UNCG Continues Homestand With Matchup Against Clemson

THE TIPOFF...

The UNCG women's basketball team looks to continue its string of recent success, welcoming Atlantic Coast Conference member Clemson to Fleming Gymnasium Thursday for a non-conference matchup. The Spartans have won three of their last four games while the Tigers come into the contest with a three-game winning streak. The Blue and Gold will attempt to win its 20th all-time game against an ACC institution. Clemson is under the direction of first-year head coach Audra Smith.

ABOUT US...

UNCG enters the game with a 4-3 record after knocking off Triad rival High Point Sunday at Fleming Gymnasium. Senior forward Janae' Stevenson set a program record with her fifth consecutive double-double as she ended the game with 11 points and 10 rebounds. The Spartans put five players in double figures offensively for the first time since 2008 with sophomore guard Lucy Mason leading the way with 17 points. Freshman guard Bailey Williams scored in double figures for the first time in her career with 10 points and she also added three assists. Posting a career day was junior guard Jarae Savage who netted a personal-best 16 points to go along with nine rebounds. Senior guard Breonna Patterson was the fifth double-digit scorer for the Blue and Gold as she went off for 15 points and was 7-of-8 at the charity stripe. UNCG won the rebounding battle by a 42-30 margin and shot a season-best 52.7 percent from the field – knocking down 29 of 55 attempts. The Spartans also hit for 67 percent from three-point range as they drained four of six. The Blue and Gold out-scored High Point 38-28 in the paint and 14-6 on the fast break. Both benches played a large factor in the outcome as the teams' reserves accounted for 75 points. UNCG averages 68.7 points per game while shooting 37.7 percent from the field and averaging 40.3 rebounds per outing.

ABOUT THEM...

Clemson has defeated South Florida, Radford and North Florida during its three-game winning streak which has pushed the Tigers' overall record to 4-3. Quinyotta Pettaway paces the offensive attack with 10.0 points per game and also leads the team in rebounding average at 8.3 boards per game. Clemson averages 54.6 points and 33.9 rebounds per game while shooting 39.8 percent from the field, 29.3 percent from beyond the arc and 66.3 percent from the charity stripe.

Wendy Palmer (Virginia, '96) is in her third season at the helm of the UNCG women's basketball program. Under her tutelage, the team doubled their win total in 2012-13 and won a game in the conference tournament for the first time since 2010. Palmer also mentored guard Lucy Mason to Southern Conference Freshman of the Year accolades. She arrived in Greensboro after a two-year stint as an assistant coach at her alma mater Virginia. While on the Cavalier staff, Palmer helped recruit and sign a class ranked in the top 15 nationally by ESPN HoopGurlz and coached All-American and national Defensive Player of the Year Monica Wright. During Palmer's tenure on the sidelines, Virginia made one NCAA appearance and a WNIT quarterfinals appearance. Palmer was an assistant for two years at Kentucky prior to returning to Virginia. There, she coached All-American Victoria Dunlap, who was taken 11th in a recent WNBA Draft. While still playing professionally, Palmer began her coaching career at Virginia Commonwealth. In her two years there, Palmer coached 2006 Colonial Athletic Association Rookie of the Year Quanitra Hollingsworth and Krystal Vaughn, who both went on to play professionally in the WNBA and in Europe. Palmer enjoyed outstanding playing careers on both the professional and amateur levels. A WNBA All-Star for the Detroit Shock in 2000, Palmer was also the WNBA's Co-Most Improved Player with the Connecticut Sun in 2004. She was selected in the 1997 Elite Draft by the Utah Starzz in preparation for the WNBA's inaugural year of competition and was a second-team All-WNBA selection that season. Palmer also played for the Orlando Miracle, San Antonio Silver Stars and Seattle Storm in her WNBA career. The Shock's Community Relations Player Representative from 1999-2001, Palmer was the recipient of the Black Legends of Professional Basketball John Isaacs Service Award. Palmer also played professionally in Spain, Brazil, Hungary, Turkey, Italy and Russia, earning another all-star bid in Italy. On the collegiate level, Palmer was a two-time Kodak All-American and Atlantic Coast Conference Player of the Year for the Cavaliers, earning those honors in 1995 and 1996. A three-time All-ACC selection, she is still the Cavs' career rebounding leader and is fourth on Virginia's all-time scoring list. Palmer was the first woman in school history and just the second player overall to record 1,000 career points and 1,000 career rebounds at Virginia. Cavalier legend Ralph Sampson was the other.

LAST TIME OUT FOR THE SPARTANS

UNCG 81, High Point 76

December 1, 2013 @ Greensboro, N.C. (Fleming Gymnasium)

GREENSBORO, N.C. – The UNCG women's basketball team faced a sizable early deficit Sunday afternoon against Triad rival High Point, but the Spartans were able to rally back and post an 81-76 non-conference victory inside Fleming Gymnasium. The Blue and Gold has won three of its last four after opening the season 0-2. Senior forward Janae' Stevenson set a program record with her fifth consecutive double-double as she ended the game with 11 points and 10 rebounds. Exactly half of her boards were on the offensive glass and she helped UNCG finish with an 18-9 advantage in second-chance points. The Spartans put five players in double figures offensively for the first time this campaign with sophomore guard Lucy Mason leading the way with 17 points. Freshman guard Bailey Williams scored in double figures for the first time in her career with 10 points and she also added three assists. Posting a career day was junior guard Jarae Savage who netted a personal-best 16 points to go along with nine rebounds. Senior guard Breonna Patterson was the fifth double-digit scorer for the Blue and Gold as she went off for 15 points and was 7-of-8 at the charity stripe UNCG won the rebounding battle by a 42-30 margin and shot a season-best 52.7 percent from the field – knocking down 29 of 55 attempts. The Spartans also hit for 67 percent from three-point range as they drained four of six. The Blue and Gold out-scored High Point 38-28 in the paint and 14-6 on the fast break. High Point raced out to a 6-0 lead just two minutes into the game before a jumper by Mason made it 6-3 with 16:28 on the clock. UNCG would go ice cold from the field over the next four minutes as a layup by Jaztmin Johnson capped a 12-2 run which made the score 18-5 at the 12:40 mark. A three-point play by Stevenson drew the Spartans to within 18-10 with 9:23 left before halftime and a layup by junior guard Jessica Collins capped an offensive flurry for the home team – pushing the score to 20-18 with 7:51 on the clock. A three-point field goal by Mason afforded UNCG its first lead of the game at 21-20 and the Spartans would extend the cushion to 27-20 on a three by Williams. All told, the Blue and Gold turned the 13-point deficit into a seven-point advantage thanks to a 22-2 run. The Panthers would answer the surge as a triple by Lexi Patterson knotted the score at 29. A pair of layups by Stevenson would put the lead back on UNCG's side at 33-32 with 21 seconds left, but Stacia Robertson put in a layup of her own inside of 10 seconds remaining to give High Point a 34-33 halftime advantage. Stevenson led the way for the Spartans in the first 20 minutes with seven points and seven rebounds while Kaylah Keys dropped in 13 points and a pair of Panthers corralled five rebounds. High Point shot 45 percent (14-of-31) from the field and held UNCG to 41 percent (12-of-29). The Blue and Gold held the upper hand on the glass, pulling down 26 rebounds as compared to the Panthers' 26. The second stanza was a nip-and-tuck affair for much of the early portion until a jumper by Keys gave High Point a 55-50 edge with 11:49 to go. The Spartans would clamp down on defense from there, however, putting together an 8-0 run capped by a Savage layup which made the score 58-55 in favor of the home team. High Point would fight back, knotting the proceedings at 64 apiece at the 6:30 mark, but two baskets by Savage helped UNCG maintain control. As it turns out, the Spartans would not trail again. A jumper by Keys pulled the visitors to within one, 69-68, with 4:22 remaining, but the Blue and Gold held on down the stretch and scored 12 of the game's final 20 points.

DOUBLE-DOUBLE MACHINE...

Stevenson's current career-best streak of five-straight double-doubles is a school record. She now has 16 career double-doubles, tying Julie Moore for third on the program chart. The school record for career double-doubles is held by Melinda Goodson who tallied 24 from 1997-2000.

PLAYING FROM BEHIND...

The Spartans have faced double-digit deficits in five games this season. However, UNCG has battled back on a couple of occasions to win. The Spartans were down 12 in the second half at Norfolk State and 13 in the first half against High Point but emerged victorious both times.

CASHING IN ON THE FREEBIES...

A bright spot for UNCG in the season opener at Florida State was its performance at the free throw line. The Spartans were 14-for-18 at the stripe led by a pair of freshman in Jade Scaife and Shanese Harris who combined to make 11 of 12 attempts. UNCG is shooting 69.8 percent at the charity stripe this season

USUALLY GOOD FOR THREE...

UNCG has nailed at least one three-point field goal in 212 of its last 214 games and 13 straight. The Spartans owned a streak of 155-straight contests with a triple until they went 0-6 at Wofford Dec. 17, 2011.

SOCON FRESHMAN OF THE YEAR...

Freshman guard Lucy Mason was selected the 2013 Southern Conference Freshman of the Year by the league's media members. She is the first Spartan to earn league freshman of the year accolades since Kristen Boone was recognized during the 2004-05 campaign and the first to garner a spot on the all-freshman team since teammate Janae' Stevenson in 2010-11. Mason paced the Spartans this season in scoring at 12.5 points per game and three-point field goals made with 35 while also averaging in double figures in SoCon play at 10.4 points per contest. She started every game for UNCG in 2012-13 and was the highest scoring rookie in the league by a full six points in all games and by three points in league contests.

LUCKY NUMBER 7(0)...

UNCG is 24-2 in its last 26 contests when scoring at least 70 points. The Spartans' last loss before the recent VCU setback when scoring 70 was nearly five years ago, Dec. 20, 2007, when the Blue and Gold fell at UCF, 76-73.

STUFFED...

Stevenson is rapidly moving her way up the UNCG career blocked shots list. As a freshman, she swatted 36 shots, the fourth-most in a single season in school history. She did two better with 38 blocked shots her sophomore campaign. With 108 to her credit now, she is third in program career history. Should she maintain her current pace, Stevenson should easily surpass UNCG's career record of 121 by Rebecca Viverette (1994-98) by the time her days in a Spartan uniform are over.

JUST FINE IN FLEMING...

UNCG has been historically successful in Fleming Gym, posting a 201-94 (.684) mark at the venue. In 23 years, UNCG has had just five losing seasons in the facility. The playing surface was christened Lynne Agee Court in honor of the former UNCG coach, who retired in March 2011 after 30 years at the helm. The court was officially dedicated at halftime of UNCG's Dec. 3, 2011 contest against Samford.

ROCKY ROAD...

The Blue and Gold has had a tough go of it away from home the last five years, compiling an 19-53 record away from Fleming Gymnasium.

BUCKETS...

The Spartans broke out in a big way against Wofford on the road last season as shots finally began to fall. The 87 points scored were the most for UNCG since dropping 88 on Elon in a 48-point victory Jan. 20, 2007. A total of four Spartans scored in double figures while Mason recorded a career-high 25 points.

A RARE FEAT ON THE ROAD...

UNCG's road win against Samford last year was notable for a number of reasons. Entering the contest, the Bulldogs were 7-2 at home for the season and 61-14 since the Pete Hanna Center opened. The Spartans also won at Samford for the first time in program history (0-4 prior).

WHAT'S BACK FOR THE BLUE AND GOLD...

Starting in 1997, the Spartans became eligible to compete for the league title after making their transition to Division I status as a member of the Big South Conference. UNCG owns two regular season championships (1998-99 and 2001-02) and one tournament title (1998) which led to the program's only NCAA Tournament appearance. 2014 SOUTHERN CONFERENCE CHAMPIONSHIP...

The 2014 edition of the Southern Conference Women's Basketball Championship is scheduled for March 7-10 in Asheville, N.C. All 10 conference squads will compete in the event, with the winner taking the league's automatic bid to the 2014 NCAA Tournament. Last season, No. 1 seed Chattanooga swept through the event to win its 14th SoCon title. The Mocs, seeded 11th in the NCAA Tournament, fell to No. 6 seed Nebraska 73-59 in the national event's first round.

UNCG also set a program single-game mark for blocked shots with 11.

UNCG head coach Wendy Palmer welcomes four new members to the Spartan women's basketball family next season. Below is a look at the new faces joining the program next year:

Keli Foster, Guard, 5-7, Hampton, Va. (Bethel)

Foster averaged 10.4 points, 3.4 rebounds, 4.9 assists and 4.1 steals per game her junior campaign at Bethel High School, earning first-team all-district accolades. She currently serves as a team captain for the Bruins and scored a career-high 24 points in an upset win over powerhouse Hampton High School in January of last season. Foster also excels in the classroom as a member of her school's honor roll and is a participant in the student athletic training program. She plays her AAU basketball for the Boo Williams Norfolk Express coached by Morris Smith.

Skye Jefferson, Forward/Center, 6-2, Richmond, Va. (Cosby)

Jefferson was the starting center last season for a state championship contending Cosby High School team under head coach Rachel Mead. She helped lead the Titans to a 26-2 overall record and racked up second-team all-district honors. Jefferson is a member of the Boo Williams Richmond AAU program coached by Max Coats and Mike Davis.

Jayda Luckie, Guard, 5-9, Norfolk, Va. (Maury)

Luckie averaged 12.7 points per game at Maury High School last season under head coach Jermaine Woods and earned first-team all-district recognition. She helped the Commodores to a 21-6 record as a junior and is a teammate of fellow signee Keli Foster on the Boo Williams Norfolk Xpress AAU program coached by Morris Smith. One of her most memorable moments last season occurred against Mount Vernon when she scored 13 points and hit a buzzer-beating layup at the end of double overtime to give Maury a 79-77 victory.

Alison Whitman, Center/Forward, 6-3, Madison, W.Va. (Scott)

Whitman is an impact post player who earned third-team all-state, first-team all-district and first-team all-conference honors last season under head coach John Porter at Scott High School. As a sophomore, Whitman helped the Skyhawks to a 25-4 overall record, 8-1 league ledger and a No. 9 ranking in the state. Scott has finished as the state runner up the past two years. Whitman is also a member of the West Virginia Thunder AAU program coached by Scott Johnson.
