UNCG Returns To SoCon Play Against Local Rival Elon

THE TIPOFF...

The UNCG women's basketball team returns home this weekend, hosting Elon Saturday inside Fleming Gymnasium. The Spartans have lost six-straight games and look to record a victory as they begin the bulk of their Southern Conference schedule. The Blue and Gold will also attempt to record its first league win of the year after losing a pair of conference games to Chattanooga and Samford at home back in December. UNCG is 3-5 at home this season and will play three of its next five contests in Greensboro. Elon is 1-4 away from its home facility Alumni Gym with a lone victory at at UNC Wilmington and losses to VCU, Vanderbilt, NC State and West Virginia. The Phoenix have won the last four games in the series against the Spartans.

ABOUT US...

The Spartans enter the game with a 4-9 overall record after falling to Tulsa 76-71 Dec. 30 to close out the Fordham Holiday Classic in The Bronx, N.Y. The Golden Hurricane knocked down 29 of 37 attempts from the free throw line to hold on while the Spartans were awarded just 17 free throw shots – draining 12 of them. Tulsa shot 40.7 percent from the field (22-of-54) and held UNCG to 26-of-66 efficiency (39.4 percent). The Hurricane also ended up with a 40-39 advantage in rebounding and forced the Blue and Gold into 15 turnovers while committing 12 of its own. Senior guard Breonna Patterson led four Spartans in double figures offensively with 17 points. Senior forward Janae' Stevenson followed with 12 points while freshman guard Bailey Williams and freshman forward Jade Scaife netted 11 apiece. Scaife fell just short of a double-double as she pulled down nine rebounds. Junior guard Jarae Savage also chipped in with nine points and eight rebounds. The Spartans are averaging 63.2 points per game and are shooting 35.9 percent from the field.

ABOUT THEM...

Elon looks to get back on the winning track after dropping decisions at West Virginia and at home to North Carolina A&T. The Phoenix sport a 5-8 overall record and a 1-1 league ledger with a victory over Samford and a loss to Chattanooga. Senior Kelsey Harris averages a team-best 12.3 points per game while junior Sam Coffer heads up the rebounding effort with 6.5 rebounds per contest. As a team, Elon averages 65.2 points per game and is firing at a 42.0 percent clip from the field. The Phoenix are getting out-scored by 8.3 points per contest and out-rebounded by a margin of 3.2 rebounds a contest.

Wendy Palmer (Virginia, '96) is in her third season at the helm of the UNCG women's basketball program. Under her tutelege, the team doubled their win total in 2012-13 and won a game in the conference tournament for the first time since 2010. Palmer also mentored guard Lucy Mason to Southern Conference Freshman of the Year accolades. She arrived in Greensboro after a two-year stint as an assistant coach at her alma mater Virginia. While on the Cavalier staff, Palmer helped recruit and sign a class ranked in the top 15 nationally by ESPN HoopGurlz and coached All-American and national Defensive Player of the Year Monica Wright. During Palmer's tenure on the sidelines, Virginia made one NCAA appearance and a WNIT quarterfinals appearance. Palmer was an assistant for two years at Kentucky prior to returning to Virginia. There, she coached All-American Victoria Dunlap, who was taken 11th in a recent WNBA Draft. While still playing professionally, Palmer began her coaching career at Virginia Commonwealth. In her two years there, Palmer coached 2006 Colonial Athletic Association Rookie of the Year Quanitra Hollingsworth and Krystal Vaughn, who both went on to play professionally in the WNBA and in Europe. Palmer enjoyed outstanding playing careers on both the professional and amateur levels. A WNBA All-Star for the Detroit Shock in 2000, Palmer was also the WNBA's Co-Most Improved Player with the Connecticut Sun in 2004. She was selected in the 1997 Elite Draft by the Utah Starzz in preparation for the WNBA's inaugural year of competition and was a second-team All-WNBA selection that season. Palmer also played for the Orlando Miracle, San Antonio Silver Stars and Seattle Storm in her WNBA career. The Shock's Community Relations Player Representative from 1999-2001, Palmer was the recipient of the Black Legends of Professional Basketball John Isaacs Service Award. Palmer also played professionally in Spain, Brazil, Hungary, Turkey, Italy and Russia, earning another all-star bid in Italy. On the collegiate level, Palmer was a two-time Kodak All-American and Atlantic Coast Conference Player of the Year for the Cavaliers, earning those honors in 1995 and 1996. A three-time All-ACC selection, she is still the Cavs' career rebounding leader and is fourth on Virginia's all-time scoring list. Palmer was the first woman in school history and just the second player overall to record 1,000 career points and 1,000 career rebounds at Virginia. Cavalier legend Ralph Sampson was the other.

LAST TIME OUT FOR THE SPARTANS

Tulsa 76, UNCG 71

THE BRONX, N.Y. - Monday's non-conference finale between the UNCG women's basketball team and defending Conference USA champion Tulsa went down to the wire and the Golden Hurricane took advantage of a 30-17 difference in fouls called to post a 76-71 victory to close the Fordham Holiday Classic at Rose Hill Gymnasium. Tulsa knocked down 29 of 37 attempts from the line to hold on while the Spartans were awarded just 17 free throw shots - draining 12 of them. The Golden Hurricane shot 40.7 percent from the field (22-of-54) and held UNCG to 26-of-66 efficiency (39.4 percent). Tulsa also ended up with a 40-39 advantage in rebounding and forced the Blue and Gold into 15 turnovers while committing 12 of its own. Senior guard Breonna Patterson led four Spartans in double figures offensively with 17 points. Senior forward Janae' Stevenson followed with 12 points while freshman guard Bailey Williams and freshman forward Jade Scaife netted 11 apiece. Scaife fell just short of a double-double as she pulled down nine rebounds. Junior guard Jarae Savage also chipped in with nine points and eight rebounds. Williams put UNCG on top with a free throw before Stevenson knocked in a layup to make it 3-0. Ashley Clark completed a three-point play to make it 8-3 in favor of Tulsa but Savage put in a layup with 16:42 on the clock to pull the Spartans within 8-5. A three-point field goal by Patterson made the score 10-8 before the Hurricane went on a 7-2 run to forge ahead 17-10. A triple by Williams ignited a 9-2 UNCG run which tied the score at 19 with 6:54 remaining before the break, but Tulsa responded with 6-3 run of its own to re-establish a three-point edge as time ticked down. The Blue and Gold would take the lead back thanks to a three by Mason, making it 27-26 at 4:09, however the Hurricane would out-score the Spartans 10-5 the remainder of the period to take a 36-32 edge into the break. Williams and Stevenson scored six points apiece for UNCG in the first 20 minutes while Mason and Scaife pulled down four rebounds each. Tulsa shot 41 percent from the field (12-of-29) and limited the Spartans to 34 percent (11of-32). The Hurricane also held a slight 21-19 advantage on the glass. Tulsa went up by six just 10 seconds into the second stanza with a layup from Erika Lane before Savage answered with an offensive rebounds and a put in. A layup by Stevenson deadlocked the score at 38 with 18:09 on the clock before Lane dropped in another bucket to put her team back on top. The Golden Hurricane stretched their advantage to six at 49-43 after a layup by Loren McDaniel but a three-pointer by Patterson sliced the deficit to just one at 50-49 with 10:24 to play. Tulsa looked to pull away after a Mariah Turner layup made the score 56-51 at 7:49, but a three-point play by Savage made it a one-point affair once more at 59-58. Patterson knocked down a layup to keep UNCG close, 63-62, with 3:16 remaining and the Spartans forced a Golden Hurricane turnover. However, the Blue and Gold could not convert on its end and two free throws by Stevi Parker put Tulsa ahead by three with 2:22 on the clock. UNCG could not quite catch up the rest of the way. A three-point field goal by Williams cut the deficit to four, 69-65, with 40 seconds left, but the Golden Hurricane was able to salt the game away at the free throw line.

DOUBLE-DOUBLE MACHINE...

Stevenson's recent career-best streak of six-straight double-doubles is a school record. She now has 17 career double-doubles, surpassing Julie Moore for third on the program chart. The school record for career double-doubles is held by Melinda Goodson who tallied 24 from 1997-2000.

HEY SPARTANS, WELCOME TO THE SIXTIES...

The Spartan offense has improved each year over head coach Wendy Palmer's tenure. UNCG averaged just 49.6 points per game in her first season before scoring 57.2 per outing last year. This campaign has the Blue and Gold scoring at an average of 63.2 points a game.

PLAYING FROM BEHIND...

UNCG has battled back from a double-digit deficit on a couple of occasions to win this season. The Spartans were down 12 in the second half at Norfolk State and 13 in the first half against High Point but emerged victorious both times.

CASHING IN ON THE FREEBIES...

A bright spot for UNCG in the season opener at Florida State was its performance at the free throw line. The Spartans were 14-for-18 at the stripe led by a pair of freshman in Jade Scaife and Shanese Harris who combined to make 11 of 12 attempts. UNCG is shooting 68.3 percent at the charity stripe this season

USUALLY GOOD FOR THREE...

UNCG has nailed at least one three-point field goal in 218 of its last 220 games and 17 straight. The Spartans owned a streak of 155-straight contests with a triple until they went 0-6 at Wofford Dec. 17, 2011.

SOCON FRESHMAN OF THE YEAR...

Freshman guard Lucy Mason was selected the 2013 Southern Conference Freshman of the Year by the league's media members. She is the first Spartan to earn league freshman of the year accolades since Kristen Boone was recognized during the 2004-05 campaign and the first to garner a spot on the all-freshman team since teammate Janae' Stevenson in 2010-11. Mason paced the Spartans this season in scoring at 12.5 points per game and three-point field goals made with 35 while also averaging in double figures in SoCon play at 10.4 points per contest. She started every game for UNCG in 2012-13 and was the highest scoring rookie in the league by a full six points in all games and by three points in league contests.

STUFFED...

Stevenson is rapidly moving her way up the UNCG career blocked shots list. As a freshman, she swatted 36 shots, the fourth-most in a single season in school history. She did two better with 38 blocked shots her sophomore campaign. With 109 to her credit now, she is third in program career history. Should she maintain her current pace, Stevenson should easily surpass UNCG's career record of 121 by Rebecca Viverette (1994-98) by the time her days in a Spartan uniform are over.

JUST FINE IN FLEMING...

UNCG has been historically successful in Fleming Gym, posting a 201-98 (.672) mark at the venue. In 23 years, UNCG has had just five losing seasons in the facility. The playing surface was christened Lynne Agee Court in honor of the former UNCG coach, who retired in March 2011 after 30 years at the helm. The court was officially dedicated at halftime of UNCG's Dec. 3, 2011 contest against Samford.

ROCKY ROAD...

The Blue and Gold has had a tough go of it away from home the last five years, compiling an 19-55 record away from Fleming Gymnasium.

BUCKETS..

The Spartans broke out in a big way against Wofford on the road last season as shots finally began to fall. The 87 points scored were the most for UNCG since dropping 88 on Elon in a 48-point victory Jan. 20, 2007. A total of four Spartans scored in double figures while Mason recorded a career-high 25 points.

A RARE FEAT ON THE ROAD...

UNCG's road win against Samford last year was notable for a number of reasons. Entering the contest, the Bulldogs were 7-2 at home for the season and 61-14 since the Pete Hanna Center opened. The Spartans also won at Samford for the first time in program history (0-4 prior).

WHAT'S BACK FOR THE BLUE AND GOLD...

UNCG may have a number of new faces joining the program this season, but the Spartans also return a large amount of their production - losing just one starter from the 2012-13 squad. Below is a more in-depth look.

SOUTHERN CONFERENCE: THE 17TH SEASON...

UNCG is in its 17th season as a basketball member of the Southern Conference. Starting in 1997, the Spartans became eligible to compete for the league title after making their transition to Division I status as a member of the Big South Conference. UNCG owns two regular season championships (1998-99 and 2001-02) and one tournament title (1998) which led to the program's only NCAA Tournament appearance. The Blue and Gold also qualified for the WNIT at the conclusion of the 2001-02 campaign. Below is a closer look at UNCG's history in the league.

2014 SOUTHERN CONFERENCE CHAMPIONSHIP...

The 2014 edition of the Southern Conference Women's Basketball Championship is scheduled for March 7-10 in Asheville, N.C. All 10 conference squads will compete in the event, with the winner taking the league's automatic bid to the 2014 NCAA Tournament. Last season, No. 1 seed Chattanooga swept through the event to win its 14th SoCon title. The Mocs, seeded 11th in the NCAA Tournament, fell to No. 6 seed Nebraska 73-59 in the national event's first round.

APPROACHING 1,000...

Stevenson entered the new campaign within reach of becoming the 23rd player in program history to score 1,000 career points. She sits at 910 points - 90 away from entering into the record books. Here is a look at all the 1,000-point scorers in UNCG women's basketball history:

For her efforts at the Fordham Holiday Classic, Stevenson was named to the all-tournament team. She averaged 13.0 points and 5.5 rebounds in games against Fordham and Tulsa while making 12 of 20 shots from the field (.600).

NEW SPARTANS...

UNCG head coach Wendy Palmer welcomes four new members to the Spartan women's basketball family next season. Below is a look at the new faces joining the program next year:

Keli Foster, Guard, 5-7, Hampton, Va. (Bethel)

Foster averaged 10.4 points, 3.4 rebounds, 4.9 assists and 4.1 steals per game her junior campaign at Bethel High School, earning first-team all-district accolades. She currently serves as a team captain for the Bruins and scored a career-high 24 points in an upset win over powerhouse Hampton High School in January of last season. Foster also excels in the classroom as a member of her school's honor roll and is a participant in the student athletic training program. She plays her AAU basketball for the Boo Williams Norfolk Xpress coached by Morris Smith.

Skye Jefferson, Forward/Center, 6-2, Richmond, Va. (Cosby)

Jefferson was the starting center last season for a state championship contending Cosby High School team under head coach Rachel Mead. She helped lead the Titans to a 26-2 overall record and racked up second-team all-district honors. Jefferson is a member of the Boo Williams Richmond AAU program coached by Max Coats and Mike Davis.

Jayda Luckie, Guard, 5-9, Norfolk, Va. (Maury)

Luckie averaged 12.7 points per game at Maury High School last season under head coach Jermaine Woods and earned first-team all-district recognition. She helped the Commodores to a 21-6 record as a junior and is a teammate of fellow signee Keli Foster on the Boo Williams Norfolk Xpress AAU program coached by Morris Smith. One of her most memorable moments last season occurred against Mount Vernon when she scored 13 points and hit a buzzer-beating layup at the end of double overtime to give Maury a 79-77 victory.

Alison Whitman, Center/Forward, 6-3, Madison, W.Va. (Scott)

Whitman is an impact post player who earned third-team all-state. first-team all-district and first-team all-conference honors last season under head coach John Porter at Scott High School. As a sophomore, Whitman helped the Skyhawks to a 25-4 overall record, 8-1 league ledger and a No. 9 ranking in the state. Scott has finished as the state runner up the past two years. Whitman is also a member of the West Virginia Thunder AAU program coached by Scott Johnson.
