UNCG Travels To Elon Saturday Afternoon

THE TIPOFF...

The UNCG women's basketball team begins the second half of its Southern Conference schedule Saturday when the Spartans head over to Alumni Gym for their second meeting of the season with the Elon Phoenix. UNCG will attempt to snap a six-game skid which dates back to a 74-71 road loss at Georgia Southern Jan. 11. The last victory for the Spartans occurred Jan. 4 at Fleming Gymnasium when UNCG downed Elon 73-62. The Phoenix are 6-3 at home this season while the Blue and Gold is 1-7 away from Fleming Gymnasium. UNCG leads the series between the schools 24-19 and broke a four-game Elon winning streak with the win in Greensboro earlier this season.

ABOUT US...

The Blue and Gold enters the game with a 5-15 overall record and 1-8 league mark after falling to Furman 73-64 Monday at Timmons Arena in Greenville. UNCG cut a 12-point second half deficit to two but could not quite complete the comeback. The Spartans are averaging 63.2 points per game and are allowing opponents to score 72.9 points per contest. The Blue and Gold owns a -1.5 margin on the glass, averaging 38.5 rebounds and giving up 40.0 boards per game. The Spartans are second in the league in offensive rebounding at 15.2 per outing. In terms of shooting, UNCG is firing at a 35.7 percent clip from the field, 32.1 percent from beyond the arc and 68.1 percent from the free throw line. Sophomore guard Lucy Mason leads the team in scoring average at 12.6 points per game while senior forward Janae' Stevenson paces the Spartans in rebounding average at 7.6 boards per contest. The Blue and Gold uses its bench liberally as 10 players have appeared in 18 or more games.

ABOUT THEM...

Elon is 8-12 overall and 4-5 in Southern Conference action after losing a 68-65 decision at Wofford Monday in front of a program-record 1,592 fans at Benjamin Johnson Arena on Education Day. The Phoenix is averaging 65.2 points per game while giving up 69.3 per contest. Elon also pulls down 37.1 rebounds per contest while allowing 40.6 - a rebounding margin of -3.5. The Phoenix is shooting 41.7 percent from the field, 35.7 percent from deep and 66.2 percent at the free throw line. Kelsey Harris is the top offensive force for Elon, averaging 12.3 points per game, while Sam Coffey leads in the squad in rebounding average at 6.8 boards per outing. Zora Stephenson ranks second in the SoCon in three-point field goals made with 41 conversions from deep.

Wendy Palmer (Virginia, '96) is in her third season at the helm of the UNCG women's basketball program. Under her tutelage, the team doubled their win total in 2012-13 and won a game in the conference tournament for the first time since 2010. Palmer also mentored guard Lucy Mason to Southern Conference Freshman of the Year accolades. She arrived in Greensboro after a two-year stint as an assistant coach at her alma mater Virginia. While on the Cavalier staff, Palmer helped recruit and sign a class ranked in the top 15 nationally by ESPN HoopGurlz and coached All-American and national Defensive Player of the Year Monica Wright. During Palmer's tenure on the sidelines, Virginia made one NCAA appearance and a WNIT quarterfinals appearance. Palmer was an assistant for two years at Kentucky prior to returning to Virginia. There, she coached All-American Victoria Dunlap, who was taken 11th in a recent WNBA Draft. While still playing professionally, Palmer began her coaching career at Virginia Commonwealth. In her two years there, Palmer coached 2006 Colonial Athletic Association Rookie of the Year Quanitra Hollingsworth and Krystal Vaughn, who both went on to play professionally in the WNBA and in Europe. Palmer enjoyed outstanding playing careers on both the professional and amateur levels. A WNBA All-Star for the Detroit Shock in 2000, Palmer was also the WNBA's Co-Most Improved Player with the Connecticut Sun in 2004. She was selected in the 1997 Elite Draft by the Utah Starzz in preparation for the WNBA's inaugural year of competition and was a second-team All-WNBA selection that season. Palmer also played for the Orlando Miracle, San Antonio Silver Stars and Seattle Storm in her WNBA career. The Shock's Community Relations Player Representative from 1999-2001, Palmer was the recipient of the Black Legends of Professional Basketball John Isaacs Service Award. Palmer also played professionally in Spain, Brazil, Hungary, Turkey, Italy and Russia, earning another all-star bid in Italy. On the collegiate level, Palmer was a two-time Kodak All-American and Atlantic Coast Conference Player of the Year for the Cavaliers, earning those honors in 1995 and 1996. A three-time All-ACC selection, she is still the Cavs' career rebounding leader and is fourth on Virginia's all-time scoring list. Palmer was the first woman in school history and just the second player overall to record 1,000 career points and 1,000 career rebounds at Virginia. Cavalier legend Ralph Sampson was the other.

LAST TIME OUT FOR THE SPARTANS

Furman 73, UNCG 64

January 27, 2014 @ Greenville, S.C. (Timmons Arena)

GREENVILLE, S.C. – The UNCG women's basketball team cut a 12-point second half deficit to two but could not quite complete the comeback as Furman captured a 73-64 Southern Conference victory Monday night at Timmons Arena. Sophomore guard Lucy Mason torched the nets for a career-high 27 points and also filled up the stat sheet to the tune of five steals, four rebounds and three assists. She knocked down 10 of 17 from the field, becoming the first Spartan to knock down double-digit field goals since Monique Floyd was 11-of 16 at Georgia Southern Feb. 5, 2011. Freshman guard Bailey Williams also netted a career high with 17 points – including a trio of three-point field goals. Freshman forward Jade Scaife led UNCG in rebounding with nine boards (six offensive). As for the Paladins, Brittany Hodges recorded a double-double of 16 points and 11 rebounds. Furman shot at least 50-percent from the field in each half to end up at 52.9 percent for the game (27-of-51). Conversely, the Spartans were 23-of-71 for 32.4 percent. UNCG won the rebounding battle 44-34 and recorded more offensive boards (23) the defensive rebounds (21). The Blue and Gold forced Furman into 19 turnovers and tallied 13 steals while also out-scoring the Paladins on the fast break 14-0. Mason put the Spartans ahead with a jumper 48 seconds into the game before Brittany Hodges answered with a layup on the other end. The score settled at 7-7 after a triple by Williams at 15:38, but Furman went on an 8-0 run capped by a Hodges layup to make the score 15-7 with 13:16 to play before the intermission. The Spartans cut into the lead a little, as four quick points by Mason made it a four-point edge for the Paladins, but Furman clamped down on defense and sprinted out to a 23-13 lead after another layup by Hodges at 9:50. From there, it was the Blue and Gold's turn to make a run as UNCG netted six straight to pull within four once more. However, Furman was able to get into the lane with ease and either score or kick the ball back out for a bucket – pulling ahead 29-19 via a Holli Wilkins jumper with 5:21 to play in the stanza. The Paladins asserted themselves down the stretch and went back up by 10 at 34-24 when Brigid Morrissey knocked down a three with 3:30 on the clock. UNCG was able to keep Furman within shouting distance in the final minutes, out-scoring the Paladins 5-2 to leave the home team with a 36-29 advantage at the break. Mason led all scorers in the first 20 minutes with 17 points on 6-for-9 shooting from the field and a 4-for-4 performance at the free throw line. Hodges and Wilkins netted 14 and 11 points respectively for Furman. The Spartans made just nine of 33 attempts overall to shoot 27.3 percent in the half and the Paladins ended up at 55.2 percent after hitting 16 of 29 field goal attempts. The teams combined to turn the ball over 17 times with Furman responsible for nine of the miscues. UNCG also took advantage of its 12 free throw attempts as the Spartans drained nine. The Paladins were 2-for-3 at the charity stripe. A pair of three pointers by Allison Beasley helped Furman grow its cushion to 45-33 early in the second stanza, but UNCG ignited from there, going on an 11-2 run capped by a Williams three to draw within 47-44 and force a Paladin timeout at 14:02. The Spartans were within 49-47 after a Williams jumper from the top of the key, but five-straight points by Sarah Durdaller extended the Furman edge back to 54-47. The run continued for the home side and a layup by Wilkins made the score 62-49 with 8:36 remaining. UNCG sliced its deficit to five at 67-62 with under two minutes left, but Hodges converted a three-point play at the 1:36 – effectively sealing the game.

DOUBLE-DOUBLE MACHINE...

Stevenson's recent career-best streak of six-straight double-doubles is a school record. She now has 17 career double-doubles, surpassing Julie Moore for third on the program chart. The school record for career double-doubles is held by Melinda Goodson who tallied 24 from 1997-2000.

WELCOME TO THE SIXTIES...

The Spartan offense has improved each year over head coach Wendy Palmer's tenure. UNCG averaged just 49.6 points per game in her first season before scoring 57.2 per outing last year. This campaign has the Blue and Gold scoring at an average of 63.2 points a game.

PLAYING FROM BEHIND...

UNCG has battled back from a double-digit deficit on a couple of occasions to win this season. The Spartans were down 12 in the second half at Norfolk State and 13 in the first half against High Point but emerged victorious both times.

CASHING IN ON THE FREEBIES...

A bright spot for UNCG in the season opener at Florida State was its performance at the free throw line. The Spartans were 14-for-18 at the stripe led by a pair of freshman in Jade Scaife and Shanese Harris who combined to make 11 of 12 attempts. UNCG is shooting 68.1 percent at the charity stripe this season

USUALLY GOOD FOR THREE...

UNCG has nailed at least one three-point field goal in 224 of its last 226 games and 23 straight. The Spartans owned a streak of 155-straight contests with a triple until they went 0-6 at Wofford Dec. 17, 2011.

SOCON FRESHMAN OF THE YEAR...

Freshman guard Lucy Mason was selected the 2013 Southern Conference Freshman of the Year by the league's media members. She is the first Spartan to earn league freshman of the year accolades since Kristen Boone was recognized during the 2004-05 campaign and the first to garner a spot on the all-freshman team since teammate Janae' Stevenson in 2010-11. Mason paced the Spartans this season in scoring at 12.5 points per game and three-point field goals made with 35 while also averaging in double figures in SoCon play at 10.4 points per contest. She started every game for UNCG in 2012-13 and was the highest scoring rookie in the league by a full six points in all games and by three points in league contests.

STUFFED...

Stevenson is rapidly moving her way up the UNCG career blocked shots list. As a freshman, she swatted 36 shots, the fourth-most in a single season in school history. She did two better with 38 blocked shots her sophomore campaign. With 116 to her credit now, she is second in program career history. Should she maintain her current pace, Stevenson should be able to surpass UNCG's career record of 121 by Rebecca Viverette (1994-98) by the time her days in a Spartan uniform are over.

JUST FINE IN FLEMING...

UNCG has been historically successful in Fleming Gym, posting a 202-100 (.669) mark at the venue. In 23 years, UNCG has had just five losing seasons in the facility. The playing surface was christened Lynne Agee Court in honor of the former UNCG coach, who retired in March 2011 after 30 years at the helm. SOUTHERN CONFERENCE: THE 17TH SEASON...

UNCG is in its 17th season as a basketball member of the Southern Conference. Starting in 1997, the Spartans became eligible to compete for the league title after making their transition to Division I status as a member of the Big South Conference. UNCG owns two regular season championships (1998-99 and 2001-02) and one tournament title (1998) which led to the program's only NCAA Tournament appearance. The Blue and Gold also qualified for the WNIT at the conclusion of the 2001-02 campaign. Below is a closer look at UNCG's history in the league.

2014 SOUTHERN CONFERENCE CHAMPIONSHIP...

The 2014 edition of the Southern Conference Women's Basketball Championship is scheduled for March 7-10 in Asheville, N.C. All 10 conference squads will compete in the event, with the winner taking the league's automatic bid to the 2014 NCAA Tournament. Last season, No. 1 seed Chattanooga swept through the event to win its 14th SoCon title. The Mocs, seeded 11th in the NCAA Tournament, fell to No. 6 seed Nebraska 73-59 in the national event's first round.

APPROACHING 1,000...

The Spartans put five players in double figures offensively in the win over Triad rival High Point, marking the first time that had happened for UNCG since Nov. 24, 2008 - also against the Panthers.

ALL-TOURNAMENT...

For her efforts at the Fordham Holiday Classic, Stevenson was named to the all-tournament team. She averaged 13.0 points and 5.5 rebounds in games against Fordham and Tulsa while making 12 of 20 shots from the field (.600).

OVERTIME NOT THE RIGHT TIME...

With the overtime loss at Wofford, the Spartans have lost five of their last seven overtime contests dating back to the 2008-09 season.

NEW SPARTANS...

UNCG head coach Wendy Palmer welcomes four new members to the Spartan women's basketball family next season. Below is a look at the new faces joining the program next year:

Keli Foster, Guard, 5-7, Hampton, Va. (Bethel)

Foster averaged 10.4 points, 3.4 rebounds, 4.9 assists and 4.1 steals per game her junior campaign at Bethel High School, earning first-team all-district accolades. She currently serves as a team captain for the Bruins and scored a career-high 24 points in an upset win over powerhouse Hampton High School in January of last season. Foster also excels in the classroom as a member of her school's honor roll and is a participant in the student athletic training program. She plays her AAU basketball for the Boo Williams Norfolk Xpress coached by Morris Smith.

Skye Jefferson, Forward/Center, 6-2, Richmond, Va. (Cosby)

Jefferson was the starting center last season for a state championship contending Cosby High School team under head coach Rachel Mead. She helped lead the Titans to a 26-2 overall record and racked up second-team all-district honors. Jefferson is a member of the Boo Williams Richmond AAU program coached by Max Coats and Mike Davis.

Jayda Luckie, Guard, 5-9, Norfolk, Va. (Maury)

Luckie averaged 12.7 points per game at Maury High School last season under head coach Jermaine Woods and earned first-team all-district recognition. She helped the Commodores to a 21-6 record as a junior and is a teammate of fellow signee Keli Foster on the Boo Williams Norfolk Xpress AAU program coached by Morris Smith. One of her most memorable moments last season occurred against Mount Vernon when she scored 13 points and hit a buzzer-beating layup at the end of double overtime to give Maury a 79-77 victory.

Alison Whitman, Center/Forward, 6-3, Madison, W.Va. (Scott)

Whitman is an impact post player who earned third-team all-state, first-team all-district and first-team all-conference honors last season under head coach John Porter at Scott High School. As a sophomore, Whitman helped the Skyhawks to a 25-4 overall record, 8-1 league ledger and a No. 9 ranking in the state. Scott has finished as the state runner up the past two years. Whitman is also a member of the West Virginia Thunder AAU program coached by Scott Johnson.
