UNCG Closes Seven-Game Homestand With St. Bonaventure

THE TIPOFF...

A seven-game homestand comes to a close Sunday as the UNCG women's basketball team hosts Atlantic 10 outfit St. Bonaventure in a non-conference affair at Fleming Gymnasium. The Spartans have struggled as of late as they have dropped three-straight games and three of their last four. The Blue and Gold is 2-4 on this current homestand and 3-4 overall in Fleming this year. Conversely, the Bonnies are 4-2 on the road. St. Bonaventure advanced to the NCAA Sweet Sixteen just two seasons ago.

ABOUT US...

The Spartans enter the game with a 4-6 record after falling to Samford five days ago at Fleming Gymnasium. Senior guard Breonna Patterson and sophomore guard Lucy Mason paced the Spartans with nine points apiece while junior guard Jarae Savage led the Blue and Gold with eight rebounds – five of the offensive glass. Samford had no trouble getting the shots it wanted, knocking down 25 of 44 attempts to finish the contest at 56.8 percent. The Bulldogs were just 10-of-21 from the free throw line (47.6 percent) but that did not ultimately factor into the final margin. The Spartans out-rebounded the visitors 39-37 and recorded 17 offensive rebounds, but the cold shooting performance was too much to overcome for homesteading UNCG. Both teams hit five three-point field goals. The Spartans are averaging 65.7 points per game as well as 37.4 rebounds per contest. UNCG is shooting 36.5 percent from the field, 34.4 percent from beyond the arc and 68.2 percent at the charity stripe.

ABOUT THEM...

St. Bonaventure is 10-4 overall after a 61-44 victory Friday at Kent State. The Bonnies have won two-straight contests. St. Bonaventure enters Sunday's matchup with three players in double-digit scoring figures, as Katie Healy continues to lead the way with an average of 14.4 points per game along with a team-leading 39 assists. Second is Gabby Richmond at 11.4 points per game and Chelsea Bowker with an average of 10.6. St. Bonaventure has eclipsed the 70 point mark in four of its nine wins thus far, surpassing their 70+ point total from games last season. SBU is currently ranked first in rebounding defense in the Atlantic 10, holding their opponents to an average of 32.2 rebounds per game. The Bonnies also rank third in rebounding margin in the A-10, as they hold a +5.1 margin in rebounds per game over its opponents this season. The Brown and White are currently third in the Atlantic 10 in 3-point FG percentage with .365.

Wendy Palmer (Virginia, '96) is in her third season at the helm of the UNCG women's basketball program. Under her tutelage, the team doubled their win total in 2012-13 and won a game in the conference tournament for the first time since 2010. Palmer also mentored guard Lucy Mason to Southern Conference Freshman of the Year accolades. She arrived in Greensboro after a two-year stint as an assistant coach at her alma mater Virginia. While on the Cavalier staff, Palmer helped recruit and sign a class ranked in the top 15 nationally by ESPN HoopGurlz and coached All-American and national Defensive Player of the Year Monica Wright. During Palmer's tenure on the sidelines, Virginia made one NCAA appearance and a WNIT quarterfinals appearance. Palmer was an assistant for two years at Kentucky prior to returning to Virginia. There, she coached All-American Victoria Dunlap, who was taken 11th in a recent WNBA Draft. While still playing professionally, Palmer began her coaching career at Virginia Commonwealth. In her two years there, Palmer coached 2006 Colonial Athletic Association Rookie of the Year Quanitra Hollingsworth and Krystal Vaughn, who both went on to play professionally in the WNBA and in Europe. Palmer enjoyed outstanding playing careers on both the professional and amateur levels. A WNBA All-Star for the Detroit Shock in 2000, Palmer was also the WNBA's Co-Most Improved Player with the Connecticut Sun in 2004. She was selected in the 1997 Elite Draft by the Utah Starzz in preparation for the WNBA's inaugural year of competition and was a second-team All-WNBA selection that season. Palmer also played for the Orlando Miracle, San Antonio Silver Stars and Seattle Storm in her WNBA career. The Shock's Community Relations Player Representative from 1999-2001, Palmer was the recipient of the Black Legends of Professional Basketball John Isaacs Service Award. Palmer also played professionally in Spain, Brazil, Hungary, Turkey, Italy and Russia, earning another all-star bid in Italy. On the collegiate level, Palmer was a two-time Kodak All-American and Atlantic Coast Conference Player of the Year for the Cavaliers, earning those honors in 1995 and 1996. A three-time All-ACC selection, she is still the Cavs' career rebounding leader and is fourth on Virginia's all-time scoring list. Palmer was the first woman in school history and just the second player overall to record 1,000 career points and 1,000 career rebounds at Virginia. Cavalier legend Ralph Sampson was the other.

LAST TIME OUT FOR THE SPARTANS

Samford 65, UNCG 52

December 16, 2013 @ Greensboro, N.C. (Fleming Gymnasium)

GREENSBORO, N.C. – The UNCG women's basketball team shot just 24 percent from the floor Monday night as Samford downed the Spartans 65-52 in a Southern Conference game inside Fleming Gymnasium. The Bulldogs improve to 3-7 overall and 1-1 in league play while the Blue and Gold drops to 4-6 and 0-2. Samford had no trouble getting the shots it wanted, knocking down 25 of 44 attempts to finish the contest at 56.8 percent. The Bulldogs were just 10-of-21 from the free throw line (47.6 percent) but that did not ultimately factor into the final margin. The Spartans out-rebounded the visitors 39-37 and recorded 17 offensive rebounds, but the cold shooting performance was too much to overcome for homestanding UNCG. Both teams hit five three-point field goals. Senior guard Breonna Patterson and sophomore guard Lucy Mason paced the Spartans with nine points apiece while junior guard Jarae Savage led the Blue and Gold with eight rebounds – five of the offensive glass. Samford's Shelby Campbell led all scorers with 16 points. A jumper by Keke Fletcher capped a quick 6-1 Samford run to start the game before freshman guard Bailey Williams dropped in a layup to make it a three-point game. After the Bulldogs later built a 9-3 edge, freshman guard Shanese Harris hit a three-point field goal to make it 9-6 with 13:03 to go in the half. Both teams struggled to find the basket for much of the first half, but Samford eventually heated up and forged ahead 24-13 on a three-pointer at the 6:10 mark. The first half saw just two points scored by UNCG in the final 3:43 as Samford took a 28-22 lead into the half. Williams and senior forward Janae' Stevenson both netted seven points in the first 20 minutes while Lydia McGee scored seven for the Bulldogs. Samford had a 17-16 edge on the glass as every Bulldog player recorded at least one board in the stanza. Harris had four rebounds for UNCG. Samford shot 54.5 percent, hitting 12 of 22 from the field while the Spartans checked in at just 28.6 percent (8-of-28). The Blue and Gold stayed within striking distance as the second half commenced, trailing just 36-31 after a jumper by freshman forward Jade Scaife with 13:57 left in the game. UNCG pulled even closer on a free throw by Scaife which made the score 41-38 at the 9:43 mark, but a quick 9-0 run by the Bulldogs took the wind out of the Spartan sails. UNCG would draw within six at 55-49 on a free throw by Mason with 3:58 to play. However, Samford ended the game on a 10-3 run to secure its first conference victory of the season.

DOUBLE-DOUBLE MACHINE...

Stevenson's recent career-best streak of six-straight double-doubles is a school record. She now has 17 career double-doubles, surpassing Julie Moore for third on the program chart. The school record for career double-doubles is held by Melinda Goodson who tallied 24 from 1997-2000.

PLAYING FROM BEHIND...

The Spartans have faced double-digit deficits in eight of 10 games this season. However, UNCG has battled back on a couple of occasions to win. The Spartans were down 12 in the second half at Norfolk State and 13 in the first half against High Point but emerged victorious both times.

CASHING IN ON THE FREEBIES...

A bright spot for UNCG in the season opener at Florida State was its performance at the free throw line. The Spartans were 14-for-18 at the stripe led by a pair of freshman in Jade Scaife and Shanese Harris who combined to make 11 of 12 attempts. UNCG is shooting 68.2 percent at the charity stripe this season

USUALLY GOOD FOR THREE...

UNCG has nailed at least one three-point field goal in 215 of its last 217 games and 14 straight. The Spartans owned a streak of 155-straight contests with a triple until they went 0-6 at Wofford Dec. 17, 2011.

SOCON FRESHMAN OF THE YEAR...

Freshman guard Lucy Mason was selected the 2013 Southern Conference Freshman of the Year by the league's media members. She is the first Spartan to earn league freshman of the year accolades since Kristen Boone was recognized during the 2004-05 campaign and the first to garner a spot on the all-freshman team since teammate Janae' Stevenson in 2010-11. Mason paced the Spartans this season in scoring at 12.5 points per game and three-point field goals made with 35 while also averaging in double figures in SoCon play at 10.4 points per contest. She started every game for UNCG in 2012-13 and was the highest scoring rookie in the league by a full six points in all games and by three points in league contests.

STUFFED...

Stevenson is rapidly moving her way up the UNCG career blocked shots list. As a freshman, she swatted 36 shots, the fourth-most in a single season in school history. She did two better with 38 blocked shots her sophomore campaign. With 108 to her credit now, she is third in program career history. Should she maintain her current pace, Stevenson should easily surpass UNCG's career record of 121 by Rebecca Viverette (1994-98) by the time her days in a Spartan uniform are over.

JUST FINE IN FLEMING...

UNCG has been historically successful in Fleming Gym, posting a 201-97 (.674) mark at the venue. In 23 years, UNCG has had just five losing seasons in the facility. The playing surface was christened Lynne Agee Court in honor of the former UNCG coach, who retired in March 2011 after 30 years at the helm. The court was officially dedicated at halftime of UNCG's Dec. 3, 2011 contest against Samford.

ROCKY ROAD...

The Blue and Gold has had a tough go of it away from home the last five years, compiling an 19-53 record away from Fleming Gymnasium.

BUCKETS...

The Spartans broke out in a big way against Wofford on the road last season as shots finally began to fall. The 87 points scored were the most for UNCG since dropping 88 on Elon in a 48-point victory Jan. 20, 2007. A total of four Spartans scored in double figures while Mason recorded a career-high 25 points.

A RARE FEAT ON THE ROAD...

UNCG's road win against Samford last year was notable for a number of reasons. Entering the contest, the Bulldogs were 7-2 at home for the season and 61-14 since the Pete Hanna Center opened. The Spartans also won at Samford for the first time in program history (0-4 prior).

WHAT'S BACK FOR THE BLUE AND GOLD...

UNCG may have a number of new faces joining the program this season, but the Spartans also return a large amount of their production - losing just one starter from the 2012-13 squad. Below is a more in-depth look.

SOUTHERN CONFERENCE: THE 17TH SEASON...

UNCG is in its 17th season as a basketball member of the Southern Conference. Starting in 1997, the Spartans became eligible to compete for the league title after making their transition to Division I status as a member of the Big South Conference. UNCG owns two regular season championships (1998-99 and 2001-02) and one tournament title (1998) which led to the program's only NCAA Tournament appearance. The Blue and Gold also qualified for the WNIT at the conclusion of the 2001-02 campaign. Below is a closer look at UNCG's history in the league.

2014 SOUTHERN CONFERENCE CHAMPIONSHIP...

The 2014 edition of the Southern Conference Women's Basketball Championship is scheduled for March 7-10 in Asheville, N.C. All 10 conference squads will compete in the event, with the winner taking the league's automatic bid to the 2014 NCAA Tournament. Last season, No. 1 seed Chattanooga swept through the event to win its 14th SoCon title. The Mocs, seeded 11th in the NCAA Tournament, fell to No. 6 seed Nebraska 73-59 in the national event's first round.

APPROACHING 1,000...

UNCG head coach Wendy Palmer welcomes four new members to the Spartan women's basketball family next season. Below is a look at the new faces joining the program next year:

Keli Foster, Guard, 5-7, Hampton, Va. (Bethel)

Foster averaged 10.4 points, 3.4 rebounds, 4.9 assists and 4.1 steals per game her junior campaign at Bethel High School, earning first-team all-district accolades. She currently serves as a team captain for the Bruins and scored a career-high 24 points in an upset win over powerhouse Hampton High School in January of last season. Foster also excels in the classroom as a member of her school's honor roll and is a participant in the student athletic training program. She plays her AAU basketball for the Boo Williams Norfolk Express coached by Morris Smith.

Skye Jefferson, Forward/Center, 6-2, Richmond, Va. (Cosby)

Jefferson was the starting center last season for a state championship contending Cosby High School team under head coach Rachel Mead. She helped lead the Titans to a 26-2 overall record and racked up second-team all-district honors. Jefferson is a member of the Boo Williams Richmond AAU program coached by Max Coats and Mike Davis.

Jayda Luckie, Guard, 5-9, Norfolk, Va. (Maury)

Luckie averaged 12.7 points per game at Maury High School last season under head coach Jermaine Woods and earned first-team all-district recognition. She helped the Commodores to a 21-6 record as a junior and is a teammate of fellow signee Keli Foster on the Boo Williams Norfolk Xpress AAU program coached by Morris Smith. One of her most memorable moments last season occurred against Mount Vernon when she scored 13 points and hit a buzzer-beating layup at the end of double overtime to give Maury a 79-77 victory.

Alison Whitman, Center/Forward, 6-3, Madison, W.Va. (Scott)

Whitman is an impact post player who earned third-team all-state, first-team all-district and first-team all-conference honors last season under head coach John Porter at Scott High School. As a sophomore, Whitman helped the Skyhawks to a 25-4 overall record, 8-1 league ledger and a No. 9 ranking in the state. Scott has finished as the state runner up the past two years. Whitman is also a member of the West Virginia Thunder AAU program coached by Scott Johnson.
