

Last Season

Charlotte finished the 2022 season with a 36-22 record, with a 17-13 mark in Conference USA action. The Niners made an appearance in the national polls for the second season in a row, slotting in at No. 23 by Baseball America after going on the road and picking up a series victory at No. 18 Old Dominion as part of a 16-7 start to the season. CLT finished the regular season in seventh place in the C-USA standings, with the potential to have finished as high as second heading into the final weekend of the season due to the competitive season across the league in 2022. Charlotte went 1-2 in the C-USA Tournament in Hattiesburg a season ago, setting a league record for the largest margin of victory in a C-USA Tournament game after beating Middle Tennessee 22-0 in seven innings in the first elimination game of the tournament.

All-Conference USA Performers

Five members of the Green and White combined for six All-Conference selections in 2022, with three of those players returning to the Queen City again in 2023. David McCabe and Jack Dragum were both named to the All-C-USA First Team while Nate Furman and Cam Fisher earned Second Team Honors. Fisher also made an appearance on the All-Freshman Team, where he was joined by pitcher Collin Kramer. Of the 2022 All-Conference winners, Dragum, Fisher, and Kramer are on the 2023 squad. The 2022 awards marked the second year in a row in which the Niners had multiple First Team selections and the fifth season in a row with at least one named to the top team.

Freshman Phenom Fish

Fisher's honors didn't stop with Conference USA awards last year as he picked up a pair of Freshman All-America honors as well. He picked up a Freshman All-America nod by Collegiate Baseball in June before being named to the Baseball America Freshman All-America Second Team a month later. He became the 22nd different 49er to be named a Freshman All-American and earned the program's 27th such award in total. The success has been ramped up in recent years as well, with Fisher representing Charlotte's fifth Freshman All-American in the last three years.

A Season for the Record Books

The 2022 season for Charlotte Baseball was one of the best seasons in program history, with the Niners ending the year ranking in the top five in program history in multiple categories. CLT drew 371 walks during the season, including 17 in one game at UTSA, setting the single-season program record and matching the single-game record. The team clobbered 99 home runs (second-most) as part of 489 total runs scored (third-most) and finished fourth in program history in slugging percentage (.469) and on-base percentage (.415). On the mound, the Niners tossed 532 strikeouts for the second-most in program history and second consecutive season of 500+ Ks. The team's 9.3 K/9 rate is the second-best in program history while a .247 opponent batting average was the third-lowest CLT has recorded. Showing the completeness of the team, Charlotte also posted the second-best fielding percentage in program history (.977) and the third-fewest errors in a single season with 49.

Preseason All-Conference USA Picks

Charlotte tied for the most selections on the 2023 Conference USA Preseason All-Conference Team with four picks. Jack Dragum and Cam Fisher both return after being named All-Conference the season before, and they are joined by 2021 C-USA Player of the Year Austin Knight and Jake Cunningham. Florida Atlantic's Nolan Schanuel and LA Tech's Jonathan Fincher took home Preseason Player and Pitcher of the Year honors, respectively. The only other team with four Preseason All-Conference selections was UTSA, with three of those four coming from the mound.

Perfect Game Preseason Honors

Charlotte also landed a pair of players on Perfect Game's Preseason All-Conference USA Team, with Jake Cunningham and Collin Kramer making the list. Cunningham received extra attention from PG as well, being tabbed as the Conference USA Player of the Year.

Tabbed Fourth in the C-USA Preseason Coaches Poll...

As a team, Charlotte was picked fourth by the Conference USA coaches. Last year's C-USA Tournament champions Louisiana Tech picked up five first-place votes to edge league newcomer Dallas Baptist (four-first place votes) by a single point for the top spot in the poll. Florida Atlantic finished third and the Niners picked up one first-place vote in fourth place, four points behind the Owls. UTSA was slated for fifth to round out the top half of the poll and was followed by Middle Tennessee and UAB (tied for sixth), Rice, FIU, and WKU.

...But Picked to Win by D1 Baseball

D1 Baseball's Conference USA outlook painted a brighter picture for Niner fans after selecting CLT to win the league this season. The publication put Charlotte atop the list, followed by Louisiana Tech, Dallas Baptist, and Florida Atlantic in the top four. Two teams from the league were picked by D1 Baseball to make a regional in the preview, with the Niners joined by 2022 Regionals participant LA Tech. The Niners were well represented on D1 Baseball's list of the top prospects in C-USA as well, leading the way with nine prospects listed in the league's top 40, the most of any C-USA team according to D1 Baseball

Preseason All-America Honor for Cunningham

Cunningham's preseason recognition continued in the form of a Third Team All-America honor from Prospects Live. He was one of two Conference USA players named to the Third Team Preseason All-America Team from Prospects Live, along with FAU's Schanuel.

Climbing up D1 Baseball's List

Ahead of the season, D1 Baseball released its list of the top 100 programs in college baseball - the first time they've published the list since 2019. Charlotte was not in either of the first three iterations but debuted at No.74 this year, ranking at No. 4 in Conference USA and No. 8 in the state of North Carolina. The Niners' schedule is chock-full of teams in the top 100, featuring games against teams ranked 14th (North Carolina), 22nd (East Carolina), 27th (Dallas Baptist), 30th through 32nd (Coastal Carolina, Clemson, South Carolina), 47th (Louisiana Tech), 48th (Virginia Tech), 52nd (Florida Atlantic), 64th (Old Dominion), 66th (UNCW), 78th (Rice), 79th (Armu), and 98th (Ball State).

NCAA Tournament Teams on the Schedule

Seven of those teams in the top 100 rankings on Charlotte's schedule featured in the NCAA Tournament last year, accounting for 16 of the 56 games on CLT's schedule. Army, ECU, LA Tech, and UNC all won their respective conference tournaments while Coastal, DBU, and Virginia Tech earned at-large bids. Three of them earned national seeds in last year's tournament - Virginia Tech (No. 4), East Carolina (No. 8), and North Carolina (No. 10) - and all three advanced to the Super Regionals.

UNC's First Visit to the Hayes in a Decade

Niner Nation has a chance to catch the Tar Heels at the Hayes for the first time in over a decade when UNC travels down to the Queen City on March 14. North Carolina hasn't played at the Hayes since the 2011 season in what was a 4-3 win for the Green and White. Teams have split each of their last two meetings, with both requiring extra innings. A capacity crowd at Hayes Stadium is expected and demand for the game has been high, with lower-bowl tickets for the matchup selling out the day single-game tickets went on sale.

Uptown Games

Once again, Charlotte is scheduled to play a pair of contests in Uptown at Truist Field, home of the AAA Charlotte Knights. Due to weather, the Niners were only able to play one contest in the heart of the 704 last season, opening up Conference USA action against WKU on the corner of S Mint St and Martin Luther King Jr. Blvd. This year Charlotte will host South Carolina (March 21) and East Carolina (April 19) in a pair of marquee matchups on the biggest stage in the Queen City.

Having a Blast in K-Town

The Niners will play a home game in another minor league ballpark for the third season in a row as well when CLT hosts UNCW at Atrium Health Ballpark in Kannapolis on March 8. Home of the Low-A Kannapolis Cannon Ballers, Charlotte played the first-ever game at the new stadium in 2021 and is currently 2-0 at the new park. Atrium Health Ballpark is one of the best in the minor leagues and was recently named the 2022 Ballpark of the Year by Ballpark Digest.

Farewell to Conference USA

After rejoining Conference USA ahead of the 2014 season, Charlotte is once again saying goodbye to the conference it was a founding member of, with the Niners moving to the American Athletic Conference this coming summer. CLT has an overall record of 244-268-1 in C-USA action and won the 2021 Regular Season Championship after winning a program-record 24 conference contests that uear.

Space City Send-Off

The 2023 Conference USA season will conclude with the Conference USA Championships in Houston from May 24-28, hosted by another school leaving for the American Athletic Conference - Rice. The Owls have hosted the C-USA Championships twice before - in 2006 and 2013 - both Charlotte's first and last seasons as a member of the Atlantic 10 Conference. The city of Houston (by way of the University of Houston) has hosted the event an additional two times, but the 49ers have yet to play a postseason contest in Space City.

An Eye on Woody's Wins

Head coach Robert Woodard enters the 2023 season with an 85-51 record as a head coach - just 15 wins away from the milestone of 100. He would be the third head coach in program history to win 100 career games and could do so as early as March 11 against Old Dominion in his 151st game as a head coach - making him the fastest in CLT history to reach his 100th career win.

Dealin' Donye

Newcomer Donye Evans is one of the most-hyped additions to the Diamond Niners this season and was ranked as the No. 51 Impact Transfer by D1Baseball in the fall. The Decatur, Georgia product comes to the Queen City after spending two seasons in the SEC at Vanderbilt. Evans appeared in 22 games on the hill for the 'Dores as a reliever and started the 2022 season with eight consecutive scoreless outings and is slated to feature in Charlotte's weekend rotation this spring.

JUCO Transfers Too

In addition to Division I transfers, D1Baseball also ranks the top JUCO transfers each season and CLT found itself in the top 50 in those rankings as well, courtesy of Brandon Stahlman. Stahlman was ranked as the 39th-best JUCO transfer in all of Division I baseball this year and joins Charlotte after two years at State Fair Community College. He was an Academic All-American and played in 68 games for the Roadrunners. He drove in 52 runs on 62 hits and slashed .297l.452l.478 in his two seasons at State Fair CC.





Top-25 Transfer Class as a Whole

All told, the Niners ranked No. 21 in D1Baseball's top transfer classes, bringing in 13 total transfers. Five of the 13 come from other Division I programs (Evans, Wyatt Hudepohl, Aubrey Gillentine, Miles Langhorne, Clark Dearman), seven come from the JUCO ranks (Stahlman, Josh Patrick, Danny Helfgott, Eli Weisner, Andrew Spolyar, Joel Sarver, Nick Cosentino), and one comes from Division III's Trinity College in Sam Conte. Those 13 are joined by freshmen Spencer Nolan and Calvert Clark to round out Charlotte's 15-member incoming class.

Among the Best at Their Positions

Five Niners were recognized as being some of the best at their positions by D1 Baseball leading into the season, with Charlotte recognized at starting pitcher, second base, shortstop, and outfield. Evans was named the 101st-best starter, Austin Knight slotted in at No. 24 at second base, Jack Dragum led CLT in the rankings as the 21st-best shortstop, and Jake Cunningham and Cam Fisher represented the Green and White in the outfield at Nos. 35 and 61, respectively.

Draft Day Success

Charlotte had three players selected last July at the 2022 MLB Draft for the most 49ers taken in a single draft since the 2017 edition. Nate Furman became CLT's highest draft pick since that 2017 draft and fifth-highest overall when he was taken in the fourth round at No. 121 overall by the Cleveland Guardians. David McCabe was taken moments later by the Atlanta Braves with the 125th overall pick and Spencer Giesting was taken by the Arizona Diamondbacks with the second pick of day three (Rd. 11 P. 318). The three selections in the latest draft bring Charlotte's total up to 62 as a program. Also joining the professional ranks last summer was Quinton Martinez, who signed as a free agent with the Los Angeles Angels after the draft.

Another All-American

Before McCabe left the 704 for the professional ranks, the Canadian became the 11th All-American in program history and gave CLT back-to-back All-Americans for the first time since the 2007-08 seasons. 'Big Maple' was named to the NCBWA All-American Third Team after hitting .386 with a .784 slugging percentage, 16 home runs, and 52 RBIs on 59 hits in just 42 games.

Bick's One of the Best

Charlotte Associate Head Coach Toby Bicknell was recognized as one of the top assistant coaches in the country according to D1Baseball during the offseason. Bicknell has been on Charlotte's staff for the last three seasons and doubles as the program's recruiting coordinator. The Charlotte native has over 25 years of experience in the game of baseball at both the high school and collegiate levels and has been instrumental in the Niners' recent success.

Staffing Changes

Coach Woodard's staff went through a few changes between the 2022 and 2023 seasons, with pitching coach Austin Meine joining the Baltimore Orioles as a pitching coach and analyst after two years wearing the 9 Across The Chest. As a result, Woodard has taken over pitching coach duties in addition to his head coaching job and he brought on recent graduate Michael Oh as the team's pitching coordinator. Oh was recruited by Woodard to North Carolina and spent his final year of eligibility pitching for the Green and White last season. Phil Cebuhar was also promoted to Charlotte's full-time hitting coach and assistant recruiting coordinator after serving in a volunteer capacity last season. The promotion comes after Cebuhar helped the Niner have one of the best offensive seasons in program history in just his first season in the Queen City.

1,149 Miles to Omaha

Playing at Charles Schwab Field in Omaha is every college baseball team's ultimate goal and some in the national media are picking the 49ers as a surprise team to make the journey this season. Aaron Fitt of D1Baseball tabbed the Niners as his sleeper team to reach the College World Series this year, projecting Charlotte to have one of the best lineups in not only Conference USA, but all of college baseball.

Preseason Regional Projections

Following up on projecting Charlotte to be one of the final eight teams in contention at the end of the year, the Niners were picked as a No. 3 seed in the Chapel Hill Regional by both D1 Baseball and College Baseball Nation in preseason NCAA Tournament projections. D1Baseball has the 49ers with UNC, South Carolina, and Davidson in Chapel Hill while College Baseball Nation predicted an all-North-Carolina site consisting of CLT with the Tar Heels, East Carolina, and Campbell.

Catch Us on Your Screens

All 30 of Charlotte's home games at the Hayes will be streamed in 2023, with 19 of them airing on ESPN+ and the remaining 11 on CUSA.tv. The Niners will also have a strong presence on ESPN's streaming platforms in road games, with a total of six games against four different opponents slated to air on ACC Network Extra (Clemson, Virginia Tech, North Carolina) and SEC Network+ (South Carolina).

Big Upgrades at the Hayes

Charlotte baseball fans are in for a treat this season with the addition of a brand new, state-of-the-art video board in right-center field. The new board replaces the old scoreboard that has stood beyond the fence at the Hayes since the 1980s. It is the second consecutive season with major upgrades at the home of the baseball program after brand new turf, including a turf pitching mound, was installed before the 2022 season last year.



second time the two sides have played a weekend series against each other. The Cardinals made the trip down to the Queen City in 2011, when the 49ers took two games of the three game series to win the weekend. Despite the two teams not playing each other in 12 years, two current members of the Green and White have played against Ball State in their careers. Kaden Hopson picked up a hit, drove in a run, and walked twice against Ball State while he was at Arizona and Wyatt Hudepohl was called upon to get an out against the Cardinals while he was pitching for Kentucky.

Scouting the Cardinals

Ball State is coming off of one of its best seasons in program history in 2022, posting a 40-19 record for the second-most wins in a single season in school history (42 wins in 1999). The Cardinals achieved a record of 32-7 in the MAC, winning the fifth MAC regular-season title in program history. Ball State was unable to cap off the double last year, falling to No. 2 seed Central Michigan in the MAC Tournament Championship to miss out on making an NCAA Regional. BSU nearly led the country in triples a season ago, finishing in second place in the NCAA with 28 three-baggers. The Cardinals' pitching staff was also particulary stingy, leading the MAC in hits

allowed per nine innings (7.57), ERA (4.65), strikeouts per nine innings (10.5), and WHIP (1.37). Three of those values were good enough to put the Cardinals in the top 40 in the country in their respective categories for H/9 (5th), K/9 (12th), and WHIP (32nd). Not projected to drop off this year, Ball State was once again picked to win the MAC in the Preseason Coaches Poll.

Leading BSU

A pair of Cardinals picked up Third Team Preseason All-America nods from Collegiate Baseball in Ryan Peltier and Sam Klein. A two-time All-MAC Second Team selection, Peltier was named the MAC Defensive Player of the Year and became the first BSU player in program history to earn an ABCA/Rawlings Gold Glove for his play at third base. He led the team defensively with 99 assists and added 42 putouts. Offensively, he batted .302 with 61 hits, 50 runs scored, 44 RBIs, and a team-best 20 doubles. Klein was the anchor in Ball State's bullpen, leading the MAC and finishing 18th in the country with 11 saves. He posted a 3.18 ERA with 47 strikeouts in 34 innings of work and only three extra-base hits allowed, while opponents only hit .179 against him. Ball State also returns two of its three weekend arms from last year in Ty Johnson (7-3, 5.47 ERA) and Trennor O'Donnell (6-2, 5.48 ERA)

HEAD COACH ROBERT WOODARD

#20 4TH SEASON · NORTH CAROLINA '07

On July 1, 2019, Robert Woodard returned home to the Queen City as the fifth Head Coach of the Charlotte 49ers Baseball program. He did so coming off of being an assistant coach at his alma mater, North Carolina, for three seasons. Woodard, a Charlotte native, has also served as pitching coach at UNCW and Virginia Tech.

In 2022, the 49ers were ranked for the second seaosn in a row, en route to a 36-22 record. Charlotte had its first back-to-back seasons with All-Americans since the 2007 and '08 campaigns when David McCabe took home NCBWA Third Team All-America honors. The 2022 squad had one of the best offensive seasons in program history, setting the program record for walks with 371. The Niners had seven different offensive categories rank inside the top five in a single season in program history, highlighted by a second-best mark of 99 home runs. In the 2022 Conference USA Tournament, CLT set a C-USA record by defeating Middle Tennessee 22-0 in the largest margin of victory in a C-USA Tournament game.

In his first full season of 2021, Woodard guided the 49ers to a 40-win season, Conference USA Regular Season Championship and berth back into NCAA Postseason play for the first time since the 2011 season. The 49ers clinched the league's east division title with a series-opening 9-6 win at Rice on May 21st before clinch the out-right regular season title the next evening with a come-from-behind 6-4 win in game two of the DH. The first postseason berth sent the Niners to the NCAA Greenville Regional where they immediately picked up a 13-10 win over Maryland in their return to June baseball on June 4th. Woodard, who took home C-USA's Keith LeClair Coach of the Year honors, also guided the Niners to 10 other postseason awards from the league, led by All-American Austin Knight winning the league's Player of the Year and Newcomer of the Year honors while also being a semifinalist for both the Golden Spikes Award and Dick Howser Trophy.

In the shortened 2020 season, Woodard picked up his first victory with the Niners in dramatic fashion with a 5-4, 11-inning victory over VCU on February 15th. The first year skipper led the 49ers to nine wins in the 17-game season (shortened due to the COVID-19 Pandemic) that included a seven-game home win streak with a four-game sweep over UMBC and three-game sweep vs. St. John's. Charlotte ended the season on a strong note picking up a 9-8 road win at #9 NC State on March 10th. In his first season in Charlotte, Woodard immediately set up new fan-friendly events off the field which included a homecoming golf tournament, bringing back the fall world series and introducing the inaugural First Pitch Dinner. Introducing new, modern technology and training with the team was also a priority as the 49ers partnered with P3 out of St. Louis for superior baseball training based on each student-athlete's unique needs. Woodard also introduced Rapsodo and Blast Motion, both data-driven sports technology, for additional team improvements off the field.

Woodard began his coaching career with Carolina prior to the 2010 postseason, which he followed by two full seasons as an assistant with the Tar Heels. Woodard's first stint as a full-time pitching coach came in 2013 at UNCW where the Seahawks finished the 2013 campaign 38-23 and 18-8 in the Colonial Athletic Association and advanced to the NCAA Charlottesville Regional. Following his one season in Wilmington, Woodard spent three seasons as the pitching coach at Virginia Tech before returning to UNC in 2016. He was promoted during his second year with the Hokies, rising to the top assistant position as well as being named recruiting coordinator.

After working with USA Baseball in 2016, Woodard was hired as the pitching coach of his alma mater. Woodard's return to Chapel Hill was a successful one as the Tar Heels finished 49-14 and won the ACC Coastal Division title outright. Woodard and the Tar Heel pitching staff had another successful campaign during the 2018 season as they helped lead Carolina back to the College World Series with a 44-20 overall record. In Woodard's final season as the Tar Heels pitching coach, the team finished with a 46-19 overall record (17-13 ACC).

As a player, Woodard attended UNC after a standout prep career at Myers Park High School in Charlotte. He was part of a #1 nationally ranked recruiting class that featured future first round selections Andrew Miller, and Daniel Bard. In his four seasons in Chapel Hill, Woodard helped transform the UNC program into one of the most successful in all of college baseball that saw the Tar Heels win 195 games and advance to back-to-back College World Series Finals in 2006 and 2007. Woodard was drafted in the 46th round of the 2006 MLB Draft by St. Louis but opted to return to school after his junior year, after which he was drafted in the 20th round to San Diego. He finished his collegiate career as the winningest pitcher in UNC history with a career 34-5 record. Woodard was a three-time All-ACC performer and the 2006-07 recipient of the Patterson Medal, Carolina's highest athletic honor. He spent parts of three seasons in the Padres organization, rising to AAA Portland on two occasions and pitching with the MLB club in exhibition games in San Diego and Anaheim before retiring from professional baseball in 2010, to begin his coaching career.

TOBY BICKNELL

Associate Head Coach • Fourth Season Wingate '02

Coach Toby Bicknell, Driveline Hitting Certified, enters his fourth season with the 49ers in 2023. Known for a tireless work ethic and passion for the game, Bicknell brings a wealth of experience with over 20 years of coaching that began in the Charlotte region.

Bicknell has a combined 22 years of coaching, scouting, and recruiting experience from just about every level of baseball. He spent seven years coaching high school and travel baseball in the Charlotte area before moving to

the collegiate level in the fall of 2004.

Beginning in August 2016, Bicknell was the Texas Scouting Director for Prep Baseball Report, spearheading grass-roots state-wide scouting efforts. In a very short time, PBR Texas became the most trusted resource for amateur baseball scouting in the state. Before moving to Texas, Bicknell spent the 2016 season at the University of Kentucky as the recruiting coordinator for Head Coach Gary Henderson.

Before Kentucky, Bicknell spent five seasons at The United States Air Force Academy. Three of Air Force's recruiting classes were ranked in the Top-100, highlighted by eight players selected in the MLB Draft. Including his coaching duties, Bicknell was also an instructor in Combatives and Water Survival.

Prior to the Air Force Academy, Bicknell spent two seasons at Davidson where the 2009 team improved in eight offensive categories. Prior to Davidson, Bicknell was the volunteer assistant coach at Clemson, where he worked primarily with infielders and hitters along with coordinating summer camps. Prior to Clemson, Bicknell spent two years as an assistant coach at UNC-Pembroke where the Braves posted a record of 63-47 in those two years and received a national ranking as high as seventh.

In 2002, Bicknell started at third base for Wingate University. He earned a BA from Wingate in 2002, and an MA from UNC-Pembroke in 2006. A Charlotte native, Bicknell graduated from Charlotte Christian School in 1997 where he lettered in both Football and Baseball.

PHILLIP CEBUHAR

Assistant Coach/Hitting Coordinator Second Season • Arkansas - Fort Smith '18

Cebuhar comes to Charlotte by way of Arkansas where he spent the last three seasons as a Graduate Assistant with the top-ranked Razorbacks. At Arkansas, Cebuhar assisted with offensive and hitting operations, worked with advanced scouting, data/analytics, field duties and other day-to-day operations. Cebuhar will be an Assistant Coach as well as Hitting Coordinator starting with the 2022 season.



In his first season with the Niners, Cebuhar helped Charlotte have one of its best offensive seasons in program history. The Green and White set a record for the most walks in program history with 371, which was the most in the country heading into Regionals. The 49ers had multiple offensive categories rank in the top-five for a single season in 2022, including 489 runs (third-most), 99 home runs (second-most), 455 RBIs (third-most), .469 SLG% (fourth-highest), 66 HBP (third-most), .415 OBP (fourth-highest), and a +181 run differential (tied for third-best). Charlotte also hit 10 grand slams

this season, which is believed to be a program record.

CLT also set the program record for most home runs in a game with eight at Marshall and scored a total of 50 runs in the three-game series with the Thundering Herd - setting a program record for most runs scored in a three-game series and Conference USA series. Charlotte hit a program-record 10 doubles earlier in the season in one game against Western Illinois and matched the program benchmark by drawing 17 bases on balls in a single game against UTSA. In the Conference Tournament, the Niners set a C-USA record for the largest margin of victory in a tournament game with a 22-0 victory over Middle Tennessee.



MICHAEL OH

Pitching Coordinator First Season • North Carolina '21

Michael Oh joined the Charlotte baseball staff as the pitching coordinator in August of 2022.

Oh begins his coaching career in the same place his collegiate playing career concluded, after pitching for the 49ers as a graduate transfer during the 2022 season. He made 18 appearances with one start, posting a 4.81 ERA with 29 strikeouts in 24.1 innings of work.

Before coming to the Queen City, Oh spent two seasons playing for North Carolina in Chapel Hill, where he made six appearances over the 2021 and shortened 2020 seasons. Prior to North Carolina, he played for North Iowa Area Community College.

Oh graduated from North Carolina with a degree in Communications Studies in 2021 and received his MBA from Charlotte in 2022.

TYLER SIMMONS

Director of Player Development Seventh Season • Wingate '16

Simmons begins his seventh overall year with the program in 2023.

In 2020, Simmons assisted in bringing modern technology to the Niners with the additions of P3 out of St. Louis, Rapsodo and Blast Motion. Simmons was a featured speaker at the 2020 ABCA Convention demonstrating how the 49ers use Rapsodo and Blast Motion hitting in today's tech world.

From 2017-2019, Simmons had served as the Volunteer Assistant and Catching Coordinator with the 49ers. In 2018, catcher Harris Yett was

named a semifinalist for the prestigious Johnny Bench award for the nation's top catchers and again in 2019. Yett went on to be drafted by the Baltimore Orioles in the 32nd round of the 2019 MLB Draft. Along with Yett, Simmons has helped six Niners go onto to play at the next level.

Simmons has a plethora of responsibility with the team assisting in the implementation of technology into the program and work closely with the team's data and analytics staff. In addition to overseeing the team's development, Simmons also oversees the day-to-day operations of the program, equipment, travel and nutrition. Simmons spent his playing career at Wingate University from 2011-2016.

Simmons helped lead the Bulldogs to one South Atlantic Conference regular season championship and NCAA Regional berth in 2014 and a SAC tournament championship in 2015.
