UNCG Entertains Appalachian State Sunday Afternoon

THE TIPOFF...

The UNCG women's basketball team looks to snap a three-game skid Sunday afternoon, hosting Southern Conference foe Appalachian State at Fleming Gymnasium. The Spartans have dropped nine of their last 10 games with the only victory in that stretch occurring Jan. 4 in a 73-62 decision over Elon in Greensboro. UNCG is 4-6 at home this season (1-3 SoCon) while the Mountaineers are 3-6 on the road (1-2 SoCon). The matchup marks the final scheduled appearance at Fleming Gymnasium for Appalachian State as the Mountaineers will join the Sun Belt Conference next season. ASU leads the all-time series between the schools 31-28 and has captured the last eight meetings.

ABOUT US...

The Blue and Gold enters the game with a 5-12 overall record and 1-5 league mark after falling to Western Carolina 60-49 Saturday at Fleming Gymnasium. UNCG shot just 23.3 percent from the field in the setback. The Spartans are averaging 63.2 points per game and are allowing opponents to score 72.6 points per contest. The Blue and Gold owns a -1.4 margin on the glass, averaging 39.0 rebounds and giving up 40.4 boards per game. The Spartans are second in the league in offensive rebounding at 15.0 per outing. In terms of shooting, UNCG is firing at a 35.2 percent clip from the field, 32.6 percent from beyond the arc and 68.6 percent from the free throw line. Senior forward Janae' Stevenson leads the team in scoring average at 12.0 points per game and is pulling down a team-best 8.0 rebounds per contest. She also has 57 offensive rebounds to her credit. Freshman center Mariah Wilson is the team leader in blocked shots with 17. The Spartans use their bench liberally as 11 players have appeared in 15 or more games.

ABOUT THEM...

Appalachian State is 5-11 overall and 2-4 in Southern Conference action after suffering a 66-54 setback Saturday at Elon. The Mountaineers are averaging 62.0 points per game while giving up 66.6. ASU also pulls down 40.4 rebounds per contest while allowing just 35.1 - a rebounding margin of +5.3. The Mountaineers are shooting 41.4 percent from the field, 32.5 percent from deep and 61.9 percent at the free throw line. Junior Maryah Sydnor is the top offensive force for Appalachian State, averaging right at 20 points per game. She also leads the team with a rebounding average of 8.6 per contest.

Wendy Palmer (Virginia, '96) is in her third season at the helm of the UNCG women's basketball program. Under her tutelage, the team doubled their win total in 2012-13 and won a game in the conference tournament for the first time since 2010. Palmer also mentored guard Lucy Mason to Southern Conference Freshman of the Year accolades. She arrived in Greensboro after a two-year stint as an assistant coach at her alma mater Virginia. While on the Cavalier staff, Palmer helped recruit and sign a class ranked in the top 15 nationally by ESPN HoopGurlz and coached All-American and national Defensive Player of the Year Monica Wright. During Palmer's tenure on the sidelines, Virginia made one NCAA appearance and a WNIT quarterfinals appearance. Palmer was an assistant for two years at Kentucky prior to returning to Virginia. There, she coached All-American Victoria Dunlap, who was taken 11th in a recent WNBA Draft. While still playing professionally, Palmer began her coaching career at Virginia Commonwealth. In her two years there, Palmer coached 2006 Colonial Athletic Association Rookie of the Year Quanitra Hollingsworth and Krystal Vaughn, who both went on to play professionally in the WNBA and in Europe. Palmer enjoyed outstanding playing careers on both the professional and amateur levels. A WNBA All-Star for the Detroit Shock in 2000, Palmer was also the WNBA's Co-Most Improved Player with the Connecticut Sun in 2004. She was selected in the 1997 Elite Draft by the Utah Starzz in preparation for the WNBA's inaugural year of competition and was a second-team All-WNBA selection that season. Palmer also played for the Orlando Miracle, San Antonio Silver Stars and Seattle Storm in her WNBA career. The Shock's Community Relations Player Representative from 1999-2001, Palmer was the recipient of the Black Legends of Professional Basketball John Isaacs Service Award. Palmer also played professionally in Spain, Brazil, Hungary, Turkey, Italy and Russia, earning another all-star bid in Italy. On the collegiate level, Palmer was a two-time Kodak All-American and Atlantic Coast Conference Player of the Year for the Cavaliers, earning those honors in 1995 and 1996. A three-time All-ACC selection, she is still the Cavs' career rebounding leader and is fourth on Virginia's all-time scoring list. Palmer was the first woman in school history and just the second player overall to record 1,000 career points and 1,000 career rebounds at Virginia. Cavalier legend Ralph Sampson was the other.

LAST TIME OUT FOR THE SPARTANS

Western Carolina 60, UNCG 49

January 17, 2014 @ Greensboro, N.C. (Fleming Gymnasium)

GREENSBORO N.C. – The UNCG women's basketball team shot 23.3 percent against Western Carolina Friday night as the Catamounts defeated the Spartans 60-49 in a Southern Conference game at Fleming Gymnasium. UNCG (5-12, 1-5 SoCon) hit just 14 of 60 attempts from the field while Western Carolina (9-8, 3-3 SoCon) knocked down 23 of 51 to finish at 45.1 percent. The Spartans also hit just two of 16 three-point field goal attempts. The Blue and Gold did win the rebounding battle, 42-37, and picked up 17 offensive boards – but UNCG was also plagued by 21 turnovers. The Catamounts turned the ball over 20 times but recorded 14 steals to help in their defensive efforts. The teams also combined for 13 blocked shots. Freshman forward Jade Scaife paced the Spartans with 10 points and seven rebounds while Rena Wakama tallied 21 points and five boards for the visitors. Alexis Carter also posted four blocks for Western to offset three blocks by UNCG freshman center Mariah Wilson. Senior forward Janae' Stevenson also totaled eight points, seven rebounds, one block and one steal. The Catamounts built a 7-2 lead with 3:13 gone in the first half after a jumper by Wakama. A pair of foul shots by Wilson would knot the score at nine at 13:31 before Western scored six-straight points to make it 15-9 with 10:45 to go in the period. UNCG fought back, going on a 12-5 run which was capped by a three-point play by Scaife and gave the Spartans a 21-20 advantage with 4:37 left in the stanza. The Blue and Gold extended the run to 19-5 as a jumper by Scaife pushed the UNCG cushion to 28-20 with time winding down, but the turnover bug started to bite the home team. Two-straight miscues allowed WCU to net four quick points and a subsequent three by Hana Haden pulled the Catamounts to within 28-27. A free throw by freshman guard Whitney Coleman stopped Western's momentum briefly, but the Catamounts would go on to net the final six points of the half and head into the break with a 33-29 lead. In all, Western Carolina ended the frame on a 13-1 run which spanned the final 2:45. Scaife led the way for UNCG with 10 points and five rebounds in the first 20 minutes while Wakama and Haden scored 15 and 10 points respectively for the Catamounts. The Spartans shot 36.0 percent and allowed Western to fire at a 48.1 percent clip. The Blue and Gold had the better of the rebounding 17-13 and the teams combined for 25 turnovers. Wakama opened the second half with a layup and Western would lead 37-31 before a pair of foul shots by sophomore guard Jazmine Missouri helped keep the deficit at four. UNCG could not keep the visitors at bay, however, as the Catamounts out-scored the Spartans 10-2 over the next four and a half minutes to enjoy a 47-35 advantage with 11:22 to play. A free throw by Stevenson cut the Blue and Gold's deficit to nine, 49-40, at 7:25, but Western Carolina allowed UNCG just nine more points the rest of the way as the Catamounts settled for the 11-point win.

DOUBLE-DOUBLE MACHINE...

Stevenson's recent career-best streak of six-straight double-doubles is a school record. She now has 17 career double-doubles, surpassing Julie Moore for third on the program chart. The school record for career double-doubles is held by Melinda Goodson who tallied 24 from 1997-2000.

WELCOME TO THE SIXTIES...

The Spartan offense has improved each year over head coach Wendy Palmer's tenure. UNCG averaged just 49.6 points per game in her first season before scoring 57.2 per outing last year. This campaign has the Blue and Gold scoring at an average of 63.2 points a game.

PLAYING FROM BEHIND...

UNCG has battled back from a double-digit deficit on a couple of occasions to win this season. The Spartans were down 12 in the second half at Norfolk State and 13 in the first half against High Point but emerged victorious both times.

CASHING IN ON THE FREEBIES...

A bright spot for UNCG in the season opener at Florida State was its performance at the free throw line. The Spartans were 14-for-18 at the stripe led by a pair of freshman in Jade Scaife and Shanese Harris who combined to make 11 of 12 attempts. UNCG is shooting 68.6 percent at the charity stripe this season

USUALLY GOOD FOR THREE...

UNCG has nailed at least one three-point field goal in 221 of its last 223 games and 20 straight. The Spartans owned a streak of 155-straight contests with a triple until they went 0-6 at Wofford Dec. 17, 2011.

SOCON FRESHMAN OF THE YEAR...

Freshman guard Lucy Mason was selected the 2013 Southern Conference Freshman of the Year by the league's media members. She is the first Spartan to earn league freshman of the year accolades since Kristen Boone was recognized during the 2004-05 campaign and the first to garner a spot on the all-freshman team since teammate Janae' Stevenson in 2010-11. Mason paced the Spartans this season in scoring at 12.5 points per game and three-point field goals made with 35 while also averaging in double figures in SoCon play at 10.4 points per contest. She started every game for UNCG in 2012-13 and was the highest scoring rookie in the league by a full six points in all games and by three points in league contests.

STUFFED...

Stevenson is rapidly moving her way up the UNCG career blocked shots list. As a freshman, she swatted 36 shots, the fourth-most in a single season in school history. She did two better with 38 blocked shots her sophomore campaign. With 112 to her credit now, she is second in program career history. Should she maintain her current pace, Stevenson should be able to surpass UNCG's career record of 121 by Rebecca Viverette (1994-98) by the time her days in a Spartan uniform are over.

JUST FINE IN FLEMING...

UNCG has been historically successful in Fleming Gym, posting a 202-99 (.671) mark at the venue. In 23 years, UNCG has had just five losing seasons in the facility. The playing surface was christened Lynne Agee Court in honor of the former UNCG coach, who retired in March 2011 after 30 years at the helm. The court was officially dedicated at halftime of UNCG's Dec. 3, 2011 contest against Samford.

ROCKY ROAD...

The Blue and Gold has had a tough go of it away from home the last five years, compiling an 19-57 record away from Fleming Gymnasium.

WHAT'S BACK FOR THE BLUE AND GOLD...

SOUTHERN CONFERENCE: THE 17TH SEASON...

UNCG is in its 17th season as a basketball member of the Southern Conference. Starting in 1997, the Spartans became eligible to compete for the league title after making their transition to Division I status as a member of the Big South Conference. UNCG owns two regular season championships (1998-99 and 2001-02) and one tournament title (1998) which led to the program's only NCAA Tournament appearance. The Blue and Gold also qualified for the WNIT at the conclusion of the 2001-02 campaign. Below is a closer look at UNCG's history in the league.

2014 SOUTHERN CONFERENCE CHAMPIONSHIP...

The 2014 edition of the Southern Conference Women's Basketball Championship is scheduled for March 7-10 in Asheville, N.C. All 10 conference squads will compete in the event, with the winner taking the league's automatic bid to the 2014 NCAA Tournament. Last season, No. 1 seed Chattanooga swept through the event to win its 14th SoCon title. The Mocs, seeded 11th in the NCAA Tournament, fell to No. 6 seed Nebraska 73-59 in the national event's first round.

APPROACHING 1,000...

For her efforts at the Fordham Holiday Classic, Stevenson was named to the all-tournament team. She averaged 13.0 points and 5.5 rebounds in games against Fordham and Tulsa while making 12 of 20 shots from the field (.600).

NEW SPARTANS...

UNCG head coach Wendy Palmer welcomes four new members to the Spartan women's basketball family next season. Below is a look at the new faces joining the program next year:

Keli Foster, Guard, 5-7, Hampton, Va. (Bethel)

Foster averaged 10.4 points, 3.4 rebounds, 4.9 assists and 4.1 steals per game her junior campaign at Bethel High School, earning first-team all-district accolades. She currently serves as a team captain for the Bruins and scored a career-high 24 points in an upset win over powerhouse Hampton High School in January of last season. Foster also excels in the classroom as a member of her school's honor roll and is a participant in the student athletic training program. She plays her AAU basketball for the Boo Williams Norfolk Xpress coached by Morris Smith.

Skye Jefferson, Forward/Center, 6-2, Richmond, Va. (Cosby)

Jefferson was the starting center last season for a state championship contending Cosby High School team under head coach Rachel Mead. She helped lead the Titans to a 26-2 overall record and racked up second-team all-district honors. Jefferson is a member of the Boo Williams Richmond AAU program coached by Max Coats and Mike Davis.

Jayda Luckie, Guard, 5-9, Norfolk, Va. (Maury)

Luckie averaged 12.7 points per game at Maury High School last season under head coach Jermaine Woods and earned first-team all-district recognition. She helped the Commodores to a 21-6 record as a junior and is a teammate of fellow signee Keli Foster on the Boo Williams Norfolk Xpress AAU program coached by Morris Smith. One of her most memorable moments last season occurred against Mount Vernon when she scored 13 points and hit a buzzer-beating layup at the end of double overtime to give Maury a 79-77 victory.

Alison Whitman, Center/Forward, 6-3, Madison, W.Va. (Scott)

Whitman is an impact post player who earned third-team all-state, first-team all-district and first-team all-conference honors last season under head coach John Porter at Scott High School. As a sophomore, Whitman helped the Skyhawks to a 25-4 overall record, 8-1 league ledger and a No. 9 ranking in the state. Scott has finished as the state runner up the past two years. Whitman is also a member of the West Virginia Thunder AAU program coached by Scott Johnson.
