NOTING THE NINERS

- Charlotte enters their second season under head coach Biff Poggi, who was named the program's third head coach on Nov. 15, 2022. Poggi follows Will Healy (2019-22) and Brad Lambert (2013-18) as the program's leader.
- RETURNING STARS:** The 49ers return very few starters from last season's squad, but the list of returners is littered with star power. Defensive back **Dontae Balfour** was named preseason All-AAC by Phil Steele and Athlon as was return specialist/running back **Henry Rutledge**. Tight end **Colin Weber**, in spot starting duty last season, became the first tight end in program history to lead the team in receiving. Rush end **Stone Handy** picked up preseason second team honors from Phil Steele, joining linebacker **Prince Wallace-Bemah** who earned third team recognition.
- PROGRAM FACTS:** Charlotte 49ers Football enters its 12th year of existence and 10th year at the FBS level. The 49ers football program began in 2013 and spent two years as an FCS Independent before taking a fast-track to FBS as a member of Conference USA in 2015. CLT joined the AAC in 2023. In 2019, Charlotte enjoyed its first winning season and participated in its first bowl game: 2019 Makers Wanted Bahamas Bowl.
- NEWCOMERS, NEWCOMERS, NEWCOMERS:** Charlotte features on the nation's most turned-over rosters in the country in 2024. 71 newcomers dot the roster in every position group and rank behind only Army (74) and North Texas (77) among total newcomers between their 2023 and 2024 rosters. The 49ers are tied with Colorado (44) for the most transfer additions in the country.
- SIMPLY CHARLOTTE:** In referring to the 49ers athletic program, simply use "Charlotte" or "Charlotte 49ers". The university remains UNC Charlotte, but for athletic purposes, please use Charlotte. For short references and/or abbreviations, use 49ers and CLT.
- WHY THE 49ERS:** Charlotte adopted the nickname "49ers" in honor of the importance of the year, 1949. In 1946, The Charlotte Center of the University of North Carolina (CCUNC) was established as a temporary institution designed to handle the influx of servicemen returning from the war. In 1949, community leaders, led by unofficial founder Bonnie Cone, successfully fought to make the school a permanent institution. Thanks to that can-do attitude and pioneering spirit, and in honor of the year 1949, the school's athletic teams were nicknamed the 49ers (adopted in 1962).
- GOLD TIES:** While the 49ers nickname was brought about by the importance of the year 1949 and had nothing to do with the gold rush of 1849, it should be noted that the first gold discovered in America was found in the Charlotte area, less than 20 minutes from campus, in 1799. Charlotte's mascot, Norm the Niner, is a gold miner, by trade.

NOTING THE GAME

- Charlotte heads north this week to conclude the non-conference portion of the 2024 schedule against an Indiana team receiving votes in both polls under new head coach Curt Cignetti.
- It will mark just the third game at a Big Ten school as the Niners previously played at Illinois (2021) and at Maryland (2023). The Green and White have never defeated a Big Ten team in three attempts.
- Charlotte started a true freshman, Deshawn Purdie, at quarterback last week vs. Gardner-Webb for the first time in program history. Purdie was one of just four true freshmen to start at quarterback this season joining Nebraska's Dylan Raiola, Florida's DJ Lagway, and San Diego State's Danny O'Neil.
- In injury relief for Purdie, Trexler Ivey rallied the 49ers from a 20-6 deficit to lead three-straight scoring drives and pull out the 27-26 victory. Among all passers with at least 12 attempts, Ivey's 11-of-12 passing mark was the best completion percentage in school history.

Media INFORMATION

CREDENTIALS: To request credentials, submit a request at Charlotte49ers.com/FootballCredentials. All requests should be made as early as possible and should be limited to working press only. Requests made on game day will not be approved. Credentials are issued to the individual.

MEDIA/SCOUTS WILL CALL AND PARKING: Due to ease of pick up outside Richardson Stadium, credentials will **NOT** be mailed this season. Credential pick up is available at the southwest corner of Richardson Stadium at a ticket office window and begins two hours prior to kick off.

Parking passes will also be delivered digitally to media and scouts to the phone number listed on the credential application. Parking passes will be sending during game week.

POST-GAME PRESS CONFERENCE: Post-game press conferences are held on the second floor of the Judy Rose Football Center. After a cooling off period and conversation with the team, head coach Biff Poggi and select players will be available to the media. Post-game video is available by request.

PHOTOGRAPHERS/VIDEOGRAPHERS: Credentials for photographers and videographers will be issued on the basis of circulation, with priority granted to agencies covering the participating schools on a regular basis. Credentials will not be issued to freelancers unless they are employed by a reputable publication or the communications office of the participating schools. Credentials are issued for the purpose of media coverage only, and images and video of the game may not be used for commercial purposes without the expressed, written permission of Charlotte Athletics.

Photographers and videographers working on the sidelines of Jerry Richardson Stadium will be required to have a photographer's bib. These can be checked out from the work room on the second floor of the Judy Rose Football Center.

SIDELINE AREAS: Excluding select portions of the game, media sideline access is reserved for photographers and videographers. Credentialed photographers/videographers who arrive without proper equipment will not be granted sideline access. When on the sideline, media must remain outside the bench area. This includes during pre-game activities.

FIELD AND LOCKER ROOM ACCESS: Photographers and videographers are allowed access to the playing field at only two points throughout the course of the event: when the 49ers enter the field immediately prior to kickoff and immediately following the game.

Charlotte's locker room is closed at all times.

RECRUITS: Per NCAA rule, media are not permitted to have contact with a prospect or family members of a prospect during their visit (official or unofficial) to campus, including prospects in attendance at practice or games. Contact includes in-person conversations, phone calls, text messages, e-mails, etc. Media are also asked to make every effort to keep distance from prospects on campus, including at practice, during pre-game activities on the sidelines and in the stands.

WEEKLY PRESS CONFERENCE: Each Tuesday during the season, with the exception of the bye weeks, head coach Biff Poggi holds his weekly press conference beginning at 11:30 a.m. Video will be available of the full availability courtesy of Charlotte Athletics.

PRACTICES: During the regular season, practices are open for media to attend on Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday. Photo and video is only allowed during the individual and stretch portions of practice.

Interviews with student-athletes and assistant coaches will be conducted at the conclusion of practice. Media members should submit interview requests for student-athletes a day prior to the interview. When attending practice, please contact Kyle Neaves or Joe Templin prior to entering the facility.

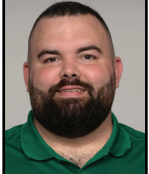

Head Coach **BIFF POGGI**

1-2 second year // 4-11 overall

The Charlotte 49ers named Francis "Biff" Poggi ("POE-g"), a two-time associate head coach of the Michigan Wolverines, as the 49ers' third head football coach, Nov. 15, 2022.

In Poggi's first season, the 49ers saw tremendous growth on the defensive side of the football, posting one of the finest defensive performances in Charlotte's young football history.

The 49ers allowed fewer than 375 yards per game for just the second time in program history in 2023 (374.2), a mark that ranked No. 61 nationally. The defense also surrendered a school-record low of 40 touchdowns on the season, surpassing the 2018 defense's mark of 42.

Following the season, Poggi and his staff went out to rebuild the Charlotte roster ahead of the 2024 by securing the No. 5-ranked transfer portal class in the American, headlined by quarterback Max Brown.

A key architect behind the Wolverines' 2021 and 2022 trips to the College Football Playoff National Semifinals, Poggi helped Michigan to an undefeated regular season in 2022 and back-to-back Big Ten Championships.

"We are extremely fortunate to welcome Biff Poggi as our head football coach," said Director of Athletics Mike Hill. "He is a transformational leader and has a sterling reputation as a coach, having had phenomenal success at the highest levels of college and high school football. But he is much more than that. He has demonstrated it by pouring himself into young men and communities, and the results have been spectacular. We are thrilled

to have Biff and his wife, Amy, join Niner Nation and the Charlotte community."

Poggi spent three seasons with the Wolverines, including two as associate head coach alongside head coach Jim Harbaugh. He was also on Michigan's staff as the Wolverines advanced to the 2016 Orange Bowl.

Poggi was recently touted for his role in the Wolverines' 2022 undefeated regular-season in an article written by Bruce Feldman for The Athletic. Prior to his tenure at Michigan, Poggi founded and led the football program at Saint Frances Academy, a private high school in his hometown of Baltimore, Maryland, to national prominence.

Poggi grew up in Baltimore and served on the board of Saint Frances Academy. Poggi, who achieved great success as a hedge fund manager, chose to invest a significant amount of personal money into Saint Frances, including funding 65 scholarships. Under his leadership, Saint Frances became a national power, able to land scholarship opportunities for its student-athletes with programs such as Alabama, LSU, Notre Dame, Michigan and others. The story was recently captured in the HBO documentary "The Cost of Winning".

"Biff is a unique leader who shares our vision for success for our football program and University as we join the American Athletic Conference," said Chancellor Sharon L. Gaber. "Most importantly, he shares our values for ensuring a Gold Standard experience for our student-athletes both on and off the field."

Prior to building Saint Frances Academy, Poggi led his high school alma mater, Gilman School, to thirteen Maryland state titles in nineteen seasons. Poggi played collegiate football at the University of Pittsburgh and Duke University, with coaching stops at Brown, Temple and The Citadel.

"Joining the Charlotte 49ers is an incredible opportunity," noted Poggi. "The great momentum created by the leadership of this University and its athletics program gives us every opportunity to build a successful pathway for so many young men in our region. For me, this is a full circle moment, a chance to pay forward the wonderful opportunities that were given to me as a young man. We can build a championship program at Charlotte, and I can't wait to get started."

THE ROSTER REBUILD CONTINUES.

To say the 2024 roster is not the same as the roster Poggi and Co. inherited just one full season ago would be an understatement. Something Niner fans will be watching for this season will be the continued strength of Charlotte's defense under coordinator Ryan Osborn and his staff. In 2023, the 49ers saw a dramatic improvement both on the field and statistically in the performance of that side of the ball. FOOTBALL EXPANSION INCOMING

As part of Phase 1 of the Evergreen Master Vision plan, Jerry Richardson Stadium is set to see its first stage of expansion beginning at the conclusion of the 2024 season.

In April, the UNC Board of Governor's approved a \$60 million Phase 1 expansion that will feature feature the construction of a state-of-the-art tower and the augmentation of stadium capacity. Notable additions include seven luxury suites, club seats, loge boxes, ledge seats and additional general seating. Additionally, the club level will serve as a dedicated team dining area, meeting facility, and conference space, enabling year-round utilization.

With this initial phase, the stadium's capacity will increase to 18,170, laying the foundation for future growth. Plans are already in motion for further expansion (Phase 2) to a capacity of 21,000 as additional funds are secured.
