Spartans Open SoCon Play Against Preseason Favorite Chattanooga

THE TIPOFE.

The UNCG women's basketball team begins its 17th season of Southern Conference play when the Spartans host preseason favorite and defending champion Chattanooga Saturday at Fleming Gymnasium. The Blue and Gold begins its SoCon slate with the Mocs for the third-straight season. UNCG brings a 3-2 home record into the contest with wins over South Carolina State, College of Charleston and High Point while Chattanooga is 1-2 on the road with a victory over Jacksonville State and losses to Tennessee and Hawai'i.

ABOUT US...

The Spartans enter the game with a 4-4 record after falling to Atlantic Coast Conference member Clemson by a 77-71 score Dec. 5 at Fleming Gymnasium. Senior forward Janae' Stevenson dropped in 16 points and pulled down 10 rebounds to extend her school record double-double streak to six games. She was joined in double figures offensively by sophomore guard Lucy Mason and senior guard Breonna Patterson who scored 20 and 15 points respectively. Mason posted 18 of her points in the second half, drained a career-best nine free throws (11 attempts) and dished out a game-high five assists while freshman guard Bailey Williams recorded four helpers. The Blue and Gold shot 40.7 percent from the field and knocked down a season-best 10 three-point field goals while also going 17-for-24 at the charity stripe (70.8 percent). Conversely, Clemson (5-3) fired at a 52.1-percent clip and was awarded a whopping 35 free throw attempts of which the Tigers hit 25 for 71.4 percent. In terms of rebounding, UNCG could muster only 24 boards while the Tigers racked up 38 – including 12 offensive rebounds. The Spartans are averaging a Southern Conference best 69.0 points per game as well as 38.2 rebounds per contest. UNCG is shooting 38 percent from the field, 35.1 percent from beyond the arc and 69.9 percent at the charity stripe.

ABOUT THEM..

Chattanooga has accrued an overall record of 6-3 and is the winner of two-straight games - knocking off Colorado State in Hawai'i and beating Jacksonville State on the road. Senior Taylor Hall paces the Mocs in scoring and rebounding average at 13.6 points and 9.7 rebounds per game. Chattanooga is scoring 66.8 points per game while also pulling down 35.4 rebounds per contest. The Mocs are shooting 41 percent from the field, 32 percent beyond the arc and 71 percent at the free throw line.

Wendy Palmer (Virginia, '96) is in her third season at the helm of the UNCG women's basketball program. Under her tutelege, the team doubled their win total in 2012-13 and won a game in the conference tournament for the first time since 2010. Palmer also mentored guard Lucy Mason to Southern Conference Freshman of the Year accolades. She arrived in Greensboro after a two-year stint as an assistant coach at her alma mater Virginia. While on the Cavalier staff, Palmer helped recruit and sign a class ranked in the top 15 nationally by ESPN HoopGurlz and coached All-American and national Defensive Player of the Year Monica Wright. During Palmer's tenure on the sidelines, Virginia made one NCAA appearance and a WNIT quarterfinals appearance. Palmer was an assistant for two years at Kentucky prior to returning to Virginia. There, she coached All-American Victoria Dunlap, who was taken 11th in a recent WNBA Draft. While still playing professionally, Palmer began her coaching career at Virginia Commonwealth. In her two years there, Palmer coached 2006 Colonial Athletic Association Rookie of the Year Quanitra Hollingsworth and Krystal Vaughn, who both went on to play professionally in the WNBA and in Europe. Palmer enjoyed outstanding playing careers on both the professional and amateur levels. A WNBA All-Star for the Detroit Shock in 2000, Palmer was also the WNBA's Co-Most Improved Player with the Connecticut Sun in 2004. She was selected in the 1997 Elite Draft by the Utah Starzz in preparation for the WNBA's inaugural year of competition and was a second-team All-WNBA selection that season. Palmer also played for the Orlando Miracle, San Antonio Silver Stars and Seattle Storm in her WNBA career. The Shock's Community Relations Player Representative from 1999-2001, Palmer was the recipient of the Black Legends of Professional Basketball John Isaacs Service Award. Palmer also played professionally in Spain, Brazil, Hungary, Turkey, Italy and Russia, earning another all-star bid in Italy. On the collegiate level, Palmer was a two-time Kodak All-American and Atlantic Coast Conference Player of the Year for the Cavaliers, earning those honors in 1995 and 1996. A three-time All-ACC selection, she is still the Cavs' career rebounding leader and is fourth on Virginia's all-time scoring list. Palmer was the first woman in school history and just the second player overall to record 1,000 career points and 1,000 career rebounds at Virginia. Cavalier legend Ralph Sampson was the other.

Clemson 77, UNCG 71

GREENSBORO, N.C. - Despite a sixth-straight double-double by senior forward Janae' Stevenson, the UNCG women's basketball team could not overcome Clemson's 52-percent shooting performance in a 77-71 loss to the Tigers Thursday night at Fleming Gymnasium. Stevenson dropped in 16 points and pulled down 10 rebounds to extend her school record double-double streak. She was joined in double figures offensively by sophomore guard Lucy Mason and senior guard Breonna Patterson who scored 20 and 15 points respectively. Mason scored 18 of her points in the second half, drained a career-best nine foul shots (11 attempts) and dished out a game-high five assists while freshman guard Bailey Williams recorded four helpers. The Blue and Gold shot 40.7 percent from the field and knocked down a season-best 10 three-point field goals while also going 17-for-24 at the charity stripe (70.8 percent). Conversely, Clemson (5-3) fired at a 52.1-percent clip and was awarded a whopping 35 free throw attempts of which the Tigers hit 25 for 71.4 percent. Many of Clemson's made field goals came down low as they out-scored the Spartans (4-4) 36-14 in the paint. The Tigers also received over half their points from the bench as the Clemson reserves accounted for 42 points. In terms of rebounding, UNCG could muster only 24 boards while the Tigers racked up 38 - including 12 offensive rebounds. Other than Stevenson, no Spartan had more than four rebounds and four players failed to corral any boards. The Blue and Gold got off to a strong start and led 9-4 at the 17:29 mark after freshman guard Shanese Harris nailed a three-pointer. Clemson rallied right back and knotted the score at nine on a layup by Quinyotta Pettaway before taking a two-point lead on another layup by Pettaway with 14:15 remaining in the first half. With the score deadlocked at 17 after two free throws by Mason as the clock under 10 minutes, the Tigers ripped off seven-straight points to move in front 24-17 with 7:31 to play before the break. A three by Bailey Williams pulled UNCG within 26-24 at the 4:06 mark before another layup by Pettaway gave the Tigers a 28-24 edge. Patterson knocked down a triple with 17 seconds on the clock, but Kelly Gramlich was wide open on the other end of the floor and she answered with a three of her own to send Clemson into the locker room with a 31-27 lead. Stevenson paced the Spartans with eight points and three rebounds in the first 20 minutes while Charmaine Tay poured in nine points and grabbed five rebounds for the Tigers. Clemson held a commanding 21-9 edge on the glass with seven offensive rebounds included in that total. Williams opened the scoring in the second half with a three-pointer to make the score 31-30, but Sade Chatman scored on the Tigers' next possession to push the Tiger lead back to three. A triple by Patterson kept Clemson within striking range, 39-36, with 14:31 to play, however, a quick 4-0 run gave the visitors some breathing room. Williams would knock down another three-point field goal to cut the deficit to 43-39 at the 10:57 mark, but UNCG would not score again for another four minutes. In that time, the Tigers would stretch their advantage to as many as 14 at 53-39 - a deficit from which the Spartans would not recover. The final few minutes became a free-throw shooting contest, and a layup by Stevenson would slice the Clemson lead to six with 1:46 on the clock, but the Tigers had enough to hold off the late charge.



SOCON OPENERS...

In 16 league openers since joining the Southern Conference, UNCG has split them right down the middle at 8-8. However, the Spartans have lost seven of their last nine SoCon lidlifters.

DOUBLE-DOUBLE MACHINE...

Stevenson's current career-best streak of six-straight double-doubles is a school record. She now has 17 career double-doubles, surpassing Julie Moore for third on the program chart. The school record for career double-doubles is held by Melinda Goodson who tallied 24 from 1997-2000.

PLAYING FROM BEHIND...

The Spartans have faced double-digit deficits in six games this season. However, UNCG has battled back on a couple of occasions to win. The Spartans were down 12 in the second half at Norfolk State and 13 in the first half against High Point but emerged victorious both times.

CASHING IN ON THE FREEBIES...

A bright spot for UNCG in the season opener at Florida State was its performance at the free throw line. The Spartans were 14-for-18 at the stripe led by a pair of freshman in Jade Scaife and Shanese Harris who combined to make 11 of 12 attempts. UNCG is shooting 69.9 percent at the charity stripe this season

USUALLY GOOD FOR THREE...

UNCG has nailed at least one three-point field goal in 213 of its last 215 games and 14 straight. The Spartans owned a streak of 155-straight contests with a triple until they went 0-6 at Wofford Dec. 17, 2011.

SOCON FRESHMAN OF THE YEAR...

Freshman guard Lucy Mason was selected the 2013 Southern Conference Freshman of the Year by the league's media members. She is the first Spartan to earn league freshman of the year accolades since Kristen Boone was recognized during the 2004-05 campaign and the first to garner a spot on the all-freshman team since teammate Janae' Stevenson in 2010-11. Mason paced the Spartans this season in scoring at 12.5 points per game and three-point field goals made with 35 while also averaging in double figures in SoCon play at 10.4 points per contest. She started every game for UNCG in 2012-13 and was the highest scoring rookie in the league by a full six points in all games and by three points in league contests.

STUFFED..

Stevenson is rapidly moving her way up the UNCG career blocked shots list. As a freshman, she swatted 36 shots, the fourth-most in a single season in school history. She did two better with 38 blocked shots her sophomore campaign. With 108 to her credit now, she is third in program career history. Should she maintain her current pace, Stevenson should easily surpass UNCG's career record of 121 by Rebecca Viverette (1994-98) by the time her days in a Spartan uniform are over.

JUST FINE IN FLEMING...

UNCG has been historically successful in Fleming Gym, posting a 201-95 (.679) mark at the venue. In 23 years, UNCG has had just five losing seasons in the facility. The playing surface was christened Lynne Agee Court in honor of the former UNCG coach, who retired in March 2011 after 30 years at the helm. The court was officially dedicated at halftime of UNCG's Dec. 3, 2011 contest against Samford.

ROCKY ROAD...

The Blue and Gold has had a tough go of it away from home the last five years, compiling an 19-53 record away from Fleming Gymnasium.

BUCKETS...

The Spartans broke out in a big way against Wofford on the road last season as shots finally began to fall. The 87 points scored were the most for UNCG since dropping 88 on Elon in a 48-point victory Jan. 20, 2007. A total of four Spartans scored in double figures while Mason recorded a career-high 25 points.

A RARE FEAT ON THE ROAD...

UNCG's road win against Samford last year was notable for a number of reasons. Entering the contest, the Bulldogs were 7-2 at home for the season and 61-14 since the Pete Hanna Center opened. The Spartans also won at Samford for the first time in program history (0-4 prior).

WHAT'S BACK FOR THE BLUE AND GOLD...

UNCG may have a number of new faces joining the program this season,

but the Spartans also return a large amount of their production - losing just one starter from the 2012-13 squad. Below is a more in-depth look.

SOUTHERN CONFERENCE: THE 17TH SEASON...

UNCG is in its 17th season as a basketball member of the Southern Conference. Starting in 1997, the Spartans became eligible to compete for the league title after making their transition to Division I status as a member of the Big South Conference. UNCG owns two regular season championships (1998-99 and 2001-02) and one tournament title (1998) which led to the program's only NCAA Tournament appearance. The Blue and Gold also qualified for the WNIT at the conclusion of the 2001-02 campaign. Below is a closer look at UNCG's history in the league.

2014 SOUTHERN CONFERENCE CHAMPIONSHIP...

All 10 conference squads will compete in the event, with the winner taking the league's automatic bid to the 2014 NCAA Tournament. Last season, No. 1 seed Chattanooga swept through the event to win its 14th SoCon title. The Mocs, seeded 11th in the NCAA Tournament, fell to No. 6 seed Nebraska 73-59 in the national event's first round.

APPROACHING 1,000...

Stevenson entered the new campaign within reach of becoming the 23rd player in program history to score 1,000 career points. She sits at 862 points - 138 away from entering into the record books. Here is a look at all the 1,000-point scorers in UNCG women's basketball history:

Keli Foster, Guard, 5-7, Hampton, Va. (Bethel)

Foster averaged 10.4 points, 3.4 rebounds, 4.9 assists and 4.1 steals per game her junior campaign at Bethel High School, earning first-team all-district accolades. She currently serves as a team captain for the Bruins and scored a career-high 24 points in an upset win over powerhouse Hampton High School in January of last season. Foster also excels in the classroom as a member of her school's honor roll and is a participant in the student athletic training program. She plays her AAU basketball for the Boo Williams Norfolk Express coached by Morris Smith.

Skye Jefferson, Forward/Center, 6-2, Richmond, Va. (Cosby)

Jefferson was the starting center last season for a state championship contending Cosby High School team under head coach Rachel Mead. She helped lead the Titans to a 26-2 overall record and racked up second-team all-district honors. Jefferson is a member of the Boo Williams Richmond AAU program coached by Max Coats and Mike Davis.

Jayda Luckie, Guard, 5-9, Norfolk, Va. (Maury)

Luckie averaged 12.7 points per game at Maury High School last season under head coach Jermaine Woods and earned first-team all-district recognition. She helped the Commodores to a 21-6 record as a junior and is a teammate of fellow signee Keli Foster on the Boo Williams Norfolk Xpress AAU program coached by Morris Smith. One of her most memorable moments last season occurred against Mount Vernon when she scored 13 points and hit a buzzer-beating layup at the end of double overtime to give Maury a 79-77 victory.

Alison Whitman, Center/Forward, 6-3, Madison, W.Va. (Scott)

Whitman is an impact post player who earned third-team all-state. first-team all-district and first-team all-conference honors last season under head coach John Porter at Scott High School. As a sophomore, Whitman helped the Skyhawks to a 25-4 overall record, 8-1 league ledger and a No. 9 ranking in the state. Scott has finished as the state runner up the past two years. Whitman is also a member of the West Virginia Thunder AAU program coached by Scott Johnson.
