UNCG Plays Host To Triad Rival High Point

THE TIPOFF...

The UNCG women's basketball team takes on Triad rival High Point for the first time since 2010 when the Spartans welcome the Panthers to Fleming Gymnasium Sunday afternoon. Both teams have played well recently as the Blue and Gold has won three of its last four contests while High Point is the winner of three-straight games. UNCG is 2-1 at home thus far while the Panthers bring a 1-1 road record into the tilt. The game is the third contest of a current seven-game homestand for the Blue and Gold.

ABOUT US...

UNCG enters the game with a 3-3 record after dropping a high-scoring 95-72 affair to VCU Wednesday at Fleming Gymnasium. The Rams knocked down 38 field goals on 63 attempts – including 10 three-point field goals – to end up at 60.3 percent from the field. VCU entered the contest shooting just 39 percent. The visitors also eclipsed their average from beyond the arc, shooting 58.8 percent from range after making just 26 percent of their three-point attempts coming in. UNCG (3-3) shot 55.6 percent from the field in the second half and ended up at 41 percent for the game (24-of-59). Thanks to 16 offensive rebounds, the Spartans won the battle on the glass by a 33-32 margin. UNCG limited VCU to 10 offensive boards – seven under its season average. Senior forward Janae' Stevenson tallied the only double-double of any player on the floor with 21 points and 14 rebounds – her fourth-straight double-double. The reigning Southern Conference Player of the Week was as good as advertised, going 7-for-9 at the charity stripe while pulling down seven offensive rebounds. Stevenson has posted four-straight double-doubles and is pacing the Spartans in scoring average at 14.0 points per game and leads the SoCon in rebounding average at 10.2 boards per contest. UNCG averages 66.7 points per game while shooting 35.4 percent from the field and averaging 40.0 rebounds per outing.

ABOUT THEM.

High Point sports a 4-1 overall record and brings a three-game winning streak into Sunday's contest with victories over USC Upstate, William and Mary and Davidson during the stretch. The Panthers average 73.8 points per game and 38.6 rebounds per contest while shooting 44.5 percent from the field, 35.5 percent from beyond the arc and 59.8 percent at the foul line. Tayler Tremblay is the leading scorer by average for High Point at 13.8 points per game and Stacia Robertson leads the way in rebounding with 7.4 boards per outing.

Wendy Palmer (Virginia, '96) is in her third season at the helm of the UNCG women's basketball program. Under her tutelege, the team doubled their win total in 2012-13 and won a game in the conference tournament for the first time since 2010. Palmer also mentored guard Lucy Mason to Southern Conference Freshman of the Year accolades. She arrived in Greensboro after a two-year stint as an assistant coach at her alma mater Virginia. While on the Cavalier staff, Palmer helped recruit and sign a class ranked in the top 15 nationally by ESPN HoopGurlz and coached All-American and national Defensive Player of the Year Monica Wright. During Palmer's tenure on the sidelines, Virginia made one NCAA appearance and a WNIT quarterfinals appearance. Palmer was an assistant for two years at Kentucky prior to returning to Virginia. There, she coached All-American Victoria Dunlap, who was taken 11th in a recent WNBA Draft. While still playing professionally, Palmer began her coaching career at Virginia Commonwealth. In her two years there, Palmer coached 2006 Colonial Athletic Association Rookie of the Year Quanitra Hollingsworth and Krystal Vaughn, who both went on to play professionally in the WNBA and in Europe. Palmer enjoyed outstanding playing careers on both the professional and amateur levels. A WNBA All-Star for the Detroit Shock in 2000, Palmer was also the WNBA's Co-Most Improved Player with the Connecticut Sun in 2004. She was selected in the 1997 Elite Draft by the Utah Starzz in preparation for the WNBA's inaugural year of competition and was a second-team All-WNBA selection that season. Palmer also played for the Orlando Miracle, San Antonio Silver Stars and Seattle Storm in her WNBA career. The Shock's Community Relations Player Representative from 1999-2001, Palmer was the recipient of the Black Legends of Professional Basketball John Isaacs Service Award. Palmer also played professionally in Spain, Brazil, Hungary, Turkey, Italy and Russia, earning another all-star bid in Italy. On the collegiate level, Palmer was a two-time Kodak All-American and Atlantic Coast Conference Player of the Year for the Cavaliers, earning those honors in 1995 and 1996. A three-time All-ACC selection, she is still the Cavs' career rebounding leader and is fourth on Virginia's all-time scoring list. Palmer was the first woman in school history and just the second player overall to record 1,000 career points and 1,000 career rebounds at Virginia. Cavalier legend Ralph Sampson was the other.

VCU 95, UNCG 72

GREENSBORO, N.C. - VCU used an uncharacteristically high-percentage shooting performance Wednesday afternoon to post a 95-72 non-conference victory over the UNCG women's basketball team at Fleming Gymnasium. The Rams knocked down 38 field goals on 63 attempts - including 10 three-point field goals - to end up at 60.3 percent from the field. VCU entered the contest shooting just 39 percent. The visitors also eclipsed their average from beyond the arc, shooting 58.8 percent from range after making just 26 percent of their three-point attempts coming in. UNCG (3-3) shot 55.6 percent from the field in the second half and ended up at 41 percent for the game (24-of-59). Thanks to 16 offensive rebounds, the Spartans won the battle on the glass by a 33-32 margin. UNCG limited VCU to 10 offensive boards - seven under its season average. The teams combined for 41 turnovers while the Rams posted more assists (16-13) and steals (9-5). The Blue and Gold went to the line 27 times and hit 21 of the attempts while holding VCU to just 12 trips to the foul line where it was good on nine of the shots. Senior forward Janae' Stevenson tallied the only double-double of any player on the floor with 21 points and 14 rebounds - her fourth-straight double-double. The reigning Southern Conference Player of the Week was as good as advertised, going 7-for-9 at the charity stripe while pulling down seven offensive rebounds. Freshman forward Jade Scaife picked up the first double-figure scoring effort of her young career, netting 12 points, while sophomore guard Lucy Mason added 10 points and went 5-for-5 from the foul line. Taking the team season lead in assists was freshman guard Bailey Williams who dropped seven dimes in the contest. She now has 21 helpers in six contests for an average of 3.5 per game. VCU rung up a 9-0 lead to start the game and would not relinquish the lead for the remainder of the afternoon. Junior guard Jarae Savage and Stevenson scored consecutive layups to make the score 9-4 at the 16:10 mark but a jumper by Zakia Williams put the score at 11-4 entering the first official timeout. The Rams quickly pushed their advantage into double figures and pushed the lead all the way to 27 points at 41-14 on a Keira Robinson jumper with 5:56 remaining in the half. Freshman guard Shanese Harris would knock down a free throw with 19 seconds left in the period as the score settled at 50-26 heading into halftime. Stevenson paced UNCG with eight points and eight rebounds in the first 20 minutes while Isis Thorpe led VCU with 15 points and four boards. The Rams hit 57 percent from the field (20-of-35) - including a 7-of-10 performance from three-point range. The Spartans shot just 28 percent from the field (9-of-32) and were 2-of-9 from deep. UNCG fought back at the beginning of the second half, scoring seven of the first 10 points of the stanza to pull within 53-33 at the 17:57 mark. A layup by Stevenson brought the Blue and Gold even closer with 12:22 remaining as the Spartans sliced the deficit to 17 points. After VCU extended the lead back to 21 at 70-49, Mason completed a three-point play and Stevenson dropped in a layup to make the score 70-54 with 9:25 on the clock. That would be as close as UNCG would come the rest of the way, however, as the Rams out-scored the Spartans 25-18 the rest of the way to account for the final margin.



CASHING IN ON THE FREEBIES...

A bright spot for UNCG in the season opener at Florida State was its performance at the free throw line. The Spartans were 14-for-18 at the stripe led by a pair of freshman in Jade Scaife and Shanese Harris who combined to make 11 of 12 attempts. UNCG is shooting 69.7 percent at the charity stripe this season

USUALLY GOOD FOR THREE...

UNCG has nailed at least one three-point field goal in 211 of its last 213 games and 12 straight. The Spartans owned a streak of 155-straight contests with a triple until they went 0-6 at Wofford Dec. 17, 2011.

SOCON FRESHMAN OF THE YEAR...

Freshman guard Lucy Mason was selected the 2013 Southern Conference Freshman of the Year by the league's media members. She is the first Spartan to earn league freshman of the year accolades since Kristen Boone was recognized during the 2004-05 campaign and the first to garner a spot on the all-freshman team since teammate Janae' Stevenson in 2010-11. Mason paced the Spartans this season in scoring at 12.5 points per game and three-point field goals made with 35 while also averaging in double figures in SoCon play at 10.4 points per contest. She started every game for UNCG in 2012-13 and was the highest scoring rookie in the league by a full six points in all games and by three points in league contests.

SCORING THE BALL BETTER...

UNCG averaged a paltry 49.6 points per game in the 2011-12 campaign. The Spartans raised that average last year by over seven points as they scored 57.2 points per game in 31 contests. This season, the Blue and Gold is averaging 66.7 points in three games.

LUCKY NUMBER 7(0)...

UNCG is 23-2 in its last 25 contests when scoring at least 70 points. The Spartans' last loss before the recent VCU setback when scoring 70 was nearly five years ago, Dec. 20, 2007, when the Blue and Gold fell at UCF, 76-73. The Blue and Gold reached 70 points for the third time this season Wednesday, dropping 72 on VCU but lost the game 95-72.

STUFFED...

Stevenson is rapidly moving her way up the UNCG career blocked shots list. As a freshman, she swatted 36 shots, the fourth-most in a single season in school history. She did two better with 38 blocked shots her sophomore campaign. With 108 to her credit now, she is third in program career history. Should she maintain her current pace, Stevenson should easily surpass UNCG's career record of 121 by Rebecca Viverette (1994-98) by the time her days in a Spartan uniform are over.

JUST FINE IN FLEMING...

UNCG has been historically successful in Fleming Gym, posting a 200-94 (.680) mark at the venue. In 23 years, UNCG has had just five losing seasons in the facility. The playing surface was christened Lynne Agee Court in honor of the former UNCG coach, who retired in March 2011 after 30 years at the helm. The court was officially dedicated at halftime of UNCG's Dec. 3, 2011 contest against Samford.

ROCKY ROAD...

The Blue and Gold has had a tough go of it away from home the last five years, compiling an 19-53 record away from Fleming Gymnasium.

BUCKETS...

The Spartans broke out in a big way against Wofford on the road last season as shots finally began to fall. The 87 points scored were the most for UNCG since dropping 88 on Elon in a 48-point victory Jan. 20, 2007. A total of four Spartans scored in double figures while Mason recorded a career-high 25 points.

A RARE FEAT ON THE ROAD...

UNCG's road win against Samford last year was notable for a number of reasons. Entering the contest, the Bulldogs were 7-2 at home for the season and 61-14 since the Pete Hanna Center opened. The Spartans also won at Samford for the first time in program history (0-4 prior).

LOW-BALLING THE COMPETITION...

UNCG clamped down defensively when it welcomed NC Central to Fleming Gymnasium last season, dealing the Eagles a 49-39 loss. The Spartans allowed their fewest amount of points in a single game since limiting Fordham to 39 in a 50-39 victory at Fleming Gymnasium Dec. 13, 2008. UNCG also set a program single-game mark for blocked shots with 11.

WHAT'S BACK FOR THE BLUE AND GOLD...

UNCG may have a number of new faces joining the program this season, but the Spartans also return a large amount of their production - losing just one starter from the 2012-13 squad. Below is a more in-depth look.

The Spartans have never faced VMI or Presbyterian. VMI will join the Southern Conference next season but the Keydets have discontinued their women's basketball program.

SOUTHERN CONFERENCE: THE 17TH SEASON...

UNCG is in its 17th season as a basketball member of the Southern Conference. Starting in 1997, the Spartans became eligible to compete for the league title after making their transition to Division I status as a member of the Big South Conference. UNCG owns two regular season championships (1998-99 and 2001-02) and one tournament title (1998) which led to the program's only NCAA Tournament appearance. The Blue and Gold also qualified for the WNIT at the conclusion of the 2001-02 campaign. Below is a closer look at UNCG's history in the league.

The 2014 edition of the Southern Conference Women's Basketball Championship is scheduled for March 7-10 in Asheville, N.C. All 10 conference squads will compete in the event, with the winner taking the league's automatic bid to the 2014 NCAA Tournament. Last season, No. 1 seed Chattanooga swept through the event to win its 14th SoCon title. The Mocs, seeded 11th in the NCAA Tournament, fell to No. 6 seed Nebraska 73-59 in the national event's first round.

Keli Foster, Guard, 5-7, Hampton, Va. (Bethel)

Foster averaged 10.4 points, 3.4 rebounds, 4.9 assists and 4.1 steals per game her junior campaign at Bethel High School, earning first-team all-district accolades. She currently serves as a team captain for the Bruins and scored a career-high 24 points in an upset win over powerhouse Hampton High School in January of last season. Foster also excels in the classroom as a member of her school's honor roll and is a participant in the student athletic training program. She plays her AAU basketball for the Boo Williams Norfolk Express coached by Morris Smith.

Skye Jefferson, Forward/Center, 6-2, Richmond, Va. (Cosby)

Jefferson was the starting center last season for a state championship contending Cosby High School team under head coach Rachel Mead. She helped lead the Titans to a 26-2 overall record and racked up second-team all-district honors. Jefferson is a member of the Boo Williams Richmond AAU program coached by Max Coats and Mike Davis.

Jayda Luckie, Guard, 5-9, Norfolk, Va. (Maury)

Luckie averaged 12.7 points per game at Maury High School last season under head coach Jermaine Woods and earned first-team all-district recognition. She helped the Commodores to a 21-6 record as a junior and is a teammate of fellow signee Keli Foster on the Boo Williams Norfolk Xpress AAU program coached by Morris Smith. One of her most memorable moments last season occurred against Mount Vernon when she scored 13 points and hit a buzzer-beating layup at the end of double overtime to give Maury a 79-77 victory.

Alison Whitman, Center/Forward, 6-3, Madison, W.Va. (Scott)

Whitman is an impact post player who earned third-team all-state. first-team all-district and first-team all-conference honors last season under head coach John Porter at Scott High School. As a sophomore, Whitman helped the Skyhawks to a 25-4 overall record, 8-1 league ledger and a No. 9 ranking in the state. Scott has finished as the state runner up the past two years. Whitman is also a member of the West Virginia Thunder AAU program coached by Scott Johnson.
