Spartans Hit The Road For Georgia Southern

THE TIPOFF...

Fresh off of a victory over local Southern Conference rival Elon, the UNCG women's basketball team looks to even its league record when the Spartans travel to Georgia Southern Saturday. The win over the Phoenix was UNCG's first SoCon victory of the season after losses to Chattanooga and Samford. The Blue and Gold is 1-3 on the road this campaign with a victory over Norfolk State and setbacks to Gardner-Webb, Fordham and nationally-ranked Florida State. The Eagles are 2-3 at home this season with wins over Jacksonville State and Wofford as well as losses to Cal State Northridge, Furman and George Mason. Georgia Southern won both meetings with UNCG last season, downing the Spartans 63-56 in Greensboro and 67-53 in Statesboro.

ABOUT US...

The Spartans enter the game with a 5-9 overall record after defeating Elon 73-62 Jan. 4 at Fleming Gymnasium. The win snapped a six-game skid that dated back to Dec. 5, 2013. UNCG is averaging 63.9 points per game and allowing opponents to average 73.1 points per contest. The Blue and Gold owns a -2.6 margin on the glass, averaging 37.4 rebounds and allowing 40.0 boards per game. The Spartans are second in the SoCon in offensive rebounding at 14.1 per outing. In terms of shooting, UNCG is firing at a 36.4 percent clip from the field, 33.7 percent from beyond the arc and 69.3 percent from the free throw line. Senior forward Janae' Stevenson and sophomore guard Lucy Mason are tied for the team lead in scoring average at 12.7 - good for ninth in the SoCon - while Stevenson is pulling down a team-best 8.1 rebounds per game. She also has 47 offensive rebounds to her credit. Freshman center Mariah Wilson is the team leader in blocked shots with 11. The Spartans use their bench liberally as 11 players have appeared in 12 or more games.

ABOUT THEM...

Georgia Southern is 4-11 overall and 2-2 in SoCon play after a 64-61 road win over Samford Monday. The Eagles are scoring 60.0 points per game and are allowing 70.3 to their opponents. On the glass, Georgia Southern is pulling down 39.1 rebounds per contest and owns a -2.2 margin - giving up 41.3 boards a game. The Eagles are shooting 36.2 percent from the field, 32.2 percent from three-point land and an impressive 74.1 percent at the free throw line. Anna Claire Knight is scoring a team-best 14.9 points per game and is coming off of a triple-double performance at Samford. Briana Jones leads the rebounding efforts with 8.5 boards per game.

Wendy Palmer (Virginia, '96) is in her third season at the helm of the UNCG women's basketball program. Under her tutelage, the team doubled their win total in 2012-13 and won a game in the conference tournament for the first time since 2010. Palmer also mentored guard Lucy Mason to Southern Conference Freshman of the Year accolades. She arrived in Greensboro after a two-year stint as an assistant coach at her alma mater Virginia. While on the Cavalier staff, Palmer helped recruit and sign a class ranked in the top 15 nationally by ESPN HoopGurlz and coached All-American and national Defensive Player of the Year Monica Wright. During Palmer's tenure on the sidelines, Virginia made one NCAA appearance and a WNIT quarterfinals appearance. Palmer was an assistant for two years at Kentucky prior to returning to Virginia. There, she coached All-American Victoria Dunlap, who was taken 11th in a recent WNBA Draft. While still playing professionally, Palmer began her coaching career at Virginia Commonwealth. In her two years there, Palmer coached 2006 Colonial Athletic Association Rookie of the Year Quanitra Hollingsworth and Krystal Vaughn, who both went on to play professionally in the WNBA and in Europe. Palmer enjoyed outstanding playing careers on both the professional and amateur levels. A WNBA All-Star for the Detroit Shock in 2000, Palmer was also the WNBA's Co-Most Improved Player with the Connecticut Sun in 2004. She was selected in the 1997 Elite Draft by the Utah Starzz in preparation for the WNBA's inaugural year of competition and was a second-team All-WNBA selection that season. Palmer also played for the Orlando Miracle, San Antonio Silver Stars and Seattle Storm in her WNBA career. The Shock's Community Relations Player Representative from 1999-2001, Palmer was the recipient of the Black Legends of Professional Basketball John Isaacs Service Award. Palmer also played professionally in Spain, Brazil, Hungary, Turkey, Italy and Russia, earning another all-star bid in Italy. On the collegiate level, Palmer was a two-time Kodak All-American and Atlantic Coast Conference Player of the Year for the Cavaliers, earning those honors in 1995 and 1996. A three-time All-ACC selection, she is still the Cavs' career rebounding leader and is fourth on Virginia's all-time scoring list. Palmer was the first woman in school history and just the second player overall to record 1,000 career points and 1,000 career rebounds at Virginia. Cavalier legend Ralph Sampson was the other.

LAST TIME OUT FOR THE SPARTANS

UNCG 73, Elon 62

January 4, 2014 @ Greensboro, N.C. (Fleming Gymnasium)

GREENSBORO, N.C. – The UNCG women's basketball team out-scored local rival Elon 42-28 in the second half Saturday afternoon on the way to a 73-62 Southern Conference victory at Fleming Gymnasium. The Spartans snap a six-game losing streak to improve to 5-9 overall and 1-2 in SoCon play while the Phoenix drop to 5-9 and 1-2 with their third-straight loss. UNCG also defeated Elon for the first time since 2011, a span of four meetings. Elon looked to run away with the game early, scoring six quick points in the first 1:26 of the contest, but Stevenson netted four-straight points to pull UNCG back within two at the 17:19 mark. A triple by Williams afforded the Spartans their first lead of the contest, 11-10, with 14:24 remaining in the first half, but Shannen Cochraham answered with a bucket down low to swing the lead back to the Phoenix. That advantage would not last long as Mason drilled a three-pointer off an assist from Williams to make the score 14-12 in favor of UNCG. Mason would then knock down two free throws to stretch the lead to 16-12 as the clock hit 12:13. The Spartans would stay ahead and eventually move six points clear of Elon at 22-16 as Savage grabbed an offensive rebound and found freshman guard Shanese Harris (Chesapeake, Va./Western Branch) for a layup with 7:50 to play in the stanza. The Phoenix would fight back and tie the score at 26 on a three by Lenaira Ruffin before Cochraham scored on a layup to put Elon back in front with time ticking down. Kelsey Harris put in a layup off an offensive rebound to push the visitors' lead to 34-30 with 2:08 on the clock and Mason would close the scoring with a free throw at the 1:54 mark to leave Elon with a 34-31 edge at the break. The Phoenix came out firing in the second half, building a 39-31 advantage behind Cochraham. UNCG refused to lay down, however, quickly knotting the score at 41 thanks to a 10-2 run fueled by good defense and scoring from four different players during the 10-2 run. Nicole Razor put Elon back in front 43-41 with 12:56 to go, but Stevenson hit two free throws on the Spartans' next possession to create another deadlock. Senior guard Breonna Patterson came up big at the 12:22 mark as Mason grabbed a defensive rebound and threw the ball to Williams who found an open Patterson in the corner for a three which forced the Phoenix to use a timeout. UNCG held Elon off the scoreboard the next three minutes and was able to stretch its lead to 49-43 after a free throw by Mason. Ruffin would attempt to keep the Phoenix close as she scored five points to slice the Spartan advantage to 52-50 and Lauren Brown would complete the rally with two free throws to leave the score tied at 52 with 8:15 left to play. Harris gave UNCG the lead back at 54-52 when she stole the ball and took it down the floor for a layup, but Harris knotted the proceedings again with a layup of her own at the 6:43 mark. On the Spartans' very next possession, Stevenson looked to be in trouble with the shot clock winding down, but she put a nice move on the Elon defense and found the basket just as the clock expired to make it 56-54. UNCG would score eight of the next 16 points to assume a 64-60 lead with 3:09 remaining. Out of a Phoenix timeout, Stevenson came up big - scoring a basket and drawing the fourth foul on Cochraham. Stevenson calmly drained the and-one free throw to make the score 67-60 with 2:44 showing on the clock. Elon had two cracks at the bucket on its next possession, but could not convert and Stevenson pulled down the defensive rebound. Savage then scored on the fast break to push the UNCG lead to an ultimately insurmountable nine points (69-60). The Spartans out-scored the Phoenix 4-2 in the final 2:20 to seal the 11-point victory.

SPARKPLUG...

Junior guard Jarae Savage has been coming on strong for the Spartans in the last two games, providing some scoring punch and working hard on the glass as well as the defensive end. In the games against Tulsa and Elon she tallied 15 points, 15 rebounds (nine offensive), two assists and five steals.

SETTLING IN...

The adjustment that first-year players have to make from the high school game to the collegiate ranks is always tough. Freshman guard Bailey Williams is beginning to make a sizable contribution to the team as she has scored in double figures in back-to-back games. She netted 11 points against Tulsa in New York before going off for a career-best 13 in Saturday's win over Elon. Williams has racked up a team-high 44 assists (3.1 per game) which is good for fifth in the Southern Conference.

DOUBLE-DOUBLE MACHINE...

Stevenson's recent career-best streak of six-straight double-doubles is a school record. She now has 17 career double-doubles, surpassing Julie Moore for third on the program chart. The school record for career double-doubles is held by Melinda Goodson who tallied 24 from 1997-2000.

HEY SPARTANS, WELCOME TO THE SIXTIES...

The Spartan offense has improved each year over head coach Wendy Palmer's tenure. UNCG averaged just 49.6 points per game in her first season before scoring 57.2 per outing last year. This campaign has the Blue and Gold scoring at an average of 63.9 points a game.

PLAYING FROM BEHIND...

UNCG has battled back from a double-digit deficit on a couple of occasions to win this season. The Spartans were down 12 in the second half at Norfolk State and 13 in the first half against High Point but emerged victorious both times.

CASHING IN ON THE FREEBIES...

A bright spot for UNCG in the season opener at Florida State was its performance at the free throw line. The Spartans were 14-for-18 at the stripe led by a pair of freshman in Jade Scaife and Shanese Harris who combined to make 11 of 12 attempts. UNCG is shooting 68.3 percent at the charity stripe this season.

USUALLY GOOD FOR THREE...

UNCG has nailed at least one three-point field goal in 218 of its last 220 games and 17 straight. The Spartans owned a streak of 155-straight contests with a triple until they went 0-6 at Wofford Dec. 17, 2011.

SOCON FRESHMAN OF THE YEAR...

Freshman guard Lucy Mason was selected the 2013 Southern Conference Freshman of the Year by the league's media members. She is the first Spartan to earn league freshman of the year accolades since Kristen Boone was recognized during the 2004-05 campaign and the first to garner a spot on the all-freshman team since teammate Janae' Stevenson in 2010-11. Mason paced the Spartans this season in scoring at 12.5 points per game and three-point field goals made with 35 while also averaging in double figures in SoCon play at 10.4 points per contest. She started every game for UNCG in 2012-13 and was the highest scoring rookie in the league by a full six points in all games and by three points in league contests.

STUFFED...

Stevenson is rapidly moving her way up the UNCG career blocked shots list. As a freshman, she swatted 36 shots, the fourth-most in a single season in school history. She did two better with 38 blocked shots her sophomore campaign. With 110 to her credit now, she is third in program career history. Should she maintain her current pace, Stevenson should easily surpass UNCG's career record of 121 by Rebecca Viverette (1994-98) by the time her days in a Spartan uniform are over.

JUST FINE IN FLEMING...

UNCG has been historically successful in Fleming Gym, posting a 202-98 (.673) mark at the venue. In 23 years, UNCG has had just five losing seasons in the facility. The playing surface was christened Lynne Agee Court in honor of the former UNCG coach, who retired in March 2011 after 30 years at the helm. The court was officially dedicated at halftime of UNCG's Dec. 3, 2011 contest against Samford.

ROCKY ROAD...

The Blue and Gold has had a tough go of it away from home the last five years, compiling an 19-55 record away from Fleming Gymnasium.

WHAT'S BACK FOR THE BLUE AND GOLD...

UNCG may have a number of new faces joining the program this season, but the Spartans also return a large amount of their production - losing just one starter from the 2012-13 squad. Below is a more in-depth look.

SOUTHERN CONFERENCE: THE 17TH SEASON...

UNCG is in its 17th season as a basketball member of the Southern Conference. Starting in 1997, the Spartans became eligible to compete for the league title after making their transition to Division I status as a member of the Big South Conference. UNCG owns two regular season championships (1998-99 and 2001-02) and one tournament title (1998) which led to the program's only NCAA Tournament appearance. The Blue and Gold also qualified for the WNIT at the conclusion of the 2001-02 campaign. Below is a closer look at UNCG's history in the league.

2014 SOUTHERN CONFERENCE CHAMPIONSHIP...

The 2014 edition of the Southern Conference Women's Basketball Championship is scheduled for March 7-10 in Asheville, N.C. All 10 conference squads will compete in the event, with the winner taking the league's automatic bid to the 2014 NCAA Tournament. Last season, No. 1 seed Chattanooga swept through the event to win its 14th SoCon title. The Mocs, seeded 11th in the NCAA Tournament, fell to No. 6 seed Nebraska 73-59 in the national event's first round.

APPROACHING 1,000...

Stevenson entered the new campaign within reach of becoming the 23rd player in program history to score 1,000 career points. She sits at 929 points - 71 away from entering into the record books. Here is a look at all the 1,000-point scorers in UNCG women's basketball history:

DOUBLING UP...

The Spartans put five players in double figures offensively in the win over Triad rival High Point, marking the first time that had happened for UNCG since Nov. 24, 2008 - also against the Panthers.

ALL-TOURNAMENT...

For her efforts at the Fordham Holiday Classic, Stevenson was named to the all-tournament team. She averaged 13.0 points and 5.5 rebounds in games against Fordham and Tulsa while making 12 of 20 shots from the field (.600).

NEW SPARTANS...

UNCG head coach Wendy Palmer welcomes four new members to the Spartan women's basketball family next season. Below is a look at the new faces joining the program next year:

Keli Foster, Guard, 5-7, Hampton, Va. (Bethel)

Foster averaged 10.4 points, 3.4 rebounds, 4.9 assists and 4.1 steals per game her junior campaign at Bethel High School, earning first-team all-district accolades. She currently serves as a team captain for the Bruins and scored a career-high 24 points in an upset win over powerhouse Hampton High School in January of last season. Foster also excels in the classroom as a member of her school's honor roll and is a participant in the student athletic training program. She plays her AAU basketball for the Boo Williams Norfolk Xpress coached by Morris Smith.

Skye Jefferson, Forward/Center, 6-2, Richmond, Va. (Cosby)

Jefferson was the starting center last season for a state championship contending Cosby High School team under head coach Rachel Mead. She helped lead the Titans to a 26-2 overall record and racked up second-team all-district honors. Jefferson is a member of the Boo Williams Richmond AAU program coached by Max Coats and Mike Davis.

Jayda Luckie, Guard, 5-9, Norfolk, Va. (Maury)

Luckie averaged 12.7 points per game at Maury High School last season under head coach Jermaine Woods and earned first-team all-district recognition. She helped the Commodores to a 21-6 record as a junior and is a teammate of fellow signee Keli Foster on the Boo Williams Norfolk Xpress AAU program coached by Morris Smith. One of her most memorable moments last season occurred against Mount Vernon when she scored 13 points and hit a buzzer-beating layup at the end of double overtime to give Maury a 79-77 victory.

Alison Whitman, Center/Forward, 6-3, Madison, W.Va. (Scott)

Whitman is an impact post player who earned third-team all-state, first-team all-district and first-team all-conference honors last season under head coach John Porter at Scott High School. As a sophomore, Whitman helped the Skyhawks to a 25-4 overall record, 8-1 league ledger and a No. 9 ranking in the state. Scott has finished as the state runner up the past two years. Whitman is also a member of the West Virginia Thunder AAU program coached by Scott Johnson.
