Having won its last two games, the UNCG women's basketball team begins a seven-game homestand by welcoming former Southern Conference rival College of Charleston to Fleming Gymnasium for an afternoon matchup. If the Spartans can knock off the Cougars, it will mark the first time since Feb. 7-12 of 2011 that UNCG will have won three consecutive games. College of Charleston won both meetings last season, including an 88-61 decision at Fleming Gymnasium Dec. 3, 2012.

Spartans Kick Off Seven-Game Homestand Against College of Charleston

ABOUT US...

UNCG enters the game with a 2-2 record after downing South Carolina State 72-63 in the home opener and Norfolk State 73-66 on the road. Senior forward Janae' Stevenson exploded for a career-high 24 points and matched her personal best in rebounding with 15 boards. The Spartans ended the game on a 31-12 run and rallied from as much as 12 points down in the second half. In addition to Stevenson's efforts, sophomore guard Lucy Mason went off for 13 points while sophomore guard Jazmine Missouri posted the first double-figure scoring performance of her career with 10 points. The two guards combined to go 12-for-14 from the free throw line as well. UNCG shot nearly 50 percent in the second half to end up at 36.4 percent for the game. The visiting Spartans also out-rebounded Norfolk State by five at 43-38 and picked up a whopping 17 offensive boards. The Blue and Gold held NSU's leading scorer Rachel Gordon to just four points in the contest while hitting 22 of 31 free throw attempts to finish 71 percent from the line. UNCG also committed a season-low 15 turnovers while forcing 21 by Norfolk State. The Spartans are shooting the ball at 34 percent from the field and are averaging right at 40 rebounds per game.

ABOUT THEM...

College of Charleston is 2-2 on the season after defeating USC Upstate 75-71 on the road Nov. 17. The Cougars have suffered losses to Winthrop and South Carolina while defeating Kennesaw State for its other victory. College of Charleston is led in scoring by Afreyea Tolbert who is averaging 13.8 points per game. She is also the top rebounder on the squad checking in at 9.8 boards per contest. The Cougars average 66.2 points and 46.0 rebounds as a team while shooting the ball at a .344 clip from the field, .246 from three-point range and .627 at the charity stripe.

Wendy Palmer (Virginia, '96) is in her third season at the helm of the UNCG women's basketball program. Under her tutelege, the team doubled their win total in 2012-13 and won a game in the conference tournament for the first time since 2010. Palmer also mentored guard Lucy Mason to Southern Conference Freshman of the Year accolades. She arrived in Greensboro after a two-year stint as an assistant coach at her alma mater Virginia. While on the Cavalier staff, Palmer helped recruit and sign a class ranked in the top 15 nationally by ESPN HoopGurlz and coached All-American and national Defensive Player of the Year Monica Wright. During Palmer's tenure on the sidelines, Virginia made one NCAA appearance and a WNIT quarterfinals appearance. Palmer was an assistant for two years at Kentucky prior to returning to Virginia. There, she coached All-American Victoria Dunlap, who was taken 11th in a recent WNBA Draft. While still playing professionally, Palmer began her coaching career at Virginia Commonwealth. In her two years there, Palmer coached 2006 Colonial Athletic Association Rookie of the Year Quanitra Hollingsworth and Krystal Vaughn, who both went on to play professionally in the WNBA and in Europe. Palmer enjoyed outstanding playing careers on both the professional and amateur levels. A WNBA All-Star for the Detroit Shock in 2000, Palmer was also the WNBA's Co-Most Improved Player with the Connecticut Sun in 2004. She was selected in the 1997 Elite Draft by the Utah Starzz in preparation for the WNBA's inaugural year of competition and was a second-team All-WNBA selection that season. Palmer also played for the Orlando Miracle, San Antonio Silver Stars and Seattle Storm in her WNBA career. The Shock's Community Relations Player Representative from 1999-2001, Palmer was the recipient of the Black Legends of Professional Basketball John Isaacs Service Award. Palmer also played professionally in Spain, Brazil, Hungary, Turkey, Italy and Russia, earning another all-star bid in Italy. On the collegiate level, Palmer was a two-time Kodak All-American and Atlantic Coast Conference Player of the Year for the Cavaliers, earning those honors in 1995 and 1996. A three-time All-ACC selection, she is still the Cavs' career rebounding leader and is fourth on Virginia's all-time scoring list. Palmer was the first woman in school history and just the second player overall to record 1,000 career points and 1,000 career rebounds at Virginia. Cavalier legend Ralph Sampson was the other.

LAST TIME OUT FOR THE SPARTANS

UNCG 73, Norfolk State 66 November 20. 2013 @ Norfolk, Va. (Echols Hall)

NORFOLK, Va. - Senior forward Janae' Stevenson exploded for career highs of 24 points and 15 rebounds and the UNCG women's basketball team ended the game on a 31-12 run to notch a 73-66 road win over Norfolk State Wednesday night at Echols Hall. The Spartans improve to 2-2 overall and drop NSU to 1-2. In addition to Stevenson's efforts, sophomore guard Lucy Mason went off for 13 points while sophomore guard Jazmine Missouri posted the first double-figure scoring performance of her career with 10 points. The two guards combined to go 12-for-14 from the free throw line as well. UNCG shot nearly 50 percent in the second half to end up at 36.4 percent for the game. The visiting Spartans also out-rebounded Norfolk State by five at 43-38 and picked up a whopping 17 offensive boards. The Blue and Gold held NSU's leading scorer Rachel Gordon to just four points in the contest while hitting 22 of 31 free throw attempts to finish 71 percent from the line. UNCG also committed a season-low 15 turnovers while forcing 21 by Norfolk State. The teams traded buckets to begin the game before a three by freshman guard Bailey Williams gave UNCG an 8-4 lead. A layup by freshman guard Shanese Harris with just under 17 minutes on the clock put the Blue and Gold ahead 10-8 before both sides hit a small scoring drought. Norfolk State was able to tie the score at 10 after a layup by Ebony Brown at the 13:39 mark. The NSU Spartans began to push ahead in the middle minutes of the half, going on a 10-3 run capped off by two Rae Corbo free throws and taking a 20-13 lead. UNCG would answer, however, as a layup by Scaife knotted the proceedings at 22 and ended a 9-2 run for the Blue and Gold. Norfolk State was the first to 30 points in the period thanks to a Rachel Gordon layup which made the score 30-26 with under three minutes left on the clock. Missouri afforded UNCG a slight 32-30 cushion at the 1:50 mark, but a lack of transition defense led to a pair of uncontested layups for NSU down the stretch as the homestanding Spartans took a 36-32 halftime advantage into the locker room. Stevenson paced UNCG with seven points and eight rebounds in the first 20 minutes while Mason dropped in seven points of her own. The visiting Spartans struggled from the field- shooting just 28 percent (10-of-36) while Norfolk State fired at a 48-percent clip (14-of-29). UNCG out-rebounded NSU 24-20, thanks in big part to 13 offensive rebounds, and forced 13 Spartan turnovers which resulted in 11 points. Norfolk State had the advantage down low in the paint 18-11. The squads traded runs as the second half began and Norfolk State would lead the game 42-40 with 15:42 remaining on the clock. UNCG went cold from the field for the next five minutes and allowed NSU to amass a large lead at 52-40. After both teams scored back-to-back, the Blue and Gold made its push. A steal by Mason and a three-point play by Stevenson made the score 54-45 before a 13-4 run fueled by Stevenson allowed UNCG to come all the way back and knot the score at 58 - a jumper by freshman forward Jade Scaife (Ft. Washington, Md./Archbishop Spalding) providing the tying points. As it turns out, UNCG would not trail again despite the home team's best efforts. Two free throws by Corbo tied the score for the final time at 62 and a layup by Stevenson pushed the visitors ahead by four points. The Blue and Gold put the game away at the line, hitting five of its final six free throws.



CASHING IN ON THE FREEBIES...

A bright spot for UNCG in the season opener at Florida State was its performance at the free throw line. The Spartans were 14-for-18 at the stripe led by a pair of freshman in Jade Scaife and Shanese Harris who combined to make 11 of 12 attempts. UNCG is shooting 68.3 percent at the charity stripe this season

USUALLY GOOD FOR THREE...

UNCG has nailed at least one three-point field goal in 209 of its last 211 games and 10 straight. The Spartans owned a streak of 155-straight contests with a triple until they went 0-6 at Wofford Dec. 17, 2011.

SOCON FRESHMAN OF THE YEAR...

Freshman guard Lucy Mason was selected the 2013 Southern Conference Freshman of the Year by the league's media members. She is the first Spartan to earn league freshman of the year accolades since Kristen Boone was recognized during the 2004-05 campaign and the first to garner a spot on the all-freshman team since teammate Janae' Stevenson in 2010-11. Mason paced the Spartans this season in scoring at 12.5 points per game and three-point field goals made with 35 while also averaging in double figures in SoCon play at 10.4 points per contest. She started every game for UNCG in 2012-13 and was the highest scoring rookie in the league by a full six points in all games and by three points in league contests.

SCORING THE BALL BETTER...

UNCG averaged a paltry 49.6 points per game in the 2011-12 campaign. The Spartans raised that average last year by over seven points as they scored 57.2 points per game in 31 contests. This season, the Blue and Gold is averaging 66.0 points in three games.

LUCKY NUMBER 7(0)...

UNCG is 23-1 in its last 24 contests when scoring at least 70 points. The Spartans' last loss when scoring 70 was nearly five years ago, Dec. 20, 2007, when the Blue and Gold fell at UCF, 76-73. The Blue and Gold reached 70 points for the second time this season Wednesday, dropping 73 on Norfolk State.

STUFFED...

Stevenson is rapidly moving her way up the UNCG career blocked shots list. As a freshman, she swatted 36 shots, the fourth-most in a single season in school history. She did two better with 38 blocked shots her sophomore campaign. With 105 to her credit now, she is third in program career history. Should she maintain her current pace, Stevenson should easily surpass UNCG's career record of 121 by Rebecca Viverette (1994-98) by the time her days in a Spartan uniform are over.

JUST FINE IN FLEMING...

UNCG has been historically successful in Fleming Gym, posting a 199-93 (.682) mark at the venue. In 23 years, UNCG has had just five losing seasons in the facility. The playing surface was christened Lynne Agee Court in honor of the former UNCG coach, who retired in March 2011 after 30 years at the helm. The court was officially dedicated at halftime of UNCG's Dec. 3, 2011 contest against Samford.

ROCKY ROAD...

The Blue and Gold has had a tough go of it away from home the last five years, compiling an 19-53 record away from Fleming Gymnasium.

BUCKETS...

The Spartans broke out in a big way against Wofford on the road last season as shots finally began to fall. The 87 points scored were the most for UNCG since dropping 88 on Elon in a 48-point victory Jan. 20, 2007. A total of four Spartans scored in double figures while Mason recorded a career-high 25 points.

A RARE FEAT ON THE ROAD...

UNCG's road win against Samford last year was notable for a number of reasons. Entering the contest, the Bulldogs were 7-2 at home for the season and 61-14 since the Pete Hanna Center opened. The Spartans also won at Samford for the first time in program history (0-4 prior).

LOW-BALLING THE COMPETITION...

UNCG clamped down defensively when it welcomed NC Central to Fleming Gymnasium last season, dealing the Eagles a 49-39 loss. The Spartans allowed their fewest amount of points in a single game since limiting Fordham to 39 in a 50-39 victory at Fleming Gymnasium Dec. 13, 2008. UNCG also set a program single-game mark for blocked shots with 11.

WHAT'S BACK FOR THE BLUE AND GOLD...

UNCG may have a number of new faces joining the program this season, but the Spartans also return a large amount of their production - losing just one starter from the 2012-13 squad. Below is a more in-depth look.

SOUTHERN CONFERENCE: THE 17TH SEASON...

UNCG is in its 17th season as a basketball member of the Southern Conference. Starting in 1997, the Spartans became eligible to compete for the league title after making their transition to Division I status as a member of the Big South Conference. UNCG owns two regular season championships (1998-99 and 2001-02) and one tournament title (1998) which led to the program's only NCAA Tournament appearance. The Blue and Gold also qualified for the WNIT at the conclusion of the 2001-02 campaign. Below is a closer look at UNCG's history in the league.

The 2014 edition of the Southern Conference Women's Basketball Championship is scheduled for March 7-10 in Asheville, N.C. All 10 conference squads will compete in the event, with the winner taking the league's automatic bid to the 2014 NCAA Tournament. Last season, No. 1 seed Chattanooga swept through the event to win its 14th SoCon title. The Mocs, seeded 11th in the NCAA Tournament, fell to No. 6 seed Nebraska 73-59 in the national event's first round.

UNCG head coach Wendy Palmer welcomes four new members to the Spartan women's basketball family next season. Below is a look at the new faces joining the program next year:

Keli Foster, Guard, 5-7, Hampton, Va. (Bethel)

Foster averaged 10.4 points, 3.4 rebounds, 4.9 assists and 4.1 steals per game her junior campaign at Bethel High School, earning first-team all-district accolades. She currently serves as a team captain for the Bruins and scored a career-high 24 points in an upset win over powerhouse Hampton High School in January of last season. Foster also excels in the classroom as a member of her school's honor roll and is a participant in the student athletic training program. She plays her AAU basketball for the Boo Williams Norfolk Express coached by Morris Smith.

Skye Jefferson, Forward/Center, 6-2, Richmond, Va. (Cosby)

Jefferson was the starting center last season for a state championship contending Cosby High School team under head coach Rachel Mead. She helped lead the Titans to a 26-2 overall record and racked up second-team all-district honors. Jefferson is a member of the Boo Williams Richmond AAU program coached by Max Coats and Mike Davis.

Jayda Luckie, Guard, 5-9, Norfolk, Va. (Maury)

Luckie averaged 12.7 points per game at Maury High School last season under head coach Jermaine Woods and earned first-team all-district recognition. She helped the Commodores to a 21-6 record as a junior and is a teammate of fellow signee Keli Foster on the Boo Williams Norfolk Xpress AAU program coached by Morris Smith. One of her most memorable moments last season occurred against Mount Vernon when she scored 13 points and hit a buzzer-beating layup at the end of double overtime to give Maury a 79-77 victory.

Alison Whitman, Center/Forward, 6-3, Madison, W.Va. (Scott)

Whitman is an impact post player who earned third-team all-state. first-team all-district and first-team all-conference honors last season under head coach John Porter at Scott High School. As a sophomore, Whitman helped the Skyhawks to a 25-4 overall record, 8-1 league ledger and a No. 9 ranking in the state. Scott has finished as the state runner up the past two years. Whitman is also a member of the West Virginia Thunder AAU program coached by Scott Johnson.
