UNCG Seeks First Road Win Of Season At Norfolk State

THE TIPOFF...

The UNCG women's basketball team looks to notch its first road victory of the campaign Wednesday, traveling to the Tidewater area of Virginia for a non-conference contest with Norfolk State. The Spartans played host to the Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference outfit last season at Fleming Gymnasium as the Blue and Gold captured a 71-63 decision Dec. 14. The game marks the second consecutive for the Spartans against a MEAC institution having played host to South Carolina State last Saturday.

ABOUT US...

UNCG enters the game with a 1-2 record after downing South Carolina State 72-63 at Fleming Gymnasium last Saturday. A trio of freshmen started the game in guards Bailey Williams and Shanese Harris as well as forward Jade Scaife. Senior forward/center Janae' Stevenson notched her first double-double of the campaign with 11 points and 10 rebounds in 24 minutes of action while sophomore guard Lucy Mason and senior guard Breonna Patterson scored in double figures with 17 and 13 points respectively. UNCG out-shot the Bulldogs by a .431-.397 margin - including a 53.6 percent first half - and out-rebounded SCSU by one at 42-41. The Spartans are paced in scoring early in the season by Patterson and Mason as the backcourt duo is averaging 12.3 and 11.3 points per game. Stevenson averages 9.7 points per game to check in at third while she also leads the squad in rebounding at 7.3 boards a contest. Mason and Williams have combined for 18 assists (nine each) as the Spartans have recorded 40 helpers as a team - 20 of which occurred against South Carolina State. UNCG is shooting 33 percent from the field, 34 percent from deep and 67 percent from the foul line. The Spartans are also getting out-rebounded by an average of nine boards a game (47.7-38.7).

ABOUT THEM...

Norfolk State enters the contest with a 1-1 record after defeating Radford 66-54 at home last Friday. Senior Rachel Gordon led the Spartans with 16 points and 16 rebounds and was 8-for-10 from the field. Junior Rae Corbo posted 12 points and dished out six assists while classmate Ebony Brown contributed 14 points and seven boards. Norfolk State shot 41 percent (24-for-58) from the field and hit 13 of its 17 free throw attempts to end up at 77 percent. The Spartans also out-muscled the Highlanders 44-40 on the glass. Norfolk State was 6-6 at home last season on the way to a 7-22 overall ledger.

Wendy Palmer (Virginia, '96) is in her third season at the helm of the UNCG women's basketball program. Under her tutelage, the team doubled their win total in 2012-13 and won a game in the conference tournament for the first time since 2010. Palmer also mentored guard Lucy Mason to Southern Conference Freshman of the Year accolades. She arrived in Greensboro after a two-year stint as an assistant coach at her alma mater Virginia. While on the Cavalier staff, Palmer helped recruit and sign a class ranked in the top 15 nationally by ESPN HoopGurlz and coached All-American and national Defensive Player of the Year Monica Wright. During Palmer's tenure on the sidelines, Virginia made one NCAA appearance and a WNIT quarterfinals appearance. Palmer was an assistant for two years at Kentucky prior to returning to Virginia. There, she coached All-American Victoria Dunlap, who was taken 11th in a recent WNBA Draft. While still playing professionally, Palmer began her coaching career at Virginia Commonwealth. In her two years there, Palmer coached 2006 Colonial Athletic Association Rookie of the Year Quanitra Hollingsworth and Krystal Vaughn, who both went on to play professionally in the WNBA and in Europe. Palmer enjoyed outstanding playing careers on both the professional and amateur levels. A WNBA All-Star for the Detroit Shock in 2000, Palmer was also the WNBA's Co-Most Improved Player with the Connecticut Sun in 2004. She was selected in the 1997 Elite Draft by the Utah Starzz in preparation for the WNBA's inaugural year of competition and was a second-team All-WNBA selection that season. Palmer also played for the Orlando Miracle, San Antonio Silver Stars and Seattle Storm in her WNBA career. The Shock's Community Relations Player Representative from 1999-2001, Palmer was the recipient of the Black Legends of Professional Basketball John Isaacs Service Award. Palmer also played professionally in Spain, Brazil, Hungary, Turkey, Italy and Russia, earning another all-star bid in Italy. On the collegiate level, Palmer was a two-time Kodak All-American and Atlantic Coast Conference Player of the Year for the Cavaliers, earning those honors in 1995 and 1996. A three-time All-ACC selection, she is still the Cavs' career rebounding leader and is fourth on Virginia's all-time scoring list. Palmer was the first woman in school history and just the second player overall to record 1,000 career points and 1,000 career rebounds at Virginia. Cavalier legend Ralph Sampson was the other.

LAST TIME OUT FOR THE SPARTANS

UNCG 72, South Carolina State 63
November 15, 2013 @ Greensboro, N.C. (Fleming Gymnasium)

GREENSBORO, N.C. – The UNCG women's basketball team raced out to an early advantage Friday afternoon and did not look back, posting a 72-63 victory in its home opener at Fleming Gymnasium. The Spartans led wire-to-wire and led by as many as 15 in the second half before closing out the win at the foul line. A trio of UNCG players scored in double figures led by sophomore guard Lucy Mason who netted 17 and hit six of her seven free throw attempts to go along with six assists. Senior forward Janae' Stevenson notched her first double-double of the season with 11 points and 10 rebounds while senior guard Breonna Patterson added 13 points and handed out three assists. Additionally, freshman forward Jade Scaife tallied nine points, nine rebounds and two steals. UNCG out-shot the Bulldogs, 431-.397 and limited the visitors to just nine percent (1-for-11) from beyond the arc while knocking down six of their own 15 attempts. The Spartans also won the rebounding battle by one at 42-41 and recorded 20 assists on 25 made baskets. UNCG fired at a 54-percent clip in the first 20 minutes and drained five of six free throws in the period while also knocking down five of 10 from range. It was all Spartans at the beginning as freshman guard Shanese Harris took the opening tip and raced down the floor for a layup. UNCG quickly extended its lead to 8-0 in the first two minutes and forced the Bulldogs to take a timeout. A layup by DayShaun Richbow cut the Spartan lead to 8-4 before a pair of three pointers by Patterson capped an 11-0 run which put UNCG in front by 15 with 14:31 left on the clock. South Carolina State cut its deficit under 10 points a couple of times, but a layup and free throw by Mason pushed the lead back to 13 as the clock ticked under eight minutes. Another triple by Patterson helped the Spartans maintain that advantage into the half as UNCG took a 40-27 lead into the locker room. The teams traded buckets as the second stanza commenced and a layup by Stevenson with 15:55 remaining in the contest kept UNCG's cushion at 48-35. The Spartans took their biggest lead of the half after a layup by sophomore guard Jazmine Missouri made it 53-39 at the 12:57 mark. However, South Carolina State began to rally – taking advantage of some costly UNCG turnovers. A layup by Cabriel Duran had the Bulldogs all the way back to within five at 57-52 as 6:17 remained in the game. The Spartans built the lead back to nine on two occasions before a layup by Persephone Goodwin made it a five-point affair once more, 63-58, with 3:36 left. It was a freshman who came up big for the Blue and Gold on the next possession, as guard Bailey Williams (Harrisonburg, Va./Spotswood) stepped back and nailed a three-pointer from the top of the key to give the Spartans a 66-58 lead. The Bulldogs would not come any closer than seven the rest of the way.

CASHING IN ON THE FREEBIES...

A bright spot for UNCG in the season opener at Florida State was its performance at the free throw line. The Spartans were 14-for-18 at the stripe led by a pair of freshman in Jade Scaife and Shanese Harris who combined to make 11 of 12 attempts.

USUALLY GOOD FOR THREE...

UNCG has nailed at least one three-point field goal in 208 of its last 210 games and nine straight. The Spartans owned a streak of 155-straight contests with a triple until they went 0-6 at Wofford Dec. 17, 2011.

SOCON FRESHMAN OF THE YEAR...

Freshman guard Lucy Mason was selected the 2013 Southern Conference Freshman of the Year by the league's media members. She is the first Spartan to earn league freshman of the year accolades since Kristen Boone was recognized during the 2004-05 campaign and the first to garner a spot on the all-freshman team since teammate Janae' Stevenson in 2010-11. Mason paced the Spartans this season in scoring at 12.5 points per game and three-point field goals made with 35 while also averaging in double figures in SoCon play at 10.4 points per contest. She started every game for UNCG in 2012-13 and was the highest scoring rookie in the league by a full six points in all games and by three points in league contests.

SCORING THE BALL BETTER...

UNCG averaged a paltry 49.6 points per game in the 2011-12 campaign. The Spartans raised that average last year by over seven points as they scored 57.2 points per game in 31 contests. This season, the Blue and Gold is averaging 63.7 points in three games.

LUCKY NUMBER 7(0)...

UNCG is 22-1 in its last 23 contests when scoring at least 70 points. The Spartans' last loss when scoring 70 was nearly five years ago, Dec. 20, 2007, when the Blue and Gold fell at UCF, 76-73. The Blue and Gold reached 70 points for the third time in the last two seasons last Saturday when they dropped 72 on South Carolina State.

STUFFED...

Stevenson is rapidly moving her way up the UNCG career blocked shots list. As a freshman, she swatted 36 shots, the fourth-most in a single season in school history. She did two better with 38 blocked shots her sophomore campaign. With 104 to her credit now, she is third in program career history. Should she maintain her current pace, Stevenson should easily surpass UNCG's career record of 121 by Rebecca Viverette (1994-98) by the time her days in a Spartan uniform are over.

JUST FINE IN FLEMING...

UNCG has been historically successful in Fleming Gym, posting a 199-93 (.682) mark at the venue. In 23 years, UNCG has had just five losing seasons in the facility. The playing surface was christened Lynne Agee Court in honor of the former UNCG coach, who retired in March 2011 after 30 years at the helm. The court was officially dedicated at halftime of UNCG's Dec. 3, 2011 contest against Samford.

ROCKY ROAD...

The Blue and Gold has had a tough go of it away from home the last five years, compiling an 18-53 record away from Fleming Gymnasium.

BUCKETS...

The Spartans broke out in a big way against Wofford on the road last season as shots finally began to fall. The 87 points scored were the most for UNCG since dropping 88 on Elon in a 48-point victory Jan. 20, 2007. A total of four Spartans scored in double figures while Mason recorded a career-high 25 points.

A RARE FEAT ON THE ROAD...

UNCG's road win against Samford last year was notable for a number of reasons. Entering the contest, the Bulldogs were 7-2 at home for the season and 61-14 since the Pete Hanna Center opened. The Spartans also won at Samford for the first time in program history (0-4 prior).

LOW-BALLING THE COMPETITION...

UNCG clamped down defensively when it welcomed NC Central to Fleming Gymnasium last season, dealing the Eagles a 49-39 loss. The Spartans allowed their fewest amount of points in a single game since limiting Fordham to 39 in a 50-39 victory at Fleming Gymnasium Dec. 13, 2008. The Blue and Gold also set a program single-game mark for blocked shots with 11 on the night as three players had at least three.

WHAT'S BACK FOR THE BLUE AND GOLD...

UNCG may have a number of new faces joining the program this season, but the Spartans also return a large amount of their production - losing just one starter from the 2012-13 squad. Below is a more in-depth look.

The 2014 edition of the Southern Conference Women's Basketball Championship is scheduled for March 7-10 in Asheville, N.C. All 10 conference squads will compete in the event, with the winner taking the league's automatic bid to the 2014 NCAA Tournament. Last season, No. 1 seed Chattanooga swept through the event to win its 14th SoCon title. The Mocs, seeded 11th in the NCAA Tournament, fell to No. 6 seed Nebraska 73-59 in the national event's first round.

UNCG head coach Wendy Palmer welcomes four new members to the Spartan women's basketball family next season. Below is a look at the new faces joining the program next year:

Keli Foster, Guard, 5-7, Hampton, Va. (Bethel)

Foster averaged 10.4 points, 3.4 rebounds, 4.9 assists and 4.1 steals per game her junior campaign at Bethel High School, earning first-team all-district accolades. She currently serves as a team captain for the Bruins and scored a career-high 24 points in an upset win over powerhouse Hampton High School in January of last season. Foster also excels in the classroom as a member of her school's honor roll and is a participant in the student athletic training program. She plays her AAU basketball for the Boo Williams Norfolk Express coached by Morris Smith.

Skye Jefferson, Forward/Center, 6-2, Richmond, Va. (Cosby)

Jefferson was the starting center last season for a state championship contending Cosby High School team under head coach Rachel Mead. She helped lead the Titans to a 26-2 overall record and racked up second-team all-district honors. Jefferson is a member of the Boo Williams Richmond AAU program coached by Max Coats and Mike Davis.

Jayda Luckie, Guard, 5-9, Norfolk, Va. (Maury)

Luckie averaged 12.7 points per game at Maury High School last season under head coach Jermaine Woods and earned first-team all-district recognition. She helped the Commodores to a 21-6 record as a junior and is a teammate of fellow signee Keli Foster on the Boo Williams Norfolk Xpress AAU program coached by Morris Smith. One of her most memorable moments last season occurred against Mount Vernon when she scored 13 points and hit a buzzer-beating layup at the end of double overtime to give Maury a 79-77 victory.

Alison Whitman, Center/Forward, 6-3, Madison, W.Va. (Scott)

Whitman is an impact post player who earned third-team all-state, first-team all-district and first-team all-conference honors last season under head coach John Porter at Scott High School. As a sophomore, Whitman helped the Skyhawks to a 25-4 overall record, 8-1 league ledger and a No. 9 ranking in the state. Scott has finished as the state runner up the past two years. Whitman is also a member of the West Virginia Thunder AAU program coached by Scott Johnson.
