterson. The Southern California native began his collegiate coaching career as a student assistant coach and video coordinator under NAIA Hall of Fame coach Dr. Dave Holmquist at Biola University in La Mirada, California. He was involved in the Eagles' game preparation, player development and recruiting efforts, and helped Biola advance to the 2009 NAIA National Tournament.

In 2006-07, he served as an assistant coach at his alma mater, Capistrano Valley Christian School under San Diego High School Hall of Champions coach Randy Wright. Sfera also served as a head coach with the North Orange County Stars AAU program and assisted with the California Summer Pro League.

Sfera played collegiately at MiraCosta College in Oceanside, Calif., after prepping at Capistrano Valley Christian School where he was an All-Academy League selection and one of the top three-point shooters in the CIF-Southern Section.
