## LEADING OFF

### Last Season

Charlotte ended the 2021 season with a 40-21 record for the program's first 40-win season since 2011. The Niners went 24-8 in Conference USA action for the first 20-win conference season since 2010 and captured the first C-USA title in program history and the first conference championship since sharing the regular-season crown in the Atlantic 10 in 2013. Charlotte earned its sixth NCAA Regional berth and just the second as an at-large team in 2021 and opened the postseason with a 13-10 win over Maryland before falling to #13 East Carolina and that same Maryland team to end the season.

### 10 Years in the Making

Last season's NCAA Regional berth ended a 10-year drought for the Niners in the postseason. Charlotte's last appearance in an NCAA Regional prior to this past June was back in 2011 when the Green and White picked up a win over No. 19 Arkansas as part of a 1-2 effort in the Tempe Regional.

### Reigning C-USA Player of the Year

Returning for Charlotte is the reigning Conference USA Player of the Year, **Austin Knight**. Knight became the fifth player in program history and the first since 2013 to take home Player of the Year honors, in addition to being named the league's Newcomer of the Year. He finished second on the team with a .342 batting average and led the Niners with 80 hits, 63 RBIs, 59 runs scored, and a nation-leading 29 doubles.

When referring to the team, please use "Charlotte 49ers." The official name of the school is UNC Charlotte. However, ALL athletic teams go by "Charlotte 49ers." Niners is also acceptable. For scoreboard reference, Charlotte, CLT, or 49ers are all acceptable.

## Captain America

In addition, Knight picked up three All-American honors in 2021, headlined by a First Team selection by Collegiate Baseball. He also picked up a Second Team nod from the ABCA/Rawlings and was an NCBWA Third Team All-American selection. Knight became the 10th Niner to earn All-American recognition (first since 2011) and just the fourth to earn First Team accolades, joining Bo Robinson (1998), James Matan (1998), and Adam Mills (2007).

## Gold Standard in the Golden Spikes

Not finished yet, Knight was also named a semifinalist for the Golden Spikes Award and Dick Howser Trophy. The Golden Spikes Award is given to the top amateur baseball player in the United States, named by USA Baseball, while the Dick Howser Trophy is given to the top collegiate baseball player by the National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association.

## Coach of the Year

Head Coach **Robert Woodard** was named the Conference USA Keith LeClair Coach of the Year in 2021 after leading the Niners to the regular-season title, becoming the second CLT skipper to win the award and first since 1998.

## Expecting More of the Same

Building on his success from last season, Knight garnered four Preseason All-American selections ahead of the 2022 season. He picked up First Team Preseason All-American nods from the NCBWA, Collegiate Baseball, and Perfect Game, and was a Third Team selection by D1 Baseball.

## Watch Out!

Announced on Tuesday (Feb. 15), Knight once again finds himself on the Golden Spikes Watch List heading into 2022. He is one of six semifinalists from 2021 that were named to the 2022 preseason watch list and is the only representative of Conference USA among the 55 players selected to the list.

## Pegged for a Repeat

Knight was tabbed to repeat his stellar performance from last season as he was named the C-USA Preseason Player of the Year on Wednesday (Feb. 16) and was Charlotte's only representative on the Preseason All-Conference Team.

## Picked Fourth

Charlotte was predicted to finish fourth in Conference USA according to the preseason coaches poll. Coming off of the first-place finish a year ago, the Niners garnered two first-place votes in Wednesday's poll and finished behind Southern Miss, LA Tech, and Old Dominion.

## First Time for Everything

Charlotte won its first Conference USA Regular Season Championship in program history after going 24-8 in conference play, including three four-game series sweeps. It was the Niners' eighth (two Metro, five A-10) regular-season title in program history and the first outright crown since winning the Atlantic 10 in 2011.

## So Fresh and So Clean

Last Season **Christian Lothes** and **Will Butcher** were named Freshman All-Americans by Collegiate Baseball. It was the second year in a row that the Green and White had two Freshman All-American selections after Dominic Pilolli and **David McCabe** earned the honor after the 2020 season. Lothes and Butcher are the 20th and 21st Charlotte players to be named Freshman All-Americans.

## BBB Rated for a Sixth Season

A trio of Niners with last names beginning with the letter 'B' are back for a sixth season of eligibility. Pitchers **Colby Bruce**, **Matt Brooks**, and **Jackson Boss** all enter the 2022 season as sixth-year seniors. Bruce missed all of last season with an injury, as did Brooks for most of 2019 and 2020, while Boss transferred to Charlotte ahead of the shortened 2020 season.

## Strength in the Infield

Five different Niners were ranked as some of the best at their positions according to D1 Baseball ahead of the season. Grad transfer **Josh Madole** was ranked as the 39th-best first baseman, **Austin Knight** came in at No. 3 in the second base rankings, despite playing third base most of last season, **David McCabe** was tabbed at No. 7 at third base, **Jack Dragum** was ranked No. 44 at shortstop, and **Will Butcher** came in at No. 111 in the outfield. Charlotte is one of just 10 programs with a top-50 player at each position and the only non-Power-5 school to accomplish that feat.

## Top Draft Prospects

Speaking of D1 Baseball, both McCabe and Knight were listed on the publication's top 250 draft prospects for the 2022 MLB Draft. McCabe was ranked 87th overall and second in Conference USA while Knight slotted in at No. 129 overall and fourth in C-USA. Old Dominion was the only other C-USA school to land multiple players in the top 250.

## A Pair of Picks

Charlotte had two players taken in last summer's abbreviated 20-round MLB Draft. Catcher Aaron McKeithan was taken in the 16th round (481st overall) by the St. Louis Cardinals and pitcher Bryce McGowan went two rounds later in the 18th round (530th overall) by the Colorado Rockies to be the Niners' 57th pick in the MLB Draft and first-ever selection by Colorado.

## School Saves Record

The 49ers set a new single-season saves record as a program in 2021, totaling 18 as a team along the way. **Christian Lothes** finished the year with eight to tie for fifth all-time in a season and **Jackson Boss** added four.

## Starting in the Sunshine State

With Florida Atlantic and FIU in Conference USA, trips to the Sunshine State are common for the Niners. However, this will be the first time CLT has taken a trip to Florida for non-conference play since the 2000 C-USA Tournament in St. Petersburg, and the first trip to Florida for a regular-season non-conference game since opening the 1992 season on the road at FIU. Additionally, its Niners are not opening the season at the Hayes for the first time since 2014 when the Niners opened the season up at High Point.

## Home, Sweet Home

Following the opening weekend in Florida, the 49ers return home for 18 straight home games in the greater Charlotte area. A total of 15 of the 18 games in the stretch will be played on campus at The Hayes, with the remaining three split between Uptown Charlotte and Kannapolis.

## Uptown Funk

For the second consecutive year, the Green and White will takeover Uptown for a pair of games at Truist Field, home of the AAA Charlotte Knights. The Niners host App. State at the home of the Knights on March 11 and then return on the 23rd to take on Davidson. Charlotte has played at least one game in Uptown for six of the last seven seasons, with the only exception being the shortened 2020 season - when the Niners were slated to play Wake Forest and NC State there later in the season.

## Having a Ball

Truist Field isn't the only professional ballpark the 49ers will host at this season as Charlotte will play Campbell at Atrium Health Ballpark, the home of the Low-A Kannapolis Cannonballers, one day before the second game in Uptown on March 22.

## New Faces

A total of 23 players will be suiting up in the Green and White for the first time in 2022. Broken down, there are six freshmen playing collegiate baseball for the first time, 15 transfers, and two graduate transfers.

## Fountain of Youth

Woodard is currently the 29th-youngest head coach in all of Division I baseball and is the youngest out of the four coaches in Tampa for opening weekend, edging out USF's Billy Mohl by just over 200 days.

## Infield Upgrade

The Hayes' infield underwent a facelift this offseason and had new turf installed. The new turf features Charlotte's new 'All-in C' logo behind the plate and includes a turf pitching mound for the first time. Additionally, the outfield wall in right has been updated to showcase years of Charlotte's conference championships and NCAA Tournament appearances.

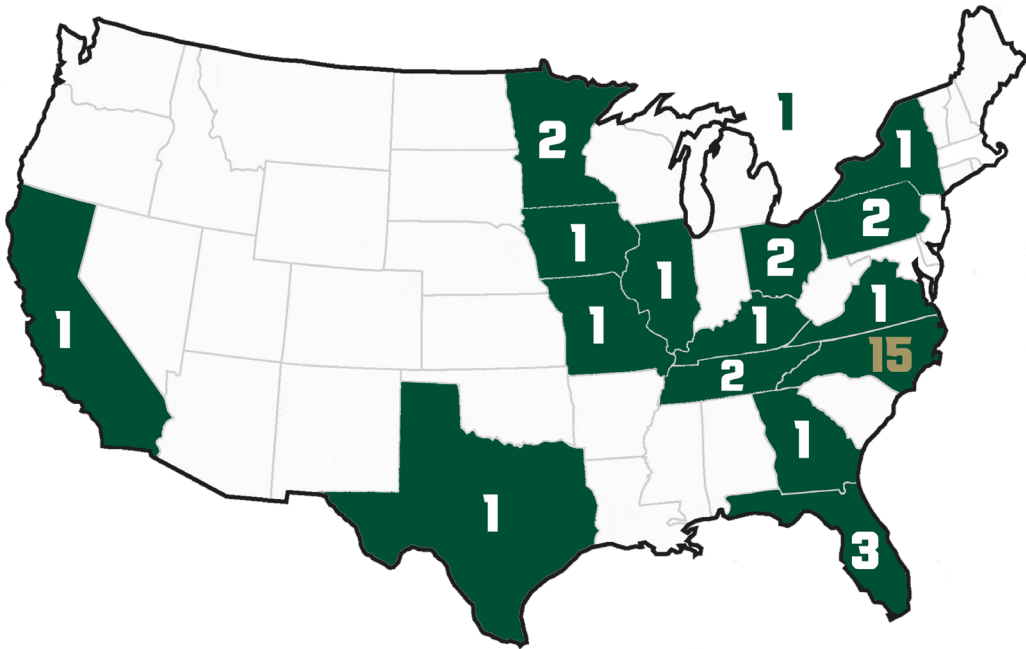

## HEAD COACH ROBERT WOODARD

### #20 3RD SEASON • NORTH CAROLINA '07

On July 1, 2019, Robert Woodward returned home to the Queen City as the fifth Head Coach of the Charlotte 49ers Baseball program. He did so coming off of being an assistant coach at his alma mater, North Carolina, for three seasons. Woodward, a Charlotte native, has also served as pitching coach at UNCW and Virginia Tech.

In his first full season of 2021, Woodward guided the 49ers to a 40-win season, Conference USA Regular Season Championship and berth back into NCAA Postseason play for the first time since the 2011 season. The 49ers clinched the league's east division title with a series-opening 9-6 win at Rice on May 21st before clinch the out-right regular season title the next evening with a come-from-behind 6-4 win in game two of the DH. The first postseason berth sent the Niners to the NCAA Greenville Regional where they immediately picked up a 13-10 win over Maryland in their return to June baseball on June 4th. Woodward, who took home C-USA's Keith LeClair Coach of the Year honors, also guided the Niners to 10 other postseason awards from the league, led by All-American Austin Knight winning the league's Player of the Year and Newcomer of the Year honors while also being a semifinalist for both the Golden Spikes Award and Dick Howser Trophy.

In the shortened 2020 season, Woodward picked up his first victory with the Niners in dramatic fashion with a 5-4, 11-inning victory over VCU on February 15th. The first year skipper led the 49ers to nine wins in the 17-game season (shortened due to the COVID-19 Pandemic) that included a seven-game home win streak with a four-game sweep over UMBC and three-game sweep vs. St. John's. Charlotte ended the season on a strong note picking up a 9-8 road win at #9 NC State on March 10th. In his first season in Charlotte, Woodward immediately set up new fan-friendly events off the field which included a homecoming golf tournament, bringing back the fall world series and introducing the inaugural First Pitch Dinner. Introducing new, modern technology and training with the team was also a priority as the 49ers partnered with P3 out of St. Louis for superior baseball training based on each student-athlete's unique needs. Woodward also introduced Rapsodo and Blast Motion, both data-driven sports technology, for additional team improvements off the field.

Woodward began his coaching career with Carolina prior to the 2010 postseason, which he followed by two full seasons as an assistant with the Tar Heels. Woodward's first stint as a full-time pitching coach came in 2013 at UNCW where the Seahawks finished the 2013 campaign 38-23 and 18-8 in the Colonial Athletic Association and advanced to the NCAA Charlottesville Regional. Following his one season in Wilmington, Woodward spent three seasons as the pitching coach at Virginia Tech before returning to UNC in 2016. He was promoted during his second year with the Hokies, rising to the top assistant position as well as being named recruiting coordinator.

After working with USA Baseball in 2016, Woodward was hired as the pitching coach of his alma mater. Woodward's return to Chapel Hill was a successful one as the Tar Heels finished 49-14 and won the ACC Coastal Division title outright. Woodward and the Tar Heel pitching staff had another successful campaign during the 2018 season as they helped lead Carolina back to the College World Series with a 44-20 overall record. In Woodward's final season as the Tar Heels pitching coach, the team finished with a 46-19 overall record (17-13 ACC).

As a player, Woodward attended UNC after a standout prep career at Myers Park High School in Charlotte. He was part of a #1 nationally ranked recruiting class that featured future first round selections Andrew Miller, and Daniel Bard. In his four seasons in Chapel Hill, Woodward helped transform the UNC program into one of the most successful in all of college baseball that saw the Tar Heels win 195 games and advance to back-to-back College World Series Finals in 2006 and 2007. Woodward was drafted in the 46th round of the 2006 MLB Draft by St. Louis but opted to return to school after his junior year, after which he was drafted in the 20th round to San Diego. He finished his collegiate career as the winningest pitcher in UNC history with a career 34-5 record. Woodward was a three-time All-ACC performer and the 2006-07 recipient of the Patterson Medal, Carolina's highest athletic honor. He spent parts of three seasons in the Padres organization, rising to AAA Portland on two occasions and pitching with the MLB club in exhibition games in San Diego and Anaheim before retiring from professional baseball in 2010, to begin his coaching career.

## THE COACHING STAFF



### TOBY BICKNELL

**Associate Head Coach • Third Season  
Wingate '02**

Coach Toby Bicknell, Driveline Hitting Certified, enters his third season with the 49ers in 2022. Known for a tireless work ethic and passion for the game, Bicknell brings a wealth of experience with over 20 years of coaching that began in the Charlotte region.

Bicknell has a combined 22 years of coaching, scouting, and recruiting experience from just about every level of baseball. He spent seven years coaching high school and travel baseball in the Charlotte area before moving to

the collegiate level in the fall of 2004.

Beginning in August 2016, Bicknell was the Texas Scouting Director for Prep Baseball Report, spearheading grass-roots state-wide scouting efforts. In a very short time, PBR Texas became the most trusted resource for amateur baseball scouting in the state. Before moving to Texas, Bicknell spent the 2016 season at the University of Kentucky as the recruiting coordinator for Head Coach Gary Henderson.

Before Kentucky, Bicknell spent five seasons at The United States Air Force Academy. Three of Air Force's recruiting classes were ranked in the Top-100, highlighted by eight players selected in the MLB Draft. Including his coaching duties, Bicknell was also an instructor in Combatives and Water Survival.

Prior to the Air Force Academy, Bicknell spent two seasons at Davidson where the 2009 team improved in eight offensive categories. Prior to Davidson, Bicknell was the volunteer assistant coach at Clemson, where he worked primarily with infielders and hitters along with coordinating summer camps. Prior to Clemson, Bicknell spent two years as an assistant coach at UNC-Pembroke where the Braves posted a record of 63-47 in those two years and received a national ranking as high as seventh.

In 2002, Bicknell started at third base for Wingate University. He earned a BA from Wingate in 2002, and an MA from UNC-Pembroke in 2006. A Charlotte native, Bicknell graduated from Charlotte Christian School in 1997 where he lettered in both Football and Baseball.



### PHILLIP CEBUHAR

**Assistant Coach/Hitting Coordinator  
First Season • Arkansas - Fort Smith '18**

Cebuhar comes to Charlotte by way of Arkansas where he spent the last three seasons as a Graduate Assistant with the top-ranked Razorbacks. At Arkansas, Cebuhar assisted with offensive and hitting operations, worked with advanced scouting, data/analytics, field duties and other day-to-day operations. Cebuhar will be an Assistant Coach as well as Hitting

Coordinator starting with the 2022 season.

Cebuhar worked with Arkansas for three seasons and helped the Razorbacks win an SEC title and reach the NCAA Super Regionals in 2021. Prior to joining Arkansas in Fayetteville, Cebuhar spent one season as a coach with the Cleveland Indian's team in the Dominican Summer League.

Cebuhar played two years as a first baseman at Arkansas - Fort Smith after spending his first two collegiate seasons at Bossier Parish Community College.

### AUSTIN MEINE

**Assistant Coach / Pitching Coach  
Second Season • Lindenwood '17**

Charlotte baseball turned toward an already familiar face on Tuesday, December 11, 2020 announcing the addition of Austin Meine to the coaching staff as the new assistant coach and pitching coordinator. Meine joins the Niners coaching staff after serving as the Director of Pitching and Biomechanics at Premier Pitching Performance (P3) out of St. Louis.

"Our coaching staff is excited to announce and welcome Austin Meine to our coaching staff," began Head Coach Robert Woodard. "Coach Meine is one of the brightest pitching minds I have come across in the game. Coach Meine will continue his work with Premier Pitching Performance in a research and development type role remotely. This unique aspect is important to our coaching staff as we feel it will strengthen the relationship and partnership of both our program and the P3 organization."

Meine started with P3 throughout his high school and collegiate baseball playing days before officially joining the P3 staff in 2017. Meine began as the Remote Program Director and Floor Trainer before advancing into the Director of Pitching and Biomechanics role.

#### MORE FROM COACH WOODARD

I believe that Coach Meine is the new wave of coach coming down the pike. He is young, hungry and fluent in utilizing all modern training techniques and technologies in player development. He has already demonstrated with our team, through our partnership with Premier Pitching Performance, that he has the skillset and the ability to communicate these methods in a simple capacity and at a high level.

As our program's pitching coordinator, Coach Meine will oversee all aspects of our program's pitcher development and will also assist our coaching staff in the recruitment of our future pitchers.



### TYLER SIMMONS

**Director of Player Development  
Sixth Season • Wingate '16**

Simmons begins his sixth overall year with the program in 2022.

In 2020, Simmons assisted in bringing modern technology to the Niners with the additions of P3 out of St. Louis, Rapsodo and Blast Motion. Simmons was a featured speaker at the 2020 ABCA Convention demonstrating how the 49ers use Rapsodo and Blast Motion hitting in today's tech world.

From 2017-2019, Simmons had served as the Volunteer Assistant and Catching Coordinator with the 49ers. In 2018, catcher Harris Yett was named a semifinalist for the prestigious Johnny Bench award for the nation's top catchers and again in 2019. Yett went on to be drafted by the Baltimore Orioles in the 32nd round of the 2019 MLB Draft. Along with Yett, Simmons has helped six Niners go onto to play at the next level.

Simmons has a plethora of responsibility with the team assisting in the implementation of technology into the program and work closely with the team's data and analytics staff. In addition to overseeing the team's development, Simmons also oversees the day-to-day operations of the program, equipment, travel and nutrition.

Simmons spent his playing career at Wingate University from 2011-2016. Simmons helped lead the Bulldogs to one South Atlantic Conference regular season championship and NCAA Regional berth in 2014 and a SAC tournament championship in 2015. During his time at Wingate, Simmons started behind the plate, DH and at first base.

Simmons received his Bachelor of Science from Wingate in the fall 2015 and went on to receive his Masters of Art in Sport Management in the summer of 2017. Simmons, a Charlotte native, graduated from Charlotte Christian High School in 2011 where he met his wife Celeste. Together they have one son, John Tyler (JT), born November 2021.



## ACROSS THE DIAMOND

### LOUISVILLE PREVIEW

#### The Louisville Series

Former conference foes, Charlotte and Louisville have played each other 41 times heading into the 2022 season. The Niners hold a slim, 22-19 advantage in the series, including an 11-8 lead in games played in the Queen City. It's been a while since the two teams met, with the last contest between the two coming back in 2005 - an extra-innings victory for the Cardinals. Charlotte has the longest winning streak in the series after winning 10 straight contests from 1992-1996.

#### Scouting the Cardinals

Louisville finished 2021 with a 28-22 record on the season and a 16-16 mark in conference play. The Cardinals saw their 2021 season end in the city of Charlotte last spring after an 8-9 loss to Georgia Tech in 12 innings in the ACC Tournament at Truist Field in Uptown Charlotte saw Louisville eliminated. The Cardinals last made the NCAA Tournament in 2019 and made a run all the way to Omaha before falling twice to eventual champion Vanderbilt at TD Ameritrade Park. Louisville is led by Dan McDonnell, who is entering his 16th season leading the program. McDonnell has amassed a 646-266 record as the Cardinals' bench boss and enters 2022 as the winningest active head coach in Division I baseball with a .708 winning percentage (min. five years as a D1 head coach). Louisville had a total of seven players taken in the 2021 MLB draft, including first overall pick Henry Davis to the Pittsburgh Pirates.

#### Leading Louisville

Christian Knapczyk is the team's leading batter returning to the lineup after the sophomore hit .297 in his freshman campaign. Only two other starters in the field are returning for Louisville in 2022 in Cameron Masterman and Levi Usher. Top starter Luke Seed returns for the Cardinals after posting a 2.64 ERA over 47.2 innings with 44 strikeouts in 12 starts. Tate Kuehner also returns and was second on the Cardinals with a 3.55 ERA over 45.2 innings in a team-best 20 appearances in his freshman campaign.

## UConn Preview

### The UConn Series

The only non-former conference opponent the Niners will face over opening weekend, Charlotte and UConn have met seven times in the past - all taking place in Charlotte. The 49ers won the first four meetings from 1984-1990 but enter the 2022 season on a three-game losing streak after being swept by the Huskies in the 1997 season.

### Scouting the Huskies

UConn earned an NCAA Regional berth in 2021 after going 34-19 with a 13-4 record in the Big East. The Huskies won both the Big East regular-season and tournament championships and picked up a win over Michigan in the South Bend Regional. Five Huskies were taken in the 2021 MLB Draft for the most the program has had in 10 years. This season, UConn was predicted to repeat atop the Big East conference according to the league's coaches poll after receiving all but one first-place vote in the poll. Jim Penders is in his 19th year leading the Huskies and has compiled a 606-416-5 career record in Storrs after taking over ahead of the 2004 season, 10 years after graduating from UConn in 1994.

### Leading UConn

The Huskies have two 2022 Preseason All-Big East Selections on their squad in Erik Stock and Austin Peterson. Stock was named to the All-Big East First Team in 2021 after finishing second on the Huskies with a .364 batting average to go with 14 doubles, six home runs, and 34 RBIs. Chris Brown has the second-highest batting average among returning Huskies after hitting .298 in his freshman campaign. Peterson was a Second Team All-Big South selection in 2021 and was named to the Collegiate Baseball Preseason All-American Second Team ahead of the 2022 season. The right-hander finished fourth in the Big East with a 2.53 ERA over 80.2 innings of action while finishing with seven wins for the third-most in the conference.

## USF Preview

### The South Florida Series

Another former conference opponent of the Niners, Sunday will be the 54th all-time meeting between Charlotte and USF and the first since 2005. The Bulls lead the series 31-22 and are 13-9 against the 49ers when playing in Tampa. Like UConn, USF is entering the season on a three-game winning streak over Charlotte after sweeping the Niners in the Queen City in 2005.

### Scouting the Bulls

USF finished the 2021 season with a 31-30 record and 14-14 mark in American Athletic Conference play but made a remarkable postseason run to make it to the Super Regionals for the first time in program history. Picked to finish last in the American ahead of the season, USF went 4-1 in the conference tournament, including taking two of three from Tulane, and then defeated UCF for the program's first conference championship since 1995. The Bulls defeated in-state foes Florida and Miami and then bounced back from a defeat to South Alabama to beat the Jaguars and advance to the Super Regionals where USF ultimately fell to No. 2 Texas. USF is led by Billy Mohl, who has compiled a 99-90-1 record in his first four seasons with the Bulls.

### Leading USF

Three Bulls were named to the Preseason All-Conference Team, led by unanimous selection Jack Jasiak. Jasiak led USF with six wins in 2021 and carries a 2.96 career ERA in 20 starts with 14 of them being quality starts. Joining Jasiak on the Preseason All-Conference Team are 2021 Freshman All-Americans Drew Bratcher and Carmine Lane. Lane led USF in batting average (.306), hits (76), RBIs (43), and total bases (123) and was second on the team in doubles (14) and slugging percentage (.496). Bratcher hit .294 in his first collegiate season and picked up six doubles, eight home runs, and 17 RBIs despite missing 29 games due to injury.
