#### Spartans Open 2013-14 Campaign At Florida State

#### THE TIPOFF...

A new UNCG women's basketball campaign kicks off Thursday evening as the Spartans travel to Tallahassee for a contest with ACC member Florida State. The two teams met last season at Greensboro Coliseum with the then No. 23 Seminoles capturing a 93-63 decision. The Spartans secured an 8-23 record in 2012-13, doubling their win total from the previous season. Head coach Wendy Palmer enters her third season at the helm of the program.

#### ABOUT US...

The UNCG women's basketball teams enters the 2013-14 campaign with a great mix of old and new. The Spartans lost just one starter from last year's team and welcome six newcomers into the fold. In 2012-13, UNCG continued to build and progress as it handed Samford a rare home loss while winning a game in the conference tournament for the first time since 2010. Sophomore guard Lucy Mason headlines the returning corps of players, having been named the 2013 Southern Conference Freshman of the Year. Mason averaged a team-best 12.5 points per game while also leading the squad in field goals made, three-point field goals made and assists. UNCG also returns leading rebounder and senior forward Janae' Stevenson who pulled down 7.7 boards per game and finished third for the Spartans in scoring at 10.6 points per game. Senior guard Breonna Patterson represents the third UNCG returner which averaged in double figures offensively as she netted 10.9 points per game last season.

#### ABOUT THEM...

The Seminoles, who received votes in both preseason top 25 polls, will look to ride the momentum of last year's 23-win season into the 2013-14 campaign behind First Team All-ACC senior Natasha Howard, senior point guard Yashira "Cheetah" Delgado and versatile redshirt sophomore guard/forward Morgan Jones. Howard is the ACC's active leader in career double-doubles (26) and she has career averages of 11.8 points, 7.7 rebounds, 1.5 steals and 1.1 blocks in 96 career games. Delgado shared floor general duties last season and dished 148 assists (4.5 per game) - the most of any returning player in the ACC. Jones, a former McDonald's All-American from Lake Mary, Fla., sat out last season after transferring to Florida State from Northwestern, where she averaged 13.9 points, 6.0 boards and 3.3 assists and captured honorable mention All-Big Ten honors.

Most Lead Changes Most Ties Most Players in Double Figures Wendy Palmer (Virginia, '96) is in her third season at the helm of the UNCG women's basketball program. Under her tutelege, the team doubled their win total in 2012-13 and won a game in the conference tournament for the first time since 2010. Palmer also mentored guard Lucy Mason to Southern Conference Freshman of the Year accolades. She arrived in Greensboro after a two-year stint as an assistant coach at her alma mater Virginia. While on the Cavalier staff, Palmer helped recruit and sign a class ranked in the top 15 nationally by ESPN HoopGurlz and coached All-American and national Defensive Player of the Year Monica Wright. During Palmer's tenure on the sidelines, Virginia made one NCAA appearance and a WNIT quarterfinals appearance. Palmer was an assistant for two years at Kentucky prior to returning to Virginia. There, she coached All-American Victoria Dunlap, who was taken 11th in a recent WNBA Draft. While still playing professionally, Palmer began her coaching career at Virginia Commonwealth. In her two years there, Palmer coached 2006 Colonial Athletic Association Rookie of the Year Quanitra Hollingsworth and Krystal Vaughn, who both went on to play professionally in the WNBA and in Europe. Palmer enjoyed outstanding playing careers on both the professional and amateur levels. A WNBA All-Star for the Detroit Shock in 2000, Palmer was also the WNBA's Co-Most Improved Player with the Connecticut Sun in 2004. She was selected in the 1997 Elite Draft by the Utah Starzz in preparation for the WNBA's inaugural year of competition and was a second-team All-WNBA selection that season. Palmer also played for the Orlando Miracle, San Antonio Silver Stars and Seattle Storm in her WNBA career. The Shock's Community Relations Player Representative from 1999-2001, Palmer was the recipient of the Black Legends of Professional Basketball John Isaacs Service Award. Palmer also played professionally in Spain, Brazil, Hungary, Turkey, Italy and Russia, earning another all-star bid in Italy. On the collegiate level, Palmer was a two-time Kodak All-American and Atlantic Coast Conference Player of the Year for the Cavaliers, earning those honors in 1995 and 1996. A three-time All-ACC selection, she is still the Cavs' career rebounding leader and is fourth on Virginia's all-time scoring list. Palmer was the first woman in school history and just the second player overall to record 1,000 career points and 1,000 career rebounds at Virginia. Cavalier legend Ralph Sampson was the other.

Sue Semrau (UC San Diego, '85) is in her 17th season as the head women's basketball coach at Florida State. A three-time winner of the ACC Coach of the Year award and Florida State's all-time leader in wins has earned a reputation as a coach that not only keeps her team in the national rankings by leading her players to victory but also one that helps foster the personal and professional growth of the student-athletes. Semrau has guided the Seminoles to nine NCAA Tournaments, including a 2010 Elite Eight appearance, won a pair of gold medals with USA Basketball and seen 27 student-athletes earn academic all-conference honors. Over the last five years, Florida State has averaged over 23 wins per season and had 12 players sign professional contracts either in the WNBA or with a European club team. Eight Seminoles have been selected in the WNBA Draft in the last 10 years.

#### LAST TIME OUT FOR THE SPARTANS

Davidson 70, UNCG 47

March 9. 2013 @ Asheville, N.C. (Southern Conference Championship Quarterfinals)

ASHEVILLE, N.C. – No. 2 seed Davidson ran up a big lead early and the UNCG women's basketball team could not catch up as the Wildcats advanced to Sunday's semifinals with a 70-47 victory in quarterfinal action at the 2013 Southern Conference Women's Basketball Championship inside Kimmel Arena. The Spartans suffered from a poor shooting performance, hitting just 25 percent from the field. Davidson countered by shooting 51 percent while also out-rebounding UNCG 49-38. The Blue and Gold forced the Wildcats into 17 turnovers, resulting in 11 steals and 16 points Junior guard Breonna Patterson paced the Spartans with 16 points while 2013 SoCon Freshman of the Year Lucy Mason added 12. A pair of UNCG players pulled down seven rebounds while senior forward Sidnei Harmon was one of two to grab three steals. Just as in the first round, the offenses took a few minutes to get going. Davidson made the initial run, scoring the game's first four points before Mason knocked down a pair of free throws at the 16:14 mark. UNCG struggled to score as the half went on, and the Wildcats took advantage – going on a 10-4 run to lead 16-6 with 10:21 remaining in the stanza. The Davidson cushion grew as big as 25-7 before freshman guard Ebona Goins converted a three-point play to cut the Spartan deficit to 25-12. A layup by Stevenson capped a 7-0 UNCG run, but the Wildcats recovered and ran out to a 33-16 lead with under three minutes to play. The Spartan defense clamped down, scoring the next four points to make it a 33-20 contest. Davidson received the last possession and Sophia Aleksandravicius lost the ball down low before putting up a wild out of control shot. Stevenson was whistled for a questionable foul and Aleksandravicius made one of two free throws to send her team into the break with a 34-20 edge. UNCG shot just 25 percent from the field in the half, hitting eight of 32 attempts while the Wildcats drained 13 of 28 to end up at 46 percent. Davidson also held a 24-19 advantage in rebounding with eight of the Spartans' boards occurring on the offensive glass. Both teams turned the ball over eight times. Stevenson and Patterson paced the Blue and Gold attack with six points apiece in the first 20 minutes. Patterson also corralled a team-best six rebounds. Aleksandravicius led all players with 13 points. Davidson scored the first five points of the second half before Stevenson hit a jumper to stop the run. UNCG could not keep the Wildcats off the offensive glass, however, as Davidson used a big advantage on the boards to run up their cushion to 45-24 at the 14:09 mark. The Spartans did not threaten again.

#### SOCON FRESHMAN OF THE YEAR...

Freshman guard Lucy Mason was selected the 2013 Southern Conference Freshman of the Year by the league's media members. She is the first Spartan to earn league freshman of the year accolades since Kristen Boone was recognized during the 2004-05 campaign and the first to garner a spot on the all-freshman team since teammate Janae' Stevenson in 2010-11. Mason paced the Spartans this season in scoring at 12.5 points per game and three-point field goals made with 35 while also averaging in double figures in SoCon play at 10.4 points per contest. She started every game for UNCG in 2012-13 and was the highest scoring rookie in the league by a full six points in all games and by three points in league contests.

#### SCORING THE BALL BETTER...

UNCG averaged a paltry 49.6 points per game in the 2011-12 campaign. The Spartans raised that average last year by over seven points as they scored an even 57.2 points per game in 31 contests.

#### MAKING IT RAIN FROM RANGE...

Not only did UNCG tie a single-game program record with 12 three-point field goals against nationally-ranked Florida State, the Spartans fired at 57 percent from beyond the arc - marking their highest percentage since hitting five of seven against Chattanooga on Jan. 28, 2012.

#### LUCKY NUMBER 7(0)...

UNCG is 21-1 in its last 22 contests when scoring at least 70 points. The Spartans' last loss when scoring 70 was nearly five years ago, Dec. 20, 2007, when the Blue and Gold fell at UCF, 76-73. The Blue and Gold reached 70 points twice this season in a 71-63 triumph over Norfolk State (Dec. 15) and an 87-75 road victory at Wofford (Jan. 28).

#### STUFFED...

Stevenson is rapidly moving her way up the UNCG career blocked shots list. As a freshman, she swatted 36 shots, the fourth-most in a single season in school history. She did two better with 38 blocked shots her sophomore campaign. With 104 to her credit now, she is third in program career history. Should she maintain her current pace, Stevenson should easily surpass UNCG's career record of 121 by Rebecca Viverette (1994-98) by the time her days in a Spartan uniform are over.

#### **IUST FINE IN FLEMING...**

UNCG has been historically successful in Fleming Gym, posting a 198-93 (.680) mark at the venue. In 23 years, UNCG has had just five losing seasons in the facility. The playing surface was christened Lynne Agee Court in honor of the former UNCG coach, who retired in March 2011 after 30 years at the helm. The court was officially dedicated at halftime of UNCG's Dec. 3, 2011 contest against Samford.

#### BUCKETS..

The Spartans broke out in a big way against Wofford on the road last season as shots finally began to fall. The 87 points scored were the most for UNCG since dropping 88 on Elon in a 48-point victory Jan. 20, 2007. A total of four Spartans scored in double figures while Mason recorded a career-high 25 points.

#### A RARE FEAT ON THE ROAD...

UNCG's road win against Samford last year was notable for a number of reasons. Entering the contest, the Bulldogs were 7-2 at home for the season and 61-14 since the Pete Hanna Center opened. The Spartans also won at Samford for the first time in program history (0-4 prior).

#### USUALLY GOOD FOR THREE...

UNCG has nailed at least one three-point field goal in 205 of its last 207 games and six straight. The Spartans owned a streak of 155-straight contests with a triple until they went 0-6 at Wofford Dec. 17, 2011.

#### WORKING DOWN LOW...

Junior Janae' Stevenson enjoyed a fine start to 2013 as she averaged 13.0 points and 9.5 rebounds per game in January. She also racked up three double-doubles on the road against Furman, Elon and Davidson.

#### EXTRA BASKETBALL...

UNCG's overtime contest against Davidson at Fleming Gymnasium marked the first time the Spartans have played the extra session since a 76-64 triumph against College of Charleston Feb. 12, 2011 at home.

#### PUT IT ON THE BOARD...

UNCG captured its first Southern Conference Championship victory since 2010 when the Spartans downed No. 7 seed Furman 73-68 in the first round. Stevenson broke the UNCG SoCon Tournament record for rebounds in a game with 15 boards to go along with 16 points.

#### WHAT'S BACK FOR THE BLUE AND GOLD...

UNCG may have a number of new faces joining the program this season, but the Spartans also return a large amount of their production - losing just one starter from the 2012-13 squad. Below is a more in-depth look.

#### IN SEASON OPENERS...

UNCG begins its 44th season of women's basketball in 2013-14. The Blue and Gold is 20-24 in season openers - including an 8-14 mark since joining the NCAA Division I ranks. The Spartans fell to Charleston Southern in last year's season lidlifter by a 60-57 scoreline as Lucy Mason dropped in 17 points in her collegiate debut. #### ROCKY ROAD...

The Blue and Gold has had a tough go of it away from home the last five years, compiling an 18-52 record away from Fleming Gymnasium.

#### 2014 SOUTHERN CONFERENCE CHAMPIONSHIP...

The 2014 edition of the Southern Conference Women's Basketball Championship is scheduled for March 7-10 in Asheville, N.C. All 10 conference squads will compete in the event, with the winner taking the league's automatic bid to the 2014 NCAA Tournament. Last season, No. 1 seed Chattanooga swept through the event to win its 14th SoCon title. The Mocs, seeded 11th in the NCAA Tournament, fell to No. 6 seed Nebraska 73-59 in the national event's first round.

#### LOW-BALLING THE COMPETITION...

UNCG clamped down defensively when it welcomed NC Central to Fleming Gymnasium last season, dealing the Eagles a 49-39 loss. The Spartans allowed their fewest amount of points in a single game since limiting Fordham to 39 in a 50-39 victory at Fleming Gymnasium Dec. 13, 2008. The Blue and Gold also set a program single-game mark for blocked shots with 11 on the night as three players had at least three.

#### SOUTHERN CONFERENCE: THE NINTH SEASON...

UNCG is in its 17th season as a basketball member of the Southern Conference. Starting in 1997, the Spartans became eligible to compete for the league title after making their transition to Division I status as a member of the Big South Conference. UNCG owns two regular season championships

(1998-99 and 2001-02) and one tournament title (1998) which led to the program's only NCAA Tournament appearance. The Blue and Gold also qualified for the WNIT at the conclusion of the 2001-02 campaign. Below is a closer look at UNCG's history in the league.
