Spartans Open Home Schedule Against South Carolina State

THE TIPOFF...

After two games on the road to begin the 2013-14 campaign, the UNCG women's basketball team plays eight of its next nine at home - beginning with Friday's non-conference contest against South Carolina State. The Spartans seek their first victory of the season after losing to Florida State and Gardner-Webb. The game serves as the season opener for the Bulldogs. UNCG was 5-11 at home last season while South Carolina State tallied a 9-6 mark away from home.

ABOUT US...

UNCG has used its bench liberally so far this season as 11 of 13 players have experienced time on the court and six are averaging 20 or minutes played per game. Senior guard Breonna Patterson leads the squad in scoring at 12 points per game while classmate and forward Janae' Stevenson checks in with a 9.0 average. In terms of rebounding, Stevenson paces the team at 6.0 per contest. Patterson has done well from range, knocking down five of her 11 three-point attempts. Free throw shooting has been a bright spot for the Spartans as they have drained 33 of 48 tries (68.8 percent). Freshman forward Jade Scaife is 8-for-10, sophomore guard Lucy Mason is 7-for-8 and Patterson is 5-for-6 from the stripe. UNCG has struggled to shoot the ball, firing at a meager 28.6 percent clip from the field. The Blue and Gold is shooting 31.3 percent from deep. In Monday's outing at Gardner-Webb, Patterson led the Spartans with 16 points while Savage pulled down a team-best eight rebounds. Savage also reached double figures with 12 points and Mason chipped in with 10 points. UNCG shot just 28 percent from the field and was out-rebounded 54-40.

ABOUT THEM...

South Carolina State, under the direction of six year head coach Doug Robertson, Jr., is coming off a 20-9 season from a year ago which was the best season under Robertson. The Lady Bulldogs returns five players from last year squad including two starters (Cabriel Duren and Kourtney Williams). Duren averaged 5.7 points, 2.2 rebounds and 2.55 assists per game. Williams, who came on strong during her sophomore campaign averaged 7.6 points and 2.8 rebounds per outing. South Carolina State played Claflin in exhibition action Nov. 4 and lost an 82-69 decision. Junior Kourtney Williams tossed in a game-high 28 points and grabbed a team-leading 11 rebounds. The Bulldogs struggled from the field, shooting 33.8 percent and were out-rebounded 58-36.

Wendy Palmer (Virginia, '96) is in her third season at the helm of the UNCG women's basketball program. Under her tutelage, the team doubled their win total in 2012-13 and won a game in the conference tournament for the first time since 2010. Palmer also mentored guard Lucy Mason to Southern Conference Freshman of the Year accolades. She arrived in Greensboro after a two-year stint as an assistant coach at her alma mater Virginia. While on the Cavalier staff, Palmer helped recruit and sign a class ranked in the top 15 nationally by ESPN HoopGurlz and coached All-American and national Defensive Player of the Year Monica Wright. During Palmer's tenure on the sidelines, Virginia made one NCAA appearance and a WNIT quarterfinals appearance. Palmer was an assistant for two years at Kentucky prior to returning to Virginia. There, she coached All-American Victoria Dunlap, who was taken 11th in a recent WNBA Draft. While still playing professionally, Palmer began her coaching career at Virginia Commonwealth. In her two years there, Palmer coached 2006 Colonial Athletic Association Rookie of the Year Quanitra Hollingsworth and Krystal Vaughn, who both went on to play professionally in the WNBA and in Europe. Palmer enjoyed outstanding playing careers on both the professional and amateur levels. A WNBA All-Star for the Detroit Shock in 2000, Palmer was also the WNBA's Co-Most Improved Player with the Connecticut Sun in 2004. She was selected in the 1997 Elite Draft by the Utah Starzz in preparation for the WNBA's inaugural year of competition and was a second-team All-WNBA selection that season. Palmer also played for the Orlando Miracle, San Antonio Silver Stars and Seattle Storm in her WNBA career. The Shock's Community Relations Player Representative from 1999-2001, Palmer was the recipient of the Black Legends of Professional Basketball John Isaacs Service Award. Palmer also played professionally in Spain, Brazil, Hungary, Turkey, Italy and Russia, earning another all-star bid in Italy. On the collegiate level, Palmer was a two-time Kodak All-American and Atlantic Coast Conference Player of the Year for the Cavaliers, earning those honors in 1995 and 1996. A three-time All-ACC selection, she is still the Cavs' career rebounding leader and is fourth on Virginia's all-time scoring list. Palmer was the first woman in school history and just the second player overall to record 1,000 career points and 1,000 career rebounds at Virginia. Cavalier legend Ralph Sampson was the other.

Doug Robertson, Jr. (Bowie State, '95) is in his fifth season as the head coach of the South Carolina State University women's basketball team. Robertson, a Baltimore native, moved to Orangeburg in the fall 2008 after three seasons as head coach at Bowie State where he compiled a 53-33 record. He had his most productive campaign during the 2007-08 season when he guided his team to a 22-5 record and the Eastern Division Championship of the Central Intercollegiate Athletic Association (CIAA), garnering Coach of the Year Honors.

LAST TIME OUT FOR THE SPARTANS

Gardner-Webb 71, UNCG 60

November 11, 2013 @ Boiling Springs, N.C. (Paul Porter Arena)

BOILING SPRINGS, N.C. – A lengthy scoring drought by the UNCG women's basketball team to start the second half allowed Gardner-Webb to record a 71-60 non-conference victory Monday night at Paul Porter Arena. Senior Breonna Patterson led the Spartans with 16 points while junior guard Jarae Savage pulled down a team-best eight rebounds. Savage also reached double figures with 12 points and sophomore guard Lucy Mason chipped in with 10 points. Catrina Green anchored the Runnin Bulldogs with 22 points and 12 rebounds. Gardner-Webb had a large advantage at the free throw line as UNCG was whistled for 29 fouls as compared to 21 for the Runnin Bulldogs. As a result, GWU went to the line 37 times but only shot 56.8 percent – missing many of those attempts in the final two minutes. The Blue and Gold shot under 30 percent for the second-straight game, making just 27 percent of their shots from the field (18-for-66). Conversely, Gardner-Webb fired at a 41.8 percent clip, knocking down 23 of 55 tries. The Runnin Bulldogs also won the rebounding war by a large margin at 54-40. Gardner-Webb raced out to an 8-2 advantage just 2:25 into the contest on the strength of six points from Green. The Runnin Bulldogs would extend the lead to 12-4 before a layup by senior guard Janae' Stevenson and a three by Patterson helped slice the UNCG deficit to 12-9. Patterson knocked down another triple with 12:06 on the clock to knot the score at 14 before Jasmine Dale gave GWU the lead back with a jumper on the next possession. The Spartan defense clamped down from there, holding Gardner-Webb scoreless until the 8:03 mark when a jumper by Candace Brown made the score 19-18 in favor of the Blue and Gold. A free throw by freshman center Mariah Wilson gave UNCG its largest lead of the half at 23-18 with 6:12 remaining and the Spartans would lead by as many as four with time winding down. The Runnin Bulldogs began to answer down the stretch, eventually moving in front 30-26 on a three by Olivia Parker. UNCG responded with four quick points to tie the score before a three by Kiera Currie with seven ticks on the clock allowed Gardner-Webb to take a 33-30 advantage at the break. A three by Dale helped Gardner-Webb go on a 7-0 run to begin the second half as the Runnin Bulldogs built a 40-30 lead with 15:51 left in the contest. UNCG continued to struggle offensively, scoring just two points in the first eight minutes of the stanza and letting GWU move in front 46-32. The pace picked up from that point as the Spartans tried to rally. A layup by freshman guard Shanese Harris made it 53-42 as the clock ticked under eight minutes. UNCG could never quite get the lead under eight points however as Gardner-Webb was able to hold on down the stretch.

CASHING IN ON THE FREEBIES...

A bright spot for UNCG in the season opener at Florida State was its performance at the free throw line. The Spartans were 14-for-18 at the stripe led by a pair of freshman in Jade Scaife and Shanese Harris who combined to make 11 of 12 attempts.

USUALLY GOOD FOR THREE...

UNCG has nailed at least one three-point field goal in 207 of its last 209 games and eight straight. The Spartans owned a streak of 155-straight contests with a triple until they went 0-6 at Wofford Dec. 17, 2011.

SOCON FRESHMAN OF THE YEAR...

Freshman guard Lucy Mason was selected the 2013 Southern Conference Freshman of the Year by the league's media members. She is the first Spartan to earn league freshman of the year accolades since Kristen Boone was recognized during the 2004-05 campaign and the first to garner a spot on the all-freshman team since teammate Janae' Stevenson in 2010-11. Mason paced the Spartans this season in scoring at 12.5 points per game and three-point field goals made with 35 while also averaging in double figures in SoCon play at 10.4 points per contest. She started every game for UNCG in 2012-13 and was the highest scoring rookie in the league by a full six points in all games and by three points in league contests.

SCORING THE BALL BETTER...

UNCG averaged a paltry 49.6 points per game in the 2011-12 campaign. The Spartans raised that average last year by over seven points as they scored 57.2 points per game in 31 contests. In the season opener against Florida State, the Blue and Gold dropped in 59 points followed by 60 at Gardner-Webb.

LUCKY NUMBER 7(0)...

UNCG is 21-1 in its last 22 contests when scoring at least 70 points. The Spartans' last loss when scoring 70 was nearly five years ago, Dec. 20, 2007, when the Blue and Gold fell at UCF, 76-73. The Blue and Gold reached 70 points twice this season in a 71-63 triumph over Norfolk State (Dec. 15) and an 87-75 road victory at Wofford (Jan. 28).

STUFFED...

Stevenson is rapidly moving her way up the UNCG career blocked shots list. As a freshman, she swatted 36 shots, the fourth-most in a single season in school history. She did two better with 38 blocked shots her sophomore campaign. With 104 to her credit now, she is third in program career history. Should she maintain her current pace, Stevenson should easily surpass UNCG's career record of 121 by Rebecca Viverette (1994-98) by the time her days in a Spartan uniform are over.

JUST FINE IN FLEMING...

UNCG has been historically successful in Fleming Gym, posting a 198-93 (.680) mark at the venue. In 23 years, UNCG has had just five losing seasons in the facility. The playing surface was christened Lynne Agee Court in honor of the former UNCG coach, who retired in March 2011 after 30 years at the helm. The court was officially dedicated at halftime of UNCG's Dec. 3, 2011 contest against Samford.

ROCKY ROAD...

The Blue and Gold has had a tough go of it away from home the last five years, compiling an 18-53 record away from Fleming Gymnasium.

BUCKETS...

The Spartans broke out in a big way against Wofford on the road last season as shots finally began to fall. The 87 points scored were the most for UNCG since dropping 88 on Elon in a 48-point victory Jan. 20, 2007. A total of four Spartans scored in double figures while Mason recorded a career-high 25 points.

A RARE FEAT ON THE ROAD...

UNCG's road win against Samford last year was notable for a number of reasons. Entering the contest, the Bulldogs were 7-2 at home for the season and 61-14 since the Pete Hanna Center opened. The Spartans also won at Samford for the first time in program history (0-4 prior).

LOW-BALLING THE COMPETITION...

UNCG clamped down defensively when it welcomed NC Central to Fleming Gymnasium last season, dealing the Eagles a 49-39 loss. The Spartans allowed their fewest amount of points in a single game since limiting Fordham to 39 in a 50-39 victory at Fleming Gymnasium Dec. 13, 2008. The Blue and Gold also set a program single-game mark for blocked shots with 11 on the night as three players had at least three.

WHAT'S BACK FOR THE BLUE AND GOLD...

UNCG may have a number of new faces joining the program this season, but the Spartans also return a large amount of their production - losing just one starter from the 2012-13 squad. Below is a more in-depth look.

SOUTHERN CONFERENCE: THE 17TH SEASON...

UNCG is in its 17th season as a basketball member of the Southern Conference. Starting in 1997, the Spartans became eligible to compete for the league title after making their transition to Division I status as a member of the Big South Conference. UNCG owns two regular season championships (1998-99 and 2001-02) and one tournament title (1998) which led to the program's only NCAA Tournament appearance. The Blue and Gold also qualified for the WNIT at the conclusion of the 2001-02 campaign. Below is a closer look at UNCG's history in the league.

2014 SOUTHERN CONFERENCE CHAMPIONSHIP...

The 2014 edition of the Southern Conference Women's Basketball Championship is scheduled for March 7-10 in Asheville, N.C. All 10 conference squads will compete in the event, with the winner taking the league's automatic bid to the 2014 NCAA Tournament. Last season, No. 1 seed Chattanooga swept through the event to win its 14th SoCon title. The Mocs, seeded 11th in the NCAA Tournament, fell to No. 6 seed Nebraska 73-59 in the national event's first round.

APPROACHING 1,000...
