UNCG Makes Short Trip To Davidson Monday Night

THE TIPOFF...

The UNCG women's basketball team looks for its first win on the road in Southern Conference play Monday as the Spartans head to Davidson for a 7 p.m. tipoff. The Spartans and Wildcats met three times last season and Davidson won all three matchups - including a victory in the SoCon Tournament quarterfinals in Asheville. UNCG comes in having lost seven of its last eight games overall while the Wildcats are winners of two of their last three contests. Davidson has won six-straight meetings between the teams as the last Spartan victory occurred Dec. 31, 2010 at Belk Arena by the score of 59-58. In last season's contest in Davidson, the Wildcats cruised to a 88-48 victory.

ABOUT US...

The Spartans enter the game with a 5-10 overall record after falling to Georgia Southern 74-71 Saturday at Hanner Fieldhouse. UNCG trailed 37-27 at the break and was able to tie the game in the second half but never take the lead. The Blue and Gold is averaging 64.4 points per game and allowing opponents to average 73.1 points per contest. The Blue and Gold owns a -2.1 margin on the glass, averaging 38.1 rebounds and allowing 40.3 boards per game. The Spartans are second in the SoCon in offensive rebounding at 14.7 per outing. In terms of shooting, UNCG is firing at a 36.3 percent clip from the field, 35.0 percent from beyond the arc and 68.6 percent from the free throw line. Senior forward Janae' Stevenson leads the team in scoring average at 12.7 - good for ninth in the SoCon - and is pulling down a team-best 8.2 rebounds per game. She also has 52 offensive rebounds to her credit. Freshman center Mariah Wilson is the team leader in blocked shots with 13. The Spartans use their bench liberally as 11 players have appeared in 13 or more games.

ABOUT THEM...

Davidson is 7-9 overall and 4-1 in Southern Conference action after defeating Elon 67-62 Saturday afternoon at Belk Arena. The Wildcats are second in the league in scoring offense with an average of 68.7 points, but Davidson is also giving up a SoCon worst 74.5. Davidson averages 34.9 rebounds per game and is getting out-rebounded by 6.8 boards per contest. Senior Laura Murray averages a team-best 18.9 points per game while Hannah Early and Dakota Dukes check in at 14.7 and 13.1 points per contest respectively. The Wildcats are shooting 41.2 percent from the field, 35.1 percent from deep and 70.3 percent at the free throw line.

Wendy Palmer (Virginia, '96) is in her third season at the helm of the UNCG women's basketball program. Under her tutelage, the team doubled their win total in 2012-13 and won a game in the conference tournament for the first time since 2010. Palmer also mentored guard Lucy Mason to Southern Conference Freshman of the Year accolades. She arrived in Greensboro after a two-year stint as an assistant coach at her alma mater Virginia. While on the Cavalier staff, Palmer helped recruit and sign a class ranked in the top 15 nationally by ESPN HoopGurlz and coached All-American and national Defensive Player of the Year Monica Wright. During Palmer's tenure on the sidelines, Virginia made one NCAA appearance and a WNIT quarterfinals appearance. Palmer was an assistant for two years at Kentucky prior to returning to Virginia. There, she coached All-American Victoria Dunlap, who was taken 11th in a recent WNBA Draft. While still playing professionally, Palmer began her coaching career at Virginia Commonwealth. In her two years there, Palmer coached 2006 Colonial Athletic Association Rookie of the Year Quanitra Hollingsworth and Krystal Vaughn, who both went on to play professionally in the WNBA and in Europe. Palmer enjoyed outstanding playing careers on both the professional and amateur levels. A WNBA All-Star for the Detroit Shock in 2000, Palmer was also the WNBA's Co-Most Improved Player with the Connecticut Sun in 2004. She was selected in the 1997 Elite Draft by the Utah Starzz in preparation for the WNBA's inaugural year of competition and was a second-team All-WNBA selection that season. Palmer also played for the Orlando Miracle, San Antonio Silver Stars and Seattle Storm in her WNBA career. The Shock's Community Relations Player Representative from 1999-2001, Palmer was the recipient of the Black Legends of Professional Basketball John Isaacs Service Award. Palmer also played professionally in Spain, Brazil, Hungary, Turkey, Italy and Russia, earning another all-star bid in Italy. On the collegiate level, Palmer was a two-time Kodak All-American and Atlantic Coast Conference Player of the Year for the Cavaliers, earning those honors in 1995 and 1996. A three-time All-ACC selection, she is still the Cavs' career rebounding leader and is fourth on Virginia's all-time scoring list. Palmer was the first woman in school history and just the second player overall to record 1,000 career points and 1,000 career rebounds at Virginia. Cavalier legend Ralph Sampson was the other.

LAST TIME OUT FOR THE SPARTANS

Georgia Southern 74, UNCG 71

January 11, 2014 @ Statesboro, Ga. (Hanner Fieldhouse)

STATESBORO, Ga. – The UNCG women's basketball team put together a furious rally from a 10-point halftime deficit Saturday, but Georgia Southern held on for a 74-71 Southern Conference victory at Hanner Fieldhouse. The Spartans trailed 37-27 at the break and were able to tie the game in the second half but never take the lead. Senior forward Janae' Stevenson fell just short of a double-double with 13 points and nine rebounds. She paced four Spartans in double-figure scoring as junior guard Jarae Savage netted 12 and sophomore guard Lucy Mason and junior guard Jessica Collins finished with 10 points apiece. Savage was also just shy of a double-double as she pulled down nine rebounds. Mason and freshman guard Bailey Williams each handed out six of UNCG's 16 assists. The Spartans put up a stout 78 attempts from the field and hit 27 of those shots to end up at 34.6 percent from the field while the Eagles knocked down 25 of 61 for 41 percent. UNCG hit nine three-point field goals in the contest on 19 attempts and was eight for 15 at the free throw line. GSU nailed five triples and 19 of 23 from the free throw line. The Blue and Gold won the rebounding battle 48-44 and recorded 22 offensive boards – leading to 21 second chance points. The Spartans committed just 12 turnovers in the game and forced 18 by the home team as UNCG picked up nine steals. Georgia Southern raced out of the gates, netting the first seven points of the game before UNCG came roaring back to knot the score at 11 after a triple by senior guard Breonna Patterson. After a timeout, the Eagles knocked in consecutive layups to go back up by four, but Patterson hit from deep again to pull the Spartans to within 15-14 at the 11:56 mark. The teams continued to trade blows and a three by Collins made the score 20-19 in favor of Georgia Southern with 10:06 to play in the half. UNCG went cold from that point and failed to get back in transition, leading to some easy buckets for the home team. When the dust settled, the Eagles found themselves up 33-21 and the Spartans called for timeout at the 5:47 mark. The Spartans picked up things on the defensive side of the ball the rest of the way before the break, clamping down and forcing some turnovers. With GSU in front 37-27 and UNCG with the ball for the last possession of the stanza, Mason missed from the top of the key and the Eagles secured the rebound as the buzzer sounded. UNCG came out with a renewed energy to start the second half, scoring the first six points of the frame to pull within 37-33 with 17:41 to play. The teams traded three-pointers before the Eagles knocked down two-straight shots to go back up by eight at 44-36. The Blue and Gold kept chipping away and playing solid defense, eventually tying the game at 49 on a three-point field goal by Williams with 10:46 on the clock. In all, it was a 22-12 run for the Spartans out of the locker room. The score stayed tied until the 8:17 mark when Knight hit a pair of free throws. Sierra Kirkland followed with a jumper to make the score 53-49 in favor of the home team. A layup by Stevenson with 5:24 left kept UNCG close, trailing just 57-53, but Knight canned a triple and Mimi DuBose hit three free throws after getting fouled beyond the arc to help Georgia Southern re-establish its 10-point advantage at 4:35. With the Eagles leading 65-55 with 2:58 on the clock, the Spartans mounted one last rally. Williams and Mason hit back-to-back threes before the teams traded layups and Collins nailed a triple to slice the deficit to one with 44 seconds left. UNCG could not quite complete the rally, however, as Georgia Southern iced the game at the free throw line and led 73-68 with eight ticks on the clock. Collins would hit another three-point field goal with one second left to make it 73-71 and Lacie Dowling hit one of two at the line to account for the final margin.

SPARKPLUG...

Junior guard Jarae Savage has been coming on strong for the Spartans in the last couple of games, providing some scoring punch and working hard on the glass as well as the defensive end. In the last three games, she has tallied 27 points, 24 rebounds (12 offensive), three assists and eight steals.

SETTLING IN...

The adjustment that first-year players have to make from the high school game to the collegiate ranks is always tough. Freshman guard Bailey Williams is beginning to make a nice contribution to the team as she has scored in double figures two of the last three games. She netted 11 points against Tulsa in New York before going off for a career-best 13 in the win over Elon. Williams has racked up a team-high 50 assists (3.3 per game) which is good for fourth in the Southern Conference.

DOUBLE-DOUBLE MACHINE...

Stevenson's recent career-best streak of six-straight double-doubles is a school record. She now has 17 career double-doubles, surpassing Julie Moore for third on the program chart. The school record for career double-doubles is held by Melinda Goodson who tallied 24 from 1997-2000.

WELCOME TO THE SIXTIES...

The Spartan offense has improved each year over head coach Wendy Palmer's tenure. UNCG averaged just 49.6 points per game in her first season before scoring 57.2 per outing last year. This campaign has the Blue and Gold scoring at an average of 64.4 points a game.

PLAYING FROM BEHIND...

UNCG has battled back from a double-digit deficit on a couple of occasions to win this season. The Spartans were down 12 in the second half at Norfolk State and 13 in the first half against High Point but emerged victorious both times.

CASHING IN ON THE FREEBIES...

A bright spot for UNCG in the season opener at Florida State was its performance at the free throw line. The Spartans were 14-for-18 at the stripe led by a pair of freshman in Jade Scaife and Shanese Harris who combined to make 11 of 12 attempts. UNCG is shooting 68.6 percent at the charity stripe this season

USUALLY GOOD FOR THREE...

UNCG has nailed at least one three-point field goal in 219 of its last 221 games and 18 straight. The Spartans owned a streak of 155-straight contests with a triple until they went 0-6 at Wofford Dec. 17, 2011.

SOCON FRESHMAN OF THE YEAR...

Freshman guard Lucy Mason was selected the 2013 Southern Conference Freshman of the Year by the league's media members. She is the first Spartan to earn league freshman of the year accolades since Kristen Boone was recognized during the 2004-05 campaign and the first to garner a spot on the all-freshman team since teammate Janae' Stevenson in 2010-11. Mason paced the Spartans this season in scoring at 12.5 points per game and three-point field goals made with 35 while also averaging in double figures in SoCon play at 10.4 points per contest. She started every game for UNCG in 2012-13 and was the highest scoring rookie in the league by a full six points in all games and by three points in league contests.

STUFFED...

Stevenson is rapidly moving her way up the UNCG career blocked shots list. As a freshman, she swatted 36 shots, the fourth-most in a single season in school history. She did two better with 38 blocked shots her sophomore campaign. With 110 to her credit now, she is third in program career history. Should she maintain her current pace, Stevenson should easily surpass UNCG's career record of 121 by Rebecca Viverette (1994-98) by the time her days in a Spartan uniform are over.

JUST FINE IN FLEMING...

UNCG has been historically successful in Fleming Gym, posting a 202-98 (.673) mark at the venue. In 23 years, UNCG has had just five losing seasons in the facility. The playing surface was christened Lynne Agee Court in honor of the former UNCG coach, who retired in March 2011 after 30 years at the helm. The court was officially dedicated at halftime of UNCG's Dec. 3, 2011 contest against Samford.

ROCKY ROAD...

The Blue and Gold has had a tough go of it away from home the last five years, compiling an 19-56 record away from Fleming Gymnasium.

WHAT'S BACK FOR THE BLUE AND GOLD...

UNCG may have a number of new faces joining the program this season, but the Spartans also return a large amount of their production - losing just one starter from the 2012-13 squad. Below is a more in-depth look.

SOUTHERN CONFERENCE: THE 17TH SEASON...

UNCG is in its 17th season as a basketball member of the Southern Conference. Starting in 1997, the Spartans became eligible to compete for the league title after making their transition to Division I status as a member of the Big South Conference. UNCG owns two regular season championships (1998-99 and 2001-02) and one tournament title (1998) which led to the program's only NCAA Tournament appearance. The Blue and Gold also qualified for the WNIT at the conclusion of the 2001-02 campaign. Below is a closer look at UNCG's history in the league.

2014 SOUTHERN CONFERENCE CHAMPIONSHIP...

The 2014 edition of the Southern Conference Women's Basketball Championship is scheduled for March 7-10 in Asheville, N.C. All 10 conference squads will compete in the event, with the winner taking the league's automatic bid to the 2014 NCAA Tournament. Last season, No. 1 seed Chattanooga swept through the event to win its 14th SoCon title. The Mocs, seeded 11th in the NCAA Tournament, fell to No. 6 seed Nebraska 73-59 in the national event's first round.

APPROACHING 1,000...

Stevenson entered the new campaign within reach of becoming the 23rd player in program history to score 1,000 career points. She sits at 942 points - 58 away from entering into the record books. Here is a look at all the 1,000-point scorers in UNCG women's basketball history:

SIGN OF THINGS TO COME?...

When the ballott for the Southern Conference All-Freshman Team comes out, the Spartans should have quite a few rookies under heavy consideration. Forward Jade Scaife leads all league freshman in rebounding while Williams is tops among first-year players in assists. Additionally, center Mariah Wilson is the only SoCon freshman in the top 15 in blocked shots.

DOUBLING UP...

The Spartans put five players in double figures offensively in the win over Triad rival High Point, marking the first time that had happened for UNCG since Nov. 24, 2008 - also against the Panthers.

ALL-TOURNAMENT...

For her efforts at the Fordham Holiday Classic, Stevenson was named to the all-tournament team. She averaged 13.0 points and 5.5 rebounds in games against Fordham and Tulsa while making 12 of 20 shots from the field (.600).

NEW SPARTANS...

UNCG head coach Wendy Palmer welcomes four new members to the Spartan women's basketball family next season. Below is a look at the new faces joining the program next year:

Keli Foster, Guard, 5-7, Hampton, Va. (Bethel)

Foster averaged 10.4 points, 3.4 rebounds, 4.9 assists and 4.1 steals per game her junior campaign at Bethel High School, earning first-team all-district accolades. She currently serves as a team captain for the Bruins and scored a career-high 24 points in an upset win over powerhouse Hampton High School in January of last season. Foster also excels in the classroom as a member of her school's honor roll and is a participant in the student athletic training program. She plays her AAU basketball for the Boo Williams Norfolk Xpress coached by Morris Smith.

Skye Jefferson, Forward/Center, 6-2, Richmond, Va. (Cosby)

Jefferson was the starting center last season for a state championship contending Cosby High School team under head coach Rachel Mead. She helped lead the Titans to a 26-2 overall record and racked up second-team all-district honors. Jefferson is a member of the Boo Williams Richmond AAU program coached by Max Coats and Mike Davis.

Jayda Luckie, Guard, 5-9, Norfolk, Va. (Maury)

Luckie averaged 12.7 points per game at Maury High School last season under head coach Jermaine Woods and earned first-team all-district recognition. She helped the Commodores to a 21-6 record as a junior and is a teammate of fellow signee Keli Foster on the Boo Williams Norfolk Xpress AAU program coached by Morris Smith. One of her most memorable moments last season occurred against Mount Vernon when she scored 13 points and hit a buzzer-beating layup at the end of double overtime to give Maury a 79-77 victory.

Alison Whitman, Center/Forward, 6-3, Madison, W.Va. (Scott)

Whitman is an impact post player who earned third-team all-state, first-team all-district and first-team all-conference honors last season under head coach John Porter at Scott High School. As a sophomore, Whitman helped the Skyhawks to a 25-4 overall record, 8-1 league ledger and a No. 9 ranking in the state. Scott has finished as the state runner up the past two years. Whitman is also a member of the West Virginia Thunder AAU program coached by Scott Johnson.
