UNCG Looks For First Victory Of Season At Gardner-Webb

THE TIPOFF...

The UNCG women's basketball team looks to get into the win column for the first time this season, traveling west for a non-conference contest at Gardner-Webb at Paul Porter Arena. The Spartans opened the season Friday at Florida State - dropping a 93-59 decision to the Seminoles. The Bulldogs played NAIA member Montreat to open their campaign and posted an 86-46 home victory. UNCG and Gardner-Webb met for the first time last season with the Spartans coming away with a 55-49 win at Fleming Gymnasium.

ABOUT US...

A total of five Spartan freshmen experienced their official collegiate debuts at Florida State Friday and UNCG was able to play 11 of its 13 team members in the contest. Senior forward Janae' Stevenson led the offensive attack for the Blue and Gold with 12 points while freshman center Mariah Wilson pulled down a team-best six rebounds - including three offensive boards. UNCG was an impressive 14-for-18 from the foul line as freshman forward Jade Scaife was 6-for-6 and freshman guard Shanese Harris was 5-for-6. The Spartans continued their prowess on the offensive glass in the season opener, out-dueling the Seminoles 19-18 in the statistic. UNCG was top offensive rebounding team in the Southern Conference last season. The Blue and Gold hung tough with Florida State in the first half of Friday's game, trailing by just six points with four minutes remaining in the first half, but the Seminoles put together a 22-0 run spanning the end of the first half and beginning of the second stanza to pull away. The Spartans also shot just 29.9 percent from the floor (20-for-67).

ABOUT THEM...

Gardner-Webb was picked to finish fifth in the Big South Conference this season after compiling a 13-18 record a season ago. Senior center Catrina Green earned preseason All-Big South recognition from College Sports Madness after averaging a near a double-double last season, posting 10.2 points and 9.4 rebounds per game. Junior forward Jessica Heilig led the way for the Bulldogs against Montreat with 14 points including a pair of three-point field goals. She was joined in double figures by Lana Doran (11 points), Candace Brown (10 points) and Green (10 points, seven rebounds). Brown added six rebounds, four assists and two steals. Gardner-Webb won the rebounding battle 45-28, forced 29 turnovers and limited the Cavaliers to just 34.1 percent from the floor (16.7 percent from 3-point range).

Wendy Palmer (Virginia, '96) is in her third season at the helm of the UNCG women's basketball program. Under her tutelege, the team doubled their win total in 2012-13 and won a game in the conference tournament for the first time since 2010. Palmer also mentored guard Lucy Mason to Southern Conference Freshman of the Year accolades. She arrived in Greensboro after a two-year stint as an assistant coach at her alma mater Virginia. While on the Cavalier staff, Palmer helped recruit and sign a class ranked in the top 15 nationally by ESPN HoopGurlz and coached All-American and national Defensive Player of the Year Monica Wright. During Palmer's tenure on the sidelines, Virginia made one NCAA appearance and a WNIT quarterfinals appearance. Palmer was an assistant for two years at Kentucky prior to returning to Virginia. There, she coached All-American Victoria Dunlap, who was taken 11th in a recent WNBA Draft. While still playing professionally, Palmer began her coaching career at Virginia Commonwealth. In her two years there, Palmer coached 2006 Colonial Athletic Association Rookie of the Year Quanitra Hollingsworth and Krystal Vaughn, who both went on to play professionally in the WNBA and in Europe. Palmer enjoyed outstanding playing careers on both the professional and amateur levels. A WNBA All-Star for the Detroit Shock in 2000, Palmer was also the WNBA's Co-Most Improved Player with the Connecticut Sun in 2004. She was selected in the 1997 Elite Draft by the Utah Starzz in preparation for the WNBA's inaugural year of competition and was a second-team All-WNBA selection that season. Palmer also played for the Orlando Miracle, San Antonio Silver Stars and Seattle Storm in her WNBA career. The Shock's Community Relations Player Representative from 1999-2001, Palmer was the recipient of the Black Legends of Professional Basketball John Isaacs Service Award. Palmer also played professionally in Spain, Brazil, Hungary, Turkey, Italy and Russia, earning another all-star bid in Italy. On the collegiate level, Palmer was a two-time Kodak All-American and Atlantic Coast Conference Player of the Year for the Cavaliers, earning those honors in 1995 and 1996. A three-time All-ACC selection, she is still the Cavs' career rebounding leader and is fourth on Virginia's all-time scoring list. Palmer was the first woman in school history and just the second player overall to record 1,000 career points and 1,000 career rebounds at Virginia. Cavalier legend Ralph Sampson was the other.

Rick Reeves (Indiana State, '81) is in his 10th season with the Gardner-Webb women's basketball program. Reeves has posted 403 career wins in 27 seasons as a college head coach and rebuilt Gardner-Webb's operation to the tune of 136 wins so far. His 2009-10 squad won the Big South Conference regular season crown and fell a basket shy of the NCAA Tournament – advancing instead to the school's first Division I basketball postseason appearance in the WNIT. His team pushed through the following season, winning the Big South Conference Tournament and playing competitively with Miami (Fla.) in the first round of the NCAA Division I Tournament in Charlottesville, Va.

LAST TIME OUT FOR THE SPARTANS

Florida State 93, UNCG 59

TALLAHASSEE, Fla. - A 22-0 run spanning the end of the first half and beginning of the second stanza allowed Florida State to pull away from the UNCG women's basketball team and record a 93-59 victory in the season opener for both teams Friday evening at the Donald L. Tucker Center. The Spartans were able to put up 67 shots but only 20 fell through as UNCG finished the game shooting 29.9 percent from the floor. Conversely, the Seminoles knocked down 41 of their 70 attempts, many of them from down low to finish at 58.6 percent. FSU out-rebounded the Blue and Gold 48-34, but UNCG won the offensive rebounding battle 19-18 - resulting in 17 Spartan second-chance points. Both squads had trouble holding onto the ball, combining for 42 turnovers in the early season battle. The Spartans did shine at the free throw line, draining 14 of 18 attempts (77.8 percent) led by freshmen forward Jade Scaife's 6-for-6 performance and freshman guard Shanese Harris' 5-for-6 showing. Senior forward Janae' Stevenson paced the offensive attack with 12 points while freshman center Mariah Wilson pulled down a team-best six rebounds including three offensive boards. Freshman guard Bailey Williams dished out a squad-high three assists in her collegiate debut. Brittany Brown gave Florida State a 2-0 lead with a layup to begin the game before Patterson responded with a three-point field goal to put the Spartans on top. The Seminoles would take control from there as a layup by Lauren Coleman capped a 12-2 run and afforded FSU a 14-5 advantage with 16:08 on the clock. Patterson kept UNCG within striking range with 10:53 remaining before halftime as she hit a jumper and drained her second trey of the contest to make the score 23-17. The Blue and Gold hung tough with Florida State down the stretch and drew within 32-26 at the 4:11 mark when junior guard Jarae Savage knocked down a free throw. However, that would be the last points UNCG would score in the half as the Spartans became careless with the ball and allowed the Seminoles to net the final 16 points of the stanza - leaving the margin at 48-26 going into the break. Florida State scored the first six points of the second half to complete a 22-0 run which spanned almost eight minutes and take a 54-26 lead. Stevenson popped in the first two UNCG points at the 17:16 mark on a layup to make the score 54-28 before two free throws by sophomore guard Lucy Mason pulled the Spartans to within 58-32. The Seminoles were able to salt the game away down the stretch, as a tip in by Savage made the score 73-43 with 8:05 left and marked the closest the Spartans would come the rest of the way.

CASHING IN ON THE FREEBIES...

A bright spot for UNCG in the season opener at Florida State was its performance at the free throw line. The Spartans were 14-for-18 at the stripe led by a pair of freshman in Jade Scaife and Shanese Harris who combined to make 11 of 12 attempts.

USUALLY GOOD FOR THREE...

UNCG has nailed at least one three-point field goal in 206 of its last 208 games and seven straight. The Spartans owned a streak of 155-straight contests with a triple until they went 0-6 at Wofford Dec. 17, 2011.

SOCON FRESHMAN OF THE YEAR...

Freshman guard Lucy Mason was selected the 2013 Southern Conference Freshman of the Year by the league's media members. She is the first Spartan to earn league freshman of the year accolades since Kristen Boone was recognized during the 2004-05 campaign and the first to garner a spot on the all-freshman team since teammate Janae' Stevenson in 2010-11. Mason paced the Spartans this season in scoring at 12.5 points per game and three-point field goals made with 35 while also averaging in double figures in SoCon play at 10.4 points per contest. She started every game for UNCG in 2012-13 and was the highest scoring rookie in the league by a full six points in all games and by three points in league contests.

SCORING THE BALL BETTER...

UNCG averaged a paltry 49.6 points per game in the 2011-12 campaign. The Spartans raised that average last year by over seven points as they scored 57.2 points per game in 31 contests. In the season opener against Florida State, the Blue and Gold dropped in 59 points.

LUCKY NUMBER 7(0)...

UNCG is 21-1 in its last 22 contests when scoring at least 70 points. The Spartans' last loss when scoring 70 was nearly five years ago, Dec. 20, 2007, when the Blue and Gold fell at UCF, 76-73. The Blue and Gold reached 70 points twice this season in a 71-63 triumph over Norfolk State (Dec. 15) and an 87-75 road victory at Wofford (Jan. 28).

STUFFED...

Stevenson is rapidly moving her way up the UNCG career blocked shots list. As a freshman, she swatted 36 shots, the fourth-most in a single season in school history. She did two better with 38 blocked shots her sophomore campaign. With 104 to her credit now, she is third in program career history. Should she maintain her current pace, Stevenson should easily surpass UNCG's career record of 121 by Rebecca Viverette (1994-98) by the time her days in a Spartan uniform are over.

JUST FINE IN FLEMING...

UNCG has been historically successful in Fleming Gym, posting a 198-93 (.680) mark at the venue. In 23 years, UNCG has had just five losing seasons in the facility. The playing surface was christened Lynne Agee Court in honor of the former UNCG coach, who retired in March 2011 after 30 years at the helm. The court was officially dedicated at halftime of UNCG's Dec. 3, 2011 contest against Samford.

ROCKY ROAD...

The Blue and Gold has had a tough go of it away from home the last five years, compiling an 18-52 record away from Fleming Gymnasium.

BUCKETS...

The Spartans broke out in a big way against Wofford on the road last season as shots finally began to fall. The 87 points scored were the most for UNCG since dropping 88 on Elon in a 48-point victory Jan. 20, 2007. A total of four Spartans scored in double figures while Mason recorded a career-high 25 points.

A RARE FEAT ON THE ROAD...

UNCG's road win against Samford last year was notable for a number of reasons. Entering the contest, the Bulldogs were 7-2 at home for the season and 61-14 since the Pete Hanna Center opened. The Spartans also won at Samford for the first time in program history (0-4 prior).

LOW-BALLING THE COMPETITION...

UNCG clamped down defensively when it welcomed NC Central to Fleming Gymnasium last season, dealing the Eagles a 49-39 loss. The Spartans allowed their fewest amount of points in a single game since limiting Fordham to 39 in a 50-39 victory at Fleming Gymnasium Dec. 13, 2008. The Blue and Gold also set a program single-game mark for blocked shots with 11 on the night as three players had at least three.

WHAT'S BACK FOR THE BLUE AND GOLD...

UNCG may have a number of new faces joining the program this season, but the Spartans also return a large amount of their production - losing just one starter from the 2012-13 squad. Below is a more in-depth look.

UNCG AGAINST THE BIG SOUTH...

The Spartans own a record of 122-58 against current members of the Big South Conference. In addition to Gardner-Webb, UNCG is also scheduled to play High Point this season at Fleming Gymnasium. The Spartans have never faced VMI or Presbyterian. VMI will join the Southern Conference next season but the Keydets have discontinued their women's baskebtall program.

SOUTHERN CONFERENCE: THE 17TH SEASON...

UNCG is in its 17th season as a basketball member of the Southern Conference. Starting in 1997, the Spartans became eligible to compete for the league title after making their transition to Division I status as a member of the Big South Conference. UNCG owns two regular season championships (1998-99 and 2001-02) and one tournament title (1998) which led to the program's only NCAA Tournament appearance. The Blue and Gold also qualified for the WNIT at the conclusion of the 2001-02 campaign. Below is a closer look at UNCG's history in the league.

The 2014 edition of the Southern Conference Women's Basketball Championship is scheduled for March 7-10 in Asheville, N.C. All 10 conference squads will compete in the event, with the winner taking the league's automatic bid to the 2014 NCAA Tournament. Last season, No. 1 seed Chattanooga swept through the event to win its 14th SoCon title. The Mocs, seeded 11th in the NCAA Tournament, fell to No. 6 seed Nebraska 73-59 in the national event's first round.
